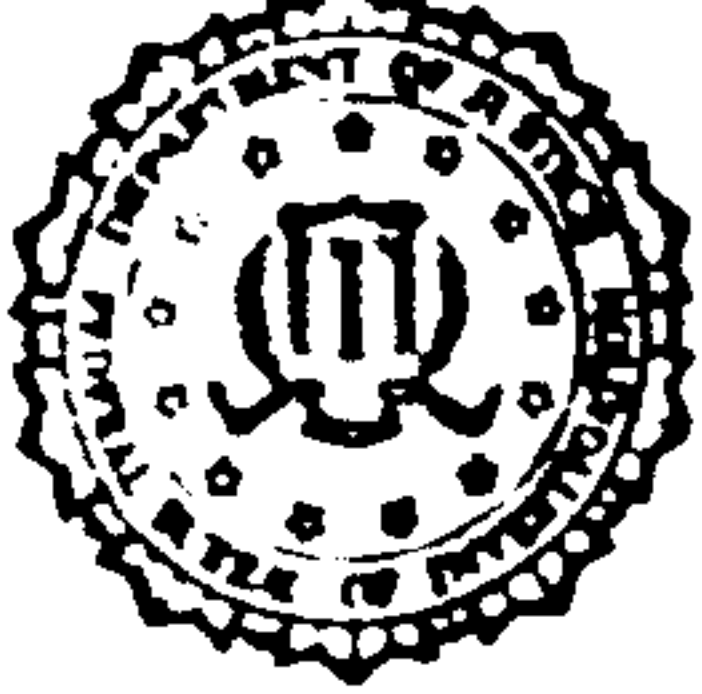

SHIRLEY ROSE FRANK

On September 28, 1964, Robert L. Poole, Immigration and Naturalization Service, Savannah, Georgia, advised that Mrs. Frank contacted his office and stated that she wanted to go to Russia because she is a Communist. She stated that it was her understanding that the "Yankees" kicked all the commies out of the country.

On September 28, 1964, Mrs. Frank advised that she was a Communist and wanted to go to Russia. When asked why she considered herself a Communist, Mrs. Frank simply laughed and restated that she was a Communist and that was all. She advised that her son was living in Leningrad, Russia, and that is where she wanted to go. She stated that she was born in Leningrad, Russia, and that the birth certificate in Madison, Wisconsin, reflecting that she was born in that state was erroneous. When queried as to how she entered this country, Mrs. Frank stated that she came to the United States when she was two years old and does not recall any of the details.

Mrs. Frank advised that her husband, Harold Lorin Frank, Jr., died in England after he was "poisoned by the crazy Yankees because he was a Jew." When asked who the "crazy Yankees" were, Mrs. Frank stated that they are all "fairies who take dope." Mrs. Frank advised that these "crazy Yankees" follow her around all the time and continually dope her and keep her covered with guns.

Mrs. Frank stated that she was in jail in Madison, Wisconsin, and she said that this jail was also called the Mongoda State Hospital. Mrs. Frank stated that during her stay at the Mongoda State Hospital, the "crazy Yankees" doped her and threatened her with guns.

SHIRLEY ROSE FRANK

Mrs. Frank advised that she knew Lee Harvey Oswald and his wife, Marina, having met them in Chicago in 1952. When the fallacy of this statement was pointed out to Mrs. Frank, and she was pressed for details, she was noncommittal and simply laughed and reiterated that she knew the Oswald's in Chicago.

On September 29, 1964, Mrs. Mildred LaMott, Women's Division, Savannah Police Department, Savannah, Georgia, advised that Shirley Rose Frank came to the Police Station on the afternoon of September 28, 1964, and advised that she wanted to go to Russia because she was a Communist. Mrs. Frank was examined by a physician employed by the Savannah Police Department, and his preliminary diagnosis was that she was an "ambulatory schizophrenic." Consequently, Mrs. LaMott advised that she is being held by the Savannah Police Department for "investigation of lunacy." During this investigation Mrs. LaMott stated that she determined from some of the personal effects of Mrs. Frank that she was born in Rock County, Wisconsin. During interview, Mrs. LaMott advised that Mrs. Frank told her that she was also confined to the Eastern State Hospital, Lexington, Kentucky.

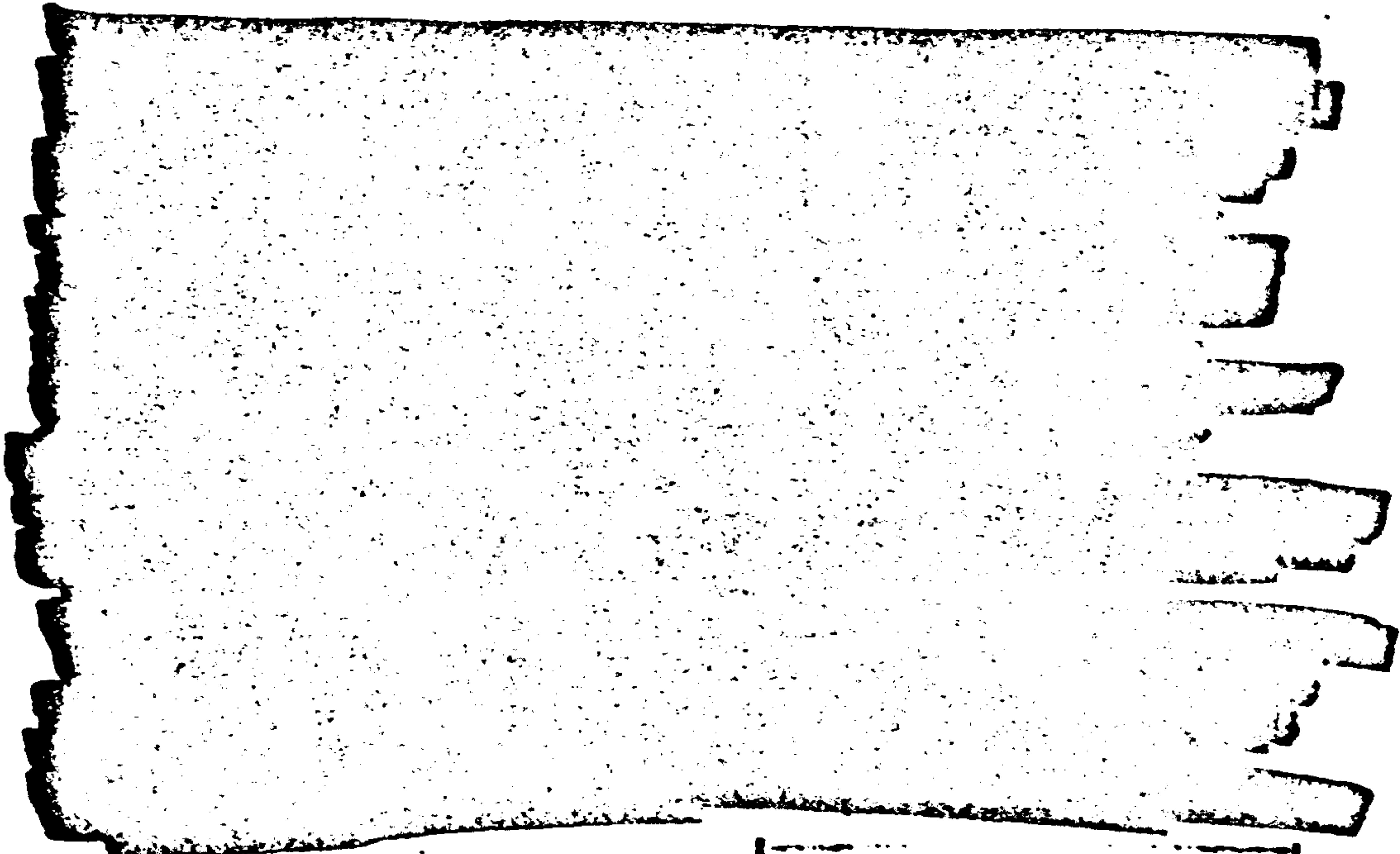

A review of the military service records on file at the Military Personnel Records Center, St. Louis, Missouri, for ORESTES FARNICIO PENA, Serial Number 51 061 050, indicated he was inducted into the U. S. Army on January 28, 1949 at New York, New York, and served on active duty until January 27, 1950, at which time he was honorably released from

active duty as a Private at Fort Benning, Georgia, and was transferred to the U. S. Army Enlisted Reserve Corps where he served in an inactive status until June 12, 1954 receiving an honorable discharge by reason of completion of his military obligation.

Records failed to reflect any foreign service, awards, citations, or decorations. His character and efficiency ratings ranged from unknown to excellent and there is no record of courts-martial or absence without official leave.

At Washington, D. C.

The following information was obtained from a review of Merchant Marine personnel file pertaining to OREST PENA obtained from Miss LUCILE R. SCHILDER, Supervisor, Merchant Vessel Personnel Records and Welfare Branch:

On August 3, 1954, at Port of New York, New York City, Orestes Farnicio Pena, 223 West 195th Street, New York City, executed an application for a United States Merchant Mariner's Document. On this application, Orestes Farnicio Pena showed he was born August 15, 1923, at Colon, Cuba, was holder of a Cuban passport, number 16583, issued June 23, 1949, by the Department of Immigration, Havana, Cuba, also was in possession of United States Immigration and Naturalization alien registration card, number A-6434157. He requested a Merchant Mariner's Document endorsed for duty as an Ordinary Seaman, Wiper and Messman. He was validated for emergency service and on November 2, 1954, was issued United States Merchant Mariner's Document, number Z-1068920. He was described as a white male, five feet eight inches tall, weight 140 pounds, black hair, brown eyes and wearing a mustache. His Social Security Number was shown as being number 068-24-0156. His next of kin was identified as his wife, Paula Pena, at 223 West 105th Street, New York City.

On May 19, 1955, Pena was issued Merchant Mariner's

Document Z-1068920 in the name Orest Pena. The file reflected he requested his name to be changed to conform with his name as it appeared on his Certificate of Naturalization, number 7426151, issued to him May 6, 1955, in United States District Court, Southern District of New York, New York City. His new Merchant Mariner's Document also showed him to be endorsed for service as Ordinary Seaman, Wiper and Messman.

On January 7, 1957, Pena's Merchant Mariner's Document was reissued at Mobile, Alabama, to show him as an able seaman-any-waters-twelve months. At that time he showed his permanent residence as 515 West 107th Street, New York City, and next of kin was identified as his daughter, Margaret Pena, at the same address.

On April 24, 1961, he was issued a Replacement Document, at which time his local address was shown as 117 Decatur Street, New Orleans, Louisiana.
