Dallas, which has grown from a single log cabin to one of America's major metropolitan centers in slightly more than a century, is the home of the Cotton Bowl, the State

Fair of Texas, Southern Methodist University and one of the nation's most impressive skylines. Dallas ranks among the greatest insurance, finance and aviation centers of the United States.



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Liberal Senators, like Hubert Humphrey, and the AFL-CIO, propose instead an individual income tax cut giving emphasis to lower bracket rate reductions. Most arguments on both sides, declare a tax cut is desirable to prime the stagnant economy and forestall a lingering recession. The business case is that with more after-tax profits, there will be more investment, stimulating the capital goods industries, which are the most stagnant. The liberal argument is that there is already overcapacity, what is needed is to raise consumer purchasing power to stimulate production.

THEIR PREREQUISITE expose the big business view. "The consumer purchasing power has held up. What has been particularly disappointing has been investment, and we have to consider whether a tax cut, and if so, what kind of a tax cut would stimulate investment & that business can meet."

As immediate Chairman of Commerce-type bill is held up by (a) hesitation of many Congressmen as well as before the elections; (b) the opinion of some businessmen that they can get more in two bites than in one; and (c) the fear of some of an increased deficit. But the delay to January may be cancelled right now. If the economic goals really are needed.

The financial journals concede that tax cuts already granted have not, and those pending are unlikely to, positively affect capital investment much.
