MARINA HARVEY OSWALD, AKA, IS DASH R DASH CUBA.

MARINA OSWALD WAS INTERVIEWED TODAY. SHE ADVISED SHE DOES NOT RECALL WHEN OSWALD BOUGHT SUBJECT RIFLE NOR DID SHE KNOW WHERE HE OBTAINED THE RIFLE UNTIL SHE FOUND OUT FROM PUBLICITY RESULTING FROM ASSASSINATION. SHE KNOWS OSWALD HAD THE RIFLE AT THE HEELY ADDRESS BUT DOES NOT KNOW HOW IT WAS TRANSPORTED TO NEW ORLEANS. OSWALD LEFT FOR NEW ORLEANS ABOUT TWO WEEKS BEFORE SHE DID. HE PACKED SEVERAL BOXES OF BELONGINGS WHICH HE SENT TO NEW ORLEANS VIA BUS THE DAY BEFORE HE LEFT. OTHER THINGS HE PACKED AND LEFT WITH MARINA, WHO STAYED AT THE PAINE RESIDENCE. SHE DOES NOT KNOW IF THE RIFLE WAS IN THE EFFECTS LEFT WITH HER OR THE EFFECTS SENT TO NEW ORLEANS BY OSWALD. SHE AGAIN REMEMBERS SEEING THE RIFLE WHEN THEY WERE SETTLED IN NEW ORLEANS. HE KEPT THE RIFLE IN A ROOM WHERE HE KEPT PERSONAL THINGS INCLUDING PAPERS, CORRESPONDENCE. THIS WAS THE SAME ROOM IN WHICH HE DIRECTLY QUOTE HANDS THE CUBA UNQUOTE THROWAWAYS.

SHE DID NOT SEE HIM LEAVE WITH THE RIFLE NOR RETURN WITH THE RIFLE AT ANY TIME FROM THEIR RESIDENCE IN NEW ORLEANS.

HE NEVER SPOKE OF PRACTICING WITH THE RIFLE EITHER IN NEW ORLEANS OR DALLAS. SHE SAW NO AMMUNITION FOR THE RIFLE EITHER IN DALLAS OR NEW ORLEANS.

SHE DOES NOT KNOW EXACTLY HOW THE RIFLE WAS TRANSPORTED FROM NEW ORLEANS TO DALLAS. SHE SAID THE NEXT TIME SHE REMEMBERS SEEING IT AFTER THEY BROKE UP HOUSEKEEPING IN NEW ORLEANS WAS WHEN SHE SAW IT WRAPPED UP IN THE BLANKET IN THE PAINE-S GARAGE. SHE KNEW IT WAS A RIFLE BECAUSE ON ONE OCCASION SHE WAS LOOKING FOR SOME STEEL LEGS FOR HER MRS. JUNE-S OLD AND OPENED A CORNER OF THE BLANKET AND NOTICED THE STOCK OF THE RIFLE.

ON THE DAY OF THE ASSASSINATION OF THE PRESIDENT, WHEN SHE HEARD THAT THE PRESIDENT HAD BEEN SHOT SUPPOSEDLY FROM A WINDOW OF THE SCHOOL BOOK DEPOSITORY, SHE THOUGHT OF OSWALD-S RIFLE AND WENT TO THE GARAGE TO CHECK ON IT AND THE BLANKET SEEMED TO BE SHAPED IN ITS USUAL WAY AND

SHE THOUGHT THE RIFLE WAS IN IT. SHE WAS SURPRISED WHEN THE POLICE ON NOVEMBER TWENTYSECOND IN SEARCHING THE GARAGE FOUND THE BLANKET EMPTY.

MARINA STATELY SHE HAD INSISTED ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS THAT OSWALD BUY A CAR BUT HE OBJECTED THAT HE DID NOT HAVE SUFFICIENT MONEY TO BUY IT, AND, FURTHER, THE CAR WOULD REQUIRE REPAIRS. SHE KNOWS OF NO OCCASION WHEN HE SAID ANYONE ABOUT THE PURCHASE OF AN AUTOMOBILE OR MENTIONED TO HER THAT HE HAD SEEN SOMEONE OR INTENDED SEEING SOMEONE ABOUT THE PURCHASE OF AN AUTOMOBILE.

MARINA STATED OSWALD COULD NOT SPEAK SPANISH. SHE TOOK A SELF DASH STUDY BOOK ON SPANISH LANGUAGE IN RUSSIA AND HE WOULD ON OCCASION ATTEMPT TO PRONOUNCE SPANISH WORDS BUT HIS PRONUNCIATION WAS BAD AND SHE LAUGHED AT HIS PRONUNCIATION. HE DID NOT SPEAK FRENCH OR GERMAN NOR ANY OTHER LANGUAGE EXCEPT ENGLISH AND RUSSIAN. HE SPOKE RUSSIAN WELL. MARINA CAN NEITHER SPEAK NOR UNDERSTAND NOR READ ANY OTHER LANGUAGE EXCEPT RUSSIAN.

OSWALD SPOKE ONLY RARELY ABOUT HIS MILITARY SERVICE. HE LEFT THE IMPRESSION THAT HE HAD ENJOYED IT. HE

MENTIONED ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS THE PRETTY JAPANESE GIRLS THAT HE HAD MET WHILE IN THE SERVICE.

MARINA RELATED AGAIN PARTICULARS OF HER VACATION TRIP TO KHARKOV, RUSSIA, IN NINETEEN SIXTYONE. THE TRIP WAS A VACATION TRIP ALLOWED HER BY THE GOVERNMENT. SHE RECALLS IT OCCURRED IN OCTOBER AS SHE WAS GONE ON OCTOBER EIGHTEEN, OSWALD'S BIRTHDAY. THE TRIP WAS OF THREE WEEKS DURATION ENDING ABOUT OCTOBER TWENTYTHREE, NINETEEN SIXTYONE. SHE TRAVELED WITH HER AUNT AND HER HUSBAND, POLINA VASILIEVANA AND YURI MIKHAILOV. YURI HOLDS A VERY RESPONSIBLE POSITION AS AN ENGINEER IN THE BUILDING TRADES PROGRAM IN KHARKOV. SHE BELIEVES HE IS A MEMBER OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY. ON HER VACATION, SHE RESTED BUT DID NOT DO MUCH AS SHE WAS PREGNANT.

MARINA DENIES SHE WAS EVER QUESTIONED BY ANY SOVIET MILITARY INTELLIGENCE OFFICER.

SHE STATED OSWALD DID NOT CONSULT HER ABOUT THE MATERIAL HE WROTE FOR WHAT SHE THOUGHT WAS A BOOK. SHE DOES NOT KNOW IT AS A DIARY. THE MATERIAL HE WAS WRITING WAS A SECRET. IT WAS IN ENGLISH AND SHE COULD NOT READ IT.

SHE SAID OSWALD FAIRELY MISSED A CHANCE TO CLORIFY HIMSELF AND THAT EVERYTHING HE DID WAS TO GET HIS NAME IN HISTORY. SHE BELIEVES THAT HIS STATEMENT THAT HE WAS A MARXIST IS NOT CORRECT BUT ONLY A STATEMENT THAT HE MADE TO DRAW ATTENTION TO HIMSELF.

SHE VOLUNTEERED THE INFORMATION THAT THERE HAD BEEN A PUBLISHED REPORT THAT OSWALD WAS A HOMOSEXUAL, WHICH WAS COMPLETELY FALSE.

SHE SAID SHE LAUGHED AT OSWALD-S IDEAS AND THE POLITICAL STATEMENTS HE WOULD MAKE AND THAT THIS WAS THE REASON THEY QUARRELED SO FREQUENTLY AS HE WOULD GET MAD AT HER FOR LAUGHING AT HIM. SHE SAID SHE WANTED A DIVORCE FROM OSWALD BECAUSE OF HIS CARZY IDEAS AND POLITICAL OPINIONS THAT HE EXPRESSED.

CONCERNING THE FAREWELL NOTE LEFT BY OSWALD ON THE NIGHT OF THE ATTEMPTED WALKER ASSASSINATION, MARIA SAID OSWALD HAD LEFT THE HOUSE SUPPOSEDLY TO ATTEND A TYPEWRITING CLAS. WHEN HE HAD NOT RETURNED AT ABOUT TEN O-CLOCK SHE BECAME WORRIED AND WENT INTO THE ROOM WHERE HE KEPT HIS PERSONAL PAPERS AND EFFECTS. SHE BELIEVES SHE WENT TO THIS

FROM THROUGH INTUITION. ON TOP OF A LITTLE END TABLE SHE FOUND THE NOTE AND THE KEY TO THE MAIL BOX. WHEN SHE READ THE NOTE QUOTE HER HAIR STOOD UP UNQUOTE. SHE COULD NOT UNDERSTAND WHAT OSWALD MEANT BY HIS REFERENCE TO BEING TAKEN A PRISONER. IN HER MIND THERE WAS A DEFINITE CONNECTION BETWEEN THE NOTE AND OSWALD'S TARDINESS IN RETURNING HOME. SHE DID NOT KNOW WHAT TO DO OR TO WHOM TO DO AS SHE DID NOT SPEAK ENGLISH. SHE WALKED AROUND THE APARTMENT, BATHED HER DAUGHTER JUNE, AND WAITED. SHE DOES NOT RECALL EXACTLY WHAT SHE DID WITH THE NOTE ON THE EVENING OF THE ATTEMPTED KENNEDY ASSASSINATION BUT RECALLS THAT LATER SHE PUT IT IN HER COCKROON AND IT STAYED THERE AS FAR AS SHE KNOWS. THERE IS NO QUESTION IN HER MIND BUT THAT THE AUTHOR OF THE NOTE IS OSWALD.

Dear Mr. Hoover,

A number of years ago when I was editorial writer for the Quincy Patriot Ledger in Massachusetts I had the privilege of commending you editorially upon the completion of, as I remember, 30 years as Director of the F.B.I. You graciously acknowledged the compliment in a letter to our paper and I am sure you must have a copy of your letter in your files.

In connection with the Sinatra case here in Los Angeles, however, I wish to express a concern that the excellent reputation of the FBI may have been done some harm. If so, this would only serve to make your already difficult job of apprehending criminals more difficult in the future.

The failure of the FBI to keep watch on Mr. Oswald in Dallas has lead to some public disenchantment, I fear. If, in addition, there is a suspicion that FBI secrecy is being used to mask unusual aspects of the Sinatra case on behalf of the Attorney General, a known friend of Sinatra, I believe this would be most unfortunate.

Sinatra is commonly felt to be a consorter with criminals. He also happens to be a strong Democrat and a friend of the Kennedys, to their loss. Chief Parker is a highly respected official.

I fervently hope that the personal friendships of the Attorney General will not influence the position of the FBI in the Sinatra case.

Dear Mr. England:

I have received your letter of December 15th and want to thank you for your interest in this Bureau. We in the FBI appreciate observations from the general public concerning various investigations we have conducted. We also welcome criticism when it is based on fact rather than speculation.

With regard to the Frank Sinatra, Jr., kidnaping case, this crime took place in an area far removed from Los Angeles. During this far-ranging, fast-moving case, some situations arose which made it necessary for us to request local authorities for assistance and man power. In every instance when this was done, complete cooperation was immediately received.

It was regrettable that some who could not be aware of all the factors saw fit to prematurely criticize our endeavors. This Bureau was guided throughout the investigation by the primary desire to obtain the victim's safe return and thereafter apprehend the kidnaper and recover the ransom. These motives governed all decisions in the handling of this investigation. At no time during this case has the FBI criticized any other law enforcement agency.

In connection with the slaying of Lee Harvey Oswald, literally thousands of people come to our attention each year who have exhibited unusual behavior or have expressed unorthodox views. However, it would be wrong for this Bureau to inundate the Secret Service with the names of people unless there was some reason to suspect that persons were potential threats. The FBI was investigating Lee Harvey Oswald. He had indicated through his actions and statements that he

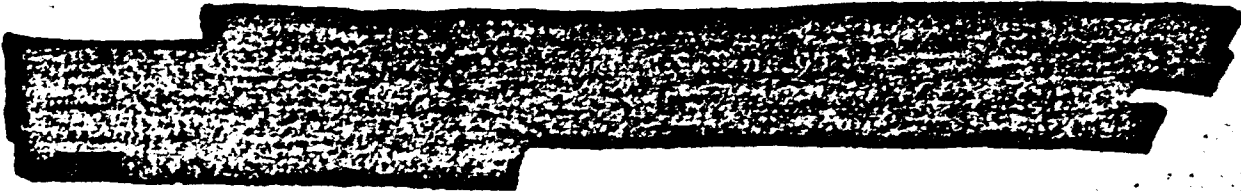

TARIN's wife, MARY ELAINE, was arrested by Orlando PD on 11/30/63, at Orlando motel and was interviewed by Orlando authorities. Car driven by TARIN returned to Orlando and last known to have been in the custody of Orlando PD. MARY ELAINE TARIN was never brought to DeLand, Fla.

On 12/20/63, ROBERT LEE TARIN, DOB 1/15/17, FBI #3840858, presently held Volusia County Jail on numerous worthless check charges and detainer's filed against him by Panama City, St. Augustine, Jacksonville, Orlando and USM, Jacksonville.

TARIN claims has resided in San Antonio since 1920 and at 802 West Mayfield Street since 1943 and employed as a building contractor. Admits incarceration in Texas State Penitentiary, Huntsfield, on 10/22/57, on forgery charge and there contracted diabetes. TARIN claims arrested on peace warrant by San Antonio PD on 1/4/63, and remained in jail until about 9/15/63. He thereafter met his wife, MARY ELAINE, whom he married at Laredo, Texas, in 1962, at her father's home in Altascosa, Texas. With his wife they moved into 620 Essex Street, San Antonio, and within several days thereafter claims he and his wife took Greyhound Bus from Laredo to San Antonio taking with them their three children. TARIN claimed that he, wife and children crossed into Mexico on foot and denied that he had ever had or applied for a Mexican tourist card. Later TARIN said he and his wife had crossed into Mexico by bus and still later he denied that he and his wife had been to Mexico at any time. He claims loss of memory due to diabetic condition and lack of insulin. He claimed he has never lived in Dallas, does not know OSWALD and has never seen and never heard of him until after the President was assassinated.

It appears that TARIN and his wife may have crossed into Mexico in the 1963 Ford station wagon mentioned above since this car was still in San Antonio on unknown date in September, 1963.

The Dallas Office submitted to the Laboratory a blue jacket which was recovered from the Texas School Book Depository on 12/16/63. This jacket was positively identified as being Oswald's by his wife and was submitted for gunpowder residue, hair and fiber examinations.

Several head hairs were found in the debris removed from this jacket that microscopically matched known head hairs from Oswald.

None of the textile fibers previously removed from the rifle used in Mr. Kennedy's assassination could be associated with this jacket and no gunpowder residues were found on the jacket.

A report setting out the above results is being prepared.

Deputy AG Katzenbach advised he had received a telephone call from Ralph Dungan, Special Assistant to the President, at the White House. Dungan, in turn, had received a report entitled "POSSIBLE PSYCHOLOGICAL MOTIVATIONS IN THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY," written by Jose I. Lasaga. According to Dungan, Lasaga is a scholar, a former university professor, and a recognized authority in the field of psychology.

Much of the factual data on which Dr. Lasaga's report is predicated has come from public sources. The matter was brought to our attention, however, by Katzenbach, because of one item contained in the report. This item is to the effect that the author ascertained through very reliable sources that Oswald held an extended interview with the Cuban Ambassador, in Mexico. He allegedly met the Ambassador in a restaurant on the outskirts of the city and they both got into the Ambassador's automobile so they could talk without being overheard

The White House asked Dr. Lasaga for the source of this information. He said he secured it from Angel Fernandez Varela, an employee of the Voice of Cuba, in Miami, who in turn secured it from Salvador D Yerson, who was in Mexico after the President's assassination doing investigative work.

In checking with the Domestic Intelligence Division it has been ascertained that this is the first time such an allegation has been made. Since the author has named specific individuals as being knowledgeable about this reported meeting with the Cuban Ambassador, we should run it out. Katzenbach is giving us a copy of Dr. Lasaga's report which will be reviewed at the Bureau. The Department is also making a copy of the report available to the Warren Commission.

ACTION BEING TAKEN:

If you approve, we will instruct Miami and, if necessary, the Legat in Mexico City, to conduct necessary investigation with regard to the alleged meeting with the Cuban Ambassador.

She stated that one of his jobs was to examine people leaving the Soviet Union for entry into the U.S. and she believes her son may have examined subject or his wife upon their departure from the Soviet Union and have given them her address since she is of Russian background.

On 1-3-64 a representative of the U.S. Air Force advised that Alexis H. Davison, former Assistant Air Attache at American Embassy, Moscow, was discharged from the Air Force 6-6-63. At that time his forwarding address was listed as 431 Riverside Drive, New York, New York.
