AT CHILLICOTHE, OHIO

The following investigation was conducted by
SA R.R. CARMICHAEL, JR., on December 16, 1963:

Mr. WILBUR SCHWEMLEIN, Registrar, Veterans
Administration Hospital (a psychiatric hospital), advised
as follows:

[REDACTED]
Huntington, W. Virginia, was admitted to this hospital
December 11, 1963. On December 11, 1963, the same day
of [REDACTED] admission to this hospital, Mr. JAMES CROUCH,
Chief, Benefits Control Section, Veterans Administration
Hospital, Huntington, W. Virginia, had telephonically
furnished the following information to the Veterans
Hospital, Chillicothe, Ohio:

[REDACTED] had come to the Hygiene Clinic at
Huntington, W. Virginia, voluntarily where he was examined
by Dr. YOUNG (not further identified) who expressed the
opinion that emergency hospitalization of [REDACTED] would be
desirable. His condition was diagnosed as "depressive
reaction and alcohol addiction chronic". During this
visit to the Hygiene Clinic at Huntington, [REDACTED] reportedly
stated that following the assassination of President
KENNEDY he took an airplane to Dallas, Texas, carrying
with him two pistols. He intended to kill LEE OSWALD,
however, the plane on which [REDACTED] was traveling was
two hours late getting to Dallas and on arrival, he learned
that OSWALD had already been killed. [REDACTED] then returned
to Huntington, W. Virginia, and gave his guns to the FBI.

Mr. CROUCH of the Veterans Administration Hospital,
Huntington, W. Virginia, in furnishing this information
to the Veterans Hospital in Chillicothe, Ohio, was unable
to confirm [REDACTED] story.

According to Mr. SCHWEMLEIN, [REDACTED] apparently
departed from Huntington, W. Virginia, accompanied by his

wife immediately after the telephone call by Mr. JIM CROUCH confirming the possibility of [REDACTED] being admitted to the hospital at Chillicothe. 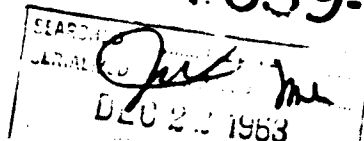

SILVA STATED THAT SHE DOES NOT KNOW OSWALD AND CAN RECALL NO ONE RESEMBLING OSWALD BEING IN THE CAROUSEL. SHE SAID SHE KNOWS OF NO CONNECTION BETWEEN OSWALD AND RUBY.

SILVA ADVISED THAT DURING TIME SHE WORKED IN DALLAS HER BOY FRIEND WAS CARMIE PETRILLO, A MEMBER OF CARMIE AND PAUL COMEDY TEAM. SHE ADDED THAT PETRILLO DOES NOT RESEMBLE ANY OF THE PHOTOS SHE HAS SEEN OF OSWALD. SHE ALSO STATED THAT PETRILLO TOLD HER THE FBI HAD TALKED WITH HIM. SILVA ADDED SHE WAS INTERVIEWED BY FBI AGENTS IN MASSACHUSETTS A FEW DAYS AFTER THE PRESIDENT WAS ASSASSINATED.

SILVA STATED THAT RUBY SEEMED TO LET LITTLE THINGS BOTHER HIM AND WAS EMOTIONAL AT TIMES. SHE SAID AT TIMES HE WAS LIKE A LITTLE BOY IN HIS DESIRE FOR COMPANION. SHE ADDED THAT SHE WAS SURPRISED WHEN SHE LEARNED THAT HE HAD SHOT OSWALD BECAUSE SHE DID NOT THINK OF HIM AS A PERSON WHO WOULD DO SUCH A THING.

SHE DESCRIBED CARMEN AS WM, TWENTYTWO YEARS, DARK BROWN CURLY HAIR, WHO PAINTED HIS EYEBROWS AND DARKENED HIS EYE LASHES. [REDACTED] ONLY OBSERVED CARMEN AND RUBY TOGETHER ON THE STREETS AND AT THE CLUB. SHE STATED RUBY TREATED CARMEN AS A TYPICAL FEMALE DATE, MAKING AFFECTIONATE GESTURES TOWARD HIM WHEN HE LIGHTED CARMEN-S CIGARETTE OR GAVE HIM A DRINK. SHE STATED CARMEN WAS A QUOTE FAGGOTT UNQUOTE THAT IS

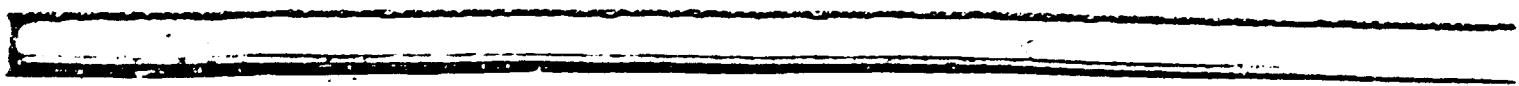

WHEN QUESTIONED CONCERNING THIS NAME, SHE SAID SHE AND OTHER PERSONNEL REFERRED TO RUBY WHEN NOT IN HIS PRESENCE AS RUBENKINS, A TERM OF ENDEARMENT AND RUBY K PROBABLY EVOLVED FROM THIS TERM. SHE STATED RUBY THREW CHAMPAGNE PARTIES AT THE CLUB AFTER CLOSING HOURS WHICH CARMEN WOULD ATTEND, HOWEVER, ██████████ WAS NEVER INVITED AND COULD FURNISH NO SPECIFIC INFO RE PARTIES. SHE COULD NOT RECALL EXACT DATES, TIMES OR ANY ASSOCIATES OF RUBY OTHER THAN THOSE SET FORTH ABOVE. FD THREE ZERO TWO FOLLOW.

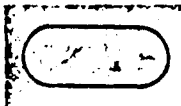

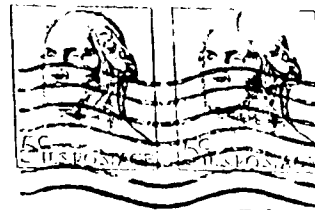

INTERVIEW OF RUBY IN PRESENCE OF ATTORNEY

Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY telephonically advised that we should go ahead with the interview and that the same should be conducted in a very businesslike manner. He suggested that we stick to the questions that the Bureau has previously set forth. He said that definitely the Agents should control the interview and if there is any attempt on the part of BELLI or whatever attorney representing him present to interfere or tell RUBY not to answer the questions, then we should tactfully terminate the interview and tell this man that we do not care to proceed with it under those circumstances. Certainly, there should be no recording made of this interview. In other words, we are to dominate and set the conditions under which the interview is conducted.

In the event Mr. BELLI or RUBY, or whatever attorney represents him, states that he wants his client to take a polygraph examination, we should advise that we have no desire to give him a polygraph examination and certainly, no truth serum. If they want to give him a polygraph examination, they can do so on their own or if they want to ask the police to give him one, that is their business.

I pointed out to him that I have been questioned by the newspapers and that I would like to furnish the following answers to the newspapers after the interview has been conducted:

1. We did not and do not desire to give RUBY a polygraph examination.
2. In answer to the question as to whether we are investigating the murder of OSWALD, I would like to state we're not investigating the murder of OSWALD by RUBY, but that we are conducting a Civil Rights investigation at the request of the Department and that the local murder case is strictly a local murder case.

At 10:10 AM, this date, SA C. RAY HALL received a telephone call from Deputy Sheriff, advising that he had a subpoena instanter, directing SA HALL and SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS to appear at the bond hearing for RUBY at 10:00 AM, this date for the defense. I immediately called the Bureau and talked to Assistant to the Director, A. H. BELMONT and advised I saw no basis for refusing to answer subpoena. Apparently Attorney BELLI was going to try to make something of the fact RUBY had been made available for examination or questioning by the Agents. I could see no objection to the agents appearing and stating that they had talked to RUBY and that he had answered questions asked, but that they should not go into any detail as to what questions had been asked or what his answers were. I also pointed out that I thought the USA should appear with them. MR. BELMONT agreed to the above. I called USA H. BAREFOOT SANDERS and advised him and he stated he would meet the agents and go down with them. SAs CLEMENTS and HALL went by to pick him up and go on the hearing.

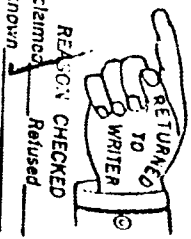
