MARINA DID NOT KNOW WHO NIXON WAS AND DID NOT RECALL OSVALD EVER MENTIONIN NIXON-S NAME PRIOR TO THIS OCCASION. SHE KNOWS NOW THAT NIXON ONCE RAN FOR THE PRESIDENCY, BUT STILL KNOWS VERY LITTLE ABOUT HIM. MARINA AND OSVALD DID NOT TALK ABOUT THIS INCIDENT OR ABOUT NIXON AFTER THIS INCIDENT, AND IN FACT DID NOT DISCUSS THE MATTER DURING THE TIME OSVALD WAS SITTING IN THE BATHROOM OR AFTER HE CAME OUT OF THE BATHROOM.

MARINA SAID BATHROOM DOOR AT NEELEY STREET OPENED TO THE INSIDE AND THERE WAS NO LOCK ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE DOOR, ALTHOUGH SHE BELIEVES THERE WAS A LOCK ON THE INSIDE. MARINA STATED SHE FEELS SHE KEPT OSVALD IN THE HOUSE BY PERSUASION AND THAT THIS WAS ONE OF THE TIMES HE DID SOMETHING THAT SHE WANTED HIM TO DO.

MARINA SAID SHE TOLD MR. AND MRS. MARTIN ABOUT THE NIXON INCIDENT APPROX. THREE TO FOUR WEEKS AFTER SHE MOVED INTO THE MARTIN RESIDENCE AND THEREAFTER REPEATED IT TO ROBERT OSVALD. SHE CANNOT RECALL WHETHER SHE TOLD ROBERT ABOUT THE NIXON INCIDENT IN THE PRESENCE OF THE MARTINS OR TO HIM ALONE.

MARINA WAS AGAIN ASKED IF SHE COULD REMEMBER ANYTHING WHICH MIGHT HAVE INDICATED TO HER THAT OSVALD WAS TO DO ANYTHING UNUSUAL ON NOV. TWENTYSECOND LAST. SHE SAID SHE COULD NOT REMEMBER ANYTHING WHICH WOULD INDICATE THIS, AND THAT THE NEWS OF OSVALD-S ARREST HAD COME AS A QUOTE 'THUNDERCLAP' UNQUOTE TO HER.

MARINA STATED MARTIN TOLD HER WHILE SHE WAS IN RESIDENCE AT THE MARTIN HOME THAT HE HAD HAD AN OPERATION AND COULD NOT BE FATHER CHILDREN.

MARINA STATED WHILE THEY RESIDED IN NEW ORLEANS ON MAGAZINE ST. TOWARD END OF AUGUST OR EARLY IN SEPT. LAST, AND FOR A PERIOD OF ABOUT TWO WEEKS, OSWALD WAS MAKING PLANS TO HIJACK AN AIRPLANE AND FORCE THE PILOT TO TAKE HIM TO CUBA. HE SUBSEQUENTLY REVISED HIS PLANS TO THE EXTENT THAT HE INCLUDED MARINA AS PART OF THE PLANS. OSWALD WAS TO SIT AT THE FRONT OF AIRPLANE WITH A PISTOL AND MARINA AT THE BACK OF THE PLANE WITH A PISTOL. THEY WERE TO HAVE THEIR DAUGHTER JUNE WITH THEM. THEY WERE THEN TO FORCE THE CREW TO FLY THE PLANE TO CUBA. MARINA STATED SHE REFUSED FROM THE INCEPTION OF THE PLAN TO HAVE ANYTHING WHATSOEVER TO DO WITH IT AND TOLD OSWALD <sup>"</sup>ONLY A CRAZY MAN <sup>"</sup> WOULD THINK THIS UP <sup>"</sup>UNQUOTE. OSWALD SAID HE WOULD BUY A LIGHT WEIGHTED PISTOL FOR MARINA AND HE WANTED HER TO AT LEAST LEARN HOW TO HOLD IT, BUT SHE REFUSED. OSWALD SAID ON ONE OCCASION HE HAD SEEN SOME LIGHT WEIGHTED PISTOLS, BUT SHE TOLD HIM NOT TO BUY ONE BECAUSE SHE WOULD NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE SCHEME.

MARINA RECALLS THAT OSWALD, DURING THIS PERIOD OF TIME WHEN HE WAS PLANNING TO HIJACK THE PLANE, STUDIED A WORLD MAP AND FIGURED OUT DISTANCES TO VARIOUS PLACES. HE TOLD MARINA IT WOULD BE NECESSARY TO HIJACK A PLANE WITH ENOUGH GAS TO GET THEM TO CUBA.

SHE RECALLS OSWALD WROTE OUT TIME TABLES OF AIRLINES,  
ON A PIECE OF PAPER. SHE DOES NOT KNOW WHAT HAPPENED TO THIS MAP  
OR TO THE PIECE OF PAPER ON WHICH HE WROTE THE TIME TABLES.  
DURING THIS PERIOD, OSWALD BEGAN TO TAKE PHYSICAL  
EXERCISE TO INCREASE HIS PHYSICAL STRENGTH.

MARINA SAID WHEN SHE REFUSED TO TAKE PART IN THE PLANE HIJACK  
SCHEME, SHE COUNSELED OSWALD TO ATTEMPT TO ENTER CUBA LEGALLY.  
HE THEREAFTER BEGAN PLANNING TO GO TO MEXICO ALONE FOR THE PURPOSE  
OF OBTAINING PERMISSION TO ENTER CUBA.

MARINA WILL BE INTERVIEWED AT TWO PM TOMORROW. HER ATTY.,  
WILLIAM A. MC KENZIE, HAS INDICATED EITHER HE OR HIS PARTNER HENRY  
BAER DESIRE TO BE PRESENT DURING INTERVIEWS. INTERVIEW WILL BE

Dallas teletype, attached, sets forth results of interview of Marina Oswald 2-24-64 concerning allegation that Lee Harvey Oswald had planned to shoot Nixon in Dallas. In addition, Marina alleges that while in New Orleans 8/63 or 9/63 Oswald planned to hijack airplane and force pilot to fly to Cuba, that Marina refused to participate and counselled Oswald to attempt to enter Cuba legally. He will disseminate by letter to President's Commission.

LEB HARVEY OSWALD, IS - R - CUBA. MARINA OSWALD HAS ADVISED THAT ON APPROXIMATELY APRIL TWENTY FOUR SIXTY THREE OSWALD PUT PISTOL UNDERBATH HIS JACKET. MARINA ASKED WHERE HE WAS GOING AND OSWALD REPLIED APPROXIMATELY QUOTE NIXON IS COMING AND I AM GOING TO TAKE A LOOK. UNQUOTE. ALLEGEDLY MARINA OSWALD, THEREAFTER, FORCIBLY KEPT OSWALD IN THE BATHROOM UNTIL OSWALD AGREED THAT HE WOULD VOLUNTARILY REMAIN IN THE BATHROOM, NOT GO ANYWHERE, WOULD UNDESS AND GIVE HER HIS CLOTHING AND PISTOL.

NY SHOULD ARRANGE TO TACTFULLY INTERVIEW FORMER VICE PRESIDENT RICHARD M. NIXON TO ESTABLISH WHEN DURING NINETEEN SIXTY THREE HE VISITED IN DL, WAS INVITED TO VISIT THERE OR HAD ANY INTENTIONS TO VISIT IN DL. DL ADVISE BY MAIL.

MR. MAURICE CARLSON, PRESIDENT OF RELIANCE LIFE AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE CO., RELIANCE BUILDING, DALLAS, TEXAS, ADVISED THIS DATE HE WAS PREVIOUSLY CONFUSED AS TO THE SOUTH AND EAST DALLAS CHAMBER OF COMMERCE INVITING RICHARD NIXON TO SPEAK IN APRIL SIXTYTHREE TO THEIR ANNUAL BANQUET.

HE STATED EFFORTS WERE MADE TO GET BARRY GOLDWATER, U. S. SENATOR FROM ARIZONA, BUT THEY DID NOT WORK OUT. STATED MR. ROBERT R. PARKS WAS CHAIRMAN OF THE SPEAKERS COMMITTEE DURING THAT TIME AND HE COULD FURNISH DETAILS ON THIS. CARLSON STATED TO HIS KNOWLEDGE NIXON WAS NOT IN DALLAS IN SIXTYTHREE AND WAS HERE ONLY ONCE IN SIXTYTHREE THAT BEING NOVEMBER TWENTYONE SIXTYTHREE.

Re Bureau radiogram to Dallas, 3/6/64, requesting additional investigation concerning a possible contemplated visit of former Vice President RICHARD M. NIXON to Dallas, Texas, in early part of 1963.

A search of the "Dallas Times Herald" newspapers on March 9 and 10, 1964, and the "Dallas Morning News" newspapers on March 10 and 11, 1964, for the period January 1, 1963, through March 15, 1963, failed to reflect any mention of a possible trip to Dallas, Texas, by RICHARD M. NIXON. The period March 16, 1963, through May 15, 1963, was covered with negative results and previously reported on pages 281 and 282 of the report of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING dated March 10, 1964, at Dallas.

On March 10, 1964, Mr. PETER O'DONNELL, 211 North Ervay Street, who is Chairman of the Republican Party of Texas, advised that former Vice President RICHARD M. NIXON was in Texas only once in 1963, that being November 21, 1963. He knows of no invitation or publicity concerning Mr. NIXON in 1963 other than the time he was in Dallas in November 1963. He stated the files of the Republican headquarters do not reflect any publicity concerning Mr. NIXON in 1963.
