JAMES N. STANDARD, Reporter, Oklahoma Publishing Company, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, advised he traveled to Dallas, Texas, at approximately 12 noon on November 22, 1963 to cover the assassination of President KENNEDY for his new paper. He stated on November 22 and 23, 1963 he spent his time talking to witnesses concerning the assassination and attempting to locate other eye witnesses and photographs of the assassination.

STANDARD advised during this period of time he did not see JACK RUBY at any time in the Dallas Police Department or that vicinity. He stated some of the reporters, names unrecalled, had mentioned RUBY was present at the District Attorney's conference regarding OSWALD and the assassination. He stated he could not verify this information because he was not present himself at the District Attorney's press conference.

STANDARD stated he was present in the Dallas Police Department basement alleyway on the morning of November 24, 1963 when OSWALD was to be transported to the Dallas County Jail. He advised he gained entrance to the alleyway through the door from the Police Department Identification Section adjacent to the jail elevator door from which OSWALD was removed. He stated as he entered the door to the alleyway he was confronted by two policemen requesting he exhibit press credentials. He informed these policemen he had no press card and exhibited a credit card and a group insurance card which identified him as an employee of the Oklahoma Publishing Company. He said one of the policemen did not want to permit him to pass; however, the other officer agreed to pass him, only after a complete search of his person. STANDARD was of the opinion the security measures set up at the Dallas Police Department were very rigid and he knew no one present in the basement alleyway who had not exhibited credentials to gain entrance.

STANDARD stated he saw no one present in the alleyway who was not connected with law enforcement or news agencies.

STANDARD advised as the police brought OSWALD from the jail elevator toward an armored car and a police car parked in the alleyway, he saw an unknown person, later

He heard on policeman, identity unknown, shout "You son of a bitch," a an instant later a shot was fired by this individual and OSWALD fell to the floor. He stated almost instantaneousl a large group of policemen pounced on this person and subdued him. STANDARD stated there was considerable turmoil at this time and he was unable to recall any statements made by RUBY, policemen or newsmen present.

STANDARD advised he neither heard nor saw anything at this time or at a later date to indicate anyone had conspired with RUBY in any way to shoot OSWALD.

STANDARD advised he had never interviewed RUBY and further he had no information whatsoever to reflect a connection between RUBY and OSWALD.

STANDARD advised he departed from Dallas, Texas on the afternoon of November 25, 1963, and that during the early afternoon of November 25, 1963, he had again been thoroughly checked by an officer of the Dallas Police Department to establish his connection with the Oklahoma Publishing Company.

MUSGROVE stated that from 1935 until 1943 he was the mail carrier who covered 124 W 6 Street, Los California. He stated that Room 605 in the Gross Bldg at that address was the headquarters for the Pacific Southern Division of the Communist Party.

MUSGROVE further stated that he remembers delivering mail regularly to Room 605 between 1940 and 1943 JACK RUBIN, JACK RUBEN, JACK STRIN, and JACK STACK. MUSGROVE stated that to his knowledge he never recalled having seen the person or persons who used the above. However, he did see persons who resembled the published pictures of JACK RUBY.

MUSGROVE stated he felt he should furnish the information to the FBI since JACK RUBY's real name, JACOB RUBENSTEIN, contained some of the names that had been used by someone in the Communist Party in the early 1940's at the Los Angeles Office.

On 12/9/63, a photograph of JACK L. RUBY, subject of "JACK L. RUBY, Aka.; LEE HARVEY OSWALD, aka. - VICTIM OF 'CR'" was exhibited to Mr. MUSGROVE by SA SAM C. COTTON. He stated he did not recognize the photo as that of any of the persons to whom he referred on 12/2/63.

There is no information to indicate RUBY ever lived in Los Angeles. In the 1930's he resided in San Francisco for a time, thereafter, returned to Chicago.
