Deputy United States Marshal of any type. He pointed out that he did not desire to harm anyone and the letter in question contained no threats.

ROBERSON was then questioned about his being out with the movie actress, AUDREY HEPBURN. ROBERSON then stated that he did not remember whether he was out with this person or not. ROBERSON said he had intended by his comments to impress the person to whom he had sent the letter. He claimed this person had given him the understanding that she would like to keep company with him, and for that reason, he had called her and had written her. He said he did not desire to harm her in any way and in fact, if she was not interested in his attention, he would no longer try to communicate with her.

ROBERSON was appropriately admonished for his allegation that he was a Deputy United States Marshal, and he was cautioned to desist in the future from such a representation of such a false impersonation. He said that he would do this.

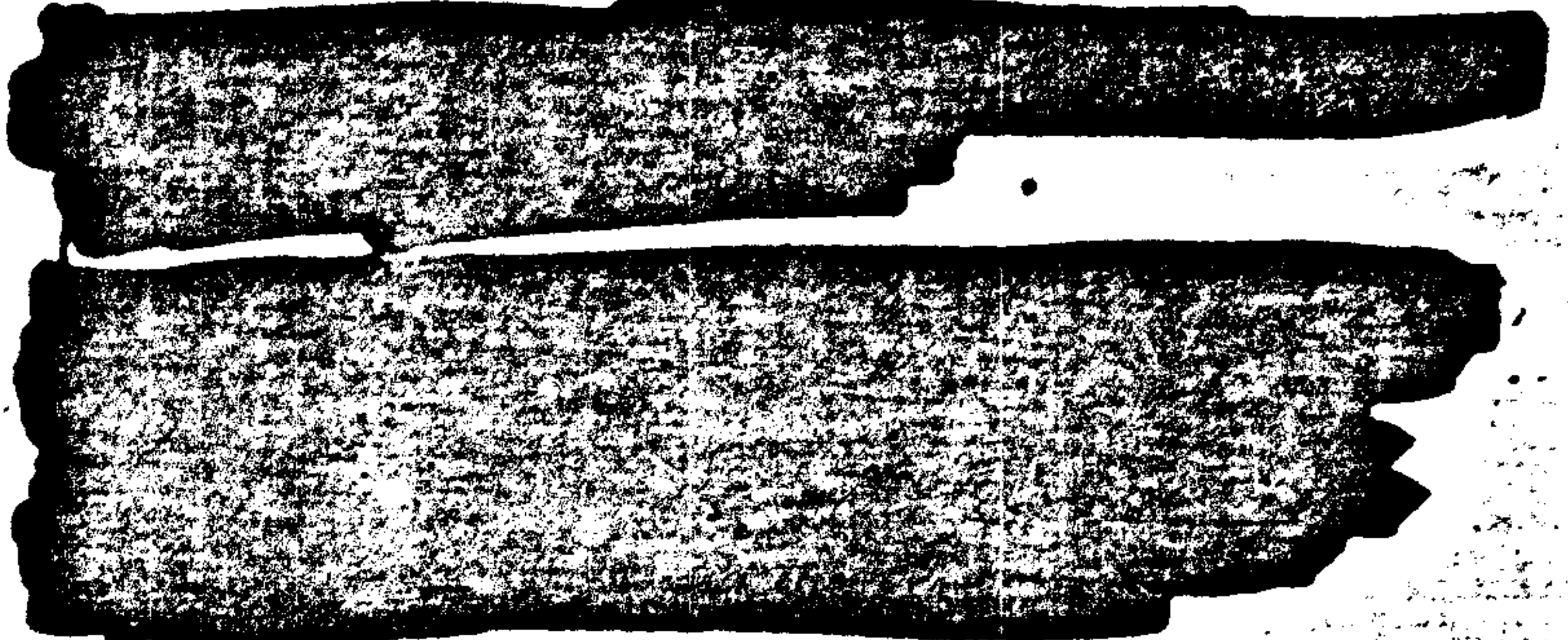

Re Buairtel to Dallas, Memphis, and Chicago dated 4/5/65 and report of SA GEORGE W. HYMERS dated 2/27/64 at Memphis captioned, "LEE HARVEY OSWALD, aka."

On 4/1/65 the Memphis Division received a letter postmarked 3/26/65 at Chicago, Ill., from EULIS LEE ROBERSON, 814 N. Fairfield St., Chicago, which had been sent to "Captain Hymers, FBI Office, Jackson, Tenn."

In this letter ROBERSON stated:

"Just a line, as I talked this last summer at Michie, Tennessee, and you said Orleary Hypeburn wrote you concerning a story I wrote to the Dallas Morning News.

"Capt., I have lost her correct address and I wonder if you can or still have her correct address. If so, please send it to me. Thank you.
