At the request of representatives of the Commission, the Laboratory has reviewed the cameras ! recovered that are reported to be Lee Barvey Oswald's, as well as an Ansco flash attachment and an empty leather case. Representatives of the Commission asked whether or not the empty leather case could be used on either of the cameras and whether or not the Ansco flash attachment could fit either camera.

These items were reviewed and the empty leather case was found to be a case for a small pair of binoculars and could not have been used for either of Oswald's cameras. It is noted that both of the cameras are presently in cases. The flash attachment was found to contain a camera connection that is different from that used on Oswald's cameras and, therefore, it could not be used without some intermediate adapter. A Minox camera, which has just been received from Dallag and is reported to be the property of Ers. Ruth Paine's husband, was also chocked and found td/have no flash connector for use with a flash adapter.
