She said ANCIRA has made frequent travels to Mexico and on the date of the assassination of President Kennedy she asked ANCIRA if he was going to watch the President motorcade to which ANCIRA replied "He's not my President" or words to that effect. Miss BLANTON also stated that for approximately two weeks immediately after the assassination ANCIRA disappeared from Dallas for reasons unknown to her.
