 ABOUT 1952 IN CUERNAVACA, MEXICO, CHAMPION MET ONE FRANCIS H. FIEDLER, A TEACHER WHO WAS WORKING ON THESIS AND WHO IS CURRENTLY RESIDING NEW ORLEANS. CHAMPION HAS HAD INTERMITTENT CONTACTS WITH FIEDLER SINCE THAT TIME.

ON JANUARY 1, 1963, CHAMPION WAS CONTACTED AT HIS HOME IN DONNA, TEXAS, BY 2 MEN WHO SAID THEY WERE FRIENDS OF FIEDLER. ONE OF THESE MEN WAS JACK J. FRAZIER, RYDER COFFEE HOUSE, 910 NORTH RAMPART STREET, NEW ORLEANS. AFTER SEEING THE PUBLICITY ON THE KENNEDY ASSASSINATION, CHAMPION IS CONVINCED THE OTHER MAN WAS LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

PURPOSE OF VISIT OF TWO MEN TO CHAMPION WAS TO REQUEST PERMISSION TO LEAVE THEIR SMALL FOREIGN CAR, POSSIBLY VOLKSWAGEN OR RENAULT, AT CHAMPION'S HOME WHILE THEY VISITED MEXICO AND TO OBTAIN INFORMATION ABOUT MEXICO FROM CHAMPION. LATTER RECOMMENDED TAMPICO AND THEY DEPARTED, LEAVING CAR AT CHAMPION'S HOUSE IN DONNA.

LASAGA, 2340 N.E. 7TH AVE. APARTMENT 4, MIAMI. LASAGA CLAIMS TO BE CHIEF CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST, CATHOLIC WELFARE SERVICE, MIAMI. HIS SPECULATIVE PAPER ATTEMPTS TO ESTABLISH THAT THE MOTIVATION OF OSWALD IN ASSASSINATION WAS CASTRO OR A CASTRO AGENT AND THAT OSWALD WAS MOTIVATED DURING HIS TRIP TO MEXICO BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 27 AND OCTOBER 2 LAST. NEIGHBOR OF LASAGA ADVISES HE WILL BE AT FOLLOWING ADDRESS FOR ANOTHER WEEK. CARE OF ANTONIO LASAGA, 6306 HALLRAN RD., FALLS CHURCH, VA., TELEPHONE 481-7322.

SALVADOR DIAZ VERNON INTERVIEWED JANUARY 4 AT MIAMI. HE IS FORMER NEWSPAPERMAN AND POLICE OFFICIAL IN CUBA WHO BECAME EXILED IN MARCH 1959. DIAZ IS KNOWN TO MIAMI OFFICE AND IS REGARDED AS PERSON OF RELIABLE CHARACTER. DIAZ STATED HE WENT FROM MIAMI TO MEXICO CITY ON NOVEMBER 20 LAST TO ATTEND CONGRESS OF THE INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF PROFESSIONAL NEWSPAPER ORGANIZATIONS WHICH LASTED UNTIL NOVEMBER 29 LAST. ON NIGHT OF NOVEMBER 25 HE WAS PRESENT AT OFFICES OF NEWSPAPER EXCELSIOR IN MEXICO CITY AND LEARNED THAT THE MEXICAN FEDERAL POLICE HAD ARRESTED SYLVIA DURAN, A MEXICAN EMPLOYED IN THE CUBAN EMBASSY IN MEXICO CITY. Handwritten notes and signatures in the top right corner, including a large '0' and various scribbles.

Reference is made to the memorandum dated 1/3/64, from Mr. Rosen to Mr. Belmont in the above-captioned matter. Memorandum set forth a statement in an article in the 12/30/63, issue of the "U. S. News and World Report" to the effect that a hole was found in the Presidential car's floor pan which speculation has indicated is a bullet hole. Allegedly this was discovered when the car was sent to Detroit to be "armor-plated." Liaison was requested to check with Secret Service to obtain details concerning the examination of the vehicle and details concerning the alleged "bullet hole" in the floor pan of the car.

On 1/6/64, Liaison Agent Bartlett discussed instant matter with Mr. Robert E. Bouck, Special Agent in Charge, Protective Research Section, U. S. Secret Service. Mr. Bouck said he was familiar with the article in question and that many inaccuracies were contained in this article including the speculation that a bullet hole was found in the car's floor pan. Mr. Bouck advised that this is one writer's opinion and that there is no truth in it. Mr. Bouck said that the car has been thoroughly examined both by the Bureau and the Secret Service and that all data developed by the Secret Service has been furnished to the Bureau.

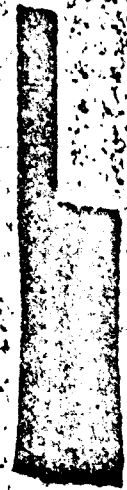

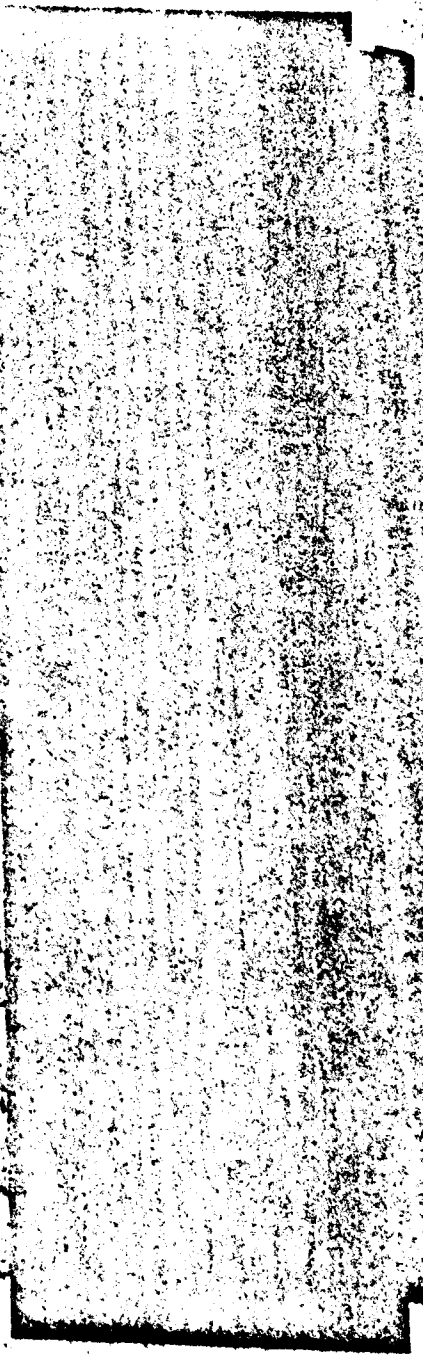

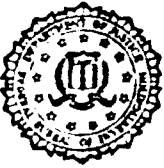

[REDACTED] was born in Spain and fought in the Spanish Civil War on the side of the Loyalists. From Spain he went to Mexico where he became a citizen. He then traveled to the United States and became an employee first for the [REDACTED] and then the [REDACTED]. He is an atheist and speaks derogatorily of the United States. He visited the Soviet Union in 1960 and has also made trips to numerous other countries throughout the world. A peculiar circumstance surrounded [REDACTED] trip to the Soviet Union. When he assumed his position at the [REDACTED] he requested [REDACTED] to contact the embassies of the countries he was to visit to get visa information. He did not request any information about the Soviet Union, since it was not on his original itinerary. She later learned that [REDACTED] had visited there however. U

She cited as instances of this, student uprisings in West Berlin, riots in Bogota, Colombia, riots in Italy, and the assassination of Rafael Trujillo in the Dominican Republic. u

When [REDACTED] left the [REDACTED] he returned to Mexico City, Mexico, where he is in charge of the [REDACTED] and is responsible for the publication of the periodical [REDACTED]. He writes for this periodical under the name [REDACTED]. u

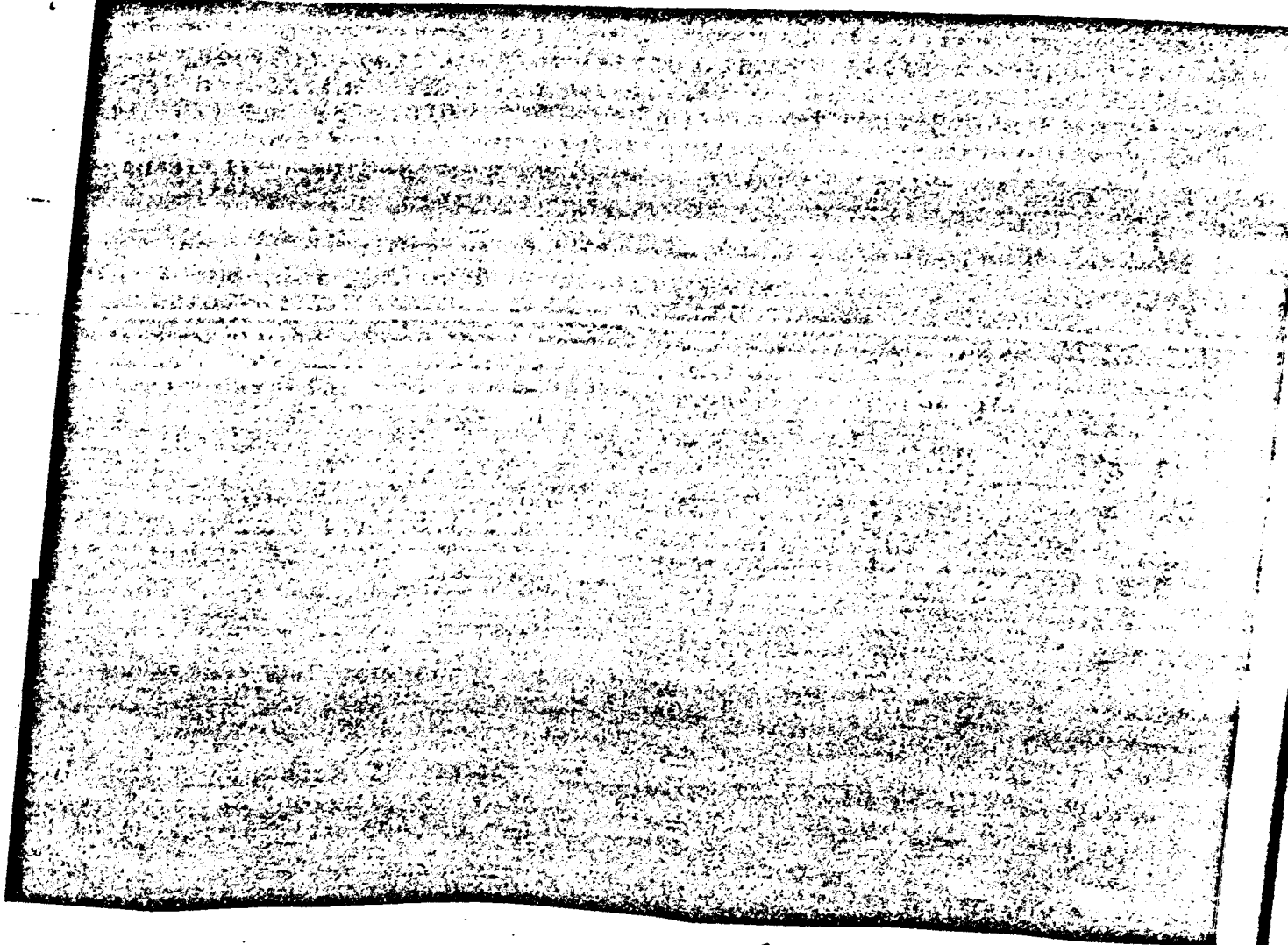
[REDACTED] suspicions of [REDACTED] were not originally aroused when she acted as his secretary, and she defended his name against the accusations of other unidentified employees of the [REDACTED] who classified Pages as a communist. Her suspicions were aroused as the result of an incident that took place in 1961 when [REDACTED] resided at 3625 Ordway Street, N.W. [REDACTED] residence had been marked by a stencil in red "Beware in this house lives a communist." At this same time, the [REDACTED] itself had been marked with somewhat similar markings and the residences of other [REDACTED] officials had been so marked. In addition, the assassination of President John F. Kennedy on November 22, 1963 caused her great concern. While he was employed at the [REDACTED], he also did translation work for the U.S. Department of State. His wife, [REDACTED], was employed at the [REDACTED] as an instructor. Among his acquaintances in this country were Angel Palerm, PAU; Javier Malagon, PAU; Walter Reuther, ALF-CIO; Arthur Schlesinger, Jr., Presidential Assistant and Theodore Sorensen, Presidential Assistant. He was also very friendly with the Mayor of West Berlin, Willie Brandt and visited that city when Brandt was elected Mayor. He is also a professed atheist with a strong hatred for the clergy. u

This proposes that San Francisco (SF) be authorized to afford R. Gallant, an inmate of a California prison farm (forgery conviction) a polygraph examination. Gallant has told a wild story of being the leader of a large underground anti-Castro force in Mexico and says that he met Oswald in Mexico City in July, 1963.

BACKGROUND: *Robert E. Gallant*

Gallant was formerly an Unlawful Flight to Avoid Prosecution - Forgery fugitive, who was located in Mexico in August, 1963, was deported and was arrested by San Antonio on 8-21-63. He is presently serving a 10-month sentence on the forgery conviction at the Milpitas California Jail Farm. On 12-12-63 he told SF the story that he has been active in the Anti-Castro underground in Mexico for the past 6 years under the name of General Roberto Cortez. He said he had under his command a secret army of 3500 men throughout Mexico and that he had a secret agent whose identity he refused to divulge working in the Cuban Embassy, Mexico City. He said that Lee Oswald went to the Cuban Embassy, Mexico City, on 7-12-63 to obtain a visa to go to Russia via Cuba and that Oswald stayed in Mexico City at that time for about a week. He claims his secret agent pointed out Oswald to him in Mexico City 7-12-63.

Unbeknownst to us (on 12-12-63) Gallant previously on 11-16-63 wrote to the Attorney General (AG) stating that he commanded a force of 92 agents operating in Cuba, Mexico and South America; that he had furnished vital information concerning the communist movement in Latin America to this Government and that he had information concerning the shipment of Cuban arms to Mexico and South America. He asked the AG to attempt to free him from prison so that he could carry on his anti-Cuban work. His 11-16-63 letter to the AG was forwarded to us by the Department on 12-23-63 and we in turn referred it to SF 12-27-63 with instructions that Gallant be thoroughly interviewed concerning his statements to the AG. SF advised on 12-26-63 that Gallant has executed a waiver giving his consent to be interviewed with the polygraph.

OBSERVATIONS

Gallant has an extensive criminal record dating back to 1942 for burglary, forgery and impersonation. His wild stories probably have no basis in fact. We know that Oswald was employed in New Orleans on 7-12-63. It is believed, therefore, advisable to afford Gallant a polygraph examination. If he shows evidences of deception, this may force him to recant his statements.

RECOMMENDATION:

That SF be authorized to proceed with the polygraph examination. Attached is an airtel to SF instructing that Gallant first be questioned concerning his allegations regarding Oswald and that he thereafter be questioned on the polygraph concerning his representations to the AG.

On December 21, 1963, William Ralph McKay, A/B, 3337th School Squadron, U. S. Air Force, Amarillo Air Force Base, Texas, advised he had met Lloyd Wilson while stationed at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas.

McKay advised Wilson seemed nice and he had noticed nothing about Wilson's behavior or attitude that indicated he was mentally unbalanced or held extraordinary political views.

McKay advised he was not particularly close to Wilson and stated he could furnish no information regarding Wilson's membership in any Nazi group, racial discrimination group, or any radical political views held by Wilson.

McKay advised Wilson had been transferred to an Air Force Base in Illinois and he had not heard from him since his transfer.

On December 26, 1963, James Lawrence Hodge, A/B, 3337th School Squadron, U. S. Air Force, Amarillo Air Force Base, Texas, advised he had met Lloyd Wilson in the U. S. Air Force Recruiting Office at Spokane, Washington, October 31, 1963, and that they had flown from Spokane to Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, together after enlisting.

Hodge advised he and Wilson were in the same barracks and were good friends. Hodge stated he noticed nothing about Wilson's behavior that indicated that he might have been mentally unbalanced, although he had been suspicious of Wilson's comments regarding a Nazi group he (Wilson) said he had started. He further stated that he had written a threatening letter to President Kennedy while a member of this Nazi group.

Hodge stated Wilson had mentioned the fact that he (Wilson) had been involved with a Nazi organization which had had something to do with racial discrimination in the South. Hodge stated Wilson had quoted Nazi slogans and had bragged about reading the book, "Rise and Fall of the Third Reich."

Hodge advised that Wilson had mentioned living in San Francisco, California, and also knowing a wrestler there named Ray (last name unknown), whom he mentioned seeing at the Cow Palace Arena in San Francisco.

Hodge advised he had never heard Wilson mention the name Lee Harvey Oswald or say anything bad against President Kennedy. Hodge stated further that Wilson had

POLYGRAPH EXAMINATION REPORT

ROBERT EDMOND GALLANT was given a polygraph examination 1/7/64, at the Santa Clara County Jail by SA DAVID E. TODD. SA C. DARWIN MARRON was present during the examination.

The emotional responses recorded by the polygraph were not the responses of a normal person telling the truth but were indicative of an emotionally unstable individual. GALLANT was vague and rambling in his speech, made general statements unsupported by specific examples and manifested the symptoms of paranoia, namely, fixed suspicions (that all political leaders in Mexico are Communists); and delusions of grandeur (that he is a doctor of electronic engineering, and industrial adviser to a Mexican manufacturer, a general in a secret Mexican army, and an associate of Mexican millionaire).

In view of above, the results of the polygraph examination are inconclusive but it is the opinion of the examiner that GALLANT's allegations that he saw OSWALD in Mexico City in July 1963, and learned OSWALD was attempting to get Cuban and Russian visas are untrue.

Result of examination:

It was concluded that the questioned handwriting in Q439, which is on a blank sheet which faces the inside back cover, was written by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, K4 and K5 in this case. The remaining brief notations in Q439 are too limited for an adequate handwriting examination.

The various isolated words appearing in Q440 are too limited for an adequate comparison with the known writings of OSWALD, K4 and K5. However, some handwriting and hand printing similarities were noted common to the questioned writings in Q440 and the known writings of OSWALD.

No indented writings of significance were noted in Q439 and

Q440.

The submitted evidence is retained.

At 1:40 a.m., 1/9/64, Midnight Supervisor William E. Assmus received a telephone call from Leo J. Turck, 25 South Street, New York City. Turck stated that he was the man who murdered Surge Rubenstein in New York in 1955. He also claimed to be a buddy of Lee Oswald who assassinated President Kennedy.

Turck asked that he be arrested in connection with his murder of Rubenstein and association with Oswald.

Bufiles disclose that on 9/20/58 Leo Turck telephoned the Bureau from Baltimore and announced that he was the murderer of Surge Rubenstein and wanted to give himself up. This information was furnished the Baltimore Police Department who arrested Turck. Investigation determined that Turck had no connection with the Rubenstein murder case. It was indicated Turck had in the past placed calls to the New York Police Department confessing to different murders as he enjoyed waiting for the police to come to pick him up for questioning. Turck has also alleged he has received shock treatments for psychoneurosis. (66-3182-5167)

The above information together with Turck's background was furnished to Midnight Supervisor William Ahrens, New York Office, with instructions that Turck be located and it be determined if, in fact, he was acquainted with Oswald and is in any way implicated in the assassination of President Kennedy.
