

Since the assassination of President KENNEDY, GARLOCK has repeatedly contacted the Oklahoma City Division alleging he had information which would be of value to the investigation. None of the information furnished by GARLOCK has been verified to date and the circumstances described by him show no basis in fact.

He has been repeatedly warned of the danger of furnishing false information to an agency of the Federal Government but insists that his information is all true and that his identifications of OSWALD and RUBY as being in John's Bar, 1213 Linwood Avenue, Oklahoma City, in the early part of October, 1963, are correct.

a fairly steady customer but emphatically denies that either OSWALD or RUBY were ever in his bar or were known to him.

GARLOCK's son, ALLAN GARLOCK, 21, has advised investigating Agents his father frequently goes on "binges" and he did get his father out of the Congress Hotel in Oklahoma City on morning of 10/20/63 after GARLOCK had been out all night. He stated his father appeared to have been drinking but was not drunk when he got him.

On 11/25/63 CAROLYN WALKER, 1217 Northwest 6th, advised that GARLOCK bumped into her and a friend on the street 11/17/63 in a drunken condition and claimed to be an investigator for the U. S. Marine Corps and made other incoherent allegations about his background.

On 11/25/63 GUY BIGTALK, employee of HARRY M. NORMAN, 828 NE 50th, advised that he is sometimes referred to as the "Chief" and did accompany GARLOCK and one JEANNIE BEMBO from John's Bar to the Congress Hotel on 11/19/63 but no individual as the "Judge" was in the party. BIGTALK denies knowing anyone named the "Judge" and states although he was quite drunk at the time he does not recall knowing or saying anything to GARLOCK about operation "Water Moccasin".

Although GARLOCK appears to be suffering from a hallucination, in view of his signed statement JEANNIE BEMBO should be interviewed to definitely eliminate persons in John's Bar as being identical with OSWALD or RUBY.

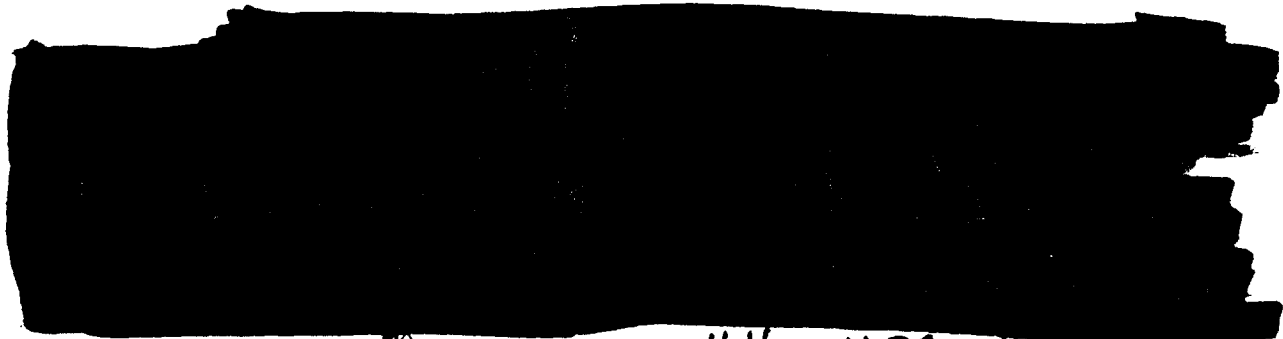
