## TELEGRAMS RECEIVED BY RUBY

Enclosed are 25 copies of insert for a report reflecting interview with Mr. VERN TOMPKINS, 206 Melody Lane, Akron, Ohio, and Mr. JOSEPH CURRIER, 162½ E. York Street, Akron, Ohio.

It should be noted that both the above individuals have never met RUBY and knew of no connection between these two men, and TOMPKINS stated that he sent the telegram while he, TOMPKINS, was drinking.

Mr. CURRIER stated that he sent the wire to RUBY because he was glad OSWALD was dead because he feared if OSWALD's case went to trial "southern justice" might have set OSWALD free.

A review of Cleveland files fail to reflect any pertinent information regarding either Mr. TOMPKINS or CURRIER.

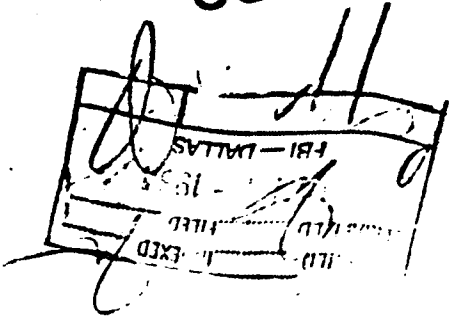

Referenced airtel reflects COP, Brady, Texas, reported one Mrs. VIVA ETTLER, beautician, Brady, allegedly knew RUBY at Burnet, Texas, about 30 years ago when he was a member of a car theft gang.

ETTTLER has been described as a "well known nut" at Brady by City Attorney JOHN WILLIAM HUGHES.

ETTTLER interviewed 12/24/63, stating in 1936 she worked at Burnet, Texas, where the husband of another beautician was a member of a gang and wanted by authorities. She said this beautician told her that her husband was in Arizona, and therefore she (Mrs. ETTTLER) was now a member of the gang since she knew where the husband was. She said in 1956 she was at Mineral Wells, Texas, and observed a man in a pink, striped shirt, white straw hat, and khaki pants who followed her in Mineral Wells and also drove by her residence at Brady. She identified this man as RUBY. She said she believes this gang had looked for her since 1936, finding her at Mineral Wells in 1956, and have been deciding since then what to do with her.

In view of the nature of this information, no FD 302 is being submitted.

Dallas, Texas, who allegedly is a salesman for the M & M Sales,  
Fort Worth, Texas.

[redacted] whom he threatened to kill with a pistol  
on one occasion. He had told [redacted] that he had been  
treated in the Army for shell shock.

[redacted] stated that Harvey always carried a  
Serringer pistol on his person and also owns a .38 caliber  
revolver. She further stated that she considered Harvey to  
be a "psycho and a nut". She continued by stating that she  
did not believe half the things Harvey said to her and to her  
daughter.

[redacted] that on November 23, 1963, Harvey  
[redacted] the general conversation  
revolved around the assassination of the President. At that  
time, Harvey stated "I think I'll go home and get my gun and  
go down and shoot Oswald". He left and on another occasion,  
several days later, [redacted] Harvey stated  
that "if Ruby gets out, he'll get the same thing Oswald got".  
Harvey did not indicate that he was planning to or would shoot  
Ruby if he had the opportunity and did not elaborate upon this

[redacted] stated that when interviewed previously by FBI Agents, she did not inform them of the statements made by Harvey inasmuch as she did not believe Harvey and considered him to be "crazy" and believed he made the remarks only because of his mentally unbalanced condition. She added that she was voluntarily furnishing this information on January 2, 1964, inasmuch as she felt that Harvey "might be crazy enough to kill Ruby". She added that she does not believe that Harvey ever knew Oswald and has no personal knowledge that he is acquainted with Ruby.
