The Federal Bureau of Investigation, Washington, D. C., received a letter dated September 15, 1964 (although postmarked November 16, 1964, at Streator, Illinois), from SUSAN GREER, 1002 East Main, Streator, Illinois. This letter reads as follows:

"September 15, 1964

"The Hon. J. Edgar Hoover
Federal Bureau of Investigation
Washington, D.C.

"Dear Sir:

"I have been told that it is not necessary for me to write this, but I feel that perhaps I should. I do not feel that the person I am writing you about had anything to do with the Kennedy plot. After it happened, (the assassination), I went to my home in Rushville, Illinois. A farmer told me that a Rushville resident has a son who lives in Dallas. He said that his son wrote him two weeks before the assassination that 'something terrible is going to happen here in two weeks.' HE LIVED NEXT DOOR TO OSWALD. He said that the FBI had been around interviewing everyone. So, as everyone tells me, you would have interviewed the nextdoor neighbors of Oswald, and this letter is not necessary. I do not believe that the boy would have written his father if he himself had anything to do with it. I think even Kennedy was aware that there was a risk in going there. However, I thought that if someone knew something it might be a clue. So, I am writing you.

"However, according to the Warren Report, Oswald had not been watched beforehand. This sounds as if someone had been in the neighborhood from the FBI. Of course, you know all this, anyway."

By communication dated December 3, 1964, the Chicago Office advised that on November 30, 1964, Miss SUSAN GREER, 1002 East Main, Streator, Illinois, had advised that she was a former resident of Rushville, Illinois, and that she still owns a farm in that area which is being managed by a LAWRENCE BEGHTOL, Frederick, Illinois. She advised that a couple of months previous she had a conversation with BEGHTOL and he furnished the information that she set out in her letter to the FBI.

Miss GREER stated that BEGHTOL apparently got the information from a Rushville farmer by the name of (first name unknown) AVERY. She further advised that she did not know the first name of AVERY's son who apparently lives in Dallas, Texas.

The following investigation was conducted by Special Agent ELYON H. DAVIS:

On December 12, 1964, efforts were made to contact LAWRENCE BEGHTOL, Frederick, Illinois, at his home located on a farm approximately one mile from Frederick. However, on that date no one could be located at the BEGHTOL home.

Also on December 12, 1964, efforts were made by SA DAVIS to locate the son of LAWRENCE BEGHTOL, GAILORD BEGHTOL, at his home on a nearby farm, Frederick, Illinois. GAILORD BEGHTOL also was not at home.

On December 12, 1964, ELVA AVERY, 739 North Liberty Street, Rushville, Illinois, advised that he did not know any AVERYS residing in the Rushville area who had a son that lives in Dallas, Texas. ELVA AVERY stated the only two AVERYS residing in the Rushville area besides himself were JAMES AVERY, Rural Route 2, Rushville, and ANDY AVERY, Camden, Illinois. Both of these individuals are related to ELVA AVERY and he was quite certain that neither had a son residing in Dallas, Texas.

On December 14, 1964, GAILORD BEGHTOL, Frederick, Illinois, advised that he is the son of LAWRENCE BEGHTOL. LAWRENCE BEGHTOL was at that time confined at St. John's Hospital, Springfield, Illinois, where he was undergoing examination. GAILORD BEGHTOL had never heard of any farmer named (first name unknown) AVERY in the Rushville, Illinois, area who has a son in Dallas, Texas. He had never heard his father mention any AVERY having a son in Dallas, Texas. The only farmer in the Rushville area known by GAILORD BEGHTOL named AVERY is ANDY AVERY who resides in the Camden area near Rushville.

On December 14, 1964, JAMES AVERY, Rural Route 2, Rushville, Illinois, advised that he did not have a son residing in the Dallas, Texas, area and he is certain there are no AVERYS residing near Rushville, Illinois, with a son in Dallas, Texas.

On December 14, 1964, ANDY AVERY, Camden, Illinois, advised that he does not have a son in Dallas, Texas, and has not had a son in Dallas, Texas. He stated he is quite certain that neither JAMES AVERY nor ELVA AVERY have any relatives in Dallas, Texas. He also stated that all of the AVERYS near Rushville, Illinois are related.

The following investigation was conducted by Special Agent ROBERT JOE IVEY at Springfield, Illinois:

On December 17, 1964, LAWRENCE BEGHTOL, Frederick, Illinois, was interviewed at the St. John's Hospital, Springfield, concerning his knowledge of a farmer by the name of (first name unknown) AVERY who has a son residing in Dallas, Texas.

LAWRENCE BEGHTOL advised that he did not know any AVERYS who might have a son in Dallas, Texas. BEGHTOL stated he knew a farmer by the name of ANDY AVERY who resided near Rushville but that ANDY AVERY did not have a son in Dallas, Texas.

BEGHTOL advised that he knew a JOHN HENRY ORR, Rushville, whom he believes might have a son in Dallas, Texas. BEGHTOL further advised that he did not know the son's name, but that sometime back he overheard ORR telling someone that his son lived close to where the assassination took place. BEGHTOL stated that this was all he could remember or recall that ORR said about his son and that he did not recall anything being mentioned concerning OSWALD.

BEGHTOL stated that he did not understand why he was questioned on this matter as he did not really understand what it was all about. He stated that he wished he could help but that he did not recall anyone mentioning that their son had written a letter which concerned OSWALD or any information that something terrible was to happen in Dallas, Texas.

The following investigation was conducted by Special Agent ELYON H. DAVIS at Rushville, Illinois:

On December 24, 1964, JOHN HENRY ORR, SR., Rural Route Number 1, Rushville, advised that his son JOHN HENRY ORR, JR., resides at 2714 North Britain Road, Irving, Texas, and is employed at the Trade Mart, Dallas, Texas. His son has never made any statement of any type to him to the effect that JOHN HENRY ORR, JR., either knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD or knew anything concerning OSWALD's activities. Also JOHN HENRY ORR, JR., never made any statement or wrote anything to his parents to the effect

that something terrible was going to happen in Dallas, Texas.

On November 21, 1963, JOHN HENRY ORR, SR., received a letter from his son JOHN HENRY, JR., written on the back of a sheet of mimeograph paper of instructions for exhibitors, Dallas, Texas, Trade Mart, dated November 18, 1963. This mimeograph sheet of instructions told the exhibitors that the Trade Mart Courtyard had been selected as the site for the luncheon for the President of the United States to be held at noon Friday, November 22, 1963. The instructions told the exhibitors of the places at the Trade Mart that would be restricted on that date and what parts of the building would be closed. The instructions for the exhibitors were signed by W. E. "BILL" COOPER.

On the back side of the letter of instructions, JOHN HENRY ORR, JR., had written his parents as follows:

"Dear Folks,

We got this today--it came as no surprise since we had heard talk around the building. Please read it all. They are certainly putting a tight check on the building. There were Secret Service men around today.

I'll write you after Friday and tell you all about it. If you will watch T.V., Friday evening for the national news, you'll be able to see KENNEDY in the Trade Mart. Hope you are all well and that you'll write me soon.

P.S. Everyone I know wants me to get them in the building Friday."

ORR advised that this letter was all his son had written about the President's visit to Dallas and that his son had never mentioned OSWALD in any way.

On December 24, 1964, Mrs. JOHN HENRY ORR, SR., advised that her son JOHN HENRY ORR, JR., has never

written or told her at any time that he knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD or knew anything concerning OSWALD. Also her son has never stated to her that something terrible was going to happen in Dallas, Texas.

JOHN HENRY ~~ORR~~, JR., 2714 North Britain Road, Irving, Texas, was contacted on January 7, 1965, at his place of employment, the Pettigrew Associates, Dallas Trade Mart, Stemmons Highway, Dallas, Texas, by Special Agent RICHARD J. FURNETT:

Mr. ORR stated that he was residing in Irving, Texas, prior to the date of the assassination of President KENNEDY and has continued to reside in that suburb of Dallas since November 22, 1963.

Mr. ORR stated that his place of residence in Irving, Texas, is approximately four miles from where LEE HARVEY OSWALD's wife was residing on West Fifth Street, Irving, prior to the assassination. He continued that he has never been a neighbor of OSWALD, nor had he ever heard of OSWALD prior to the assassination.

He stated that he never wrote or told anyone, including his father, that "something terrible was going to happen here in two weeks" or words to that effect prior to November 22, 1963.

JOHN HENRY ORR, JR., stated that to the best of his knowledge there are no other residents in Irving, Texas, who formerly lived in the area of Rushville, Illinois.

Mr. ORR stated that it would not surprise him if his father, JOHN HENRY ORR, SR., had been the person referred to in any letter received by the FBI to the effect that a son of a Rushville, Illinois, resident had written prior to the assassination from Irving, Texas, that something terrible was going to happen in two weeks. Mr. ORR attributed this opinion to the fact that his father considers himself to be a "seer", that is, "a person who can predict what will happen in the future".

He continued that when he last visited his father at Rushville, Illinois, in September, 1964, his father had told him, in all seriousness, that he (the father) had on the

eve of the assassination, in a church meeting, predicted that President KENNEDY would be killed the following day. ORR stated that his mother was present in the room when his father made this remark and he asked her if his father had actually done so. His mother just smiled at him, thus indicating to him that his father's statement was not true. He did not pursue the matter further.

ORR stated that while he does not like to say so, he must state that he believes that his father is a "mental case" when it comes to predicting events and claiming that he had information regarding "world shaking" events prior to their happening.

He further advised that he was greatly shocked about the assassination of President KENNEDY and that he was present at the Dallas Trade Mart, where his business is located, and where the President was en route to make a speech a few minutes before his death.

ORR added that if he had had any information whatsoever regarding the assassination, he would have immediately contacted the appropriate government investigative agency.

The following investigation was conducted by SAs
DAVID G. LOVELESS and JAMES R. NEVES:

AT STATELINE, CALIFORNIA

On December 13, 1964, FLOYD EUGENE SWINK, Olympic
Motel, P.O. Box 2, Stateline, California, furnished the
following information:

SWINK stated that he has no additional information
concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY other than
that previously furnished to the FBI by letters to Special
Agent BEDFORD of Mesa, Arizona.

SWINK stated that all information furnished to the
FBI came as a result of direct manifestations or visions from
God. SWINK further advised that he was healed of a serious
heart condition by a minister in Los Angeles, California,
thirteen years ago. He stated that since this time he has
been gifted with visions, verbal direction, and physical
manifestations from God. SWINK stated that he holds no allegiance
to any church, as he feels that there is no true church on the
earth.

SWINK stated that his visions generally take place
during the evening or resting hours and are frequently accom-
panied by voices. He stated that visions and voices are real
and true; however, his interpretation of these visions may
not always be correct. SWINK stated that the Lord will
frequently give him a physical manifestation to let him know
if a decision is correct. He stated that the most common
physical sign is the twitching of his right eye. He further
advised that he will also witness signs in his arms, legs,
and back.

RE: RAY ALLEN DURALL

Since October, 1955, RAY ALLEN DURALL, present address of rear house, 522 North 18th Street, Phoenix, Arizona, has written numerous letters to various persons including the Phoenix Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. One of the most recent was a letter to the FBI, Washington, D. C., on November 9, 1964, and one on November 10, 1964, to the FBI, Phoenix, Arizona, alleging that his daughter and granddaughter had been kidnaped. Interview with him on November 17, 1964, indicated that he had no information indicating any kidnaping, but that his daughter had not written to him and that she had been "brainwashed and misled by people misleading her against her father".

During the interview on November 17, 1964, DURALL also stated that he knew that the Bonanza Airlines airplane, Flight 114, which had crashed near Las Vegas, Nevada, on Sunday, November 15, 1964, had been sabotaged. He then went into a long statement of his beliefs of this to be sabotage claiming he had gotten the information from "newspapers, truck drivers, hobos and people in skid row".

In the case entitled, "RAY A. DURALL, SR.; SENATOR JOHN F. KENNEDY - VICTIM; EXTORTION", investigation disclosed that DURALL had written a letter under date of August 30, 1960, from Rockport, Illinois, to Senator JOHN F. KENNEDY of Massachusetts. In this letter DURALL claimed that he had built a house with his own two hands and that it was "not built, with, by, for, Politicians or Catholics". This letter contained:

"This is your Order to either kill or release MEYESRS & McMEHNA Two spies of the Natll Bank who defected to Communism with my papers, money & propety.

"In event that you don't definitely carry out my Orders, I will, hunt you down with the big iron on my hip, just like any other criminal.

"Warning.

"When a marksman shoots don't look around the target look in it. You are in it.

"Notice NIXON got off easy with a bear tag and a bad knee. You Honor aint worth a damn. and your life less...."

On October 6, 1960, FREDERICK G. SMITHSON, Assistant United States Attorney, Washington, D. C., felt that the facts in this case were not strong enough to support a successful Federal prosecution. Investigation reflected that DURALL had lost a farm through mortgage foreclosure proceedings by the First National Bank, Pittsfield, Illinois, in the Circuit Court there some years before. The Circuit Court in Illinois has a voluminous file in the DURALL matter which was considered by Judge REARDON and Circuit Court Clerk AUSTIN ALTIZER, Pittsfield, to be the rattlings of a mentally deranged person. In the case DURALL refused to abide by the regular legal proceedings but wrote "Home-made" legal type "orders" demanding that his farm be returned to him without court proceedings.

DURALL was also the subject of an impersonation case in 1959 during which time he assumed various titles to himself, including FBI Agent, U. S. Marshal, Secret Service Agent, and Atomic Energy representative. These titles were assumed when he wrote to various officials, particularly when writing about his farm foreclosure.

Since 1954, DURALL has written numerous letters to persons, organizations (private and governmental) and the FBI complaining about various and sundry matters. He has written "ordering" Special Agents to various localities in the United States to conduct investigations specified by him. He claimed in January, 1960, to have done "undercover work for the Navy and Army" during World War II and that he would always hold the title of "Investigator for the Government".

On December 2, 1964, SHERWOOD M. ANDERSON, Special Agent in Charge, U. S. Secret Service, Phoenix, Arizona, advised Special Agent CALVIN W. EVANS that RAY ALLEN DURALL had been interviewed three times in connection with his knowledge of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

On November 22, 1963, DURALL came to the Phoenix Office of the U. S. Secret Service and told Mr. ANDERSON that he felt that the plan to assassinate President JOHN F. KENNEDY had originated in Phoenix. DURALL further alleged that his mail is being held up and read and it is then being revised in Phoenix. He claimed he had written to Senator DIRKSEN and in this letter he had mentioned a symbol of "shooting a lion with his mouth open". It was DURALL's belief that this letter had been intercepted and that, because of his mentioning this symbol, President KENNEDY had been shot.

On March 25, 1964, Mr. ANDERSON and Agent JOHN A. WALTERS, of the U. S. Secret Service, again interviewed DURALL. He reiterated the information in the letter to Senator DIRKSEN, but on this occasion stated that this letter had been written to Senator CARL HAYDEN of Arizona, rather than Senator DIRKSEN. DURALL indicated that his life had been in jeopardy for 19 years and claimed that he could not go into a restaurant or a cafe for fear the waitress would put poison in his coffee.

On March 30, 1964, DURALL wrote to the U. S. Secret Service a communication which read "Sheriff of Chchise County, Arizona, a guest at R. 45, Montezuma Motel, Dec. 8 to 18th 1963.... assassinator, sharpshooter -- Suspect #1".

Mr. ANDERSON pointed out that he had talked to DURALL on a number of occasions and that DURALL is constantly complaining about something. He further stated that his file contained the following letter:

On November 20, 1964 at approximately 3:15 PM, the San Diego FBI Office received a telephone call from a male individual who refused to identify himself. The caller stated that during the last week of October, 1963 or the first week of November, 1963 he was involved in a conversation at the Quality Bar on Market Street in San Diego, California. He recalled an unidentified woman said, "How did it go for you in Mexico?", and a person whom the caller identified as LEE HARVEY OSWALD, answered, "No good". The woman then said, "Are you going back to Mexico?" OSWALD answered, "No, I'm going to Dallas tonight."

The anonymous caller stated the bartender at the Quality Bar was involved in the conversation. The anonymous caller then hung up after expressing concern for his personal safety.

The following investigation was conducted by SA ROBERT S. BAKER:

THOMAS GROESHEL, owner of the Quality Bar and Cafe, 1115 Market Street, San Diego, California, on November 25, 1964, advised he and ROY DELANE, the latter who was terminated in December, 1963, were bartenders at the Quality Bar and Cafe during the pertinent period (October and November, 1963). GROESHEL stated he has no recollection or information indicating LEE HARVEY OSWALD was ever in the Quality Bar and Cafe, and cannot recall the alleged incident reported by the anonymous caller. He advised that due to the publicity OSWALD has received he felt sure other persons in the San Diego area would have reported the fact that OSWALD had been in San Diego, California. Except for his former bartender, ROY DELANE, Mr. GROESHEL could not suggest anyone else who might have information on the alleged incident.

ROY R. DELANE, JR., 519 Fourteenth Street, San Diego, California, on December 13, 1964 advised he was formerly employed as a bartender at the Quality Bar and Cafe, San Diego, California during most of the year 1963. He stated he was employed by and worked with THOMAS GROESHEL during the pertinent period of the alleged incident (October, November, 1963). DELANE stated he

cannot recall the alleged conversation reported by the anonymous telephone caller nor does he recall ever seeing LEE HARVEY OSWALD at the bar or at any other time. Except for THOMAS GROFSBEL, he was unable to suggest anyone else who might have any information on the alleged incident.

DELINE stated he is medically retired from the U. S. Navy and currently tends bar at Beasley's Friendly Corner Bar, 1201 Market, San Diego, California.

While on the ship, he conversed with the steward
of the ship whose name he does not know, however, he was
Russian and spoke fluent English.

He and the Russian talked about Russia and the
United States with the Russian doing most of the talking.
The Russian then asked him if he knew that GEORGE PARR
had talked to LYNDON JOHNSON about having the Federal
charges against PARR dismissed. The Russian went on to say
that JOHNSON in turn talked to BOBBY KENNEDY who had the
charges against GEORGE PARR dismissed.

The Russian then told him that GEORGE PARR had
met with LEE HARVEY OSWALD and that PARR had aided OSWALD
in destroying President JOHN F. KENNEDY so that LYNDON
JOHNSON could become President.

DE LACQUESEAU stated that he worked for GEORGE PARR
in the past on construction in Alice, Texas. He added that
he does not know what charges GEORGE PARR had pending against
him.

DE LACQUESEAU stated that GEORGE PARR is the well
known political leader from Duval County, Texas, sometimes
referred to as the "Duke of Duval."

JAMES OGDEN MINNICK, who described himself as a cook by occupation, during the past year traveling throughout the United States, was interviewed upon his request at the Hudson Hotel, 311 West Sheridan, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, concerning information which he wished to relate about the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

MINNICK, employed in Dallas, Texas, from 1959 to December, 1963, said that as a patron of the Vegas Club, from about 1961, he had gained a speaking acquaintance with JACK RUBY and RUBY's sister, EVA GRANT, operator of the Vegas Club; a man thought to be an associate of RUBY's had dated one PATRICIA ASHER of 1414 North Peak, Dallas, Texas, where MINNICK lived during the period prior to and following the assassination, a period when MINNICK had been employed at the Speedee Barbecue on North Ross, patronized by RUBY.

MINNICK, though never acquainted with LEE HARVEY OSWALD, said he believed he had identified OSWALD as being in contact with RUBY several weeks prior to the assassination:

(1) RUBY, in company with two men unknown to MINNICK and a woman described as a "red-haired stripper," had held what appeared to be some kind of a business meeting between 2 a.m. and 3 a.m., several weeks prior to the assassination, at the Speedee Barbecue on North Ross. The group appeared to be considering some kind of a blueprint, a plan or a map which RUBY had folded inside a newspaper. MINNICK was unsuccessful in his attempts to eavesdrop.

(2) The man, now thought by MINNICK to have been LEE HARVEY OSWALD, had driven the car, a late model black four-door sedan, in which the RUBY party had arrived. During the course of the meeting this individual waited outside, pacing the walk; one time walked the two dogs that RUBY had in the car - a poodle and a Great Dane; one time entered the restaurant to make a purchase at the cashier's counter, possibly cigarettes. This individual acted as chauffeur when the party left.

(3) MINNICK first considered that this individual might have been OSWALD several days after OSWALD had been shot by RUBY. This occurred to him following a conversation at the ASHER residence, 1414 North Peak, with PATRICIA ASHER, FRANCES ASHER, and the boyfriend of PATRICIA ASHER, thought to be an associate of RUBY's. This man had stated that he had attempted unsuccessfully to visit RUBY at the jail; stated that nothing would be done to RUBY; that RUBY ought to receive a medal for shooting OSWALD. MINNICK recalled no other specifics of the conversation; no mention had been made of a possible prior association between RUBY and OSWALD, and MINNICK had not mentioned the incident at the Speedee Barbecue as he said he had not thought about it until later.

The date of the meeting in question at the Speedee Barbecue might be established, MINNICK said, through contact with a waitress then employed there and present at the time. It had occurred to days after her husband had blacked her eye. The waitress was one RONNIE LEE (LAST NAME UNKNOWN) described as about 23 or 24, 4'9" to 5' tall, 118-20 pounds. She had two children, both boys; her husband also worked at the restaurant. The injury had required medical treatment at Dallas Hospital through which the date of the meeting might be established.

The men meeting with RUBY at the Speedee Barbecue were two whom MINNICK thought he had seen about Dallas before, but not in a former association with RUBY. He thought he might be able to identify photographs of the men.

MINNICK claimed to have known EVA GRANT and claimed to have known her well enough to have borrowed \$5 from her at one time while patronizing the Vegas Club, an amount which he said he had repaid. He said he had not been "real personally acquainted with RUBY - we did not hit it off." RUBY was said to have liked the way in which MINNICK prepared steaks and thus ate in the places where MINNICK had been employed, including the DeMar's Steak House, 6127 Sherry Lane, Preston Center, Dallas. He had never worked for RUBY.

MINNICK supplied the following descriptive data concerning the individuals whom he had seen in association with RUBY at the Speedee Barbecue:

(1) One female described by MINNICK as a "red-haired stripper," a white female, 24-25, 5'6-7", 120 pounds, fair complexion, with red hair, either dyed or a wig, worn in the fashion of a beehive. She was dressed modishly and wore a fur cape about her shoulders.

(2) Unknown male, an executive type, with the appearance of an attorney of the age late 40's or early 50's, 180 pounds, 5'5-4", stocky build, gray hair, very distinguished, wearing a business suit with a white shirt and tie. To the best of MINNICK's recollection, he was round faced and wore glasses.

(3) Unknown male, described by MINNICK as an older man who had the appearance of being retired, described as about 60 years old, of possibly Italian extraction, 6', 165-70 pounds, dark hair, graying, wearing a dark suit and a topcoat.

(4) The individual thought by MINNICK to have been OSWALD is described as a white male, in his mid-20's, 5'6-7", 150-70 pounds, dark wavy hair, combed back, wearing a white shirt and dark trousers. It is noted that MINNICK stated this man was seen to operate a motor vehicle.

MINNICK stated that his point of observation had been from the back of the Speedee Barbecue to the front walk, a distance of 45-50 feet. He said he was under fluorescent lights looking to a somewhat darkened street at night time and stated that, "A man's eyes can play tricks." He considered, however, that the man he saw without question was LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

MINNICK described the friend of PATRICIA ASHER, thought to be an associate of RUBY's, as follows:

A white male, in his late 20's, 6'-6'2", 220-230 pounds, dark hair, combed back, medium complexion, broad shoulders, good looking, described by MINNICK as a "loud-mouthed drinker." This individual operated a 1958 white over black Oldsmobile 88 two-door automobile, thought to have had California license plates.

MINNICK said that his knowledge of this possible prior association between RUBY and OSWALD began to prey upon his mind.

He feared he might meet with foul play at the hands of RUBY's "henchmen." He left Dallas and has done nothing but travel since. MINNICK stated, "I am not a nut or anything like that, but I had a premonition that KENNEDY might be killed in Dallas." He said that when anything happens of an untowards nature to members of his family, he knows it instinctively. He described this, though without using the word, as extra-sensory perception.

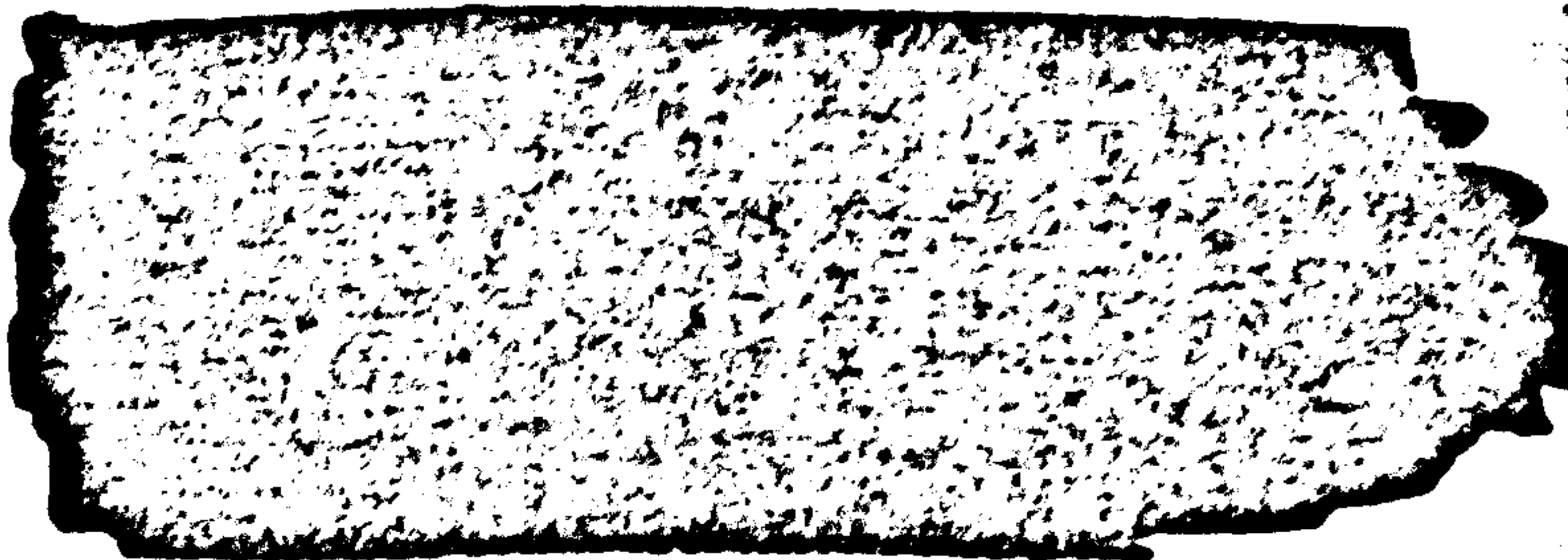

LEE R. SPRADLIN, part owner, Speedy's Charcoal Burgers, Dallas, advised that JAMES MINNICK worked as a cook on several occasions in 1963 at his restaurant located at 4004 Ross Avenue, Dallas. (T.K.)

SPRADLIN stated that MINNICK was a good cook, but not too reliable due to his drinking habits. He stated that he frequently had to go to MINNICK's rooming house on North Peak Street to get him to come to work. However, SPRADLIN stated that he considered MINNICK to be a likeable and good employee.

He stated that MINNICK had never mentioned to him that he, MINNICK, had seen LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY together at Speedy's restaurant on Ross Avenue at anytime prior to the assassination of President KENNEDY.

However, SPRADLIN stated that JACK RUBY used to infrequently stop at the restaurant on Ross Avenue on purely personal visits. SPRADLIN added that he does not personally know RUBY.

In regards to OSWALD having ever been at the restaurant on Ross Avenue in the past, SPRADLIN stated that he is sure he would have heard of this, if true, as two of his older employed waitresses at the Ross Avenue restaurant would have mentioned the matter to him; which neither have ever done. Thus, SPRADLIN doubts if OSWALD was ever at the Ross Avenue restaurant.

JAMES OGDEN MINNICK, residing at the Dean Hotel, 416 North Broadway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, was interviewed for information supplementing that concerning himself and the ASHERS, FRANCES and PATRICIA, which he had provided on November 28, 1964; a matter in which he had reported the belief he had seen LEE HARVEY OSWALD in the company of JACK RUBY prior to the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

MINNICK had reported his residence, and that of the ASHERS, during the period to and following the assassination, as 1414 North Peak, Dallas, Texas, an address found to be non-existent, though investigation had determined that MINNICK, in fact, had resided on Peak. Investigation, based on the information which he had provided, also had failed to identify FRANCES ASHER and her daughter PATRICIA ASHER.

JAMES OGDEN MINNICK, residing at the Dean Hotel, 416 North Broadway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, was interviewed for information supplementing that which he supplied on November 28, 1964, in order to establish his address at Dallas, Texas, during the period prior to and following the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY; to obtain identifying data and background information concerning FRANCES ASHER and her daughter PATRICIA ASHER.

After research of the 1963 Polk City Directory for Dallas, Texas, MINNICK advised he had resided during the period in question at 1513 North Peak, Dallas, Texas, an apartment conversion owned by HAROLD O. McCAIN. McCAIN, he said, formerly had resided at this address.

By way of confirmation of the address, MINNICK described the house as a story and one-half frame house with gray-shingled exterior; a gable end facing the street; a recessed front entry; a house located one door from the Hampton Apartments, and four and five doors west, respectively, from the O. H. White Filter Service, and the Doyle Cafe. The house had two apartments on the first floor, separated by a central hallway running from front to rear. In addition, two sleeping rooms were to the front. MINNICK said he had occupied the sleeping room to the right of the front entry. FRANCES ASHER, and later, PATRICIA ASHER, had resided in the apartment on the right. An attic apartment had been occupied by a man named LUTHER, last name unknown, whose wife had been acquainted with FRANCES ASHER. MINNICK said he had not known the occupants of the east apartment.

MINNICK said he had moved to this address about 10 days prior to his obtaining employment at Speedy's Charcoal Burgers No. 2, Dallas, Texas; had moved out about two weeks following the assassination. Previously, he had been visiting his brothers, FRANKLIN and TRACY MINNICK, at Arlington, California.

MINNICK stated that the above constituted all of the information which he could recall concerning FRANCES and PATRICIA ASHER.

In the event a later interview might be required, MINNICK said he would advise the Oklahoma City Office should he move from the Dean Hotel in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

HAROLD O. McCAIN, 1513 North Peak, Dallas, advised that he operates a rooming house at this address.

McCAIN stated that during the latter part of 1963 he had a roomer named JIM MINNICK who used to work at a hamburger restaurant nearby on Ross Avenue. McCAIN described MINNICK as a heavy drinker who was prone to greatly exaggerate on any topic being discussed. McCAIN stated that it got to the point that he could not believe anything MINNICK said.

McCAIN stated that MINNICK never mentioned anything to him about having seen LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY together at the restaurant where he worked, even though MINNICK was rooming at this address at the time prior to and after the assassination of President KENNEDY. McCAIN added that MINNICK had not made such a comment to him as MINNICK knew "that I would have laughed in his face."

McCAIN added that he would personally consider any statement made by MINNICK in connection with OSWALD and RUBY as completely unreliable.

Mrs. FRANCES LYNN ASHER, Apartment 7, 4625 San Jacinto, Dallas, advised that she and her daughter, PAT, formerly rented a room in the home of a Mr. HAROLD O. McCAIN at 1513 North Peak Street, Dallas.

Mrs. ASHER stated that while a roomer at the latter address, there was another roomer by the name of JIM MINNICK who had a room located in the front of the house. She stated that MINNICK was employed as a cook at various restaurants in Dallas and for a while worked at Speedy's restaurant on Ross Avenue in Dallas.

Mrs. ASHER described MINNICK as a heavy drinker in whom she had no confidence. She stated that she had caught MINNICK in so many "unnecessary" lies that she eventually would not believe anything he talked about.

She stated that MINNICK never mentioned anything to her about having seen LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY together at any time in the past.

Mrs. ASHER stated that neither she nor her daughter, PAT, with whom she is very close, ever knew RUBY or knew anyone who knew RUBY.

She stated that the description of the man MINNICK states was a boy friend of her daughter who was thought to be an associate of JACK RUBY fits that of a BOB RAMSEY. She stated that RAMSEY worked as a bartender in the neighborhood of North Peak Street and Bryan Avenue when MINNICK was living at 1513 North Peak Street. She stated that he was from California, but had only dated her daughter on several occasions. Mrs. ASHER stated that RAMSEY was in Dallas for only a short time and he had never mentioned to her that he knew JACK RUBY. RAMSEY was in Dallas at the time of the assassination.

Mrs. ASHER stated that MINNICK detested RAMSEY for personal reasons.

She further advised that her daughter, PAT SILVERGLIED, has moved to California and is now living at 1151 West 31st Street, Los Angeles, California.
