## Synopsis:

Mrs. ALICE KAYE, wife of ROBERT KAYE, was located at North Las Vegas, Nevada, and interviewed as to her husband. ROBERT KAYE's true name is ROMAN SOKOLOWSKI and has used last name KLONOWSKI. He left Denver, Colorado, 9/25/63, and Mrs. KAYE has not seen him since. She does not know husband's friends or associates, has no knowledge of organizations in which he might hold membership, nor does she know subject or have knowledge her husband ever associated with subject. On 12/9 and 21/63, she received telephone calls from husband in Tucson, Arizona. Her husband was staying at YMCA, Room 12, 516 North Fifth Avenue, Tucson, Arizona. Registration cards, Tucson YMCA, reveals ROBERT KAYE checked out morning of 12/23/63, and left no forwarding address. Mrs. KAYE reinterviewed 12/26/63. She had no knowledge of her husband's present whereabouts, nor did he contact her over the holiday. Her husband told her he was employed at small machine shop in Tucson, Arizona. He claimed to be moving to a trailer court in Tucson, but advised Mrs. KAYE she could write him at the YMCA address in Tucson. She described her husband as a liar and she cannot believe what he tells her. She will notify FBI in event she learns of her husband's whereabouts.

Mrs. ALICE KAYE, 2411 Crawford Street, North Las Vegas, Nevada, advised as follows:

Her husband's true name is ROMAN SOKOLOWSKI and he has in the past used the last name of KLONOWSKI. He is presently using the name of ROBERT KAYE.

Her husband left Denver, Colorado, on September 25, 1963, at 10:00 AM, and she has not seen him since that time. On September 27, 1963, she received a letter from him which letter was addressed to himself at their Denver, Colorado, address, and this letter was postmarked El Paso, Texas, and bore no return address.

She subsequently learned from her husband that on September 30, 1963, he was in jail in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and that he has had an accident. She knows no details concerning this accident, but he claims he is going to get a settlement from the All State Insurance Company.

She does not know any of her husband's friends or associates, nor does she know of any organizations in which her husband has held or presently holds a membership.

She does not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD, nor does she have any knowledge that her husband has ever associated with OSWALD.

Her husband's friend, guardian, and sponsor, is EDWARD KLONOWSKI, 4621 Grace, Chicago, Illinois. She further advised that to her knowledge, her husband has not taken out his United States Citizenship papers.

On December 9 and 21, 1963, her husband telephonically contacted her in Las Vegas, Nevada, and on the latter date he stated that his address was in care of the YMCA, 516 North Fifth Avenue, Room 12, Tucson, Arizona. He further told her that after December 25, 1963, he would move to a trailer court in the Tucson, Arizona, area, and if she wanted to send him a letter she should address it to the YMCA address.

She described her husband as an "emphatic liar."

AT TUCSON, ARIZONA

The Phoenix Office advised on December 24, 1963, that efforts to locate ROBERT KAYE through the YMCA were made with negative results.

The registration cards at the YMCA reflected that ROBERT KAYE, born December 25, 1934, address listed as 13396 East Colfax, Denver, Colorado, was registered at the Tucson YMCA from December 12, 1963, until the morning of December 23, 1963.

Clerk DANIEL L. POTTER, YMCA, Tucson, Arizona, advised on December 24, 1963, that the day before ROBERT KAYE checked out of the YMCA he called his wife or ex-wife in Las Vegas, Nevada. KAYE had originally tried to telephone his wife in Denver, Colorado; however, this call was completed to KAYE's wife in Las Vegas, Nevada.

ROBERT KAYE, when departing the YMCA, left no forwarding address, nor was it noted whether he was traveling by car.

Mrs. ALICE KAYE, 2411 Crawford Street, North Las Vegas, Nevada, advised as follows:

Her husband, ROBERT KAYE, has not contacted her since December 21, 1963, nor does she know her husband's present whereabouts.

Her recollections, at this time, are that during a telephone conversation with her husband on December 21, 1963, he mentioned he was working at a small machine shop in Tucson, Arizona, as a Brown and Sharp Operator, and that he was to get paid on Monday, December 23, 1963. He also told her he was staying at the YMCA in Tucson; however, he was moving to a trailer court but she could write to him at the YMCA address in Tucson, Arizona.

He also told her that Mr. WARD of Superior Finisher's in Chicago, Illinois, was the owner of the machine shop in Tucson where he was presently employed. Her husband has in the past actually worked for Superior Finisher's in Chicago.

Her husband is a liar and she cannot believe anything he tells her. He does not know how to read or write, and when he talks over the telephone he mumbles; so therefore, she does not actually know if his employer's name is Mr. WARD or just something similar to this name.

During the telephone conversation, her husband stated that he did not have a car and that he was walking on crutches at the present time. He had also told her that he had been in an automobile accident and was expecting a settlement from an insurance company.

The letter her husband sent to their Denver address from El Paso, Texas, contained five fifty dollar bills and a hand written note which told her to save the money.

Her husband had previously departed Denver, Colorado, to see BESSIE MOYEN of Tulsa, Oklahoma. Her husband did in fact obtain a loan from BESSIE MOYEN and this money was obtained so her husband could invest in the Colorado Lending Company, Denver, Colorado.

Her husband's present whereabouts are unknown to her; however, in the event she should learn of his whereabouts, she will notify the local office of the FBI.

The following investigation was conducted in an effort to determine travel OSWALD may have made on or about September 26, 1963, and October 3, 1963.

Date December 24, 19631

OSCAR FERRINO, owner of the St. Anthony Hotel, Laredo, Texas, advised that JOHN HOWARD BOWEN has been staying at the St. Anthony Hotel in Laredo for many many years as he travels to and from Mexico. FERRINO stated that BOWEN is a Baptist missionary who teaches the Baptist religion in Puebla, Mexico, and at present is operating a school for approximately 25 to 30 boys. FERRINO advised that he has no records for BOWEN at the hotel for the past two or three months inasmuch as a typewriter belonging to BOWEN was stolen at the hotel and that he gave BOWEN free rent at the rate of \$8.00 per week for room 108 which is the room BOWEN always occupies until typewriter is paid for and therefore did not enter his appearance at the hotel in the registry book. FERRINO stated that BOWEN is approximately 80 years old but appears to be around 60 or 70 years, is heavyset, bald headed, and is approximately 5'9" tall.

FERRINO stated that he forwards BOWEN his mail each Friday to the address of "JOHN HOWARD BOWEN, Emilio Carranza 4-A Texmelucan, Puebla, Mexico."

He states that he is often on temporary duty at other places within the Army command, however, he did know the SCHILLER family very slightly. He states the SCHILLER's lived at this home for a matter of a few months during which time a new home was being built in another part of town.

Mr. WARREN stated that he did not know the SCHILLER's present address or phone number as he was never that friendly with the people. WARREN suggests that the phone company may furnish pertinent information.

The following investigation was conducted by

AT SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS

On December 23, 1963, Mr. MILTON FINK, General Manager, and Mr. FRED MOEY, Manager, Instrument Department, C. Bruno Company, 1100 Broadway, advised that their firm deals in musical instruments and related accessories. They advised that the photograph of a leather strap which was used by OSWALD as a rifle sling was apparently a guitar strap but was unlike any that they had ever handled or seen. They advised that the snaps on the widest portion of the strap were unusual and they could not advise concerning the apparent purpose of such snaps. They also advised that the straps which they handle are manufactured by the Vogel Leather Goods Company at San Antonio and are available in about ten different colors.

Mr. ADOLF VOGEL, 117 Military Plaza, Owner, Adolf Vogel Belt Manufacturing Company, advised on December 23, 1963, that upon examining the photographs of the leather sling used by OSWALD for his rifle, he could not identify the origin or source of such a sling which he opined was a guitar strap. He added that the metal snaps on the widest part of the strap were unusual and were dissimilar to anything produced by his firm. He added that the products produced by his firm are available strictly on a wholesale basis and are not available to retail customers.

Mr. GENE MCKINNEY, Vice President, Maxwell Meyers, Inc., 830 East Houston, advised on December 23, 1963, that his firm is engaged in the wholesale distribution of musical instruments and accessories. He observed photographs of the rifle sling used by OSWALD and opined that it was a guitar strap. He added that his firm has never handled an item identical with the sling used by OSWALD and added that he was not able to advise concerning the probable purpose of the metal snaps on the widest part of the strap. He was not able to advise concerning the probable source or origin of the strap.

None of the above individuals were advised of the purpose for which the strap was used.

III. MISCELLANEOUS

Date December 23, 1963

Mrs. ANITA RODRIGUEZ DE LOSANO, 102 Felton, advised that she is a Civil Service Employee, employed as a secretary to Colonel WALTER W. MEIVIN, Building 206, Kelly Air Force Base, and remained on duty in her office all day, November 21, 1963, when President JOHN F. KENNEDY was in downtown San Antonio, Brooks Air Force Base and departed from Kelly Air Force Base.

She stated that she did not at any time on November 21, 1963, go to downtown San Antonio, and did not observe any fat lady standing on Houston Street in front of Carl's Store or in the vicinity of the Gunter Hotel.

The following day, November 22, 1963, she states, she watched television off and on and recalls seeing and hearing an interview of the manager of the guest house where LEE HARVEY OSWALD had resided. She stated that she did not recall seeing any fat woman in the foreground or background in connection with this interview.

Mrs. DE LOSANO stated that sometime on Sunday, November 24, 1963, after the murder of LEE HARVEY OSWALD by JACK RUBY, she observed a fat woman being interviewed on television. This woman was identified during the interview as a sister of JACK RUBY. She said this was the first time that she had seen this woman on television and had never seen her in person.

On the afternoon of Sunday, November 24, 1963, she and her husband, RAYMUNDO DE LOSANO, and her parents, FELIPE RODRIGUEZ and ANITA GARCIA DE RODRIGUEZ of 3114 West Commerce Street, San Antonio, met their friends, Attorney ARTURO ALCOCER RUIZ, Mrs. DELORES AHEDO DE ALCOCER and Mrs. ALCOCER's friend, Mrs. MARIA LUISA LEON, all of Mexico City at the Gunter Hotel, San Antonio, and proceeded to Mammy's Cafeteria, Donaldson and Fredricksburg

Hotel San Antonio, where they had dinner. While at dinner Mrs. and Mrs. ALCOCER related seeing a fat woman several times in person on Houston Street in San Antonio on Thursday, November 21, 1963, seeing her on television on November 22, 1963, following the assassination of President KENNEDY while the manager of the guest house where OSWALD had resided in Dallas, Texas, was being interviewed, and last saw this same woman on television on Sunday, November 24, 1963, following the murder of OSWALD by JACK RUBY, when she was identified as a sister of JACK RUBY. Mrs. DE LOSANO stated that Mr. and Mrs. ALCOCER indicated they were almost positive in their identification of the fat woman being identical with the sister of JACK RUBY.

Mrs. DE LOSANO stated that insofar as she knows, Mr. and Mrs. ALCOCER and Mrs. MARIA LUISA LEON were by themselves shopping in downtown San Antonio on November 21, 1963, and were not accompanied by any San Antonio residents at the time they observed the fat woman on Houston Street.

He further advised that all of his business is strictly over the counter, and that he does absolutely no mail order business. He stated he does not keep any records reflecting the names of those persons purchasing ammunition from him.

The following investigation was conducted by SA HOLLIS Q. BOONE at Victoria, Texas, on January 2, 1964:

Mr. EDDIE PEARL, owner of Victoria Army Sales, 401 East Rio Grande Street, furnished the following information:

Mr. PEARL advised that he handled foreign ammunition and after searching his files located invoice number 112630 concerning ammunition purchased from the Sloan's Sporting Goods Company, New York, New York. Mr. PEARL advised that this consisted of two cases of 303 British, one case of 6.5 mm Italian, and one case of 7.65 Argentina mauser ammunition.

Mr. PEARL stated after observing a photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWALD that he had never seen him or anyone who resembled him, to his knowledge, in his store at Victoria. He exhibited the photograph to other employees who also denied that they had ever seen OSWALD or had ever heard of him until the recent incident in Dallas on November 22, 1963.

It was concluded that the typewriting on Qc352 and Qc353 was prepared on the typewriter used to prepare specimens Q232 through Q235, Q350 and Q351.

It was noted that the envelope, Qc352, is similar to the three previous envelopes in this case. It was further noted that the typed signature on Qc353 is the same as the signature on Q351; the date and the postmark of Qc352 and Qc353 are the same as those on Q350 and Q351.

There is no handwritten signature on Qc353 for comparison with the previous signatures in this case.

Q232 through Q235, Q350 and Q351 were three letters previously submitted, all bearing Cuban postmarks.

It is my pleasure to write this letter to inform you that the assassination of President John F. Kennedy was paid for by Mr. Pedro Charles, Fidel Castro's agent in Mexico. This man became a close friend of former Marine and expert shooter Lee H. Oswald in Mexico. They were seen together frequenting various night clubs. The above-mentioned Mr. Pedro Charles had to deliver to Oswald \$7000 as a down payment for the preparations. Later he was to deliver \$10,000 upon completion of the work. In other words, the crime was agreed upon for \$17,000.

Mr. Pedro Charles, who uses other fictitious names and a diplomatic passport to enter and leave Mexico and the United States, is at present in the residence of the Cuban Ambassador in Mexico, according to the latest information in my possession. I want you to know before anybody else, the truth about the Dallas assassination of President Kennedy.

PEREGRIM also stated he was familiar with the name of OSWALD, after having read about the assassination of President KENNEDY and he was unable to locate any reference to him.
