NOTE: This matter pertains to the leaks of Oswald's diary, Ruby's polygraph examination and Ruby's interview with Chief Justice Warren. Numerous individuals formerly associated with the President's Commission were located outside the Washington, D. C., area. Commission members and staff have now been interviewed with the exception of Hubert and Chief Justice Warren. Laboratory examinations are pending and awaiting results of New York inquiry with Dorothy Kilgallen in which we are attempting to obtain her photostat copy of Ruby's interview with Warren to compare against copies received from the Commission and in possession of the Laboratory.

Pages 42 through 45 of this report contain results of interview with Mr. and Mrs. Wayne E. Hartman of Dallas on 8-6-64. Mr. and Mrs. Hartman indicated that on the day of the assassination in the vicinity of the line of fire from the Texas School Book Depository building to the point where the late President Kennedy was shot, they noted a small hole in the ground that was just below the roots of the grass but which continued on a path below the surface of the ground in a horizontal direction for approximately 18 to 24 inches. They suggested this hole in the ground could have been caused by a bullet.

On 9-17-64 W. A. Branigan contacted ASAC Clark, Dallas, and suggested to Clark that if the Dallas Office had not made a physical check of the area of the aforementioned hole in the ground, such check be immediately made. Mr. Branigan suggested to Clark that mine detecting equipment possessed by the Department of the Army might be highly useful in such a check.

Pursuant to the conversation of Miss Jane Vida of your staff with Special Agent Robert E. Lenihan of this Bureau on September 22, 1964, there were delivered to the Commission on September 22, 1964, the following data:

Information furnished by PAUL BETHEL, Secretary of the Citizens Committee for a Free Cuba, Washington, D. C., claiming travel of JACK RUBY to Cuba following break in U. S. - Cuban relations, is hearsay, according to sources of BETHEL at Miami, Fla. Such information apparently based on a handbill of a clandestine organization in Cuba, and on a letter received by a Cuban exile at Miami; neither the handbill nor the letter give any specifics of RUBY's activity while alleged to be in Cuba. U. S. Government agencies at Miami handling interviews of Cuban refugees have received no information from arriving refugees concerning OSWALD or RUBY.

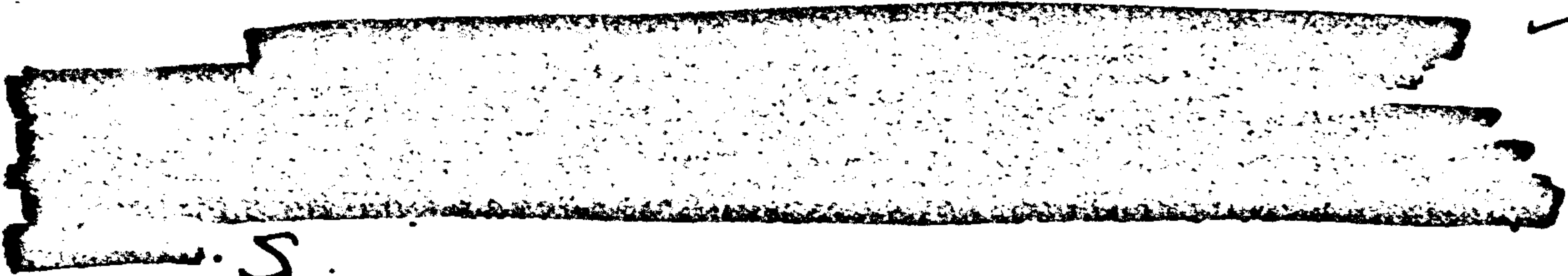

Mr. VALDES stated that his sister-in-law writes regularly of conditions in Cuba, and information which she believes of interest to Mr. VALDES. With respect to the items on RUBY, Mr. VALDES mentioned it only to his wife and to a friend, CARLOS GONZALEZ PARRA, a man about 60 years of age. Mr. VALDES stated he does not know JUAN MANUEL SALVAT or anyone else in the DRE at Miami. He supposed that either Mr. GONZALEZ PARRA or VALDES' wife had mentioned the item concerning RUBY to someone who, in turn, was connected with the DRE.

Mr. VALDES stated that his sister-in-law, GRAZIELLA RUBIO, is unemployed and lives with an aged stepfather in Marianao. He stated his sister-in-law very probably learned the information concerning RUBY, as mentioned in her letter, through hearsay. He said she would not normally learn of any activities taking place in the vicinity of the Sevilla Hotel in Havana, and he pointed out that the Havana suburb of Marianao is a considerable distance from the area of the Sevilla Hotel.

On April 15, 1964, Investigator DANIEL SHEERIN, Travel Control Section, U. S. Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), Miami, Florida, and Investigator JOHN ELDRED, Deportation Section of INS, both advised they have direct contact with all Cuban refugees being processed and interrogated by INS upon arrival of the refugees from Cuba. They advised that while they do not specifically question the refugees concerning aspects of the assassination of President KENNEDY, no refugee has volunteered information bearing on the assassination, and specifically concerning trips of JACK RUBY to Cuba.

DETAILS:

This phase of investigation is predicated upon information received from PAUL BETHEL, Executive Secretary of the Citizens Committee for a Free Cuba, Inc., 1426 G Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. Mr. BETHEL had appeared on the "BARRY GRAY" radio program over Station WMCA, New York City, on February 6, 1964, at which time he discussed aspects of the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY. A resume of the radio program was set forth in memorandum dated April 6, 1964, at Washington, D. C., in the caption, "LEE HARVEY OSWALD; INTERNAL SECURITY - RUSSIA - CUBA."

Mr. BETHEL had stated on the radio program that "we" had been notified by people, whose judgment was trusted, that JACK RUBY had been in Cuba several times after the break in U. S. - Cuban diplomatic relations (January 3, 1961). He said that such travel by RUBY was clandestine.

On April 2, 1964, Mr. BETHEL advised Special Agents of the FBI at Washington, D. C., that his sources, whom he considered reliable as to RUBY's Cuban travel, were JOSE LANUZA, whom he described as affiliated with the Cuban Student Directorate in Miami, Florida, and Dr. SALVADOR LEW, associated with a Miami law firm.

He said another source to be contacted for information concerning OSWALD and concerning RUBY's trips to Cuba was Dr. FERNANDO CARANDI at Miami. Mr. BETHEL also stated he remembered reading, from unrecalled sources, that

recent escapees from Cuba were advising that JACK RUBY had been in Cuba subsequent to the break in diplomatic relations. He suggested that representatives of newspaper wire services in Miami be contacted in this respect.

On April 15, 1964, SALVADOR LEW, a Cuban exile who is an attorney by profession, resident at 1260 S. W. 6th Street, Miami, Florida, advised that he had no knowledge of his own concerning the background or activities of either LEE HARVEY OSWALD or JACK RUBY. He suggested that the anti-CASTRO organization Directorio Revolucionario Estudiantil (DRE) (Cuban Student Directorate) at Miami, might be contacted for such information. He advised that the DRE engages in anti-CASTRO propaganda, and the dissemination of current news on the Cuban situation.

On April 15, 1964, Mr. FERNANDO CARANDI, a Cuban exile residing at 1038 S. W. 7th Avenue, Miami, Florida, stated he is a lawyer, teacher, and newspaperman by profession. He said that he is currently active in the publication of a news bulletin under the name Agencia de Informaciones Periodisticas (AIP) (Newspaper Information Agency). He advised that this publication is directed against Communism and the regime of FIDEL CASTRO in Cuba, and is disseminated primarily in Latin America. Mr. CARANDI stated that in his work with the AIP bulletin, he had received no information concerning trips of JACK RUBY, the assassin of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, to Cuba. He stated he recalled that the Cuban Student Directorate (DRE) at Miami had made such allegations in propaganda material which is edited by the DRE. He suggested that JUAN MANUEL SALVAT, an officer of the DRE, be contacted in this regard.

The following investigation was previously set forth in the case captioned, "JACK L. RUBY; LEE HARVEY OSWALD - VICTIM; CIVIL RIGHTS," and is being repeated here as pertinent to the information furnished by PAUL BETHEL:

Inquiry concerning an alleged association between JACK RUBY and one (FNU) PRATKINS was predicated on information received on January 13, 1964, from JOHN MARSHALL, Special Agent in Charge of the Secret Service office at Miami. Mr. MARSHALL advised that Mr. FRANK WATTERSON, Security Agent, United States Department of State, Miami, had received information from JOSE ANTONIO LANUSA of the Directorio Revolucionario Estudiantil (DRE) (Cuban Student Directorate) at Miami, to the effect that LANUSA heard that JACK RUBY had gone to Cuba last year, presumably 1963, by way of Mexico City. According to LANUSA, RUBY shared an office in a tourist agency on the main floor of the Sevilla Hotel in Havana, Cuba, with an American whose name was (FNU) PRATKINS.

On January 23, 1964, JOSE ANTONIO LANUSA, 24 years of age, Intelligence Officer for the DRE at Miami, Florida, stated that his information concerning the association of JACK RUBY and (FNU) PRATKINS was derived from two sources. The first source was a handbill-type newsletter dated December 24, 1963, at Havana, circulated by the clandestine anti-CASTRO organization in Cuba known as Accion Revolucionaria Anticomunista (ARAC) (Anti-Communist Revolutionary Action). This handbill had been sent by letter posted December 28, 1963, in Cuba, to the DRE, Post Office Box 168, Miami, Florida. The handbill, which was mimeographed, set forth the following sentence, as translated from the Spanish:

MM 105-8342

"The killer of the assassin of the deceased President KENNEDY, JACK RUBINSTEIN, has been proven the owner of a tourist office in the Sevilla Hotel, Havana."

LANUSA stated there was no evidence to support this statement; however, he regarded the allegation as true, since it appeared in the clandestine newsheet disseminated by the anti-CASIRO organization ARAC.

LANUSA said that in addition to the information from ARAC, JUAN MANUEL SALVAT, another officer in the DRE at Miami, had received a letter containing additional information pertaining to RUBY and PRATKINS. This letter had been sent from Cuba to an exiled Cuban attorney (FNU) VALDES FAVLI, who furnished it to SALVAT, according to LANUSA. LANUSA said this letter reported that JACK RUBINSTEIN was a habitual visitor to a souvenir store located across the street from the Sevilla Hotel on Prado Street, Havana, Cuba. The store belonged to a man by the name of (FNU) PRATKINS. RUBINSTEIN reportedly visited the store about a year ago, that is, about January, 1963, after flying to Cuba by way of Mexico City.

LANUSA stated that in the first part of January, 1964, on the occasion of a visit by him to the office of Mr. FRANK WATERSON, State Department, Miami, Florida, he mentioned to Mr. WATERSON the information that JACK RUBY had gone to Cuba during 1963, and had been associated with the individual PRATKINS in a tourist business at the Sevilla Hotel, Havana.

On January 23, 1964, JUAN MANUEL SALVAT, 25 years of age, also in the DRE, Miami, stated he had not actually received the letter from Attorney VALDES FAULI which is supposed to contain the information concerning the relationship of JACK RUBY and (FNU) PRATKINS. He said the information was related to him by a contact of VALDES. SALVAT declined to furnish the identity of the contact, stating he had not obtained this party's consent to involve him.

On January 27, 1964, Mr. CARLOS VALDES FAULI, a Cuban exile living at 2000 S. W. 24th Street, Miami, Florida, stated that he had been an attorney in the Supreme Court system in Havana, Cuba, prior to the advent of FIDEL CASTRO to power in Cuba. He stated he had arrived in the United States as an exile in November, 1961, after spending seven months in jail on political charges.

Mr. VALDES related that in approximately the beginning of January, 1964, he received a letter from his sister-in-law, GRAZIELLA RUBIO, age 45, who lives in Marianao, Cuba.

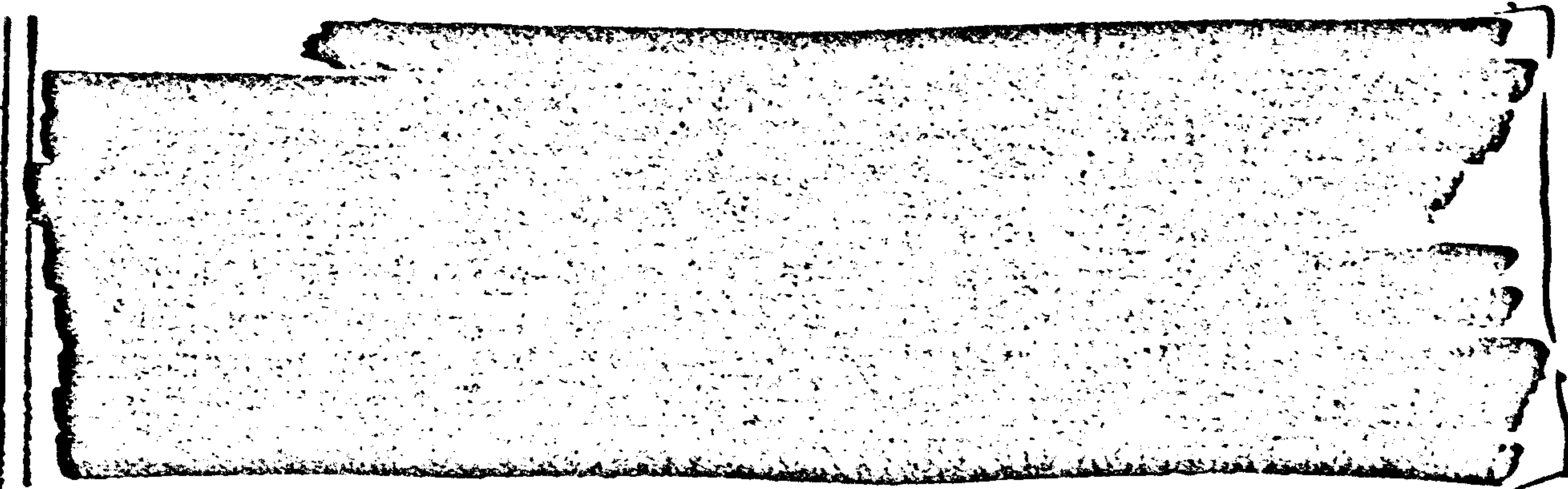
Mr. VALDES made available the section of the letter pertaining to JACK RUBY, and a translation from the Spanish is as follows:

"RUBY, the assassin of OSWALD, was in Havana a year ago. He is a friend and a client of an individual named PRASKIN, who owns or manages a souvenir shop located on Frade between Animas and Trocadero Streets in front of the Sevilla Hotel."



For the information of the Bureau, the summary regarding this item appearing on Pages 359 and 360 of Dallas report dated 1/7/64 was prepared from a photographic copy made on large rough paper, which at that time bore the # 59 and not 113.

Regarding Exhibit 113, Dallas is in possession of glossy photograph consisting of cover and the page containing OSWALD's photograph only.

One copy of this report is being furnished the Miami and Phoenix Offices in view of their previous interest and investigation concerning this particular matter.

Referenced Dallas teletype dated 9/15/64 reflects that information had been furnished to the President's Commission by SYLVIA ODIO, a Cuban refugee residing at Dallas, Texas, who claims that a person believed by her to have been LEE HARVEY OSWALD and two other individuals using anti-CASTRO war names of 'LEOPOLDO' and possibly 'ANGELO' had appeared at her apartment door during the evening of either 9/26/64 or 9/27/64 stating they were members of the Cuban underground and soliciting her help in translating a Spanish note to be used in the anti-CASTRO movement. At the time of this visit by the three individuals described above, ODIO was residing in Apartment A, 8014 Magellan Circle, Dallas, Texas, which address is located approximately five miles east of downtown Dallas in a large garden-type apartment development.

Referenced teletype reflects that SYLVIA ODIO has mental treatment background and the President's Commission has requested an expedite investigation to determine her reputation for veracity. b7c

Synopsis:

LORAN EUGENE HALL advised 9/16/64, that in September, 1963, he was at Dallas, Texas, in company of LAWRENCE HOWARD and WILLIAM SEYMOUR to solicit aid in anti-CASTRO movement. HALL contacted many Cubans in Dallas area. HALL recalled meeting a Cuban woman, Mrs. ODIO, who lived in Apartment A, located on Magellan Circle and the same apartment building where a Cuban friend named, KIKI FERROR, was then residing. HALL specifically denies that LEE HARVEY OSWALD was with him during his visit to Mrs. ODIO's apartment. On 9/20/64, HALL reinterviewed and advises that information furnished by him on 9/16/64 was incorrect and was furnished by error. After reflection concerning his many trips to Dallas, Texas, he has resolved that LARRY HOWARD and BILL SEYMOUR not in Dallas at the same time in HALL's company. He admits his presence in Dallas in September, 1963, with LARRY HOWARD and one WAHITO, a Cuban refugee. HALL recalls visiting a friend, KIKI FERROR and that FERROR had introduced HALL to a Cuban living in lower front apartment in same apartment occupied by FERROR. HALL denies this Cuban woman was ever contacted by him or his group for assistance. LAWRENCE

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J. HOWARD interviewed 9/20/64. Admits traveling to Dallas, Texas with LORAN HALL and friend, CELLIOS ALBAS, a Cuban refugee, during September, 1963. HOWARD denies that he accompanied HALL to meet a Cuban refugee named SYLVIA ODIO. HOWARD states he and BILL SEYMOUR were not present in Dallas with HALL at the same time during 1963. HOWARD denies any personal knowledge or acquaintance with LEE HARVEY OSWALD until after assassination of President KENNEDY and then only what he read in local press.

DETAILS:

Date

LORAN EUGENE HALL advised that he presently resides at 55 Rogers Road, Kernville, California, and receives mail at Post Office Box 84, Kernville, California. He is presently employed as a truck driver for the King-Davis Company which is contracting the hauling of logs to the Mt. Whitney Lumber Company at Johnsondale, California. HALL advises he also operates the Rainbow Motel at Kernville, California.

HALL stated that during the latter part of September, 1963, he was in Dallas, Texas in company with LAWRENCE HOWARD and WILLIAM SEYMOUR. HALL had gone to Dallas to solicit aid in the anti-CASTRO movement. HALL said they contacted three professors at the University of Dallas who are Cuban refugees. One of these professor's name HALL recalled, was ODIO. These professors furnished HALL with a list of Cubans living in the Dallas area who could be contacted to solicit assistance in this movement.

HALL said that they consequently contacted about 40 or 50 such persons. HALL said that he, HOWARD and SEYMOUR had been in Dallas about three or four days when he and SEYMOUR were arrested and held by the police. HALL and SEYMOUR were in custody for one day, during which time they were interrogated by various Federal intelligence agents concerning their activities. He recalled that the police took Polaroid photographs of himself and of SEYMOUR. HALL was also under the distinct impression that he had been fingerprinted.

HALL said that he recalled that while in Dallas on this particular occasion, the three of them, HALL, HOWARD, and SEYMOUR, had gone to the apartment of a Cuban woman who lived in a garden style apartment located on Magellan Circle in Dallas. HALL said that he could not picture this woman in his mind now. He said that her name was possibly ODIO. He said that he seemed to recognize this woman's name as ODIO because of the association with the name of the Cuban professor who had the same name, ODIO.

HALL stated that this Cuban woman lived in Apartment A of the same apartments located on Magellan Circle where

a Cuban friend of his by the name of KIKI ~~FERROR~~ was living with two or three other Cuban men. He visited KIKI FERROR and on one occasion was introduced to this woman in passing outside of the apartments. Later, HALL, in company with WILLIAM SEYMOUR and LARRY HOWARD, went to her apartment to ask her assistance in the movement. HALL did not recall whether she was on the list given by the professors or if their previous introduction to her had prompted them to contact her. He said this contact was very brief and he did not believe that they even went into her apartment. HALL said that this would have been about three days before he and SEYMOUR were arrested.

HALL said that the above described incident would undoubtedly be the same incident which has been referred to by SYLVIA ODIO, but that he certainly would not have been the person whom SYLVIA ODIO could have mistaken as LEE HARVEY OSWALD. HALL explained that it now occurs to him that WILLIAM SEYMOUR is a person who might be said to generally resemble OSWALD. HALL described SEYMOUR as being white, male, American, age about 25 or 26, five nine to five ten in height, 155 to 160 pounds, slender build, light hair and blue eyes. HALL said that he does not know where SEYMOUR is at the present time. He said that SEYMOUR is from Phoenix and is probably living some where at Phoenix, Arizona. He said SEYMOUR works as a welder and might be living with a stepfather who has a different name than SEYMOUR. HALL thought it possible that LAWRENCE HOWARD, who lives in East Los Angeles, California, and may be listed in the telephone directory, might be able to furnish further information as to SEYMOUR's current address.

HALL stated that in his work in the anti-CASTRO movement, he used the name LORENZO PASCILLO. HALL said that when he was in Dallas on this occasion he had grown a full beard. HALL also said that he speaks Spanish fluently and although he does not have the Cuban dialect or use of Spanish colloquialisms mastered, he nevertheless has, on occasion, been mistaken for being a Cuban by other Cubans. He admitted that some Cubans would likely mistake

him for a Mexican. HALL said that LARRY HOWARD is of Mexican decent and speaks Spanish fluently. SEYMOUR, according to HALL, has a very limited ability in the Spanish language.

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HALL added that when they contacted persons in Dallas, Texas, during September, 1963, he believed that SEYMOUR was introduced to these persons as BILL SEYMOUR.

LAWRENCE JOHN HOWARD, Jr., advised he was born January 17, 1935, at Los Angeles, California, and currently resides with his wife, ROSE HOWARD, and two young daughters at 3191 Blanchard Street, Los Angeles, California. HOWARD stated he is currently employed at the I.T.E. Circuit Breaker Company, in East Los Angeles.

HOWARD stated that in January, 1963, he was in the Florida Keys engaged in training activity with a group of men planning for an anti-CASTRO invasion of Cuba. HOWARD stated that he did not want to identify these men further by name or description. HOWARD stated that he met and briefly conversed with LORAN EUGENE HALL at a bar in Miami, Florida, during one evening and this was the first time he had ever met HALL. This conversation could not have extended for more than 15 minutes. HALL told HOWARD that he had been with FIDEL CASTRO in Cuba during the revolutionary period of 1958. HALL related to HOWARD how he had defected from CASTRO prior to the revolutionary victory when he discovered that CASTRO was a Communist. HALL, according to HOWARD, appeared to be sincerely interested in the anti-CASTRO movement and offered to obtain medical supplies and funds to support a 'small invasion group.' HOWARD said he thought nothing more of HALL's remarks at this time in January, 1963.

HOWARD said that he returned to Los Angeles, California, to be with his family during late August, 1963. He recalled that he remained in Los Angeles for about 17-days prior to departing for return to Florida. During this time, HALL contacted HOWARD and stated that he had gathered some medical supplies for the anti-CASTRO movement and had contacted an unknown man in Dallas, Texas, who was willing to furnish a boat for the group's invasion attempt.

HALL desired to have HOWARD accompany him with these supplies on the trip back to Florida. HOWARD stated that one ~~CELLIOS ALBAS~~, a Cuban refugee who is also known as ~~'QUARITO'~~ and who was one of a group of anti-CASTRO persons training to land in Cuba, had come with HOWARD

from Florida and had been visiting at HOWARD's home. HOWARD states that ALBAS was last known residing at 218 Northwest 15th Avenue, Apartment 307, Miami, Florida.

On about September 17, 1963, HOWARD, LORAN HALL and CELLIOS ALBAS, departed Los Angeles driving HALL's 1956 Oldsmobile and pulling a luggage carrier. HALL planned to stop in Dallas to pick up additional supplies, funds and contact an unknown man regarding a boat. They arrived in Dallas on about September 20, 1963, and all three thereafter registered at a motel located near a memorial park on the main highway leading out of Dallas toward Florida. HOWARD could not remember the name of this motel. HOWARD said they remained in Dallas for about ten days, during which HALL was busy making contacts to obtain additional supplies and attempted to contact this unknown man whom HALL had previously stated would furnish a boat large enough for a small invasion group. HOWARD said that HALL was most secretive about this unknown man and never named him or further described him. HOWARD said that on some of those contacts by HALL, he and CELLIOS ALBAS were present. On other such contacts, HALL insisted on going alone. HOWARD said that at this time he, HALL, and ALBAS all had heavy beards.

HOWARD stated that he recalls no contacts which he made with 'a Cuban woman named ODIO at an apartment on Magellan Circle in Dallas.' HOWARD is certain he would have remembered such a contact if it had occurred. HOWARD stated that the circumstances concerning a Cuban refugee woman living in Dallas would have certainly spurred his memory and therefore he is positive that he has no knowledge of such a personal contact.

HOWARD stated that the only KIKI FERRER he knows is one KIKI MASFERRER, a well known Cuban refugee and dentist now residing at Miami, Florida. This KIKI MASFERRER, according to HOWARD, is the brother of ROLANDO MASFERRER, who is well known in the anti-CASTRO movements. HOWARD states he has never known this KIKI MASFERRER to have resided in Dallas, Texas.

HOWARD stated he had no personal knowledge of, or acquaintance with LEE HARVEY OSWALD until after the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY and then only to the extent of what he had read in the local press.

HOWARD said that he, HALL, and ALBAS departed Dallas around September 30, 1963, and drove in HALL's automobile to the Florida Keys. HOWARD stated he was anxious to return to the training activity with this invasion group. HOWARD specifically recalls that they left behind in Dallas, the luggage carrier with the medical supplies. HOWARD stated that later during the middle of October, LORAN HALL and BILL SEYMOUR, another member of the anti-CASTRO group in training in the Florida Keys, drove HALL's automobile back to Dallas to pick up the luggage carrier and make further arrangements for a boat.

HOWARD later learned that HALL and SEYMOUR were arrested in Dallas by the police shortly after their arrival and were charged with possession of "dangerous drugs." HOWARD said they told him that they were released after one day. HOWARD said that HALL and SEYMOUR then returned to the Florida Keys with the luggage carrier and medical supplies. HALL told HOWARD that he had not been successful in obtaining a boat from the unknown benefactor in Dallas, Texas. HOWARD recalled that HALL and SEYMOUR arrived back in the Florida Keys late in October, 1963.

HOWARD stated that he has no knowledge that LORAN HALL or BILL SEYMOUR had any knowledge of, or were acquainted with LEE HARVEY OSWALD during September, 1963.

LAWRENCE HOWARD stated that he has not been on
friendly terms with LORAN EUGENE HALL since about January,
1964, in that HALL is basically responsible for having
destroyed the effort which HOWARD, SEYMOUR and others of
an invasion group had made to effect a successful invasion
of Cuba. HOWARD said that HALL is 'a scatter brain,
unreliable, emotionally disturbed and an egotistical liar.'

LORAN EUGENE HALL, 55 Rogers Road, Kernville, California, was reinterviewed. HALL said that he had been in error in previously stating that the incident referred to by SYLVIA ODIO had probably involved a contact by himself, WILLIAM SEYMOUR and LAWRENCE HOWARD. After reflection regarding trips made by him to Dallas and Miami, he now recalls that he was accompanied by WILLIAM SEYMOUR and by LAWRENCE HOWARD in Dallas on separate trips to that city.

HALL said he actually has no independent recollection of the date when he and BILL SEYMOUR were arrested in Dallas, or for any other of his experiences. He recalls now that he left Los Angeles in his 1956 Oldsmobile, pulling a small trailer of supplies, about the middle of September, 1963. He was accompanied on this trip by LARRY HOWARD and one "WAHITO", who claimed to be a Cuban refugee, but who HALL has now concluded was a "CASTRO" plant. They reached Dallas about two and a half or three days later and stayed in Dallas about four days. He said that he did not now recall any contacts made by this trio for the purpose of soliciting assistance, especially since he did not trust WAHITO.

HALL said that on this visit to Dallas, as on each of his visits there, he got in touch with KIKI FERRER. HALL is now unable to recall that HOWARD or "WAHITO" were with him when he saw KIKI, and believed he recalled that they waited in the car when he went to KIKI's apartment. He said that he believes that it was on this visit that KIKI had introduced him to the Cuban woman living in the lower front of KIKI's apartment building. However, now he does not believe that this woman was ever contacted by him or his group for any type of assistance.

HALL said that KIKI FERRER is no relation to the dentist, KIKI MASFERRER (phonetic), who lives in Miami and who is the brother of "EL TIGRE." According to him, KIKI FERRER was employed by the Texas Optical Instrument Company of Dallas. HALL described the apartment where KIKI lived

as a new two story building located in an area of old houses. He said it has 'Plaza' in wrought iron on the front of the building and was built around a garden. However, he now thinks that it was located about 14 blocks north, and seven block west of the Nieman Marcus Department Store of downtown Dallas, not five miles east of downtown Dallas. He said he is almost positive that the name of the street is Magellan Circle, and if not, that it was some name very similar.

The trio then took about three days to drive to Miami. HALL said that he left the trailer which he brought from Los Angeles at Dallas. HALL was in Miami about two weeks and then returned to Dallas accompanied by BILL SEYMOUR. No one else was with them. They stayed at Dallas for six days during which time they were waiting for a contact with a U. S. citizen, who he declined to identify, concerning obtaining a boat. He said that they stayed in a hotel in downtown Dallas and also at the home of a Dallas resident, but that he could not identify this person as he is unwilling to bring any Americans into any account of his activities.

HALL said that when he and SEYMOUR were under arrest at Dallas, Texas, he was interviewed by several different representatives of various federal intelligence agencies. He also said that his photograph had been taken several times while he was in custody, both by Polaroid and by a "mug shot" when he was seated behind a board which had numbers placed on it. SEYMOUR was also photographed. Both were fingerprinted.

HALL said that a Dallas resident had made available \$5,000, which HALL put up for bail, and that they were released. They stayed at the YMCA for two days, and when they were told by the prosecuting attorney, one Mr. WADE, that charges had been dropped, they left Dallas, taking the trailer which he had left on his previous trip through Dallas to Miami.

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HALL said that his recollection now is that while he and SEYMOUR were in Dallas, they made no contacts with any Cubans regarding assistance. He said that he made a few contacts with personal friends, including KIKI FERROR. However, he does not think that SEYMOUR was ever in the apartment building where FERROR was living. He said he thinks that SEYMOUR waited for him in the car when he went in to see KIKI, and that they located KIKI at a phone booth about two blocks away from the apartment and drove KIKI over to his girl friend's house where they dropped him off.

HALL explained that recalling specific information concerning incidents and persons and places involved in Dallas and Miami is complicated for him by the numerous and extensive traveling he did during 1963. He said that he is now able to recall that it was probably in April, 1963, when he contacted the three Cuban professors at the University of Dallas and was provided with a list of Cubans residing in Dallas from whom he later solicited assistance. On this occasion he was by himself and flew in from Miami and back. He said that he recalled visiting Dallas five times during 1963, in January, April, June, September, and October.

HALL said that, having eliminated the confusion of his associates of the September and October visits from his recollection, he now does not remember any incident where he, in company of two other individuals, may have made a contact such as the one described by SYLVIA ODIO. He maintained that the name ODIO and information concerning a father being a prisoner on the Isle of Pines is familiar to him, but that he is now unable to relate this to any experience which he had in Dallas.

HALL said that based on his calculation concerning travel made by him, HOWARD and "WAHITO", they very possibly could have been in Dallas on or close to September 26, and 27, 1963. He said that compared with HOWARD and "WAHITO"

he would be the one in this trio who would be taken for an American as HOWARD is definitely latin appearing and 'WAHITO' has an extremely dark complexion. However, he emphasized that both he and HOWARD wore full beard at the time.

Enclosed herewith for the Dallas Division is a small notebook reflecting it was made for the Sheraton Hotels and Motor Inns.

This notebook was furnished the San Antonio Office on 9/28/64, by ELMER E. COOPER, M.D., offices at 505 Howard, San Antonio, Texas. He does not desire the notebook returned.

On 9/28/64, Dr. COOPER orally advised SA JOHN M. KEMMY, to whom he gave this notebook, that on Thursday, 9/24/64, at about 5 p.m., he checked in at the Sheraton Hotel in Dallas, Texas. On that date he found this notebook in a phone table between the beds in his room number 2422 at the Sheraton Hotel. He found the notebook under some blank hotel stationery in a drawer in this table. Dr. COOPER returned to San Antonio on 9/27/64 and explained that he checked out of the Sheraton Hotel on that date at about 10 a.m. Dr. COOPER advised that from reading the notebook some of the notations therein appeared to refer to LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and desired to call this matter to the Bureau's attention. He speculated that possibly the notebook had belonged to some reporter.

Kennedy - Was Oswald The Lone Assassin?" This debate will be held at Manhattan Center, 6th Ave. and 35th St., NYC, and tickets will be priced from \$1.00 to \$7.00. Tickets for the affair are presently on sale at the offices of the Citizens' Committee of Inquiry (CCI), 156 6th Ave., NYC.

During his lecture LANE also announced that on 10/15/64, he will appear on the "New David Susskind Show" (television) with WILLIAM BUCKLEY and New York Columnist BERTHA KILGALIN. BUCKLEY is the publisher of "National Review".

During his lecture on 9/23/64, LANE alleged that JACK RUBY told his attorney, MELVIN BELLI, that he, RUBY, was instructed to kill OSWALD the night before he actually murdered him in the headquarters of the Dallas Police Department. According to LANE, RUBY is extremely worried about the personal safety of his sister. RUBY claims, according to LANE, if he could leave Dallas he would be able to tell a great deal more concerning the assassination. LANE stated that Chief Justice WARREN has refused to help RUBY in leaving the Dallas area.

LANE further claimed there is a negro woman who witnessed the shooting of Dallas Police Officer J. D. TIPPIT. LANE stated she has been warned by the Dallas Police Department that she will be killed if she tells all that she knows and further a Dallas police officer told her "the guy that killed the president is still around".

LANE stated the report of the Warren Commission will very likely show as its main feature a picture of LEE HARVEY OSWALD firing a rifle from a window in the Texas Book Depository, Dallas, Texas.

During the course of his speech LANE again accused the FBI of altering or changing evidence relating to the assassination of President KENNEDY. He alleged that the handling of the investigation by the FBI warrants the "abolishment" of the FBI.

No further information has been received re subject's scheduled appearance in San Francisco, California, on 10/5/64, or his possible appearance at The University of Texas, Austin, Texas.

Re Bureau radiogram to Dallas, 9/4/64, concerning additional identification of latent prints on four cartons found in the Texas School Book Depository Building and instructing that if not already done, Identification Division should be requested to compare the prints of all FBI employees in Dallas including those on special assignment as of 11/23/63, against unidentified latents on cartons.

With respect to the above instructions, the following information is submitted concerning communications bearing on the four cardboard cartons containing the unidentified latent prints:

By Dallas letter 11/23/63, certain items were described therein which were obtained by SA VINCENT E. DRAIN from Capt. WILL FRITZ of the Dallas PD, all of which items were delivered by SA DRAIN in person to the FBI Laboratory and returned to the Dallas PD by SA DRAIN on 11/24/63 after examination by the Laboratory. The four cardboard cartons were not among items listed in this letter and were not among items delivered by SA DRAIN.

Dallas letter to the Bureau dated 11/27/63 reflects description of items obtained from Lt. CARL DAY, Dallas PD on 11/26/63 by SA DRAIN. Among such items obtained from Lt. CARL DAY were the items listed in the 11/23/63 letter which were obtained for resubmission along with certain additional items. Inadvertently, the four cardboard cartons which were obtained by SA DRAIN from Lt. CARL DAY on 11/26/63 for the first time, were listed on page two of this letter among items which had previously been taken to the FBI Lab in person by SA DRAIN as described in the 11/23/63 letter mentioned above.

By letter dated 11/29/63, the Latent Fingerprint Section of the FBI Identification Division, under Latent Case #46903, referred to Dallas letter of 11/27/63 described above, as well as personal delivery of evidence by SAs DRAIN and WARREN C. DeBRUEYS on 11/23/63. This letter reflects that among the items received were "four cardboard boxes".

The Bureau's attention is called to the fact that SA DRAIN delivered the evidence described in Dallas letter of 11/23/63 in person while SA's DRAIN and DeBRUEYS delivered evidence described in Dallas letter of 11/27/63.

Current investigation has established through Lt. J. CARL DAY that the four cardboard boxes were processed by Lt. DAY at the Texas School Book Depository on 11/22/63 shortly after the assassination but such cartons were not removed from the Texas School Book Depository building by the Dallas Crime Lab until the morning of 11/25/63, which according to Lt. DAY's best recollection, was the date the boxes were actually taken to the Dallas PD Crime Lab.

These four cardboard cartons were turned over by the Dallas PD Crime Lab to SA DRAIN on 11/26/63 for the first time, along with other evidence.

The Bureau's attention is therefore respectfully called to pages 181 and 182 of the report of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING dated 11/30/63 which reflects the same information as contained in Dallas letter to the Bureau of 11/27/63, described above, and which lists the four cardboard boxes being delivered to the FBI Lab on 11/27/63 by SA DRAIN but inadvertently lists the four cardboard boxes as having been previously examined by the FBI Lab on 11/24/63.

The Bureau's attention is also respectfully called to pages 363 and 364 of the report of SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING dated 12/10/63, which sets forth the results of the Latent Fingerprint Section examination contained in the Latent Fingerprint Section letter of 11/29/63 described above. The first paragraph on page 363 reflects that the specimens listed were received at the Latent Fingerprint Section, Identification Division by personal delivery of SAs DRAIN and DeBRUEYS on 11/23/63. The four cardboard boxes were not delivered by SAs DRAIN and DeBRUEYS on 11/23/63 but were first delivered to the Lab along with other items on 11/27/63.
