Mrs. BESSIE/WHITE, Vice President, Pisgab Home Movement, Pikeville, Tennessee, advised that she has known of JOHN HOWARD BOWEN for about the past four years. She stated she received information through some source, unrecalled at the present time, that BOWEN was a supervisor of a mission in Mexico, and she has been making contributions to be used to support one of the Evangelists. She said that BOWEN is a representative of the Pentacostal or Full Gospel Church and that he reportedly has several Evangelists working under him at this mission that he operates. She said that the Evangelists are reportedly Mexicans and are working throughout Mexico.

She indicated that she contributes \$35.00 pe, month at the present time but originally only contributed \$25.00 per month. This money is supposed to be used to support one of the Evangelists and she receives a receipt each month from the person who received the money. The money is sent to ROWEN, who, in turn, makes the money available to the Evangelist. BOWEN also furnishes a receipt indicating that he receives the money that she contributes. She stated that she makes the contribution in the form of bank drafts, which are drawn on the littst Motional Bank of Pikeville, Pikeville, Tennessee, and these drafts are made payable to BOWEN. She said that these cancelled bank drafts, as well as the receipts, are presently in her possession. She said that she has received information that other persons were contributing to this same cause, but she did not know the identity of any of these persons. She said that BOWEN has never solicited any contributions from her; however, he did notify her that the cost of supporting one of the Evangelist had increased from \$25.00 to \$35.00 per month. She has never seen BOWEN and her only contain has been through the United States mails by letter.

She said that she knew very little about BOWEN, but he has advised her in his letters that he is originally from Knoxville, Tennessee. She does not know any thing about his background but understands that he has been in Mexico for about 18 years doing missionary work. In addition to the money sent each month, the Pisgah Home Mission occasionally sends used clothing and other articles to BOWEN to be distributed to the needy.

Haurice Carlson, President of the Reliance Life and Accident Insurance Company, had previously indicated that former Vice President Nixon was scheduled to appear in Dallas in April, 1963, to receive an award from the chamber of connerce. On recontact Carlson in effect admits he was nistaken in furnishing his first infornation. A check at the newspaper morgue of the Dallas "Morning News" for the period 3-16 to 5-16-63 was negative as to any publicity concerning a visit of Vice President Rixon to Dallas. It is inconceivable that a person of the public stature of former Vice Mresident Nixon could visit Dallas without some public notification. We have furnished the available information on the Nixon incident to the President's Commission and we will have to completely run this out until we are satisfied that we have arrived at the truth.

For the information of Buffalo and Philadelphia, MARK LANE is carried on RI-A of the NYO and is an Attorney-at-Law with offices in Room 1001, 654 Madison Ave., NYC. He resides at 164 W. 79th St., NYC.

The "New York Herald Tribune" newspaper dated 1/15/64, page 7, column 1, contained an article entitled "Oswald's Mother Hires Lane". This article stated that on 1/14/64, Mrs. MARGUERITE C. OSWALD, mother of accused assassin LEE HARVEY OSWALD announced she had hired MARK LANE to represent her slain son before the Warren Commission investigating the murder of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. According to this article, Mrs. OSWALD stated she had been in contact with LANE during his stay in Fort Worth, Texas, the previous weekend. It was also pointed out that LANE had accepted the case although Mrs. OSWALD stated she had no funds with which to pay him.

On 6/10/63, (conceal-reliable in the past) advised that at a meeting of the NYCAHUAC held 5/28/63 at 74 5th Ave., NYC, MARK LANE was elected to the position of Vice-Chairman of the organization.

ON JANUARY 23 LAST EMBASSY, MEXICO CITY, MADE AVAILABLE A SPANISH TEXT LETTER DATED DECEMBER 2, 1963, WHICH HAD BEEN DIRECTED TO PRESIDENT LYNDON B, JOHNSON BY PEDRO GUTIERREZ VALENCIA. A CREDIT INVESTIGATION FOR A MEXICO CITY DEPARTMENT STORE. THIS LETTER HAD APPARENTLY BEEN IN POSSESSION OF THE WHITE HOUSE OR STATE DEPARTMENT AT WASHINGTON, D. C., AND FORWARDED TO EMBASSY HERE FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION.

LETTER FROM GUTIERREZ ALLEGES THAT HE WAS AT CUBAN EMBASSY, MEXICO CITY, ON SEPTEMBER 30 OR OCTOBER 1, 1963, ON CREDIT INVESTIGATION OF EMPLOYEE THERE AND UPON LEAVING OBSERVED A CUBAN IN COMPANY OF AMERICAN CITIZEN. THEY WERE ENGAGED IN HEATED DISCUSSION IN ENGLISH INVOLVING "CASTRO, CUBA, AND KENNEDY." HE ADVISED IN LETTER THAT CUBAN WAS COUNTING AMERICAN DOLLARS, THAT BOTH PERSONS DEPARTED AREA IN AN AUTOMOBILE.

GUTIERREZ, A FORMER ASSISTANT PRISON DIRECTOR IN MEXICO CHARLAND SELF-AVOWED ANTI-COMMUNIST OF LONG STANDING, FINALLY LOCATED TODAY AND ADVISED AS FOLLOWS:

ON ABOUT SEPTEMBER 30 OR OCTOBER 1 LAST HE VISITED CUBAN EMBASSY MERE TO CONTACT FEMALE EMPLOYEE THERE CONCERNING HER

CREDIT APPLICATION. SHE WAS FOUND NOT TO HAVE BEEN ACCREDITED TO MEXICAN GOVERNMENT AND APPLICATION WAS LATER REJECTED. HE COULD NOT RECALL NAME OF THIS FEMALE EMPLOYEE OF CUBAN EMBASSY BUT FEELS MAY BE ABLE TO LOCATE OLD APPLICATION TO ESTABLISH HER IDENTITY AND DATE OF VISIT TO CUBAN EMBASSY IF APPLICATION NOT DESTROYED IN VIEW OF REJECTION FOR CREDIT.

GUTIERREZ CLAIMED THAT UPON LEAVING CUBAN EMBASSY AND WHILE STILL IN COURTYARD A CUBAN WHO SEEMED TO BE IN A HURRY BUMPED INTO HIM IN PASSING. HE THEN NOTED THAT THE CUBAN WAS ENGAGED IN A HEATED DISCUSSION IN ENGLISH WITH A SECOND INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS APPARENTLY AN AMERICAN CITIZEN; THAT THE CUBAN WAS COUNTING SOME AMERICAN CURRENCY OF UNKNOWN DENOMINATIONS, AND HE HEARD THE WORDS "MISTER CASTRO AND KENNEDY" MENTIONED DURING THEIR DISCUSSION IN THE COURTYARD AND WHILE THEY WERE STILL WALKING TOWARD THE WALL GATE OF THE CUBAN EMBASSY."

ALTHOUGH GUTIERREZ ADMITTEDLY CAN UNDERSTAND VERY LITTLE ENGLISH HE CLAIMED HE BECAME INTERESTED AND WALKED ABOUT TWO YARDS BEHIND THESE PERSONS TO A POINT ON THE SIDEWALK OUTSIDE THE WALL OF THE EMBASSY WHERE HE SAID HE OBSERVED THE CUBAN HAND THE AMERICAN THE MONEY HE HAD BEEN COUNTING.

GUTIERREZ STATED THAT HE NOTED THE AMERICAN PLACED THE MONEY IN HIS LEFT HAND TROUSERS POCKET USING HIS LEFT HAND TO DO SO.

HE RELATED THAT HE CONTINUED TO FOLLOW THESE TWO PERSONS
TO THE CORNER ADJACENT TO THE CUBAN EMBASSY AND NOTED THAT THEY
ENTERED A "DINA RENAULT" AUTOMOBILE SOLID BEIGE IN COLOR BEARING
MEXICAN LICENSE PLATES AND DROVE AWAY.

GUTIERREZ STATED THAT IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY, HE OBSERVED PHOTOGRAPHS OF OSWALD IN VARIOUS MEXICO CITY NEWSPAPERS AND IMMEDIATELY CAME TO THE FIRM CONCLUSION THAT THE AMERICAN HE HAD SEEN WITH THE CUBAN AS INDICATED ABOVE WAS IDENTICAL WITH THE PERSON DEPICTED IN THESE NEWSPAPER PHOTOGRAPHS.

GUTIERREZ FURTHER ADVISED THAT ON OR ABOUT OCTOBER 4, 1963, HE RETURNED TO THE CUBAN EMBASSY AND LOOKED AROUND TO SEE IF HE COULD OBSERVE THE CUBAN HE HAD SEEN WITH THE AMERICAN AND POSSIBLY IDENTIFY THIS INDIVIDUAL AS A CUBAN EMBASSY EMPLOYEE BUT DID NOT OBSERVE THIS INDIVIDUAL AMONG THE CUBAN EMBASSY EMPLOYEES.

GUTIERREZ ALSO CLAIMED THAT TWO DAYS FOLLOWING THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY HE AGAIN RETURNED TO THE CUBAN EMBASSY FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRYING TO IDENTIFY THIS UNKNOWN CUBAN BUT WAS AGAIN UNSUCCESSFUL.

GUTIERREZ TODAY EXAMINED 22 PHOTOGRAPHS OF CURRENT AND RECENT EMPLOYEES OF THE CUBAN EMBASSY AT MEXICO CITY AND STATED THAT NONE OF THE PERSONS DEPICTED ARE IDENTICAL WITH THE CUBAN HE OBSERVED IN THE COMPANY OF THE AMERICAN IDENTIFIED BY HIM AS OSWALD.

GUTIERREZ ALSO EXAMINED PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD WHICH HAS APPEARED IN MEXICO CITY NEWSPAPERS AND A FRONT, SIDE, AND FULL LENGTH PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD TAKEN ON AUGUSI 9, 1963, BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AT NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA, AND STATED THAT THESE PHOTOGRAPHS ARE IN HIS OPINION IDENTICAL WITH THE AMERICAN SEEN BY HIM AT THE CUBAN EMBASSY AS MENTIONED ABOVE.

A PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD WHICH HAD APPEARED IN LIFE MAGAZINE AND DEPICTS THE SUBJECT PASSING OUT PRO-CUBA LITERATURE ON A STREET IN NEW ORLEANS WAS MIXED IN WITH 16 MISCELLANEOUS PHOTO-GRAPHS OF OTHER PERSONS AND DEMONSTRATED TO GUTIERREZ AND HE INDICATED NO RECOGNITION OF THIS PARTICULAR PHOTOGRAPH OF OSWALD.

GUTIERREZ APPEARS TO BE INTELLIGENT AND MATURE INDIVIDUAL WHO SEEMS SINCERELY CONVINCED HE SAW OSWALD AT CUBAN EMBASSY ON ONE OF DATES MENTIONED AND TODAY INDICATED ONLY DESIRE IS TO ASSIST U. S. IN STRUGGLE AGAINST COMMUNISM. HE MADE NO MENTION OF POSSIBLE COMPENSATION, HOWEVER, IT HAS BEEN NOTED HE RESIDES IN OLD RUN DOWN APARTMENT BUILDING IN POOR SECTION OF CITY. THE DESCRIPTION PROVIDED OF AMERICAN SEEN BY GUTIERREZ AT CUBAN EMBASSY GENERALLY FITS THAT OF OSWALD EXCEPT THAT HE ESTIMATED AGE AT 27 TO 30 YEARS OF AGE, WITH DARK BROWN HAIR AND VERY LIGHT COMPLEXION WHICH IS AT SLIGHT VARIANCE WITH AVAILABLE DESCRIPTION OF OSWALD.


