REBTEL TO BUREAU, NY, AND DALLAS, DECEMBER FIVE LAST.

ON DECEMBER SIX INSTANT, ~~DEWEY EKDAHL~~, THIRTY FOUR FAIRVIEW AVE.,

UPPER NYACK, NY, ADVISED SA JOHN E. FOLEY THAT HE IS THE ONLY SON BORN TO THE UNION OF EDWIN ALBERT AND RASMINE EKDAHL. HE STATED HIS MOTHER AND FATHER ARE BOTH DECEASED.

DEWEY EKDAHL ADVISED THAT HIS MOTHER AND FATHER SEPARATED IN APPROXIMATELY NINETEEN FORTY TWO. A SHORT TIME LATER, HIS FATER WENT TO THE FORT WORTH , TEXAS, AREA, WHERE HE WAS EMPLOYED BY EBASCO SERVICES OF NYC. HIS FATHER OCCASIONALLY RETURNED TO THE NYC AREA AFTER THAT TIME, AND ON ONE OCCASION TOLD HIM THAT HE HAD REMARRIED. HE NEVER KNEW THE NAME OF HIS FATHER-S SECOND WIFE OR ANYTHING ABOUT HER. HE HAD NEVER HEARD OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD UNTIL AFTER THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY.

EKDAHL STATED HE IS POSITIVE THAT LEE HARVEY OSWALD OR HIS MOTHER WERE NOT NAMED IN THE WILL OF EDWIN A. EKDAHL. HE ALSO BELIEVES THAT HIS FATHER NEVER HAD ANY CONTACTS WITH HIS SECOND WIFE OR ANY OF HER CHILDREN AFTER NINETEEN FORTY EIGHT.

EKDAHL ADVISED THAT HE WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO FURNISH THE ADDRESSES OF HIS FATHER FROM NINETEEN FORTY FIVE TO FORTYEIGHT.

HORTINCIA REYES, ONE THREE FOUR FOUR TWO WESTERN AVENUE, BLUE ISLAND, ILLINOIS, OWNER OF THIS PROPERTY, ADVISED THAT JOSE GERARDO BENAGIDES HAD RESIDED HERE UNTIL OCTOBER OF SIXTY THREE AFTER WHICH HE MOVED TO CHICAGO, ILLINOIS. SHE HAD HEARD AT ONE TIME AFTER HE HAD LEFT THAT HE HAD GONE TO MEXICO. SHE STATED THAT HE IS MARRIED AND HIS WIFE/S MAIDEN NAME IS GARCIA, A SISTER OF ALEXANDER GARCIA, WHO RESIDES AT MONTEREY ONE ONE SIX ZERO NUEVO LAREDO TAMAULIPES, MEXICO. This memo discusses the question of dissemination of reports in the captioned case.

Four reports have been received from the Dallas Office since the assassination which totaled approximately 2500 pages. In addition, we have already received approximately 145 reports from auxiliary offices and, of course, many more will be received. These reports contain pertinent information pertaining to the captioned individual and the investigation of him after the assassination but in addition contain the results of coverage of dozens and dozens of false leads, hoaxes and allegations. Some of the material contained in the reports includes nonspecific-type data concerning statements made by persons who were opposed to President Kennedy and his Administration, data alleging that persons or groups are in possession of firearms and may be a threat to the security of President Johnson or other public figures and data pertaining to mental cases who might possibly be considered dangerous. Such material was previously forwarded to the Bureau by teletype and/or letterhead memo and disseminated locally as well as at the Bureau to the Secret Service.

In view of the fact that we are making reports to the Commission which was created to investigate the assassination it is not believed necessary or desirable that we automatically disseminate all of these investigative reports in the captioned case to the Secret Service. Unless advised to the contrary we will take the following action:

1. Screen each report for specific information re any person or group who might be considered dangerous and a possible threat to Government officials and establish that this information has previously been disseminated to the Secret Service. (If any instances are noted where no prior dissemination has been made, it will be disseminated promptly. If the report consists entirely of such data, the entire report
