MRS. LOVING ADVISED THIS DATE SHE HAD DESTROYED PERTINENT LETTER FROM OSBORNE. FEELS CERTAIN IT WAS MAILED FROM TEXMELUCAN, MEXICO. RECALLS IT BORE MEXICAN POSTAGE STAMPS WHICH SHE SAVED FOR FRIEND. MRS. LOVING SENDS FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION TO OSBORNE EVERY MONTH IN TEXMELUCAN, USUALLY BY CHECK, WHICH IS CASHED AT AMERICAN EXPRESS, MEXICO CITY. ALSO IS CURRENTLY PREPARING CONTRIBUTION OF CLOTHING WHICH SHE SAID CANNOT BE MAILED INTO MEXICO. SUCH CONTRIBUTIONS ARE PICKED UP BY OSBORNE ON TRIPS TO STATES. MRS. LOVING RECALLS THAT IN ABOVE LETTER, WHICH IS LAST SHE RECEIVED, OSBORNE SAID CLOTHING THIS TIME SHOULD BE SENT TO HIM AS EITHER ALBERT OSBORNE OR JOHN HOWARD BOWEN, P.O. BOX THREE ZERO EIGHT LAREDO, TEXAS, WHICH IS ADDRESS OF FRIEND, NAME UNKNOWN TO MRS. LOVING. SHE PRESUMES HE MIGHT BE AT THIS ADDRESS EITHER NOW OR SOON IF NOT IN TEXMELUCAN. UACB, NO FURTHER REPORT WILL BE SUBMITTED.

Dear Mr. Rankin:

At the request of representatives of the Commission, the Laboratory has reviewed the cameras recovered that are reported to be Lee Harvey Oswald's, as well as an Ansco flash attachment and an empty leather case. Representatives of the Commission asked whether or not the empty leather case could be used on either of the cameras and whether or not the Ansco flash attachment could fit either camera.

These items were reviewed and the empty leather case was found to be a case for a small pair of binoculars and could not have been used for either of Oswald's cameras. It is noted that both of the cameras are presently in cases. The flash attachment was found to contain a camera connection that is different from that used on Oswald's cameras and, therefore, it could not be used without some intermediate adapter. A Minox camera, which has just been received from Dallas and is reported to be the property of Mrs. Ruth Paine's husband, was also checked and found to have no flash connector for use with a flash adapter.

The above information was telephonically conveyed to Mr. Howard P. Willens.
