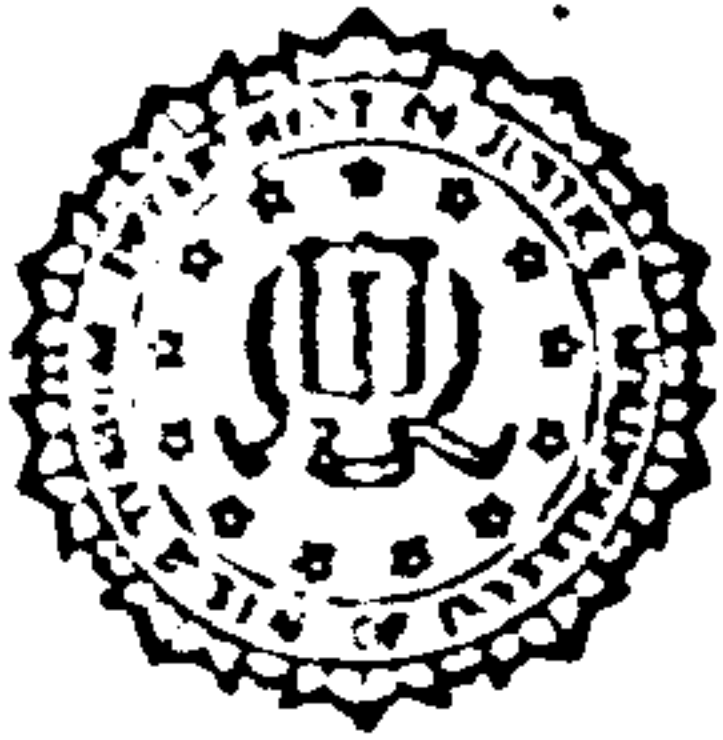

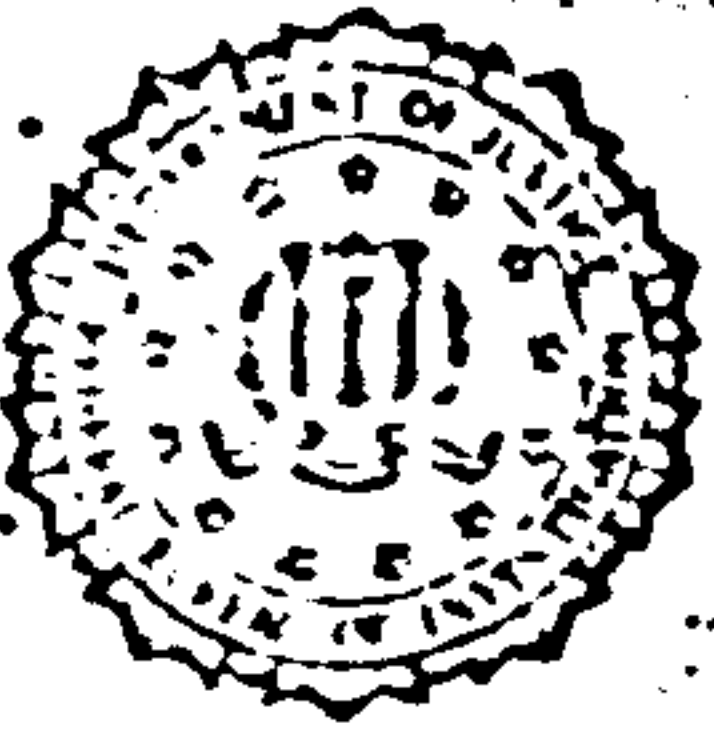

Reference is made to your letter of April 7, 1964, requesting this Bureau to conduct further investigation for the purpose of locating a safe-deposit box which Lee Harvey Oswald may have rented in his name, in the name of a member of his immediate family or in any assumed name in Irving, Fort Worth, Dallas, Houston or Laredo, Texas.

Our letter of April 30, 1964, transmitted to the Commission results of our investigation in this particular inquiry. We also indicated that we were conducting further investigation concerning a \$25,000 charge which was made on January 7, 1964, against the account at the First National Bank of Grand Prairie, Grand Prairie, Texas, entitled "The Oswald Trust Fund." This account was opened on December 5, 1963, by James H. Martin and Marina N. Oswald.

Enclosed are two copies of a memorandum dated May 4, 1964, at Dallas, Texas, which sets out results of our additional inquiries regarding the aforementioned \$25,000 charge against the account entitled "The Oswald Trust Fund."

This concludes our investigation in this particular matter.

NOTE:

At the request of the President's Commission, we made an exhaustive survey of banks in each of the cities mentioned herein in an attempt to locate a safe-deposit box Oswald may have rented. In the course of our inquiries, we obtained considerable information concerning bank accounts of Marina Oswald and her former business manager, James H. Martin. There was a large withdrawal of \$25,000 from one account opened by Marina and Martin which was not explained. The enclosure sets forth added data developed concerning this \$25,000 charge. The money was deposited in the First National Bank of Fort Worth on 1/20/64 in the name of James H. Martin and John M. Thorne (Marina's former attorney) as Co-trustees for Marina Oswald and children. There currently is a cash balance in the trust of \$2040 and the remaining portion of the \$25,000 has been invested in various stocks and bonds at the discretion of the bank's Trust Committee. An additional deposit of \$1940 on 3/25/64 was made in the account, such sum was forwarded by a school principal in York, Pennsylvania.

to expound his version of the assassination of President Kennedy which has been shown to be unfounded, distorted and speculative by our inquiries in the same matter. Lane persists in claiming the innocence of Oswald of the murders of President Kennedy and Dallas Police Officer Tippit. Lane also claimed that President Kennedy was shot from a railway overpass in front of the President's motorcade rather than from the Texas School Book Depository Building. Reference is made to your letter dated April 24, 1964, in which you requested, in part, that we maintain contact with appropriate Mexican authorities to ascertain whether Albert Alexander Osborne will be available on reasonably short notice should the Commission desire to request his appearance for the taking of testimony. You asked specifically to be advised whether Mr. Osborne has been placed on a "two-week reporting schedule" by the responsible Mexican authorities.

Mexican immigration officials have advised that Albert Alexander Osborne has not been located in Mexico. Consequently, he has not been placed by them on a "two-week reporting schedule." Mexican immigration officials are checking records in an effort to locate information concerning his possible departure from Mexico. We have inquired at his residence at San Martin de Texmelucan and have determined that Osborne has not been seen in that area since March, 1964. A stophas been placed at Osborne's former residence in Mexico.

CONFIDENTIAL as this shows our conduct of investigation in Mexico, which has to be protected.

Osborne is 76-year-old self-professed clergyman who has for years lived in Mexico and has been soliciting contributions from ~~foreign~~ sources in US. He is British citizen who holds Canadian passport and has traveled extensively in US and in Fall of 1963 in Europe. He is probably a con man. He sat next to Oswald on Red Arrow bus from Laredo to Mexico City 9-26 and 9-27-63. During 4 interviews, he has denied this to us. Commission representatives when in Mexico evidenced interest in Osborne. However, they said they could not make firm request that he be located or detained as full Commission's desires were not known in this regard. Commission's 4-24 let shows that body is still indecisive as to whether or not to call Osborne. As this man is in almost constant travel status and has violated no law, we cannot exercise any control over him if he is in US and, therefore, inadvisable to conduct fugitive investigation and thereafter probably chase after him in his travels unless Commission definitely wants to subpoena him and issue subpoena.

We have already interviewed 33 former Marine Corps associates of Oswald. However, these three men were interviewed by representatives of "Life" magazine and in view of this we should interview them. It is noted they furnished no information to "Life" magazine, as reported by it, not already known to us.

On May 5, 1964, SA John L. Quigley, New Orleans Office, appeared before the President's Commission to give testimony concerning Agent Quigley's interview of Oswald at New Orleans, Louisiana, on 8-10-63.

Present were the following Commission members: Chief Justice Earl Warren, Senator John Sherman Cooper, Congressman Gerald R. Ford, Mr. John J. McCloy, and Mr. Allen Dulles. Also present were Mr. J. Lee Rankin, General Counsel, together with his staff members: Mr. Samuel Stern, Mr. Norman Redlich and Howard P. Willens. In addition to these, there was present a Mr. Leon Jaworski, representative of the Attorney General's Office of the State of Texas.

The questioning of Agent Quigley was directed primarily by Mr. Stern, however, the various members of the Commission, from time to time, interjected questions of Agent Quigley to clarify various phases of the interrogation. Mr. Stern during the questioning specifically queried Agent Quigley as to whether or not consideration was ever given by Agent Quigley's securing the services of Oswald as an informant or whether it was suggested to Oswald that he subsequently contact the FBI. Agent Quigley testified unequivocally that no attempt or consideration had been given to securing the services of Oswald as an informant nor had Oswald been told to contact the FBI for any reason.

Mr. Stern during questioning inquired if during interview of Oswald, Agent Quigley noted anything which would indicate that Oswald was dangerous or could be considered as potentially dangerous. Agent Quigley made it completely clear that nothing along this line was noted.

On 4/16/64 Griffin telephonically requested Scatterday to handle this request. This request was confirmed by Commission letter dated 4/20/64.

Mrs. Cheek, a wealthy woman, knew Jack Ruby in view of their mutual interest in night clubs. Cheek's sister, Earlene Roberts, was landlady at Lee Harvey Oswald's Beckley Street residence at the time of the assassination. Roberts did not take an active part in the management and has denied knowing Oswald or Ruby. This matter has been thoroughly investigated and no connection established between Oswald and Ruby.

We interviewed an employee of Cheek who advised she owned a property at 5212 Gaston, Dallas, where two Cubans were reported to have been residing in 1958 and 1959 (when Oswald was in USMC). Efforts to identify these Cubans have been unsuccessful. The above facts have been furnished previously to the Commission.

The Commission's staff requested photographic copies of Cheek's records on the Gaston Street residence for 1958 through 1961 as well as copies of all records for all of her properties (7) for 1963.

This project involves some 1600 frames and would require 3200 photographic enlargements. Malley discussed this matter with Griffin on 4/28/64 and it was agreed he or a member of the staff would review the film at the Bureau at his first opportunity. Griffin so advised Mr. Conrad on 4/28/64. Since Griffin nor any member of the staff has recontacted the Bureau to review the film, it is felt we should go on record with the Commission that the material is available so that no delay can be attributed to the FBI in handling this request.

John Wythe Fain (retired Special Agent of the FBI) appeared today before the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy for the purpose of furnishing testimony relative to Fain's investigation while a Special Agent of the FBI concerning Lee Harvey Oswald.

Present were Earl Warren, Chairman, and members of the Commission Senator John Sherman Cooper, Congressman Gerald R. Ford, John J. McCloy, and Allen W. Dulles. Present also was J. Lee Rankin, General Counsel. Mr. Samuel Stern, staff member, led in the questions directed to Fain. Also present were two or three other unidentified individuals who were presumably staff members of the Commission.

It is noted that Chairman Warren excused himself after about one hour of the testimony for the purpose of keeping an appointment. He returned during the latter part of the testimony. It is also noted that Mr. Dulles was present only during about the last 45 minutes of the testimony.

Reference is made to my letters dated April 28, 1964, and February 20, 1964, and to the enclosures to each.

There are enclosed two copies of a memorandum dated April 27, 1964, concerning John K. Jacobs and his wife, Katia Jacobs.

As you can see from the enclosed memorandum, Mr. Jacobs has advised that on February 7, 1964, he met Mrs. Marina Oswald, her young daughter, her business manager and her attorney at about 6 p.m. in front of the Willard Hotel, Washington, D. C. He drove them to his home in Alexandria, Virginia, where they dined. Later in the evening he drove them back to Washington, D. C. He left them at the Willard Hotel at about 11:30 p.m. that night.

This conflicts with the information furnished by Marina Oswald as reported in the enclosure to my letter of February 20, 1964. According to Mrs. Oswald, on February 7, 1964, she, James Herbert Martin and her daughter ate together and, thereafter, took a walk in Washington, D. C. They returned to their hotel about 7 or 8 p.m. and that evening slept together and engaged in sexual intercourse.

Marina Oswald will not be reinterviewed about her activities on February 7, 1964, unless you specifically desire it. This is for your information.

On May 5, 1964, SA James P. Hosty, Jr., Dallas Office, appeared before the President's Commission to give testimony concerning Agent Hosty's knowledge of Lee Harvey Oswald.

Present were the following Commission members: Chief Justice Earl Warren, Senator John Sherman Cooper, Congressman Gerald R. Ford, Mr. John J. McCloy and Mr. Allen Dulles. Also present were Mr. J. Lee Rankin, General Counsel, together with his staff members: Mr. Samuel Stern, Mr. Norman Redlich and Mr. Howard P. Willens. In addition to these, there was also present Mr. Leon Jaworski, representative of the Attorney General's Office of the State of Texas.

The questioning of Agent Hosty was directed primarily by Mr. Stern, however, various members of the Commission, from time to time, interjected questions to Agent Hosty to clarify various phases of the interrogation. Mr. Stern questioned Agent Hosty in chronological order as to his handling of the case of Lee Harvey Oswald. Agent Hosty testified as to his conversation with Lieutenant Jack Revill in the Dallas Police Department on 11-22-63, at which time, Agent Hosty unequivocally denied ever having made a statement to Lieutenant Revill or to anyone else that the FBI knew that Oswald was capable of assassinating the President of the United States or possessed any potential for violence. Agent Hosty introduced into evidence his affidavit to this effect.

UNRECORDED COPY FILED IN

Off the record, J. Lee Rankin and Chief Justice Warren had a conversation as to Revill's deposition concerning his conversation with Agent Hosty. Rankin compared this affidavit of Lieutenant Revill to the testimony of Dallas Police Sergeant Dean, stating that, in both cases, pertinent information was withheld until long after it

had been developed before making it known. Rankin noted that Lieutenant Revill's affidavit was dated 11-22-63, but was not sworn to until 4-7-64, and not furnished to the President's Commission until 4-22-64, by Chief Curry of the Dallas Police Department. Rankin noted that Lieutenant Revill had furnished a deposition to members of the staff of the President's Commission in Dallas on 3-31-64, and had not mentioned this information concerning his conversation with Agent Hosty in this deposition. Chief Justice Warren then ordered all of the above information concerning Lieutenant Revill be placed on the record by Rankin which was then done by Rankin.

Agent Hosty also placed into evidence his deposition which stated that at no time prior to the assassination of President Kennedy did he ever see or talk to Lee Harvey Oswald, made no payments to him and made no attempt to develop him as an informant.

No problems or unusual questions arose during the testimony and it appeared apparent to Agent Hosty that all members of the Commission were completely satisfied with the presentation.

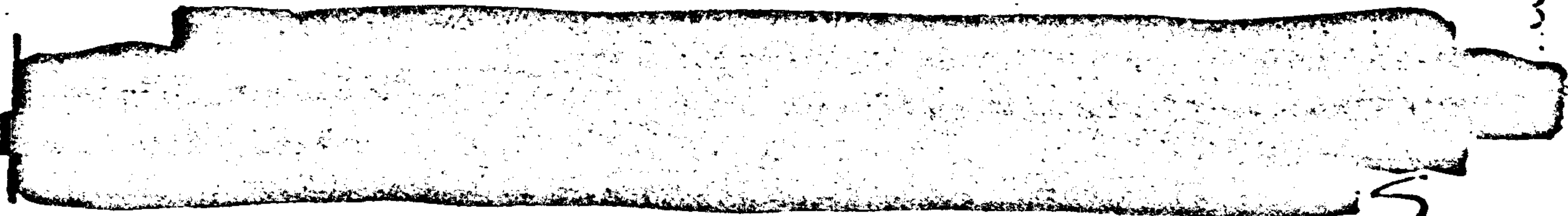

Reference is made to the memo Branigan to Sullivan, 5/1/64 relative to the FBI investigative reports which had been furnished to the Commission detailing our investigation of Oswald prior to the assassination. These reports and communications were discussed with Commission staff members Howard Willens and Samuel Stern on May 4. I reiterated our position that we have no desire to restrict the activities of the Commission in any way and the decision as to whether these documents are introduced into the record is a decision for the Commission to make.

I pointed out that Mr. Stern, at a previous meeting, had raised questions on certain items which might reflect on innocent persons if the reports are made public in their entirety. I noted that in the report of Special Agent Hosty dated December 11, 1963 at Dallas captioned Ruth Hyde Paine, there were a number of interviews relating to Mrs. Paine's marital difficulties, etc. Stern and Willens looked this over and concluded that if the Commission publishes this report in its entirety, the Commission will be criticized for making public information concerning innocent persons. Therefore, they decided they would introduce only those pages pertaining to the interviews of Mrs. Paine by Agent Hosty on November 1st and November 5th, 1963.



The other reports and documents will go in in their entirety.

PURPOSE:

To recommend the attached letter be sent to the President's Commission complying with the Director's instructions and furnishing the President's Commission further substantiation that the statement issued by Dallas Police Department (DPD) Chief Curry relating to alleged statements made by SA Hosty of our Dallas Office on 11/22/63 are false.

BACKGROUND:

Chief of Police Curry, DPD, issued a press release allegedly based on a memorandum prepared by Lt. Jack Revill of the DPD. This statement alleges that Dallas Agent James Hosty told Revill on 11/22/63 as Oswald was being led into Dallas Police Headquarters that we knew Oswald was a potential assassin but never felt he would shoot the President.

We have already categorically refuted this allegation inasmuch as we were not in possession of such information at the time and Agent Hosty has submitted an affidavit denying the allegations.

DETAILS:

Dallas by airtel 4/30/64 advised that Resident Agent Earle Haley of the Ft. Worth Resident Agency had been in contact with Lt. Herbert F. Hopkins (NA) of the Ft. Worth Police Department, at which time Hopkins volunteered the following information.

Lt. Hopkins stated he had just returned from Sacramento, California, where he attended a conference at which Lt. Jack Revill was present. Hopkins stated when the "Dallas Morning News" came out with the story attributing certain statements to SA Hosty he was with Revill. Revill told Hopkins he did not release any of this information and that the story as printed in the paper was not the same information he had furnished in his memorandum to Chief Curry. Revill informed Hopkins part of the story was completely false.

Revill was of the opinion Chief Curry had released the information and he, Revill, appeared very upset because he could not understand why the information had been released since it certainly could not help Chief Curry or anyone else.

According to Hopkins Revill indicated he had good relations with SA Hosty and other Agents and shortly thereafter disappeared from the conference.

The Director instructed this information be furnished to the President's Commission.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the attached letter be disseminated to the President's Commission complying with the Director's instructions.

Dear Mr. Rankin:

On April 28, 1964, Lieutenant Herbert F. Hopkins, Special Intelligence Section, Fort Worth, Texas, Police Department, volunteered the following information to an Agent of our Dallas, Texas, Office.

Lieutenant Hopkins advised he had just returned from a conference at Sacramento, California, which was also attended by Lieutenant Jack Revill of the Dallas, Texas, Police Department. According to Lieutenant Hopkins he was with Lieutenant Revill at the time the news was released concerning a story in the "Dallas Morning News" attributing certain statements to Special Agent James Hosty of our Dallas Office to the effect that this Bureau had knowledge Lee Harvey Oswald was a potential assassin; however, we did not feel he would shoot the President.

According to Lieutenant Hopkins, Lieutenant Revill stated he did not release any of this information and the story as released was not correct and was not the same information he had written in his memorandum to Chief of Police Jesse Curry of the Dallas, Texas, Police Department and part was completely false.

Lieutenant Hopkins continued that Lieutenant Revill was of the opinion Chief of Police Curry had released this information and he was very upset. Lieutenant Revill reportedly told Lieutenant Hopkins he had heard this information had first been "leaked" about one week before it appeared in the "Dallas Morning News."
