at Phoenix; report of SA CALVIN W. EVANS dated 6/10/64
at Phoenix, 10 copies of which are enclosed for the Bureau.

The report of SA EVANS dated 6/10/64 sets forth
a sworn statement dated 1/2/64, by ROBERT J. KAYE, G.C.
CHOPPE, Officer in Charge, USINS, Tucson, has indicated
that inasmuch as ROBERT J. KAYE, an alien, claims to
have entered the US at port of El Paso, Texas, about
11/25/63, without documents or inspection, he may have vio-
lated the immigration laws. Before a determination can be made
as to what action that Service should take it is necessary
that the record reflect his reason for making this visit to
Mexico in November, 1963. KAYE has refused to state the pur-
pose of his making this trip outside of the US, but has stated
that he gave this information to FBI of the Phoenix Office.
Mr. CHOPPE has requested information submitted to the FBI
11/25/63.

The Bureau is requested to advise whether there are
any objections to the furnishing of copies of the rereps
to USINS, Tucson.

SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY
REQUEST BY THE COMMISSION

On 6/12/64 SA Lyndal L. Shaneyfelt furnished testimony at the Commission to Mr. Melvin Eisenberg. The testimony given concerned the reproductions of the photograph of Oswald holding the rifle that has been widely publicized. SA Shaneyfelt testified regarding his comparison of the copy of this photograph, obtained from Oswald's possessions, with the reproductions of a similar photograph in the New York Times, the Detroit Free Press, the New York Journal American and Newsweek magazine.

Because the reproductions in the publications are engravings, they do not contain sufficient detail to warrant positive identification with the photograph of Oswald, obtained from his possessions. SA Shaneyfelt testified and stated that all of the photographs were entirely consistent and contain no differences to suggest they were from a source other than the photograph obtained from Oswald's possessions or a duplicate print of that photograph.

The Commission was previously advised of the results of the examination by letter dated 6/11/64.

Reurairtel 3-28-64, captioned "Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, 11-22-63, Dallas, Texas, Miscellaneous - Information Concerning," (RPG/ds) concerning a question from the President's Commission as to whether elimination prints had been taken of employees of the Texas School Book Depository Building (TSBD).

Enclosed for your assistance is a copy of a self-explanatory letter from the President's Commission dated 6-9-64, and a copy of Bureau letter dated 3-30-64, which is referred to in the current Commission letter.

As you will note, Identification Division records were checked to locate fingerprints, based on descriptive data available at the Bureau, of those employees known to have been at the TSBD on 11-22-63. It was necessary for the Bureau to qualify its reply to the Commission on the 16 identification records located with the statement "who may be identical with employees" of the TSBD.

The only apparent logical method to comply with the Commission's most recent request and to preclude later questions in this matter from the Commission, would be to take major case prints of all employees of the TSBD.

Dallas should immediately endeavor to obtain major case prints of all TSBD employees known to have been in the

building on 11-22-63, and furnish same to the Bureau, Attention: Identification Division.

Extreme care should be exercised to take clear, classifiable prints which will be compared with the 19 identifiable latent fingerprints and 6 identifiable latent palm prints found on cartons near the sixth floor window of the TS'D. It may be necessary to furnish these major case prints or copies thereof to the Commission for its use. Therefore, all necessary identifying and descriptive data should be appropriately executed.

You should also submit an appropriate letterhead memorandum for dissemination to the Commission indicating the identities of the persons printed, as well as indicating the date when each was printed by your office.

This matter should be expedited and every effort made to complete this project and have the major case prints at the Bureau on or before 8-18-64. The results of the Identification Divisions comparison of these prints with the latent palm and fingerprints will be furnished to the Commission and your office.

When the major case prints are received from Dallas it is requested that they be appropriately compared with the latent palm and fingerprints in this matter and the results furnished to the General Investigation Division, Attention: R. D. Rogge.

NOTE: The Commission by letter 3-26-64, initially requested we endeavor to identify the individuals who left latent prints on the afore-mentioned cartons. The Commission requested we undertake this project "without" taking any fingerprints. The most recent request will require the taking of approximately 70 major case prints of employees of the TSBD. This appears to be the most logical method of complying with the Commissions request. This matter will be closely followed and when the results are obtained, the Commission will be appropriately notified.

Enclosed for the Bureau are five copies, for New Orleans two copies, and for Dallas one copy of a LHM dated and captioned as above which represents results of a survey conducted by WFO on 6/3/64 to 6/5/64 at State Passport, Washington, D.C., as requested by re airtel and defined by two of its enclosures, namely Bureau airtel to New Orleans 5/22/64 and the President's Commission letter to the Bureau dated 5/19/64.

As pointed out in the LHM, New Orleans Passport Office handles several states for the issuance of passports. To parallel OSWALD's situation and to obviate explanations of delays caused by incomplete filing by mail, which appeared immaterial to the issue, only those applications were selected which were filed at the New Orleans Passport Agency. These were determined from a review of hundreds of issue cards pertaining to applications filed during the designated period. Those issue cards bearing a New Orleans or Louisiana address were then selected for the random sampling finally used.

The passport survey was conducted by SAs JAMES F. MORRISSEY and WILLIAM A. WIGHTMAN.

The material presented in the attached LHM confirms the information previously furnished by State to the effect that a 24 hour period for receiving the authorization to issue a passport was usual.

As indicated in Bureau airtel 5/22/64, one of the factors in which the Commission was interested was the amount of time between the filing of the passport ^{application} at New Orleans by an applicant and the receipt of authority to issue ^{passpor} sent by the New Orleans Office from Washington, D.C.

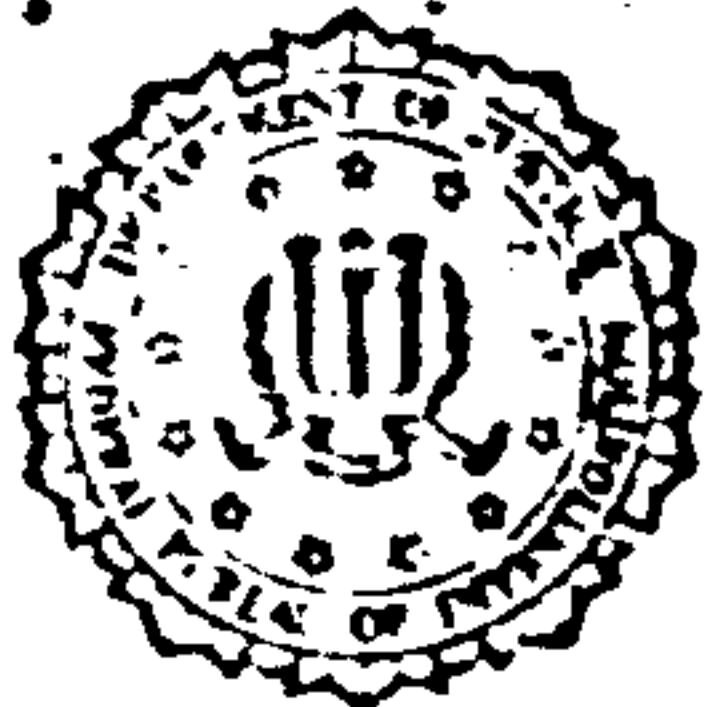
It is noted that in a few of the instances presented in attached LHM, the cashier's date stamp and the execution stamp date of the Passport Agency differ. To clarify the handling of the passport applications from the standpoint of time of filing, the following lead is set forth for the New Orleans Office, if not already done in this case.

Lee Harvey Oswald was issued passport number DC02526 on June 25, 1963, by the U.S. Passport Office in New Orleans, Louisiana, he having made formal application for the passport at the same office on June 24, 1963.

The President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy has requested that a random sampling be made of those persons who applied for passports at the U.S. Passport Office in New Orleans between the dates of June 17, 1963, and July 1, 1963, and determine how long in each case it took for the authorization to issue the passport to reach the New Orleans Office. The Commission expressed an interest in the amount of time between the filing of the application for passport at New Orleans by an applicant and receipt of the authority to issue the passport by the New Orleans Office from Washington, D.C.

It will be recalled that on May 26, 1964, Mr. George Maddocks, Acting Agent in Charge, Passport Agency, Department of State, 701 Loyola Avenue, New Orleans, Louisiana, advised that daily teletypes are sent to the Passport Office, Department of State, Washington, D.C., setting forth the names and birth dates of individuals who have made applications either on that date or the day before; that it might be possible to ascertain the identities of persons who made applications at New Orleans, Louisiana, during the pertinent period by reviewing these teletypes. Maddocks further stated that if the identities of these individuals could be ascertained from these daily teletypes, the desired information could then be obtained from their passport applications which should also be on file at Washington, D.C.

Mr. Maddocks advised that during the period of June 17, 1963, through July 1, 1963, a total of 280 applications for passports were made in person by individuals at New Orleans, Louisiana. Mr. Maddocks further stated that during this same period, an additional 2,091 applications for passports were received by his office through the mail.

On June 3, 1964, the daily incoming teletypes (or TWXs) from the New Orleans Passport Office of the U.S. Department of State for the period June 17, 1963, through July 1, 1963, were made available for review to Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation by Mr. Robert Johnson, Chief Counsel, Passport Office, U.S. Department of State. It was noted that these TWXs are generally filed by year, office and the date of the incoming TWX. The reply TWX from the Passport Office is generally attached to each incoming TWX. There may be several incoming TWXs from New Orleans in one day. In that case, each of the several incoming TWXs is a complete and separately numbered message and the reply TWX is affixed to that particular TWX. An indication of the number of names handled on each TWX is set forth subsequently in this communication. It is to be noted that during the period designated, the Passport Office at New Orleans handled passport applications from several states. For the requested purpose, only those persons were selected whose passport application indicated they were formally executed at the Passport Office, New Orleans, during the designated period. On June 3, 4 and 5, 1964, samples were taken at random of the applications of these persons. The results are set forth graphically below. The breakdown date is based on the date of the incoming TWX from the New Orleans Office to the Passport Office, Washington, D.C. The columnar headings are explained as follows:
