SHE STATED SHE HAS HAD NO FURTHER CONTACT WITH RUBY SINCE THAT LAST PHONE CALL, WHICH WAS PROBABLY IN THE FIRST WEEK OF SEPTEMBER.

CHERYL ASTON STATED THAT HER OPINION OF RUBY WAS THAT HE WAS QUOTE GIVING HER A LINE UNQUOTE AND YET HE SEEMED TO BE INTERESTED IN A MORE FATHERLY WAY BECAUSE HE WAS NOT AT ALL SUGGESTIVE IN HIS CONVERSATIONS AND HAD HE BEEN, SHE WOULD HAVE IMMEDIATELY HUNG UP ON HIS

TELEPHONE CALLS. SHE ALSO STATED THAT SHE DID NOT KNOW HOW HE HAD OBTAINED HER LAST NAME AND HOME TELEPHONE NUMBER, BUT RECALLED THAT AFTER GETTING THE CALL AT HOME THE NEXT DAY, SHE ASKED THE NIGHT MANAGER OF HENRICI/S, MR. PAUL STRAND, WHO IS A PART TIME MANAGER AND PART TIME COLLEGE STUDENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS, ABOUT RUBY, AND HE STATED THAT HE KNEW NOTHING ABOUT HIM AND HE MIGHT HAVE CALLED AND OBTAINED HER LAST NAME AND/OR TELEPHONE NUMBER FROM THE SWITCHBOARD OPERATOR. CHERYL BELIEVED THAT MIGHT BE THE CASE AND DID NOT CHECK FURTHER.

SHE STATED THAT DURING THEIR CONVERSATION THERE WAS NO MENTION OF POLITICS OR ANYTHING CONNECTED WITH POLITICS, BUT DOES RECALL THAT HE BRAGGED A LOT ABOUT DALLAS AND WHEN TALKING ABOUT HAVING FILM CONNECTIONS, MENTIONED MIKE TODD IN A MANNER WHICH WOULD LEAD ONE TO BELIEVE THAT HE KNEW MIKE TODD, ALTHOUGH HE NEVER SAID THAT DIRECTLY.

SHE STATED THAT THIS WEEK AFTER LEARNING THAT OSWALD HAD BEEN SHOT BY ONE JACK RUBY, THE OWNER OF THE CAROUSEL CLUB, SHE KNEW THAT IT WAS

SOMETIME BETWEEN NOVEMBER ONE, AND NOVEMBER FIVE, SIXTY THREE, A TELEPHONE CALL WAS RECEIVED FROM JACK RUBY AT HIS PLACE OF BUSINESS, HOWEVER, HE WAS OUT TO LUNCH AT THE TIME AND DID NOT SPEAK WITH RUBY. ON ABOUT THE FIFTH OF NOVEMBER HE SPOKE WITH RUBY OVER THE PHONE FROM DALLAS, AND JACK RUBY ADVISED HIM THAT EARL RUBY HAD TOLD HIM TO CALL MARDASH DIN COMPANY AS CONCERNS THE SALE OF A TWIST WAIST EXERCISER.

RUBY WAS VERY ENTHUSIASTIC ABOUT THIS ITEM AND HE UNDERSTOOD RUBY TO BE THE SALES AGENT FOR IT. WHEN HE LEARNED OF THE PRICE RUBY WAS ASKING FOR THE ITEM, HE TOLD HIM THAT HE WOULD NOT BE INTERESTED. AT A LATER DATE RUBY MAILED A TWIST WAIST EXERCISER AND PROMOTIONAL MATERIAL BEARING THE NAME EARL PRODUCTS COMPANY, P.O. BOX FIVE FOUR SEVEN FIVE, DALLAS, TEXAS. ALSO INCLUDED WAS AN ADVERTISEMENT FROM THE SANGER HARRIS STORE IN DALLAS CONCERNING THE TWIST WAIST EXERCISER, WHICH WAS APPARENTLY PRINTED IN A LOCAL DALLAS PAPER.

BILL DECKER, Sheriff, Dallas County, Tex., advised SA's ARTHUR E. CARTER and CHARLES T. BROWN, JR. on 11/26/63 that he had not personally appointed JACK RUBY as an honorary deputy sheriff at anytime. He also added that he knew no member of his staff had given such a permit to RUBY and that the "honorary deputy sheriff" commission given to many people by his office would in no way qualify as a "gun permit". Sheriff DECKER said the only legal permit for carrying a gun would be the "long form" permits which are executed by and for duly constituted law enforcement officers.

He advised that ROBIE LOVE, Constable, Precinct 1, Dallas County Courthouse, Dallas, Tex., had issued honorary constable commissions to many persons in Dallas County. (It should be noted that ROBIE LOVE has been interviewed by Agents CARTER and BROWN and he has denied any knowledge of JACK RUBY having been given a commission by his office or any member of his office.)

Sheriff DECKER said he doubted any of the guards in the Dallas police station would have honored a special deputy constable commission or honorary deputy sheriff commission card had it been presented in an attempt to gain admission to the OSWALD transfer on the morning of OSWALD's death.

Constable A. P. ~~CLICK~~, Precinct 6, 630 W. Main, Grand Prairie, Tex., advised he had handed out "hundreds" of special deputy constable commission cards to people who assisted him in his election and to notable persons who requested them.

He stated that ~~HARLEY H. HIGHTOWER~~, 111 N. Frances, Dallas, Tex., telephone FE 1-6357, was engaged by him as a printer to print "The 1961 Safety Manual", West Dallas County Edition, and he used this manual as a campaign piece in 1961 when he was running for his office of constable.

Constable ~~CLICK~~ said that ~~HIGHTOWER~~ printed the "special deputy constable commission" cards for him and that ~~HIGHTOWER~~ had given a number of these cards to advertising solicitors for the safety manual and he, ~~CLICK~~, later determined that some of these cards got into the hands of criminal type persons and he thought he had recalled all of these at present.

~~CLICK~~ denied that JACK RUBY had ever been given one of these cards and that RUBY had ever made a request for one.

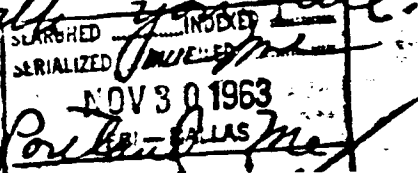

Mrs. ESTHER JEAN EATON, also known as Mrs. **EDWARD A. EATON**, housewife, residing at Harrison, Michigan, with mailing address of Post Office Box 503, Harrison, Michigan, advised of the following information:

She is the aunt of **CURTIS LAVERN CRAPARD**, who is the son of her brother, **HUGH EDWARD CRAPARD**, 1219 Birch Street, Dallas, Oregon. **CURTIS CRAPARD** arrived at her home at approximately 10:00 AM, November 26, 1963. He remained at her home until approximately 10:30 AM, November 27, 1963. He stated at the time of his arrival that he had hitchhiked from Dallas, Texas, to Clare, Michigan, from November 23, 1963, to November 25, 1963. He claimed that he had spent the night of November 25-26, 1963, with his cousin, **CLIFFORD LEROY ROBERTS** at Clare, Michigan. (ROBERTS is a cousin of CRAPARD on his maternal side.) When CRAPARD left Harrison, he stated he was hitchhiking to Fife Lake, Michigan, and that he intended to spend Thanksgiving Day with his sister, Mrs. **CHAUNCEY INGERSOLL**, Post Office Box 53, Fife Lake.

Mrs. EATON stated that **CURTIS CRAPARD** refused to give an explanation concerning why he left Dallas, Texas, but he did state that he had been the private secretary to **JACK RUBY** at the Carousel Club, Dallas, until he left during the morning of November 23, 1963. CRAPARD stated that he "just decided to leave." He stated that he did not tell anyone in Dallas he was leaving or where he was going. Mrs. EATON stated that she got the impression from CRAPARD that he was constantly moving, possibly to keep from being questioned concerning his association with RUBY.

Mrs. EATON further advised that her daughter, **GALE ANN EATON**, age 17, had received a letter dated October 29, 1963, from CRAPARD, which advised that CRAPARD was "the private secretary" to **JACK RUBY**, owner of the Carousel Club. **GALE EATON** answered this letter, but no further correspondence was carried on between them.
