On 11/29/63, ELI RUSHING, Warden, Eastham State Farm, Texas Department of Corrections, advised records reflect [redacted] was received by TDC, 5/7/63, after conviction of forgery Tarrant County, Texas, minimum expiration: 7/25/65, maximum: 2/17/67. [redacted] works as bookkeeper and clerk-typist and is above average in intelligence. Information contained on his card, which was obtained through interview of [redacted] by other individuals, revealed he has admitted being confined in a hospital at Ft. Bliss, Texas, in 1956 for [redacted]. Further, he attempted to [redacted] denied using narcotics. There are detainees in file from Tarrant County, Texas and from Tishomingo, Okla. **b7cd**

On 11/28/63, [redacted] was interviewed by TDC official and this interview was recorded on tape. A copy of this interview has been furnished to the Intelligence Section of the Texas Department of Public Safety.

The original tape was furnished to SA ROBERT J. STEVENS by Assistant Director JACK F. HEARD, TDC, Huntsville, Texas, which he requested be returned to him as a transcript is made. **b7d**

[redacted] was interviewed at the Eastham State Farm on the night of 11/29-30/63, and after the interview was concluded, [redacted] said he would be willing to be interviewed by use of the polygraph.

Action: It is suggested the Bureau be contacted and authority obtained to interview [redacted] by use of the polygraph.

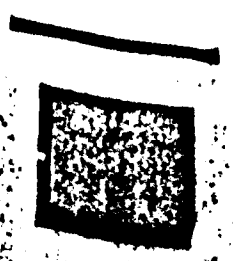
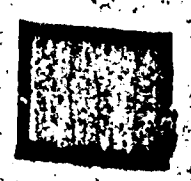
