Q494 One 8 mm motion picture film and one 16 mm movie film showing the assassination of President Kennedy which were obtained from Mr. Bert Reinhardt of UPI and which are copies of the 8 mm film made by Mrs. Marie Muchmore, Dallas, Texas

Result of examination:

The assassination portion of the Q494 film was found to contain only 66 frames with an elapsed time of approximately 3 seconds. This does not include the portion of the film taken along the motorcade route prior to the actual assassination. The third shot is recorded in the forty-second frame of this sequence.

Specimen Q494 is being temporarily retained and will be returned to the New York Office when it is no longer needed by the Laboratory.

Re Minneapolis letter to Bureau dated December 2, 1963 and report of SA EWALD I. CARLSON dated December 2, 1963 at Minneapolis.

By referenced letter it was pointed out the discrepancy of information given by Mrs. KATHERINE SHIRLEY HORST and Mr. and Mrs. HAROLD JEROME MANDERY. It was suggested in this letter that the Bureau may desire to resolve the discrepancy of these individuals by giving these persons a polygraph examination.

Both Mr. and Mrs. MANDERY have executed consent to a polygraph examination as has Mrs. HORST.

If a polygraph of the above individuals is desired by the Bureau, an early determination should be made inasmuch as the MANDERYS are constantly changing their place of residence and to this date have been advising the Minneapolis Office of their location.

Authority to interview Mrs. Katherine Shirley Horst and Mr. and Mrs. Harold Jerome Mandery utilizing polygraph denied.

Review of Bufile concerning allegation of Harold Mandery indicates this appears to be a wild malicious allegation based on personal animosity. The allegation has been categorically denied by the Horsts and investigation has failed to develop any information supporting claim of Harold Mandery.

Bureau does not desire to become further involved in personal situations which appear to be based on personal animosity or jealousy.

In the event additional pertinent information is received indicating additional investigation warranted, immediately advise Bureau with recommendations for further action.

NOTE:

Harold Mandery alleged Mrs. Shirley Horst stated following assassination of President Kennedy, Oswald was a communist, some kind of a nut, and would kill the President if he had a chance. Statement reportedly made at dinner party at home of Horsts in Kansas City, Missouri, during course of evening of heavy drinking and conversation. Mention was reportedly also made concerning a Jack Ruby who ran Carousel Nightclub in Dallas, Texas. All

allegations categorically denied by Mr. and Mrs. Horst stating they had never met Oswald or Ruby. Mandery had been employee of Mr. Horst who reportedly had given him a job when in need and investigation revealed Mandery to be an unreliable untrustworthy individual apparently jealous of Horsts who in turn reportedly are reliable individuals. Mandery also has numerous arrests for petty offenses, has been described as an alcoholic and person who might make false allegation against Mr. Horst for spite purposes. Mrs. Mandery also has been described as a person who drinks to excess. Signed statements have been obtained from all persons involved and Mrs. Horst as well as Mr. and Mrs. Mandery have stated they would consent to polygraph interviews. In view of the above, however, it is not felt polygraph or further investigation warranted in this matter.

At approximately 1:00 p.m. today SAC Shanklin of Dallas called and made reference to Bureau instructions to Dallas to interview General Walker for information which formed the basis for Walker's statement that Lee Harvey Oswald had been a member of the Communist Party in Dallas. Shanklin said that General Walker was contacted this morning in this connection and he said he would be glad to be interviewed by a representative of the Bureau but requested that the interview be conducted in the presence of his attorney at the attorney's office. Walker said he would contact his attorney and the attorney would call SAC Shanklin and indicate a time.

Shanklin said he subsequently received a telephone call from the attorney who said General Walker would be in the attorney's office at 1:45 p.m. Dallas time (2:45 p.m. Washington time) and would be available for interview. Shanklin said the attorney is known to the office and is a very reputable and reasonable person. Shanklin said he is a much more sensible person than Walker himself, and Shanklin, therefore, recommended that the interview be conducted in the attorney's office as he felt it highly desirable to pin General Walker down on this.

ACTION:

I told Shanklin to go ahead with the interview under these circumstances unless he was advised to the contrary in the interim; and that it should be carefully handled in order not to make available to the attorney or Walker any information concerning developments in this case.

ALBERT ONCE LIVED LAREDO, TEX., ADDRESS AND OCCUPATION NOT RECALLED. VAGUE KNOWLEDGE HE WAS AFFILIATED WITH SOME CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION AND FULFILLED ENGAGEMENTS, TALKS ON INDIA. AT ONE TIME, AFFILIATED WITH UNRECALLED BOYS CAMP IN SOUTH, POSSIBLY TENN. REMEMBERED IN ALBERT'S INFREQUENT CORRESPONDENCE AND LETTERS FROM OTHER RELATIVES THAT HE FREQUENTLY TRAVELED TO MEXICO, CROSSING AT LAREDO AND EL PASO, TEX.
