She stated she is known as TAMARA, and had never been called by the name ROBERTA. She said she had never heard of anyone named RAMON B. CORTES or (first name unknown) FERNANDEZ FEITO, and she stated she possessed no information pertaining to the assassination of President KENNEDY (u)

Mrs. J. W. "MARGARET" MOFFITT, 134 E. Dixie Highway, Hallandale, Florida, was informed of the fact that she was believed to possess information relating to the assassination of President KENNEDY, inasmuch as she was believed to have given such indication to the Police Department at Douglas, Arizona, by a telephone call on December 7, 1963, from Florida. (u)

Mrs. MOFFITT stated that she had called long distance to the Douglas, Arizona, Police Department in an effort to obtain a current address for ROY T. RUTHERFORD, who, she stated, owes her some money. She said she was embarrassed over the contact by the FBI in this matter, because she had been joking when she remarked to the police officer at Douglas that RUTHERFORD was "the one who helped LEE OSWALD." (u)

She stated that she had known RUTHERFORD and his family when she lived in Douglas, Arizona, two or three years ago, at which time she worked as a Registered Nurse for Cochise County and RUTHERFORD was employed by the County Fair Grounds. (u)

Mrs. MOFFITT stated that she possesses no information whatsoever concerning LEE HARVEY OSWALD or the assassination of the President, and did not believe that ROY T. RUTHERFORD knew anything about OSWALD or the assassination. (u)

Mrs. MOFFITT, about fifty years of age, stated she had used her home telephone, Wabash 2-4847, in making the call to Douglas, Arizona. She said she was sorry for having caused so much trouble, and that she would not be responsible for such an incident again in the future. (u)

1. Mr. ORLANDO PIEDRA, former Chief of the Bureau of Investigations of the Cuban National Police until the overthrow of the FULGENCIO BATISTA regime on January 1, 1959, was located at 624 N. E. 10th Avenue, Fort Lauderdale. He stated he was visiting relatives at that address and would return to his residence at 5386 Charlotte Drive, New Orleans, Louisiana, about January 1, 1964. (u)

It was explained to Mr. PIEDRA that personal effects of LEE HARVEY OSWALD contained a listing of Cuban exile stores at various addresses in New Orleans, Louisiana, including one such store at 117 Camp Street in New Orleans. (u)

Mr. PIEDRA stated that he had been a partner in a store at that address called the Hispano American Discount House, Inc., which was opened in January, 1963. He said that in April or May, 1963, he sold his interest to his partner, JOSEPH B. NAKER, whom he stated is a United States citizen who had been born in Cuba. He said that NAKER subsequently closed down the store about October, 1963. (u)

Mr. PIEDRA stated that he himself had never had any personal contact with LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He suggested that OSWALD had probably listed the locations of various Cuban exile stores in New Orleans as part of his activity directed against anti-CASTRO exiles. (u)

Mr. PIEDRA stated that possibly JOSEPH NAKER, whose residence in New Orleans is or was 3305 Louisiana Avenue, may have some personal knowledge of OSWALD. (u)

Mr. PIEDRA related that in his contacts with other Cuban exiles in New Orleans, he had been advised that the wife of a Cuban attorney named (First Name Unknown) CUSCO, who lives in exile in New Orleans, had received information that OSWALD had attempted to buy trucks for the government of FIDEL CASTRO. According to Mr. PIEDRA, the wife of CUSCO is employed in an office at New Orleans where the boss of the office had stated that a friend, who is a truck dealer, had refused to do business with OSWALD when the latter attempted to buy trucks for the Cuban Government. FAIR PLAY FOR CUBA COMMITTEE

The April 6, 1960, edition of "The New York Times" newspaper contained a full-page advertisement captioned "What Is Really Happening in Cuba," placed by the Fair Play for Cuba Committee (FPCC). This advertisement announced the formation of the FPCC in New York City and declared the FPCC intended to promulgate "the truth about revolutionary Cuba" to neutralize the distorted American press.

"The New York Times" edition of January 11, 1961, reported that at a hearing conducted before the United States Senate Internal Security Subcommittee on January 10, 1961, Dr. Charles A. Santos-Buch identified himself and Robert Taber as organizers of the FPCC. He also testified he and Taber obtained funds from the Cuban Government which were applied toward the cost of the afore-mentioned advertisement.

On May 16, 1963, a source advised that during the first two years of the FPCC's existence there was a struggle between Communist Party (CP) and Socialist Workers Party (SWP) elements to exert their power within the FPCC and thereby influence FPCC policy. However, during the past year this source observed there has been a successful effort by FPCC leadership to minimize the role of these and other organizations in the FPCC so that today their influence is negligible.

On May 20, 1963, a second source advised that the National Headquarters of the FPCC is located in Room 329 at 799 Broadway, New York City. According to this source, the position of National Office Director was created in the Fall of 1962 and was filled by Vincent "Ted" Lee, who now formulates FPCC policy. This source observed Lee has followed a course of entertaining and accepting the cooperation of many other organizations including the CP and the SWP when he has felt it would be to his personal benefit as well as the FPCC's. However, Lee has indicated to this source he has no intention of permitting FPCC policy to be determined by any other organization. Lee feels the FPCC should advocate resumption of diplomatic relations between Cuba and the United States and support the right of Cubans to manage their revolution without interference from other nations, but not support the Cuban revolution per se.

The CP and the SWP have been designated pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

Pages 24000-24092. Senator Smith, (R) Maine, spoke concerning mail-order guns and included with her remarks several articles from the Christian Science Monitor by Josephine Ripley. An article dated December 3, 1962 discusses the purchase of a mail-order gun by Lee Harvey Oswald and points out that "No one checked his statements or investigated this purchase, the purpose of it, and the need for the weapon until the Federal Bureau of Investigation traced the murder weapon back to a sporting goods, mail-order firm in Chicago—after it had been used, so the FBI reports, in the assassination of a President of the United States." Mrs. Smith stated "J. Edgar Hoover, FBI Director, said only last June that "the easy accessibility of firearms is a significant factor in murder committed in the United States today."

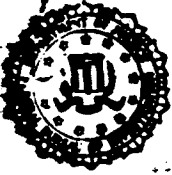
