On 12/18/63 Mrs. RUTH VAN METER, Manager of the apartment house at 2454 South Zangs, stated MARKS left there on 8/15/62 for California. He left no forwarding address.

On 12/18/63 postal inspector H. D. HOLMES stated TED MARKS left forwarding address 8/15/62 of 4125 Shenandoah.

A check of files of Dallas Office reflects file 100-130-1503C has to do with a ROSE ALICE PALMER, born 1921, from Fort Worth, Texas. At the time of the investigation, which was in 1951, she was being investigated as a Second Lieutenant in the Air Force, and the file reflects the following information:

She entered Texas Christian University, Fort Worth, in 1939. References, who had all apparently known her 15 to 20 years, were shown as: Mrs. TOM RYAN, 3602 Crestline; O. W. PORTMAN, 1319 Washington Avenue; Dr. T. L. LENDER, Medical Arts Building, all Fort Worth, Texas.

It is recommended that an Agent conduct investigation at Fort Worth attempting to locate ROSE ALICE PALMER. It is noted that her name was taken from a list furnished by Mr. J. M. COONER, Chief, Intelligence Branch, IRS, Dallas. This name apparently was found in a book which was the property of JACK RUBY. It is believed that PALMER is either a charter member or temporary member of one of RUBY's clubs.

ROBERT STOREY, former Dean of SMU Law School, and past President of American Bar Association, as well as a former member of the President's Civil Rights Commission, had telephonically contacted CURRY on Wednesday, ~~Nov.~~ 18th. STOREY related to CURRY that he had just returned from Washington, D. C. with Texas Attorney General WAGGONER CARR, where they had conferred with the President's Committee to investigate the assassination of President KENNEDY.

STOREY requested a meeting with Chief of Police CURRY, Mayor EARL CABELL of the City of Dallas, City Manager ELGIN CRULL of Dallas, and USA BAREFOOT SANDERS for Monday, Dec. 23rd. STOREY stated that the meeting was necessary in order to apprise them of what would be requested of the Dallas PD by the President's Commission and what information generally would be expected to be produced by the Dallas PD to the Commission.

CURRY related to [REDACTED] that after conferring with City Manager CRULL and Mayor CABELL, it was determined that Dec. 23rd was the day on which the City Council usually meets. CURRY called STOREY and told him that the meeting would have to be postponed until Tuesday, Dec. 24th. That was agreed upon with STOREY and according to [REDACTED] the meeting will be held next Tuesday between STOREY, CURRY, CRULL, CABELL and USA SANDERS. b7D

STOREY has been appointed by CARR to represent the Attorney General's office in assisting the Commission. It is not known whether or not the Commission had requested STOREY to obtain a copy of reports from the Dallas PD or other data, or whether STOREY is doing this on his own.

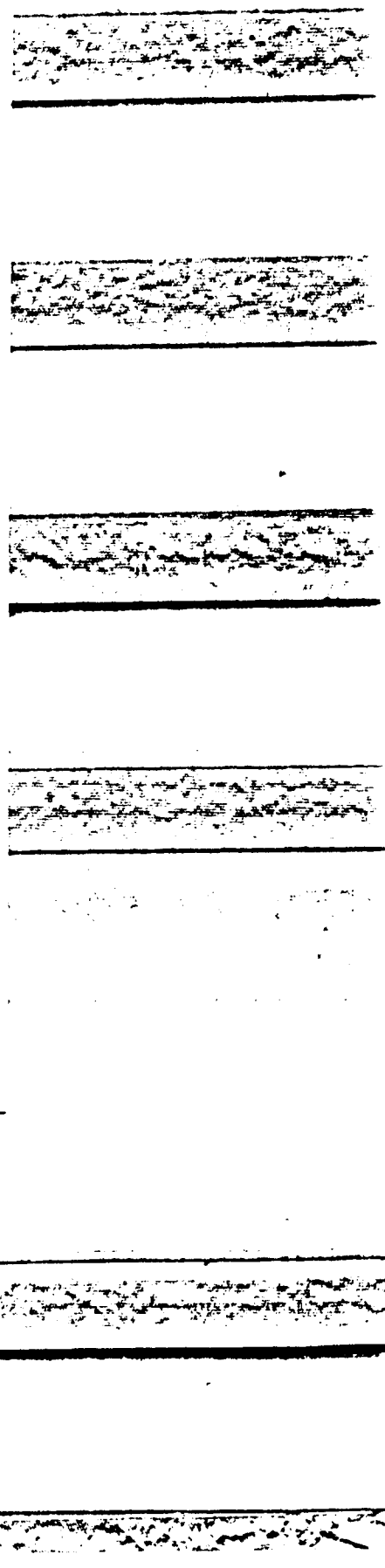

RUBY was a co-signer on some promissory notes relating to loans obtained at unknown Dallas banks by various officers of the Dallas Police Department.

- Wynnewood State Bank.

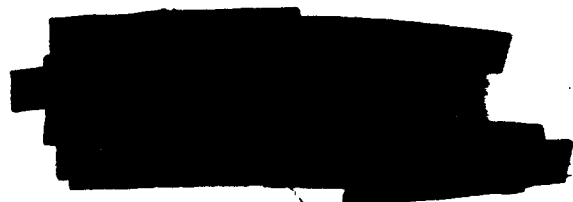

Re Lead Sheet to interview GEORGE SENATOR, RUBY's roommate, at 223 South Ewing.

On 12/16/63, GEORGE SENATOR, c/o the Carousel Club, Dallas, was contacted telephonically to make arrangements for an interview. He subsequently called from the office of JIM MARTIN, attorney, Room 1207, Davis Building, Dallas, telephone Riverside/2-2833, and stated he would consent to an interview only in the presence of his attorney, Mr. MARTIN. It is noted that Mr. MARTIN is also one of RUBY's attorneys. Mr. MARTIN was contacted for a tentative date for the interview, and he advised he would consent to an interview of SENATOR concerning the activities of RUBY on 11/22 through 24/63 only if he were present and the questions and answers were recorded by a reporter.

In the presence of Mr. SENATOR, he consented to an interview of SENATOR about background of RUBY, names and identities of associates and any information he could provide up to 11/22/63.

He advised he did not feel his presence would be necessary in an interview of this type and consented to SENATOR coming along to the FBI Office on 12/18/63 for an interview.

In view of the above, it is recommended that SENATOR be interviewed for available information up to 11/22/63 and no attempt made at this time to interview him during the period from 11/22/63 through 11/24/63.

The street address section of this directory listed
Mrs. RUBY MINOR residing at 4806 $\frac{1}{2}$ Bryan.

Coles 1963 Criss-Cross Directory covering Dallas Co.,
Texas, failed to show a JACK RUBY or JACK FISHER at 4806-8
Bryan, Dallas.

On 12/6/63, RADCLIFFE LEWIS CAVINESS, DDS, and
owner of the building at 4806-8 Bryan, advised that he
has never had an individual by the name of JACK RUBY
live in his apartment building. He had a JACK FISHER whom he
described as a tall individual, with light brown hair, blue
eyes and heavy eyebrows, either living or visiting his wife in
this building and that this JACK FISHER was apprehended by the
