Ruby Unpredictable, Insecure Says Strip-Teaser in El Paso

A strip-tease actress who had a stormy experience while employed in the Dallas nightclub of Jack Ruby, slayer of Lee Harvey Oswald, accused assassin of the late President Kennedy, said in El Paso today that Ruby is a split personality — kind and cruel, weak and boisterous, a friend one minute and a bitter foe the next.

This description of Ruby as a really unpredictable person was given by Jada — that's it, just Jada, her stage name and the only one she uses. She came to El Paso for a two-week engagement at an Upper Valley night spot.



Jada

"I KNOW JACK Ruby well — well for my own welfare, and had to go to court to get my contract with him cancelled," Jada said.

"My contract with him started July 17. He was impossible. He is totally unpredictable. His treatment of me was so shabby, so unbearable, that I went to court and had the contract vacated. My last night at Ruby's Carousel was all too soon.

"Jack is completely emotional. One minute he is nice, and the next minute he goes berserk. One minute he is for you, and the next he is bitterly against you."

Jada said a Dallas friend watching developments predicted Ruby would either go free at his trial or to the electric chair — no in-between" sentence, like a prison term.

"Ruby is wholly contradictory," Jada declared. "He will advocate something today and announce the same thing tomorrow. He will do anything to attract attention to himself."

"I AM CERTAIN his personality was fixed in childhood. He was raised in a poor slum in Chicago. I have heard him tell about it, how the family fought at the table over food,

"He craves attention. He really wanted to be somebody, but didn't have it in him. He hangs around police headquarters. He is a nuisance around newspaper offices. He knows a tremendous number of people in Dallas. But he doesn't have many friends.

"Oh, he wants friends! But he doesn't have the capacity to make and hold them. He is insecure. He wants to be noticed. He often makes such remarks as, 'I'm a character! I'm colorful.'

"Although he hangs around police, I don't think there was any payoff to police by him. He had no reputation of being a dope handler, or of being involved in other criminal affairs."

JADA SAID Ruby's nightclub did well while she was there.

"Jack suddenly became affluent as his place became packed with patrons," she said. "But he became even more obnoxious when he was in the money. He would yell at me, and at others, for a few days, then he would come around and talk nice.

"Jack was a tyrant, nothing less. He would yell at the girls working for him just like it had been a call house. He chased women, but I don't think he succeeded much."

Jada described Ruby as self-centered to the extreme.

"He dreaded showing his age,

although he was not old, maybe in his 50s. He would say, 'My hair is getting thinner. I must get a toupee. I must lose weight. I must diet.' But instead of dieting, he would load in the food.

"WHEN I COULDN'T stand Jack any longer, I took a day off to take action that would break my contract. He barred the door to my room where I had \$10,000 worth of clothes. I went to the sheriff's office and complained. Jack came to the sheriff's office. He screamed at the top of his voice, and told them to go ahead and lock him up, and to lock me up. He lost out in this showdown, and I left the show."

When asked if she considers Ruby mentally unbalanced, Jada said "I don't think he is sane." She expressed no opinion regarding the possibility that she will be called as a witness at Ruby's trial.

JADA SAID she was at Parkland Hospital in Dallas when the mortally wounded President was taken there.

"I was with a friend in a car when an accident occurred on the outskirts of Dallas, and a man apparently was injured," she said. "He was taken to Parkland for examination, and I went along to see the car arrive with the President and Governor Connally and others.

"One published report said Jack Ruby announced that he rushed to Parkland Hospital as soon as he learned the President had been shot. That is just what Ruby would tell the newspapers, but it was not true. A Dallas newspaper reporter blew that statement up. The reporter said he saw Ruby in the Dallas News lunch room only minutes after the President was shot, and that Ruby was in the lunch room a half-

"I TELL YOU that Ruby would do anything for attention. Besides, he was a bully. He would throw drunks down stairways, but he never picked trouble with anyone capable of flooring him.

"He was ruthless in his conduct. He would grab girls off the street and put them in his show the kind of girls who couldn't afford to start trouble.

"I'm certain Jack thought he would be acclaimed as a hero by shooting Oswald. He now sees it isn't working out so well."

Jada said she closed at a nightclub in Little Rock last Saturday night, and drove to El Paso to begin appearances at the Carousel at Sunland Park. She mentioned the coincidence that this name, carousel, is the same as Ruby's nightclub in Dallas.

ONE OF HER features is a "Bengal tiger act." Jada said she owns Madame Francine's nightclub in New Orleans. She said she recently completed a color movie entitled, "Dallas After Dark."

She mentioned incidentally, that she is the descendant of Samuel Houston, the first Revolutionary War hero of the state.

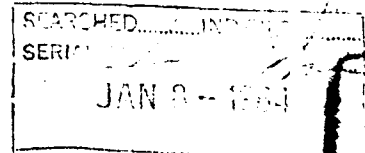

Appearing on the back cover (inside) is the name of "JACK RUBY WH 1-5601". (*This is Ruby's non published number at 223 So Evening apt 207*)

Re Louisville teletype dated November 25, 1963 regarding location of WALLY WESTON.

On November 25, 1963, while being interviewed regarding WESTON, CHESTER LORCH, 2343 Lansdowne, Louisville, Kentucky, advised SAs JOHN JAMES BOYD and ROBERT M. DOMALEWSKI as follows:

He is a booking agent for theatrical performers, and in connection with his business, he makes occasional trips to Chicago. He is less active, however, presently than he had been in the past.

In 1948 or 1949, while visiting Chicago on one of his business trips, he was in a restaurant frequented by Agents and other show people. He was with another agent, although he could not remember exactly who the agent might be when he was introduced to JACK RUBENSTEIN. This consisted only of a brief meeting, and he has had no additional contacts or meeting with RUBENSTEIN. However, since RUBENSTEIN was in the particular restaurant, he had got the impression that RUBENSTEIN was in some type of show business or owned a club of some type in Chicago.

He stated as far as he knew there were several old-time agents in the Chicago area, who might be more familiar with RUBY and his operations than was he. He identified these people as PAUL MOORE, MARCUS GLAZER, and PHIL CONSOLLO.

Subsequent to that meeting, he later heard from other contacts in show business that RUBY had a club in Dallas, Texas. He had no reason to inquire of RUBY's activities, but over the period of several years, he remembered some comments by the performers that RUBY did have such a club.

LORCH, himself, never booked a performer into RUBY's club since the performers he normally handled were in a different strata of show business according to LORCH. RUBY's place, from what he heard, was a strip joint and he normally did not handle performers who were booked into strip joints.

LORCH did state there were two agents in the Dallas area who might be familiar with RUBY. He identified them as PHIL BROWN, 4308 North Central Expressway, and ROWLAND DREER, 2533 McKinney.

LORCH had never heard anything of RUBY's background, knew nothing of his family, or his association. He likewise stated that he never heard any comments or conversation connecting RUBY with racketeers or underworld characters in the Chicago area.

The foregoing appears to have no direct bearing upon this investigation but is being furnished Dallas and Chicago in the event contact with the agents named in Chicago and Dallas who might know RUBY, appears logical to Dallas and/or Chicago.
