On 12/24/63 I talked to Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY at the Bureau and pointed out to him that HENRY WADE, District Attorney, had indicated that he would like to have copies of a number of interviews conducted by this office in connection with RUBY, particularly those interviews that showed what he was doing between the time the President was assassinated and the time that he shot OSWALD. He also indicated that he would certainly like to have copies of the interviews with RUBY by our Agents. WADE had pointed out that he would, of course, keep this information confidential, but it would be very helpful to him in the possible connection with cross examination of some of the witnesses. WADE had also indicated that he might subpoena some of our Agents and have them testify in the event some of the witnesses told a different story on the stand from what they did tell the Agents.

Inspector MALLEY suggested that one of the Agents familiar with this investigation might go through and pick out the interviews that it was felt would be of material assistance to WADE and then send an airtel to the Bureau, giving the reference to the particular interviews, or even sending copies of them, and requesting Bureau permission to make the same available to WADE.

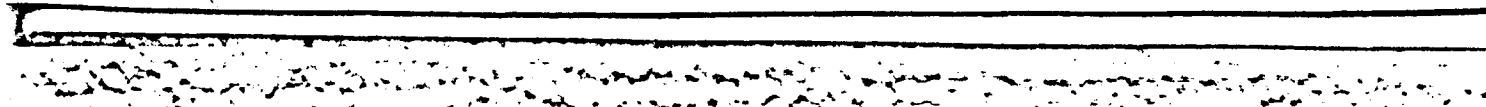

On 12/26/63, Miss VIOLA WILLIAMS, 4130 Ranger Drive, Telephone FE 7-5516, telephonically advised that she was interviewed by an Agent of this office several days ago in connection with JACK RUBY and explained that her name and phone number were found in RUBY's address book.

Miss WILLIAMS stated that she has been employed as a secretary and cashier for ROBERT F. HERRING, Office Manager, Republic National Life Insurance Company, 210 Wynnewood Professional Building, Wynnewood Shopping Center, Telephone WH 2-6171, for the past 7 months. She stated on 12/24/63 Mr. HERRING informed her that she was being released at the close of business that date and that she would receive a letter from Mr. DODSON, Personnel Manager, Home Office of Republic National Life Insurance Co., Central Expressway, Dallas, confirming her release and furnishing her with check, etc. Miss WILLIAMS stated that HERRING told her that he did not know why she was being released and intimated that if the FBI had made a background check of her at the Home Office, this perhaps would be the reason why she was being released. Miss WILLIAMS stated that she received DODSON's letter 12/26/63 in which he enclosed her check and the W2 Form, but merely stated that she was being released of her duties as of 12/24/63.

Miss WILLIAMS stated that she went to the Carousel Club with her date, HAROLD MC LAUGHLIN, and his friend, R. R. ROBINSON, about three months ago and that ROBINSON introduced her to RUBY. She stated that RUBY asked her if she would be interested in a job as hostess or cashier, and she told him that she had a job and was not interested. However, she gave RUBY her name and her home and business telephone numbers. She stated this was all she knew of RUBY.

She advised that an FBI Agent, name not known, called her office one day trying to contact her, but she was not at work because she was ill. She stated that on one occasion, Mr. HERRING asked her to take some dictation and, while in his office, he asked her if the FBI had talked to her, and she informed him that they had.

He stated that Miss VIOLA WILLIAMS, former secretary, was fired from that company on 12/23/63 because she falsified some information relating to a message from the Regional Representative of this Insurance Company, and that she was fired because she was attempting to cause trouble between him (HERRING) and his boss, R. L. DODSON.

Mr. HERRING stated that the contact the FBI had with Miss WILLIAMS had absolutely nothing to do whatsoever with her being released by that company. He stated that no credence can be placed in any statement that she might make.

Miss WILLIAMS came to HERRING on 12/24/63 and attempted to get him to tell Miss WILLIAMS' boy friend that she had been released because the FBI had her under investigation. HERRING told her that this was not true and he did not want to see anything more of her.

SAC SHANKLIN called attention to the fact that an article entitled "EARL WARREN Poster--Upset RUBY Took Photos at 4:00 AM, Says Roommate", appeared in the 12/24/63 edition of the Dallas Morning News. According to testimony by GEORGE SENATOR, RUBY's roommate, after photographing a billboard sign reading "Impeach EARL WARREN," SENATOR and RUBY went to the Post Office, Dallas, Texas, and protested to a clerk there about the "newspaper ad" (full page ad in Dallas Morning News of 11/22/63 of American Fact-Finding Committee, BERNARD WEISSMAN, Chairman, P.O. Box 1792, Dallas, Texas).

On 12/24/63 SA GASTON C. THOMPSON telephonically contacted Postal Inspector HARRY HOLMES in an effort to determine the nature and extent of investigation required to identify the post office clerk referred to in testimony by SENATOR. HOLMES subsequently advised that some thirty postal employees were on duty at the Main Post Office between 6:00 and 7:00 AM, November 23, 1963, when RUBY reportedly protested to a clerk about the newspaper ad. HOLMES advised that he had issued instructions to various supervisors in the post office to make all inquiries in an attempt to identify the post office clerk in question and efforts would be made to contact each of the thirty (approximate) employees on duty at the pertinent time.

He pointed out some of these employees are now working at substations while others are on annual leave, thereby presenting a problem of immediately determining the identity of the clerk referred to above.

Postal Inspector HOLMES advised that he would be on leave after 12/25/63; however, he would leave word with the

On 12/26/63 Inspector J. R. MALLEY called in connection with another matter, at which time I discussed with him serial 2846, which is an airtel from the Bureau to Dallas, instructing that we pin [redacted] down as to her statements concerning any alleged homosexual activities on the part of RUBY. I pointed out to him that we have now received a teletype from Albuquerque which indicates that RUBY supposedly had a boy friend whose homosexual name was CARMEN.

I pointed out to Mr. MALLEY that I did not think we should go out specifically asking questions regarding RUBY's homosexual tendencies. He agreed. He stated, however, that if we came up with some information and it was voluntarily given to us, that we should certainly take it, and if the name of a close associate was mentioned, we should then try to interview that individual as an associate to find out what he or she might know about RUBY, but under no circumstances should we go out specifically asking was he a homosexual or did he engage in homosexual activities with him. In other words, our only purpose of interviewing these people is as an associate, and see what they will volunteer.

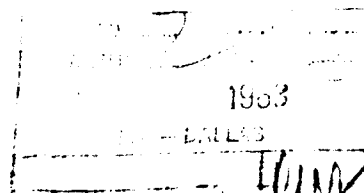
