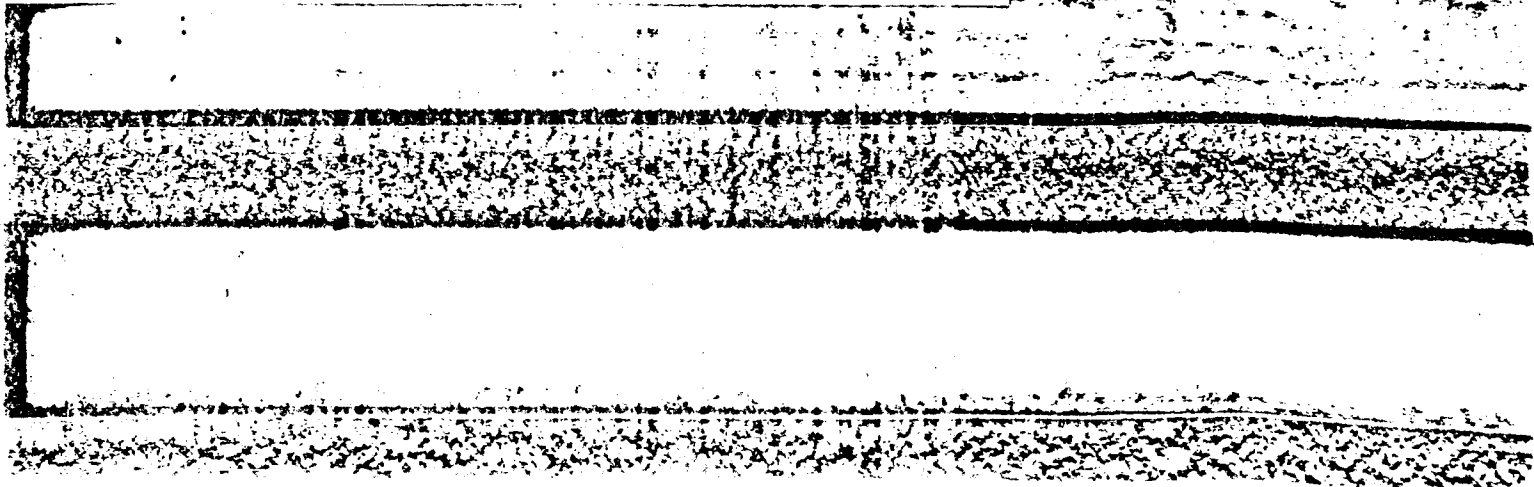
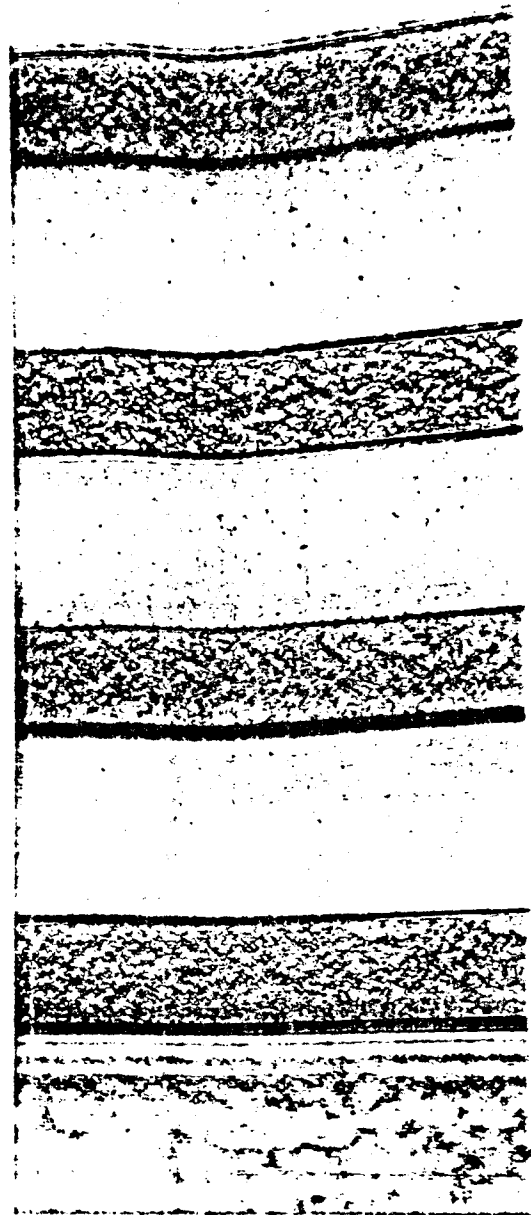

A copy of the following letter was furnished the Federal Bureau of Investigation by the Department of Justice under date of December 23, 1963:

"Nov. 16, 1963

"U. S. Att. General-Robert F. Kennedy
White House
Washington, D. C.

"Dear Sir:

"I am writing in respect to my confinment in the United States, which is located at one Milpitas, California Jail farm, for ten months. I am from Mexico, and whyll I am here confined, my wife and children are without food or money. And do to the fact that just before this jail farm confinment here in the U. S. I have been supplying your Government with vital information as to the Communist movement in Latin American Countrys. Mainly Cuba, Brazil, Argentina and Mexico. I hold the rank of General in the Secret Underground movement in Mexico. Which will over throw any and all Communist movements in Mexico. I am known as General Roberto de Edmundo Cortez, Director of the Secret Army of Mexico. I would like to state also that the Mexican Government does not approve of this movement, for resons do to the fact that its top brass is 100% Communist, both in the Government Party, and the military.

"I sent your brother President J. F. Kennedy, a long letter pertaining to this matter.

THIS document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

"I would also like to stat at this time that Cuba has made the following shipments of arms and ammunition as follows:

"1) Sept. 12th of this year. Landings made at 2:15 in the morning. two large shrimp boats of arms and ammunition to Argentina.

-- "2) Sept. 7th of this year. Landings made at 1:45 in the morning. three large shrimp boats of arms and ammunition to Brazil.

"3) Sept. 9th of this year. Landing made at 1:20 in the morning. one shrimp boat of arms and ammunition to Mexico. Note: to Communist Agents. My information is obtained from my 62 agents who are cor. in the above mentioned countrys. I would like also to mention that I represent 29 million Loyalist in the Republic of Mexico, out of the 34 million the total population, the remainder of which is the P. R. I. Party, the Revolutionary party of 5 million. this party is as your Government recognizes as the Mexican Government.

"In this respect I am asking if possible, to be freed as to carry on my work, which is far more in need to my people and your Government, than confinment here in the U. S. on a County farm.

"I have been risking my life for the last 4 years to obtain information on the inside of the Communist movements and opr. for Communism is like cancer, if not properly approached at the beginning stage, it will spread and claim human life just as Communism will claim the freedoms and libertys of great masses of people.

"If given my freedom to carry on my work, I will do all in my power to aid your Government with the information obtained from Cuba, throughout to Mexico.

"Note: This information must not be publist in any way or form. To do so, it will mean the lives not only of myself, but my wife and children and many more loyal agents.

"My name here in this country Robert E. Gallant. this can be verified by my agent in Mexico as to my rank.

Robert Edmond Gallant was interviewed at the Santa Clara County Jail on January 7, 1964, by Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

He furnished the following information concerning his background:

He was born March 19, 1922, at Claremont, New Hampshire; does not know his mother's maiden name since he was reared in foster homes; graduated from Grove Street High School, Spencer, Massachusetts in 1936; attended night school for two years at Holy Cross College receiving an "E.D." (sic) degree in electronic engineering (1937-1938). He went to Canada and served about seven months in Royal Canadian Air Force, ground training, Montreal; enlisted in U. S. Civilian Conservation Corps, serving about a year during 1938-1939, someplace in Massachusetts, place not recalled; employed for short period U. S. Marshall's Office, Troy, New York; employed as machinist, "Watervliet" Arsenal, Troy, New York, shortly before outbreak of World War II for about eight months. Also worked other unrecalled odd jobs. Shortly after outbreak of war enlisted in U. S. Army, served in 33rd Infantry, Panama until 1942, when transferred to Walter Reed Hospital, Washington, D. C., following injury to back sustained while unloading heavy military equipment in Panama. Claims "CDD" (sic) honorable discharge from Army in 1942, no disability pension (could not say what CDD stood for). Following that worked in cafeteria, Brooklyn, New York, and later for General Electric, Pittsfield, Massachusetts, then held odd jobs at White River, Vermont, until latter part of 1943.

He moved to Houston, Texas in 1943, employed at Dixon Gun Plant for nine months and then Galena Park, Houston, for four months. At this time he was arrested by Texas authorities for burglary, and served seven years at Texas State Prison at Huntsville, Texas, being released in 1953. He thereafter moved to Texas City, obtained seaman's papers and made two or three trips on the Mississippi for the Brownsville Tug Line. In the latter part of 1953 he moved to Monterrey, Mexico, where he lived for seven years, employed by "Trailers of Monterrey" as technical director, and claims he built and set up three plants for this company. In 1960 he moved to Mexico City where he resided until the Fall of 1963, at which time he was arrested by the Mexican authorities and deported to the United States for writing the fraudulent checks for which presently imprisoned. This came about when he returned to the United States from January to June, 1963, and was employed by the D and L Engineering Company, Sunnyvale, California. The bad checks, amounting to about \$2000, were written on this company. He was married in 1960 at Allende, Nueva Leon, to Irene Leal de Gallant, has two children by this marriage. His wife now resides at Allende, but he writes to her in care of her brother, SILVERIO M. DE LEAL, Colonia Anouhc, Monterrey, Mexico. Allende is about 46 miles from Monterrey.

Concerning the letter written by him to the Attorney General, he furnished the following:

About five years ago while in Mexico City, he was asked to a meeting by a Mexican official whom he refused to name, which was a meeting of an underground organization against communism, known as the "Secret Army of Mexico" (sic). When asked to give the name of the organization in Spanish, he said it was the same and rendered it as "Secreto Army de Mexico" (sic). He said he joined this organization after attending three meetings at which were discussed the problems of the Mexican states and he learned that the commanding general of the Mexican Army (he was unable to provide his name) was a communist, as were all the leading Mexican Army officers. The three richest and most powerful men in Mexico were also communists (he could not give their names). The governors of all the States of Mexico were communists (he could not name them except to say the Governor of Monterrey was Levieco), and that the unions in Mexico are 100% communist. (It should be noted that Monterrey is in the State of Nueva Leon).

He said the "Secret Army of Mexico" is headed by ten men, himself and nine Mexican millionaires, known as "agente general;" and that he has the title of General Roberto de Emondo Cortes, which is a translation of his name into Spanish; the organization has detachments of guerillas fighting communism throughout Mexico; that he has a detachment of guerillas under him of about 4000 men in the Coahila area which he commands and trains; that he deals with subordinate officers whom he refused to name; the organization is financed by the wealthy Mexicans and communications are by short wave radio. Also that there are 63 secret agents operating in Mexico, Cuba, Argentina, and Brazil and that he knows the names of 16 of them but refused to divulge any. There is no U. S. activity.

He said that in July of 1963 he learned from one of these secret agents (whom he refused to name) that Lee Harvey Oswald was in Mexico trying to get a visa to Cuba and Russia, and that the agent pointed Oswald out to him on the street near the Monument to the Revolution on Avenida Juarez.

He said he had furnished information concerning the "Secret Army of Mexico" and communism in Mexico to former President John F. Kennedy by letter; that four letters had been written by him in June 1963, and sent to the United States by courier to be mailed in New York, asking that the President reply to him at Cata 68, Dept. 3, Mexico 1, D. F., but he had received no reply. He stated he had furnished no information to any other agency of the United States Government, and it was to these letters he was referring when he stated in the letter to the Attorney General that he had been supplying the Government with vital information. These letters contained information concerning the systems of government in Mexico which were communist, details of arms shipment by Cuba to Brazil, Argentina and Chile; the "general setup" in Mexico itself. He could not amplify the above by any specific details. He said he had included everything in the letters from documents available to him in Mexico. He said the details as to times and dates of shipments of arms by shrimp boat to Brazil, Argentina, and Chile contained in his letter to the Attorney General, which was written from prison, were on a paper brought with him from Mexico when arrested but which he has now destroyed. (It should be noted that county jail regulations do not permit prisoners to retain any such papers or personal belongings in the jail.)

Callant was asked for the names of any of the men in the "Secret Army of Mexico" who could corroborate his story. He refused to name any except T. Manuel Zapata, Avenida Juarez 135-9, Mexico, D. T., whom he described as "one of the bigger men in the organization" who owns land worth 4,000,000 pesos in Mexico, owns a furniture factory and housing projects. This name was in the letter to the Attorney General.

ADMINISTRATIVE:

Interview of HOMOONO ALCARAZ ARAGON was conducted at Mexico, D. F., on 1/22/64 by SA ROLAND E. TRENT. This individual was identified through VON PEACOCK, Acting Director, Friends Service Center, Mexico, D. F., who, on 1/20/64, advised that ANO ALGYZAR, the alleged graduate student at the National University of Mexico who planned to study further in France, was undoubtedly HOMOONO ALCARAZ ARAGON, who had frequented the Friends Service Center in the past.

PEACOCK also advised on 1/20/64 that GUSTAVO ALCARAZ, a brother of HOMOONO ALCARAZ, was at the Friends Service Center on 1/20/64 and GUSTAVO ALCARAZ promised to locate his brother and have him come to the American Embassy, Mexico, D. F., which was accomplished on 1/22/64.

HOMOONO ALCARAZ ARAGON was further identified by [REDACTED] who has furnished reliable information in the past,

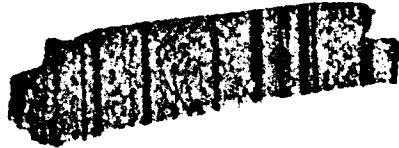

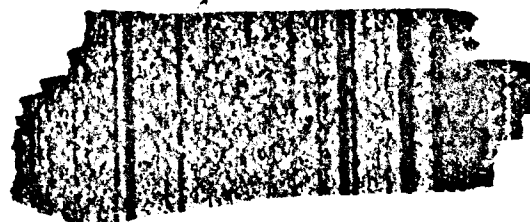
A confidential source abroad has advised as follows:

HOMOBONO ALCARAZ ARAGON, Calle Anaxagoras #232, Apartment #22, Colonia Narvarte, Mexico, D. F., on January 22, 1964, advised that he is a graduate of the Universidad Nacional Autonoma de Mexico (National Autonomous University of Mexico) at Mexico, D. F.; that he has to complete his thesis to qualify for a law degree from this University, and that he contemplates further studies in France later in 1964 on a scholarship grant.

ALCARAZ ARAGON stated that he is engaged to an American student, BARRIE MILLMAN, who attends the University of California at Berkeley, California, and that she visited ALCARAZ ARAGON at Mexico City during the Christmas 1963 holiday season.

During this visit, everyone in Mexico, according to ALCARAZ ARAGON, was talking about the assassination of President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY and ALCARAZ ARAGON stated that he mentioned to BARRIE MILLMAN the possibility that a young American, STEVE KENNAN, described by ALCARAZ ARAGON as a pro-Communist from some city in Pennsylvania, might have had something to do with OSWALD.

ALCARAZ ARAGON stated that he first met STEVE KENNAN in Mexico City in 1962; later saw him in Mexico City

Nacional Autonoma de Mexico (National Autonomous University
of Mexico) at Mexico, D. F.; that he has to complete his
thesis to qualify for a law degree from this University, and
that he contemplates further studies in France later in 1964
on a scholarship grant.

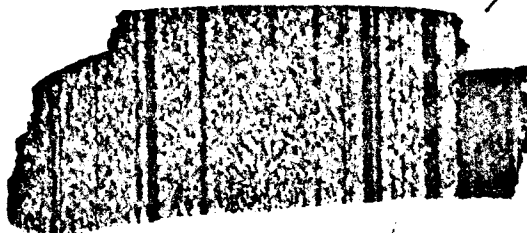
ALCARAZ ARAGON stated that he is engaged to an
American student, BARRIE MILLMAN, who attends the University
of California at Berkeley, California, and that she visited
ALCARAZ ARAGON at Mexico City during the Christmas 1963
holiday season.

During this visit, everyone in Mexico, according
to ALCARAZ ARAGON, was talking about the assassination of
President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY and ALCARAZ ARAGON stated
that he mentioned to BARRIE MILLMAN the possibility that a
young American, STEVE KENNAN, described by ALCARAZ ARAGON as
a pro-Communist from some city in Pennsylvania, might have had
something to do with OSWALD.

ALCARAZ ARAGON stated that he first met STEVE
KENNAN in Mexico City in 1962; later saw him in Mexico City

in 1963, and was first introduced to KENNAN, according to his recollection, as a person who had been in Cuba following the CASTRO led revolution there.

ALCARAZ ARAGON advised that he could not recall who it was who had introduced him to KENNAN, but that it was undoubtedly one of many American students with whom ALCARAZ ARAGON has been associated in Mexico over the past two years. ALCARAZ ARAGON said he had, in the past, roomed with an American student in Mexico City and had come to know many of these students. He explained that names of Americans are difficult for him to comprehend or remember because he is a Mexican national and American names are difficult for him to grasp.

ALCARAZ ARAGON further advised that when KENNAN was in Mexico in 1962 and 1963, it was the former's understanding that KENNAN unsuccessfully tried to secure a visa from Cuban authorities in Mexico City in order to be able to travel to Cuba.

ALCARAZ ARAGON said that when he engaged in the discussion concerning OSWALD with his girl friend, BARRIE MILLMAN, it was public knowledge that OSWALD had been in Mexico City prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY and he said he did mention to MILLMAN that OSWALD may have been acquainted with KENNAN, since both of these individuals were reportedly adherents of the Communist ideology and both had visited in Mexico.

ALCARAZ ARAGON stated definitely that he had never met anyone he could identify as OSWALD in the company of KENNAN, although he had seen other Americans in the company of KENNAN at various times in Sanborn's Restaurant, which is adjacent to the American Embassy building in Mexico City.

ALCARAZ ARAGON examined various photographs of OSWALD and stated that he cannot identify these photographs as being possibly identical with anyone he has ever seen in Mexico and definitely cannot identify photographs of OSWALD as anyone he ever saw in the company of KENNAN.

ALCARAZ ARAGON also mentioned that he had never discussed the possibility of a friendship between KENNAN and OSWALD with anyone other than BARRIE MILLMAN and that this discussion was merely speculative. He said that he and MILLMAN were "chatting" about the alleged assassin, OSWALD, when he mentioned STEVE KENNAN as a person who might have been associated with OSWALD purely because KENNAN is an alleged pro-Communist and was in Mexico in 1963, as was OSWALD. ALCARAZ ARAGON, in summation, stated he has no concrete data which would place KENNAN in contact with OSWALD.

ALCARAZ ARAGON also mentioned that it is rather obvious that BARRIE MILLMAN has brought up his conversation with her during discussions with someone in California which has led to the mistaken belief that he had met OSWALD in Mexico.

ALCARAZ ARAGON, in conclusion, stated that he himself does not adhere to the Communist ideology and that, although he would like to be of assistance to United States authorities in the investigation of OSWALD, he does not have any factual data he can honestly provide.

ALCARAZ ARAGON described the person known to him in Mexico as STEVE KENNAN as follows:

On January 22, 1964, VON PEACOCK, Acting Director, Friends Service Center, Calle Ignacio Mariscal #132, Mexico, D. F., a charitable and religious center operated in Mexico by the Quaker religious organization, viewed various photographs of OSWALD and stated he was certain that OSWALD had never visited the Friends Service Center in Mexico City. PEACOCK felt that he would have known of any contact OSWALD might have had with the Center if such contact had taken place because he is usually around the Center on a daily basis and is well acquainted with most of the persons who visit there.

VON PEACOCK was well acquainted with HOMOBONO ALCARAZ ARAGON and stated he has no knowledge of any possible connection between ALCARAZ ARAGON and OSWALD.

PEACOCK also advised that he has heard that a Friends Society member in the state of Texas had reportedly befriended either OSWALD or the wife of OSWALD, but that he knew nothing about any connection OSWALD may have had with any Friends Society member in Mexico. PEACOCK felt that OSWALD had no association with Friends Society members or affiliates in Mexico because of PEACOCK's familiarity with persons affiliated with this Society's activities in Mexico.

On 1/7/64, Captain JAMES W. MARLIN, Webb Air Force Base, Big Spring, Texas, made available to SA'S RONALD E. BRINKLEY and COLEMAN MABRAY a 35 mm transparency slide, which he stated he took while on a sightseeing trip in Washington, D. C.

Captain MARLIN stated this slide is a photograph of a group of pickets in front of the White House, on 9/22/62, and, upon viewing the slide on his projector, he believes one of the individuals in the picket line to be LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He stated the slide shows a man carrying a sign, "Don't Make Cuba Our 51st State," and he feels this is the individual who may be identical to OSWALD.

Captain MARLIN stated the man believed to be OSWALD is partially hidden behind a man in the exact center of the slide wearing a grey suit and carrying a sign against his chest.

The FBI Laboratory is requested to endeavor to enlarge this slide and review it in an effort to determine if the individual referred to by Captain MARLIN is LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

Captain MARLIN requested that this slide be returned to him after it has served its purpose.

On 1/9/64, Bureau Supervisor WILLIAM ASSMU advised that [redacted] NYC, had telephonically contacted the Bureau and advised that he was a buddy of LEE HARVEY OSWALD. SA ASSMU stated that [redacted] had called the Bureau prior in 1948 at which time he had confessed to the murder of Serge RUBENSTEIN at NYC.

On 1/10/64, Mr. PATRICK O'NEILL, former NYC police officer and presently the Senior Security Officer at the Seaman's Church Institute, 25 South St., NYC, advised that [redacted] had resided at this institute on and off for the past fifteen years. He advised that [redacted] is an alcoholic and definite mental case. He stated he believed at one time [redacted] was committed to a mental institution. He also stated that [redacted] was always confessing to murders and is constantly in trouble with the PD because of this.

Mr. O'NEILL stated that [redacted] moved out on 1/9/64 and left no forwarding address.

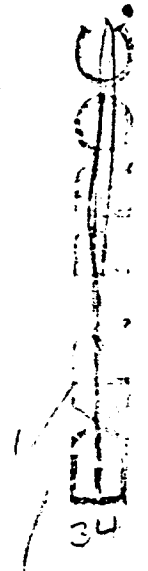
