Re New Haven tel to Director dated 11/27/63, captioned "Assassination of President Kennedy", 11/22/63, Dallas, Texas.

CHUCK PERLIN, Production Department, Radio Station WHN, 400 Park Avenue, NYC, advised SAS GEORGE S. TEMPRO and MARTIN R. GREALY on 11/30/63, that WHN carried about 2:00 p.m. on 11/24/63, a news broadcast by SERGE FLIEGERS from Europe. He stated his station did not tape this broadcast since it was carried through the facilities of the Mutual Broadcasting Corporation (MBC), who employes FLIEGERS. He stated that most likely MBC has the tape of that broadcast.

7-11-63

On same date, CHARLES KING, Director of News Service, MBC, 1440 Broadway, NYC, advised SAS TEMPRO and GREALY that on 11/29/63, he had a telephone conversation with Assistant Director DE LOACH, FBI, concerning the broadcast of 11/24/63, by SERGE FLIEGERS, MBC Chief Foreign Correspondent. He advised based on this conversation he could furnish a tape of this broadcast to NYO. This tape was furnished to Bureau on 11/29/63. In addition, KING stated he has instructed FLIEGERS, upon his arrival, Paris, France, 11/1/63, to immediately furnish FBI, Paris all information he has concerning subject.

KING advised he believes FLIEGERS source of information on OSWALD is someone connected with the Austrian Intelligence Service. KING added FLIEGERS, in the past week, interviewed a person, only identified as "Mr. X", who furnished alleged information concerning OSWALD's activities and training while in Russia and this interview was broadcast on 11/29/63 by MBC on the show "World Today." KING furnished a tape of this interview to Bureau Agents, which is being enclosed to you for your information. KING indicated "Mr. X" is probably associated with the Austrian Intelligence Service. He also furnished SERGE FLIEGERS' addresses as Ritz Hotel or Press Wireless, #8 Rue Edward VII, both Paris, France.
