"We had an anonymous phone call who gave the following information on the JACK RUBY case.

"This woman drives a car, PW1784, and they all left town after all this killing. The woman's name is Mildred. Another woman named Click who lives on South Barnett knows where this woman is. David Miller is man who runs with Click. They are connected with Lee Oswald and also Jack Ruby."

"He said to not turn this over to the FBI but to get the woman and he thinks she will squeal."

It is noted this matter refers to subject case.

Mr. SELAH stated he had found this card and had determined that Mr. WILKISON had been sent home for Christmas.

He stated the card was a business card showing "Inquire Shine and Press Shop, 1322 Commerce Street, Dallas," with names IZZY MILLER and DAVE MILLER on it. Mr. SELAH stated that at the time RUBY gave him this card he commented that one of the MILLERS had helped him and that he wanted to help them by sending customers to them. Mr. SELAH stated he had no other information concerning this card.

On the night of 12/19/63 Captain O. A. JONES of the Dallas Police Department who has been coordinating the police department's investigation of RUBY's shooting of OSWALD, advised that he had completed part of the report and taken it to Chief CURRY. He said that it lacked some drawings of the basement area showing where each officer was standing at the time of the incident and the officers' identities. CURRY, who had previously stated that he would give this office a copy of the report, was asked by me if he would be able to furnish us a copy of the report at that time. He stated that it was not complete. He stated that he had to give a copy of the report to the Attorney General, meaning the Texas Attorney General, a copy of the report to the City Manager, one copy to District Attorney HENRY WADE and one copy to the President's Commission. I asked CURRY if he had been asked by the Commission for a copy of his report and he replied by saying he was to meet next Tuesday with BAREFOOT (meaning the U. S. Attorney BAREFOOT SANDERS) and Dean STOREY (ROBERT STOREY, former Dean, SMU Law School and past President of the ABA). He stated that STOREY was a representative of the Texas Attorney General to the President's Commission and he, CURRY, was going to try to find out what would be required of the Dallas Police Department by the Commission in the way of reports or other material.

It was rather obvious that CURRY had not intended to say anything about this meeting with BAREFOOT SANDERS and Dean STOREY since he said after he started the conversation "Of course, this is off the record and I don't want to get in trouble with these people" or something to that effect. CURRY changed the subject.

It is to be noted that ROBERT STOREY traveled to Washington last week with Attorney General WAGGONOR CARR for the purpose of meeting with the Commission. It is not known

as to what instructions, if any, were given by the Commission to CARR or STOREY. It is not known exactly as to what authority STOREY has for receiving information from other sources in behalf of the Commission. It is also to be pointed out that CURRY and STOREY are very close personal friends.

It is also to be noted that STOREY, who is past President of the American Bar Association and a former member of the President's Civil Rights Commission, is allegedly a close friend of Chief Justice WARREN.

These observations are being made for your information.

This teletype contains appreciable background information furnished by ERWIN HORWITZ, Chicago, Ill., who grew up with subject RUBY as a boy and young man in Chicago, Ill. HORWITZ recalled an incident that probably occurred when subject was aged 15, at which time subject attempted to sneak into the ^{TOURNEY} DEMPSEY ~~Tourney~~ fight and a policeman had hit him in the head, causing a rather severe injury that required hospitalization. He said that his memory was somewhat vague, but that he recalled subject had a metal plate installed in his head as a result of this injury.

HORWITZ further advised subject's older brother, TINY, is the only person that he knows that might have first-hand information about this injury.

DALLAS - AT DALLAS, TEXAS

Will, at the time of next interview with RUBY, inquire of him as to the injury referred to above, when it happened, the extent of such injury, where hospitalized and how long, name of doctor or physician who attended him, etc. Upon obtaining specific information, will set out lead to verify and substantiate injury and determine extent thereof.

Will question subject as to which of his brothers is known by the nickname "TINY" and have leads set out to have this brother interviewed as to his knowledge and extent of such injury of subject.

No prior information received by the Baltimore Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation could be identified with JUDY OBERLIN.

On December 18, 1963, SAs JOHN F. HANSON and J. STANLEY ROTZ attempted to contact JUDY OBERLIN at Apartment 7, 929 North Charles Street, Baltimore, Maryland. This apartment was found to be located above the Blue Mirror Night Club at 929 North Charles Street. No one could be located at this address during the afternoon of December 18, 1963.

On December 18, 1963, Mr. ROBERT W. LIONELLO, 4011 Loch Raven Boulevard, Baltimore, Maryland, advised SA J. STANLEY ROTZ telephonically that he had formerly been the owner of the building in which the Blue Mirror Night Club and the apartments above it are located. He had sold this building approximately three months ago to the Maryland Club which is located next door to the building. He advised that his records did not show anybody named JUDY OBERLIN as a tenant during the period of time he had the building. He also recalled that apartment 7 had been vacant for an extensive period of time, perhaps as long as a year prior to his sale of the building.

On the night of December 18, 1963, Mrs. PHYLLIS NAPP advised SA J. STANLEY ROTZ that she is the current manager of the Blue Mirror Night Club and the apartments which are located above it at 929 North Charles Street. She advised that she had no record or any information concerning anyone named JUDY OBERLIN residing there during the three months she has been so engaged. She stated that both tenants of apartment 7 are show girls employed at the Blue Mirror and that one of them is named JODI SUMMERS. Mrs. NAPP advised that she did not know whether this latter individual could be identical

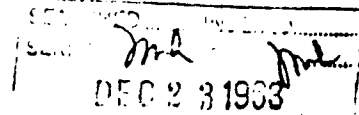
