Synopsis: Information received, RALPH BRADLEY, in New Orleans, on 11-22-63 when news of President's assassination announced, someone mentioned OSWALD as suspect in crime before OSWALD came to attention of press. BRADLEY stated that after OSWALD was announced as suspect, he noticed OSWALD appeared to be well-known in New Orleans as being a demonstrator and distributor of literature. Never heard anyone mention OSWALD as suspect prior to time of arrest. Records, U. S. Penitentiary, fail to reflect anyone incarcerated who would be identifiable with DONALD EDWARD BROWDER. Captain ROBERT KENNETH BROWN, Fort Benning, Ga., advised was at home of Dr. STANLEY L. DRENNAN, North Hollywood, California, and DRENNAN stated that the National States Rights Party needed a group of young men to get rid of KENNEDY, the Cabinet, and all members of Americans for Democratic Action and possibly 10,000 other people.

DETAILS

LEE HARVEY OSWALD

On November 29, 1963, HUGH JACKSON, Vice-President of the Cartersville Bank, Cartersville, Georgia, advised SA JACK M. WEBRECK that RALPH BRADLEY, owner of Bradley's Service Center, Cartersville, Georgia, was allegedly in New Orleans at the time President KENNEDY was assassinated. BRADLEY supposedly heard someone mention OSWALD as a suspect in this crime possibly before OSWALD came to the attention of the press.

On November 29, 1963, ~~RALPH BRADLEY~~ advised SA WEBRECK that he had been in New Orleans, Louisiana, from November 21 - 24, 1963, with a group of other businessmen on a business-pleasure trip. While there, he stayed at the Royal Orleans Hotel. After President KENNEDY was killed, BRADLEY said he heard a considerable amount of talk among the citizens of that city and over the news media concerning LEE OSWALD. He gathered from this that apparently OSWALD was well-known in New Orleans as being a demonstrator and a distributor of literature. He recalled seeing pictures of OSWALD that were apparently taken in New Orleans by a local TV station. Since returning to Cartersville, he has commented concerning how well OSWALD was known in New Orleans. During his stay in New Orleans, he never met anyone who personally knew OSWALD and never heard of anyone mentioning OSWALD as a suspect prior to the time his arrest was announced through news sources.

JACK LEON RUBY

Information was previously reported that DONALD EDWARD BROWDER, an inmate of the U. S. Penitentiary in Atlanta, was formerly associated with JACK LEON RUBY in Miami, Florida, in smuggling guns to Cuba.

On December 2, 1963, records of the U. S. Penitentiary, Atlanta, Georgia, were checked by SA GEORGE H. TREADWELL. Records failed to reflect the name of any person presently or formerly incarcerated at that institution who would be logically identifiable with the DONALD EDWARD BROWDER, formerly described as being an associate of RUBY.

Cuba

Captain ROBERT KENNETH BROWN, The School Brigade,
Fort Benning, Georgia, advised that he has been active in
 Cuban matters for several years and during the Spring of
 1963, in connection with anti-Castro activity, he was
 in contact with the National States Rights Party in
 Los Angeles, California.

In connection with this, he contacted Dr. STANLEY
L. DRENNAN, 375 Wonderview Drive, North Hollywood, Califor-
 nia, who was active in the National States Rights Party.
 BROWN stated that once while a guest in Dr. DRENNAN's
 home, DRENNAN stated in general conversation that he
 could not do it, but what the organization needed was a
 group of young men to get rid of KENNEDY, the Cabinet
 and all members of Americans for Democratic Action and
 maybe 10,000 other people. BROWN stated that he considered
 the remark as being "crackpot;" however, as DRENNAN
 continued the conversation, he gained the impression that
 DRENNAN may have been propositioning him on this matter.

BROWN stated that he is a Reserve Officer and
 free-lance writer and has been to Cuba several times.
 He stated that prior to 1960, he was pro-Castro. He
 stated that he related his conversation with DRENNAN to
 STEVE WILSON, free-lance writer, Miami, Florida.

BROWN stated that he was again in contact with
 DRENNAN during the Summer of 1963 and DRENNAN revealed
 he had been interviewed by the Secret Service concerning
 his remarks.

NATIONAL STATES RIGHTS PARTY

On November 26, 1957, a source advised that the United White Party (UWP) was organized at a convention held in Knoxville, Tennessee, on November 10, 1957. An article in the November 26, 1957, issue of the "Greenville Piedmont," a newspaper of Greenville, South Carolina, reported that a "Ku Klux Klan spokesman of Greenville reported the recent formation of a new political party to be known as the United White Party." According to the article, the party was formed at a recently held meeting in Knoxville, Tennessee, at which many Klansmen were represented. The UWP was reported as being opposed to all "race mixing organizations and individuals."

The July, 1958, issue of "The Thunderbolt," self-described as the "official Racial Nationalist Organ of the National States Rights Party" (NSRP) reported that rank and file "States Righters" had merged with the UWP under "the banner of the National States Rights Party" with national offices at Post Office Box 261, Jeffersonville, Indiana.

In November, 1958, a source advised that the NSRP is composed of past members of the Ku Klux Klan and notorious anti-Semites.

Issue #19, dated June, 1960, of "The Thunderbolt" announced the address of the headquarters of the NSRP had been changed from Jeffersonville, Indiana, to Post Office Box 783, Birmingham, Alabama.

On June 17, 1960, a source advised that EDWARD R. FIELDS, the Information Director of the NSRP, is the individual who "runs the NSRP."

The March, 1959, issue of the Anti-Defamation League Bulletin contained an article by JEROME BAKST entitled "Angry Young Men of Hate." Regarding EDWARD R. FIELDS, the article stated, "FIELDS, 26 years old and a Louisville chiropractor, is a key figure in the National States Rights Party and co-ordinator of all its activities, contacts and liaison with leaders of other hate groups. He apparently started Jew-baiting in his teens,

aided STONER in the Christian anti-Jewish Party, and got involved in newspaper notoriety while attending chiropractory school in Davenport, Iowa. There, early in 1954, according to newspaper reports, he pasted anti-Jewish stickers on store windows during Brotherhood Week."

A source advised in May, 1961, that Dr. EDWARD R. FIELDS participated in the disturbance at the Trailways Bus Station, Birmingham, on May 14, 1961, involving the "Freedom Riders" and, in fact, caused the fighting there.

Dear Mr. Hoover:

Lee Harvey Oswald

All men of good conscience must share the responsibility for the horrendous assassination of our beloved President John Fitzgerald Kennedy.

Perhaps foremost among those who should feel the pangs of guilt should be we in the psychiatric community of our nation, one of whose aims is the early diagnosis and treatment of the mentally ill.

The act of assassination itself being utterly senseless, itself was the symptom of mental derangement; and already the evidence being gathered as reported by the news media points more and more toward a mentally ill Lee H. Oswald.

Alas, our country and our world not only was robbed of our president, but his assassin (who might have shed much light and knowledge on himself and on his act which claimed the fourth president to be assassinated), was himself assassinated.

The primary source (L. H. Oswald) having been eliminated, the next best sources are ~~from those~~ who knew him and particularly those who bore him, raised him, lived with him, educated him, and married him.

As a citizen who has been outraged by the president's assassination yet who feels wisdom and not unbridled passion should prevail, and particularly as a psychiatrist who is moved by a sense of responsibility and of guilt for what has happened as well as by judicious fear of what might happen still (L. H. Oswald's family might be harmed or assassinated), it is highly recommended that psychiatric observation and study be arranged for L. H. Oswald's mother, wife, and siblings. By psychiatrically observing and studying Oswald's family, his mother particularly, a fairly reliable image of Oswald can be reconstructed.

Attached are the two reports we have prepared concerning the assassination of the President and the subsequent killing of the assassin, Lee Harvey Oswald, by Jack Ruby.

ASSASSINATION REPORT

This report, in Part I, briefly relates the assassination of the President and the identification of Oswald as his slayer. Part II sets forth the evidence conclusively showing that Oswald did assassinate the President. Part III is in two sections, the first setting forth what the FBI knew about Oswald prior to the assassination; and the second section setting forth the results of our investigation of Oswald's background, activities, associates, et cetera, subsequent to the assassination.

Three sets of exhibits accompany this report. The first sets out evidence tying Oswald in with the assassination of the President; the other two set out documents relative to Oswald's contacts with the Soviets, the Communist Party, et cetera.

We are continuing to receive leads concerning Oswald, and consequently at the end of the report we state that investigation will continue until every piece of relevant evidence has been developed and examined.

The Dallas Office has read and approved the first two parts of the Assassination report. The third part of the Assassination report was sent to Dallas for reading after completion during the early morning hours of December 5, 1963.

REPORT OF KILLING OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD

The report on the killing of Oswald by Jack Ruby covers the actual killing; the information developed concerning Jack Ruby; the interview of Ruby; Ruby's whereabouts from 11/22 to 11/24/63; and the investigation by the Bureau under the Civil

Rights Statutes to determine whether there was any conspiracy involved in the killing.

Attached to this report are two exhibits, one a photograph of the actual killing, and the other a diagram of the police department building basement where the killing occurred.

Due to the fact that no records were kept of the police officers or news media representatives in the basement at the time of the killing, we have not been able to identify, locate and interview all persons who were present when Ruby killed Oswald. We state in the report that persons identified to us have been or are being interviewed. We have interviewed 88 Dallas police officers, and are attempting to identify any others who were in the basement and interview them. An estimated 150 news media representatives were in the basement. We have been able to identify and interview 36 so far, and leads are set out throughout the country to identify and locate others who may have been present. We have no reason at this time to believe that the stories of these people, when we locate them, will be at variance with the facts developed so far, but we do want to locate them so that all possible questions can be resolved.

We say at the end of this report that the investigation will continue until every possible source of pertinent information has been exhausted.

The Dallas Office has read and approved this report on the Killing of Lee Harvey Oswald.

Bob Waldron, Administrative Assistant to captioned Congressman, telephonically contacted the Bureau on the morning of 12-5-63 and advised that the Congressman had received a letter which dealt with the Oswald case and he would like to turn it over to the FBI.

SA Hanning immediately proceeded to the Congressman's office and picked up this letter which is attached. At the time, Waldron advised that the Congressman felt that the writer of this letter was possibly a [nut] but in view of the importance of this case, he felt he should turn it over to us for whatever action we deemed necessary. The Congressman does not desire that the letter be returned to his office.

Briefly, the letter is from one James Breeding of Corpus Christi, Texas. He advises the Congressman that he is passing on this information which the Congressman, in turn, can pass on to Mr. Hoover. Breeding alleges in his letter that Mr. Hoover did him a favor at one time and he has never forgotten it. Continuing, he stated that he had formerly lived in an old people's home in Liverpool, Texas, run by a Mrs. LeRoy Barkslo. According to Breeding, Mrs. Barkslo's husband was a tugboat captain for the Dow Chemical Company at Freeport, Texas. He states that one day they were all watching the President make a speech on television and Captain Barkslo cursed the President and said he hoped someone would kill him. Barkslo's oldest son, LeRoy, commented he would furnish the gun. According to Breeding, ten days later Mrs. Barkslo asked him to mail a letter and this letter was allegedly addressed to Lee Oswald at some rural route in Dallas, Texas. According to the return address, Breeding is apparently living in a Baptist Mission in Texas at Corpus Christi, at the present time. Files have not been checked on Breeding.

On page 7 of referenced communication it is set out that CARLOS VASQUEZ GALINDO, 131 Osage Drive, San Antonio, Texas entered Mexico at Nuevo Laredo, Tamps. He listed his destination as Mexico from San Antonio and mode of travel or documentation is not known.

A check of 131 Osage Drive, San Antonio reflects that it is occupied by SALVADOR and ORELIA GARCIA. SALVADOR advised on 12/5/63, that CARLOS VASQUEZ GALINDO when in San Antonio stays with them. Approximately eight to ten weeks ago he left San Antonio en route to Monterrey, Nuevo Leon, Mexico. He traveled in an automobile of a friend who is not known to GARCIA. On another occasion ANDREWS advised that he recalls OSWALD entering the office at the same time a Mexican looking youth, who appeared to him to be "gay", entered the office. This Mexican youth had a "butch hair cut" which is a very short hair cut and while OSWALD was speaking with ANDREWS, he remained in the outer office. ANDREWS advised that he did not know this Mexican looking youth and has not seen or heard of him since this visit from OSWALD and could not identify him even if he should see him again.

Mr. ANDREWS advised that OSWALD was to bring to his office copies of his discharge from the United States Marine Corps, a record of his serial number and any other papers he had as well as the necessary expense money to enable him (as OSWALD's attorney) to write to obtain the necessary records. ANDREWS advised that OSWALD never brought the records or the necessary money to pay for obtaining a copy of the records and therefore no action was taken by him.

ANDREWS advised that OSWALD came to his, ANDREWS' office the last time approximately July 9, 1963. ANDREWS stated that nothing of importance was discussed and OSWALD did not bring his necessary records and did not bring necessary funds to enable him, ANDREWS, to take any action for OSWALD. ANDREWS stated that he next observed OSWALD on Canal Street several weeks or a month later near the Maison Blanche Building passing out some "Friends of Cuba Literature". Mr. James, whose local telephone is 783-7507, called me at approximately 6:45 p.m. this evening. He identified himself as the Secretary of the "Citizens Committee for A Free Cuba." He indicated that his organization had been operating in Washington for some period of time and that the members of his board of directors include Admiral Arleigh Burke and Clare Boothe Luce. He stated his organization was strictly an anti-Castro one.

Mr. James indicated that his office would be very interested in receiving any information whatsoever regarding the subject, Oswald, who allegedly killed a police officer in Dallas this afternoon and who also was considered as a suspect in the assassination of President Kennedy. He wanted to know if we could furnish him information from FBI files. I told him we could not, our files were confidential, that I could not be of any assistance to him.

Mr. James stated that he could understand our reasons for maintaining our files on a confidential basis; however, it was possible that his office had information on Oswald. He stated he did not know this to be true, however, merely wanted to let us know of the possibility.

I told Mr. James we would keep his call in mind.

BY LETTER NOVEMBER TWENTY SIX LAST TO ATTORNEY GENERAL, ERNEST ANGELL, CHAIRMAN, BOARD OF DIRECTORS, ACLU, ONE FIVE SIX FIFTH AVENUE, NEW YORK CITY, FURNISHED SUBJECT'S ORIGINAL APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP IN ACLU AS WELL AS HANDWRITTEN NOTE REQUESTING HIS ENROLLMENT AS ASSOCIATE MEMBER AND ADVICE AS TO HOW HE COULD CONTACT ACLU GROUP IN DALLAS. ANGELL'S LETTER, WHICH WAS FURNISHED TO THE BUREAU, REFERRED TO TWO PUBLIC STATEMENTS BY ACLU CONCERNING THIS MATTER BUT THESE STATEMENTS WERE NOT FURNISHED TO BUREAU.
