She could furnish no specific details of any irregularities or violations of Federal statutes; however, she advised that she has been in contact with the District Attorney's Office at Nashville, Tenn., and has consulted with a private attorney. She stated that she believed that CHAMBERS has a record for uttering bad checks in Texas.

She stated that she had no knowledge of any link between RUBY and LEE HARVEY OSWALD and had no knowledge that CHAMBERS was involved in any way. She advised that she wanted CHAMBERS investigated and was furnishing this as a matter of information.

Mrs. YOUNG was advised that no investigation of CHAMBERS was to be instituted in the absence of any indication that he had violated any Federal statute. She was informed that he was to be contacted concerning her information that he had known JACK LEON RUBY.

It might be noted that during the week of 1/6 - 1/11/64, efforts were made to contact Mr. CHAMBERS at Metro Electric Company, Nashville, Tenn., where it was learned he was ill and confined to bed. He was contacted at the earliest date available, that is, 1/13/64; 25 copies of an FD 302 reflecting results of that interview are transmitted herewith for Dallas.

Mr. WENTWORTH DURANT, Attorney, 2323 Fidelity Union Towers, telephone RI 8-0074, telephonically contacted me on 1/22/64 and related the following information.

GEORGE T. DAVIS, Attorney, San Francisco, who is presently in Washington, D.C., called DURANT on 1/22/64, stating he would like to talk with some appropriate person or persons in Dallas relative to the background information of RUBY and also of MELVIN BELLI, an Attorney who is representing RUBY. DURANT described DAVIS as an individual who was not too reliable at times and was a competitor of BELLI in San Francisco. DURANT related that he did not want DAVIS to know that he related the fact that DAVIS had contacted DURANT about six or eight weeks ago wanting to know if DURANT had any contacts whereby he could get involved in the RUBY case. GEORGE T. DAVIS has been the Attorney in the past for CAROL CHESSMAN, a noted case in California. According to DURANT, DAVIS has written a book and probably is jealous of BELLI's publicity in the RUBY case.

DURANT related that DAVIS stated he would arrive in Dallas, Texas at 11:50 AM on Flight 107, 1/23/64. DURANT is to meet DAVIS and have lunch with him.

'Per your instructions, arrangements have been made with FRANK AUSTIN, Manager of Braniff's operations at Love Field whereby room 707 can be utilized for the interview for privacy. This room is normally used by Braniff as a conference and press room. It is located adjacent to Braniff gate 11. DURANT stated that he would meet the Agents at room 707, adjacent to gate 11 at 11:30 AM. DURANT does not want DAVIS to know of his comments regarding DAVIS' character, but doesn't know how much credence can be placed in DAVIS' information.

On 11/26/63, [REDACTED] advised that he had observed STEVE MAGADDINO, PETER A. MAGADDINO and SAM RANGATORE having a brief discussion concerning a new automobile obtained by RANGATORE. There then followed a brief discussion between STEVE MAGADDINO, PETER A. MAGADDINO, RANGATORE and one other unidentified individual, during which they briefly speculated about the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY and the killer of LEE HARVEY OSWALD. The subject believed RUBY will not be convicted. RANGATORE and PETER A. MAGADDINO believed RUBY - will be released on a plea of insanity. PETER A. MAGADDINO had no doubts, according to the informant, that OSWALD killed the President; whereas RANGATORE stated that it is difficult to prove who exactly pulled the trigger. The subject and PETER A. MAGADDINO expressed the belief that RUBY has the Nation's sympathy. However, they add that it has been established that

OSWALD had been seen at RUBY's nightclub prior to the assassination. The subject stated that he suspected there may be a connection between OSWALD and RUBY and that there is more involved than meets the eye. He explained that with so many policemen in the Dallas Police Station, no one could possibly gain entrance without being noticed. However, inasmuch as RUBY got in, the subject implied there might have been a conspiracy with the Dallas Police. He further stated that the family of the Dallas policeman who was killed by OSWALD should receive a pension from the Government. RANGATORE recommended that the KENNEDY family should provide money for the deceased officer's family.


The remainder of this conversation became unintelligible due to extraneous noises and the mumbled and muffled tones of RANDACCIO. However, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] RANDACCIO then began to speak in a very low whisper tone which rendered a brief conversation between him and the subject inaudible.

RANDACCIO then facetiously called out to RANGATORE and congratulated him on the death of the President. Everyone present began to laugh. STEVE MAGARDINO interrupted and cautioned the group that the public around them is watching

for their reaction in this matter, and that they must not speak in this fashion. All agreed with the subject, who then proceeded to tell them that the late President was one of the greatest presidents we have had and blamed the cause for his assassination on his brother, the Attorney General. MAGADDINO stated that ROBERT KENNEDY pressed too many issues behind the scenes. As an example, MAGADDINO cited the VALACHI hearings. He stated that neither the President, nor (Director J. EDGAR) HOOVER and the FBI wish to bring up "discussions" which were brought out by the "VALACHI hearings." He remarked that the Attorney General had to "accomplish something" and therefore pressed too many issues. MAGADDINO stated he had received this information from "educated people who have gone to school for many years and know what they are talking about."

He stated that he had obtained confidential information that the prosecution intended to use one of their informants by the name of [REDACTED] to testify as a witness for the prosecution to the effect that she definitely knows that LEE HARVEY OSWALD and JACK RUBY were good acquaintances and old friends. TONAHILL stated that the prosecution may or may not subpoena [REDACTED] and if they do not subpoena her, they probably will have her close at hand for quick availability when they need her to testify.

Synopsis: Threatening call made to Governor's mansion, Austin, Texas, 12:55 p.m., 3/14/64. Caller, an unknown male and female, both talking from Nashville, Tenn., used profane language, referred to the RUBY verdict and both threatened to come to Texas and shoot Governor JOHN CONNALLY on Good Friday and blow up the place. Investigation determined call made from Nashville phone CA 8-0915, the unlisted phone of HUGH MONTGOMERY, Plum Street, Nashville, Tenn. Investigation disclosed seven adults and two children at Plum Street address at time call made. HUGH MONTGOMERY employed 41 years Western Union, Nashville, stated all were drunk or drinking. MONTGOMERY stated he had not been drinking and denied knowledge of the call made to Austin, Texas. He stated if call made it was probably by his brother GEORGE MONTGOMERY and niece CHRISTINE BURKE. GEORGE MONTGOMERY denied making call. Subjects admitted they made call but were drinking and had no intention of carrying out the threat. CHRISTINE BURKE admitted making threat on phone. McGRIFF said she talked but made no threats. AUSA, Nashville, declined prosecution. Authorized complaint filed before USC, San Antonio, Texas, 3/18/64, charging subjects with a violation of Section 875(c), Title 18, USC. \$2500 bond recommended. Subjects arrested by Bureau Agents, Nashville, Tenn., 3/18/64. Subjects appeared before USC, Nashville, Tenn., and released on \$2500 non-surety bond.

DETAILS:

ME 9-1241

On March 14, 1964, the San Antonio Division telephonically advised the Memphis Division as follows:

At 12:55 p.m., Central Standard Time, on March 14, 1964, a long distance call from an unknown male and female, both talking from Nashville, Tennessee, using profane language, called for Governor JOHN CONNALLY at Greenwood 7-6186, Austin, Texas, which is the phone number of the Governor's mansion. Governor CONNALLY was out of town at the time the call was received by BILL NELSON, Texas Highway Patrolman at the mansion. The callers referred to the RUBY verdict. The unknown male and female threatened to come to Texas and shoot Governor CONNALLY on Good Friday and "blow the place up." They said that they were going to shoot a bullet in Governor CONNALLY when the switch was pulled on JACK RUBY. NELSON tried to trace the call and the operator in Nashville, Tennessee, who came on the line, refused to furnish the information as to the identity of the callers. NELSON could hear an infant crying in the background and a radio playing, therefore, assumed the call was from a residence.

Records of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company disclosed that at 12:52 p.m., March 14, 1964, a prepaid call was made from Nashville phone CA 8-0915 to Greenwood 7-6186, Austin, Texas. The records disclosed that Nashville phone CA 8-0915 is the unlisted phone subscribed to by HUGH MONTGOMERY, Plum Street, Nashville, Tennessee. The call was charged to Nashville phone CA 8-0915 and the operator was not on the line at the time of the call.

HUGH L. MONTGOMERY, residing Plum Street at Nashville, Tennessee, Nashville phone CA 8-0915, was contacted at the Warner Drug Company, located on Eighth Avenue South, Nashville, Tennessee. MONTGOMERY was advised of the nature of the interview and the identity of the interviewing agents. He was advised that he did not have to make any statements and that any statements he did make must be made freely and voluntarily. He was advised that he had the right to consult an attorney before making any statement. He was further advised that any statement he made could be used in a court of law against him.

MONTGOMERY thereafter advised that he is 56 years old and that he has been employed as a clerk in the Credit and Collection Department of the Western Union Telephone and Telegraph Company, Nashville, Tennessee, for the past 41 years.

He stated that the property located at Plum Street where he presently resides is owned by his mother, Mrs. MARY MONTGOMERY, age 80.

He stated that living at the same address is his brother GEORGE MONTGOMERY, age 45; his sister ANNIE BEATY, a widow age 49; and her daughter CHRISTINE BURKE, who is 34 years old. He stated that CHRISTINE's daughter, age 2 years, also resides at this address with them.

MONTGOMERY stated that on the night of March 13, 1964, he stayed at 2015 Franklin Road, Nashville, Tennessee. He stated that on March 14, 1964, he arrived at his home on Plum Street at approximately 12:15 p.m. He said that as he recalls, he left his home on Plum Street at approximately 1:00 p.m. or after to go to the grocery store. He advised that he knows nothing concerning any call that was made from his telephone at Plum Street address to Austin, Texas. He said that he believes that he would have known of this call if it had been made while he was in the house. He advised that during the period of time that he was at the Plum Street address between 12:15 and approximately 1:00 p.m. on March 14, 1964, there was also at this residence his mother, brother, sister and his niece CHRISTINE BURKE and

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her daughter in addition to one NORMA JUNE McGRIFF, residing Portland Avenue, Nashville, and her daughter LINDA, age 6 or 7 years old.

He stated that also at the address at that time was one HARVEY WITT residing on Hart Street who is of low intelligence and considered a moron, age 36 or 37 years old, and one ERNEST WITT, the father of HARVEY WITT, age 70 or 80 years old, also residing on Hart Street in Nashville. He stated that there was also at this address at the time one CLINTON MATTHEW, who resides on Settle Court in Nashville, Tennessee.

He stated that during the period of time on March 14, 1964, when he was at the Plum Street address between 12:15 and 1:00 p.m. GEORGE MONTGOMERY, NORMA JUNE McGRIFF, CHRISTINE BURKE, HARVEY WITT and CLINTON MATTHEW were drinking both whiskey and wine. He advised that as he recalls, CLINTON MATTHEW had passed out.

He stated that he does not believe that ANNIE BERRY was drinking, at least he could not tell it from observation of her. He stated that in his opinion CHRISTINE BURKE, NORMA McGRIFF, GEORGE MONTGOMERY and HARVEY WITT were definitely drunk and as previously stated, CLINTON MATTHEW had passed out.

He advised that the above named had been watching television and had observed and heard the results of the trial of RUBY at Dallas, Texas. He stated they seemed rather upset about it but that he attributed this to the fact that they had been drinking excessively.

MONTGOMERY advised that if a telephone call was made to the Governor's mansion at Austin, Texas, and that if threats were made against the Governor, he would believe that either GEORGE MONTGOMERY and/or CHRISTINE BURKE were the ones responsible for this call.

He again pointed out, however, that he had no knowledge of a call being made and no positive information as to who may have made the call.

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Date March 24, 1964

GEORGE MONTGOMERY, age 43, born Nashville, Tennessee, April 23, 1919, was contacted on March 14, 1964, at his address on Plum Street in Nashville, Tennessee.

MONTGOMERY was advised as to the identity of the agents and the purpose of the interview. He was advised that he did not have to make any statements, that any statements he made could be used against him in court. He was advised that he had the right to consult an attorney before making any statements. He was further advised that any statements he made must be made freely and voluntarily.

It was noted at the time of this interview that GEORGE MONTGOMERY appeared to be under the influence of alcoholic beverages and was drinking alcoholic beverages in the presence of the interviewing agents. He appeared to be incoherent to a great extent.

MONTGOMERY stated at this time that he formerly resided on Cranwell Drive in Hendersonville, Tennessee, with his wife until approximately one week ago. He stated at that time that his wife left him and that he had been drinking ever since. He advised that he was at the residence on Plum Street the entire day of March 14, 1964, except for a short period of time when he left at approximately 2:30 p.m. to buy some wine. He advised that the phone number at this address is CA 8-0915.

He stated at the time of this interview that one HARVEY ODEL WITT, residing on Hart Street, and ERNEST WITT, also residing Hart Street, Nashville, Tennessee, were at the residence on Plum Street and were drinking with him. He stated that one CLINTON MATTHEWS, who resides on Settle Court, was also at the Plum Street address and had been drinking to such an extent that he had passed out.

MONTGOMERY on March 15 and 18, 1964, was again questioned concerning the telephone call made to the Governor's mansion in Austin, Texas, from Nashville telephone No. GA 8-0915. He again denied any knowledge of this telephone call and stated that he had not known about the telephone call until CHRISTINE BURKE had admitted to them that she had made such a call.

MONTGOMERY on March 15, 1964, and again March 18, 1964, denied having participated in any telephone call to the Governor's mansion at Austin, Texas, on March 14, 1964.

It is noted that at the time of this interview present at the home of HUGH MONTGOMERY, Plum Street, Nashville, Tennessee, on March 14, 1964, was CHRISTINE BURKE and her 2-year-old daughter, as well as Mrs. MARY MONTGOMERY, age 80 years.

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DIANA GRUBB, Central Records Division, Metropolitan Police Department, Nashville, Tennessee, on March 16, 1964, advised SA HONETOR that records of her office disclose the following:

NORMA JUNE McGRIFF, white female, born March 26, 1926, has a record of seven arrests from February, 1953, to October, 1961, involving charges of loitering and disorderly house; disorderly and offensive conduct; disorderly conduct; drunk; disorderly and offensive conduct and drunk on the street. Fines for these offenses range from \$5.00 to \$10.00 and in some instances charges were dismissed.

CHRISTINE BURKE, white female, born April 28, 1930, has a record of arrests shown as follows:

Present at the time of this interview was GEORGE MONTGOMERY and Mrs. MARY MONTGOMERY, age 80 years. Also present at this address at this time was the 2-year-old daughter of CHRISTINE BURKE.

It was noted at the beginning of this interview that CHRISTINE BURKE appeared to be under the influence of alcoholic beverages and quite incoherent.

CHRISTINE BURKE advised at this time that she had been at this address on Plum Street the entire day of March 14, 1964.

BURKE denied having watched television and denied having seen the results of the RUBY trial on television.

BURKE denied knowing anything concerning any telephone call to Austin, Texas.

She advised that the only person she recalls at this address during the noon period from 12:00 until 1:00 p.m. on March 14, 1964, was Mrs. MARY MONTGOMERY, her 80-year-old grandmother; HUGH MONTGOMERY and her (BURKE's) mother, ANNIE BEATY, who also resided at Plum Street, Nashville.

On March 15, 1964, CHRISTINE BURKE telephonically contacted SA CHARLES J. HONETOR and advised that she desired to discuss the telephone call which was made to Austin, Texas, on March 14, 1964.

CHRISTINE BURKE, who stated that her maiden name is BEATY, again denied that any man at the residence on Plum Street had been involved in making the telephone call to Austin, Texas. She furnished the following free and voluntary statement:

"Nashville, Tennessee
March 15, 1964

"I, Christine Burke, hereby make the following free and voluntary statement to Charles J. Honetor and Charles P. Grigsby who have identified themselves to me as being Special Agents with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. I have been advised that I do not have to make any statement but that any statement I do make can be used against me in court. I have been advised that I have the right to consult an attorney before making this statement.

On March 14, 1964 about noon I was watching the Ruby trial on T.V. My Grandmother, Mrs. Mary Montgomery, my mother-in-law Beaty and Norma McGriff and possibly others were watching T.V.

"Norma McGriff, after the results of the Ruby trial were shown, went to the telephone which is number CA 8-0915 at Plum Street, Nashville, Tenn. where I live. Norma McGriff made a call on the telephone and then called me to the telephone and said I have got the Governor's Mansion on the phone. I knew that she meant the Mansion of the Governor of Texas at Austin, Texas. She said she had already told him that they were going to kill him.

"I got on the telephone and told the man that the Governor was going to get killed when they pull the switch on Ruby. I hung up the telephone. If a man talked on the telephone I don't know who it would be. Both Norma and I were drunk as well as everyone else except my grandmother Mrs. Mary Montgomery. Hugh Montgomery had gone to the grocery store.

"The only reason the telephone call was made is because Norma and I were drunk and had become emotionally

upset over the results of the trail of Ruby when we saw it on T.V.

"I am 34 years old and was born 4/28/30 at Nashville, Tenn. I live in a house on Plum Street owned by my grandmother Mrs. Mary Montgomery. I also have a 2 year old daughter whom I take care of and who lives with me at this address.

"I have read the above statement consisting of this & two other pages and it is true.

NORMA JUNE McGRIFF denied that any man was involved in the telephone call made on March 14, 1964, to the Governor's mansion at Austin, Texas. Mrs. McGRIFF furnished the following free and voluntary statement:

"I Norma June McGriff, hereby make the following free and voluntary statement to Charles J. Honetor and Henderson Hillin, Jr. who have identified themselves to me as being Special Agents with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. I have been advised that I do not have to make any statement and that any statement I do make can be used against me in a court of law. I have been advised that I have the right to consult an attorney before making this statement.

I am 38 years old, born Springfield, Tennessee March 26, 1926. I presently reside in Apt. 13, 1705 Portland Ave., Nashville, Tennessee with my 7-year old daughter.

"On March 14, 1964, sometime in the early afternoon I was at the home of Hugh Montgomery, Plum Street. I do not know what the phone number is at this address but it would be listed to the Montgomery's who live at this address. Present at the time were Ann Beaty, George Montgomery, and Christine Burke, and possibly others.

"All of us had been drinking and had been watching the Ruby trial on T.V. When the results of the trial was announced we all became emotionally upset and excited. Either Christine Burke or I made a phone call to the Governor at Austin, Texas. Some man answered the telephone and said Governor Connally was away for the weekend. I did not make any threats over the phone. I told the man that we wanted

Christine Burke then took the phone and told this man that when they pull the switch on Ruby, Connally would die too.

"Christine and I are the only ones that I can remember saying anything over the telephone during this telephone call to Governor Connally in Austin, Texas.

"The only one in the house that would not know that the call was made would be Mrs. Mary Montgomery who is 60 years old. I would not have talked in this manner if I had not been drinking. Christine is the only one that made any threats during this telephone call and she didn't mean it. She was just drunk. Everyone except the children and Mrs. Montgomery were drunk. There was no man who talked on the telephone but there could have been men's voices in the background. Also it was Christine's baby that was crying when this phone call was made. I cannot recall whether I put through the call or whether Christine did it. Christine was using profane language while talking on the telephone.

The facts in this case were discussed with Assistant U. S. Attorney CARROL KILGORE, Nashville, Tennessee, on March 16, 1964, by SA HONETOR.

Mr. KILGORE advised that he would decline prosecution of the subjects in this matter since the threatening telephone call grew out of publicity given the RUBY trial and was caused by drunkenness of the subjects; that it apparently was not a deliberate and serious threat and was not seriously taken. Further, the actual threat itself did not cause actual damage. He further stated that prosecution in his opinion for this threat might inspire additional crackpot threats.

By communication dated March 18, 1964, the San Antonio Division advised that on March 18, 1964, Assistant U. S. Attorney WILLIAM O. MURRAY, Western District of Texas, San Antonio, Texas, authorized a complaint being filed charging subjects with a violation of Section 875(c), Title 18, U. S. Code, and recommended \$2500 bond. San Antonio further advised a complaint was filed on March 18, 1964, by SA DAVID M. MAGENNIS before U. S. Commissioner FRANK J. BASKIN, San Antonio, Texas, and a warrant was issued.

CHRISTINE BURKE, nee BEATY, Plum Street, Nashville, Tennessee, on March 18, 1964, was arrested at her residence on Plum Street by SA's CHARLES J. HONETOR and CHARLES F. GRIGSBY.

NORMA JUNE McGRUFF, nee WARD, Apartment 13, 1705 Portland Avenue, Nashville, Tennessee, on March 18, 1964, was arrested at her residence by SA's HENDERSON HILLIN, JR. and CORNELIUS W. SHEA.

Subjects were taken before U. S. Commissioner A. B. NEIL, JR., Nashville, Tennessee, on March 18, 1964. Subjects at their appearance before Commissioner NEIL waived removal hearing and were released on a non-surety bond of \$2500.

ALBERT G. HARVEY, also known as AL HARVEY, 3025 Touraine Street, Dallas, Texas, whose name was furnished by Mrs. FRANCES BIRCH as having made the statement on November 22, 1963, or November 23, 1963, that he was going to shoot OSWALD, advised as follows on January 20, 1964:

Mr. HARVEY advised that he is employed as salesman by the M & M Company, Fort Worth, Texas, and is so employed in selling funeral cars.

HARVEY stated that for a period of about four months ending in December 1963 he had a continuous illicit affair with JANE BIRCH, 9100 Metz Drive, Dallas, and during this period he stayed in the BIRCH home with JANE and her mother, Mrs. FRANCES BIRCH. He stated that during this time he gave JANE BIRCH \$100.00 a month in compensation for his relationship with her and to help provide the necessities of life for her and her mother. According to HARVEY, JANE BIRCH was caring for an infant illegitimate daughter which was not his child. JANE's mother was a former "stripper", as well as JANE's sister, PAT KOHS, wife of KEN KOHS.

HARVEY continued by stating in December 1963 he learned that JANE BIRCH was going out with other men and using his money to pay expenses during these activities, whereupon he became angry with her and ceased his relationship with her and discontinued giving her money, which in turn caused her, her mother and her sister to become angry with him, inasmuch as they had no other means of securing

the necessities of life. As a result, they all harassed him by phoning his residence and his place of business and using abusive and threatening language to him and to others who answered the phone. He finally, through the assistance of attorney WYNN G. STANTON, signed peace bond complaints against both BIRCH women and Mrs. KOHS in Judge JOE B. BROWN's court, Dallas. As a result of several arguments with the BIRCH women, they accused him of assault and threatened to file complaints against him in local courts but later changed their minds.

HARVEY stated that, as a result of his differences with the BIRCH women, these women have stated on more than one occasion that they would "get even" with HARVEY and would do anything to get him in trouble.

HARVEY stated that he does not recall ever making a statement to anyone to the effect that he contemplated getting a gun and shooting LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and added that he could not have made such a statement while intoxicated inasmuch as he does not drink. He added that he may have made a statement expressing the opinion that if JACK RUBY were released from jail on bond he might be shot or otherwise killed just as OSWALD was killed. He added that if he did make such a statement it was not to convey the impression that he himself had any notion of harming RUBY but merely expressing the opinion or fear that if RUBY were released, someone might kill him.

Mr. HARVEY advised that he does not know JACK RUBY and never knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD; further, that he knows of no information indicating a connection between OSWALD and RUBY or the assassination of President KENNEDY and the shooting of OSWALD by RUBY.
