MALLEY stated today that LYLE WILSON of United Press in Washington had stated that they had received information that a Mrs. MICHEIZ (phonetic) who is supposed to have at one time operated the Red Fox Inn at Middleburg, Virginia, is now living in New York. She claims that she was recently interviewed by some Agent, probably in New York, by the name of FRANK, and that she had seen a picture of RUBY and remembered that sometime in June, 1963 that this picture of RUBY appeared to her to be a picture of an individual who had stayed in her Inn about June. She has now also claimed that he had a girl with him and she thinks the girl is MARINA OSWALD.

MALLEY stated that if we had anything like this to call him back on it. If not, they are going to call New York Office to find out about it.

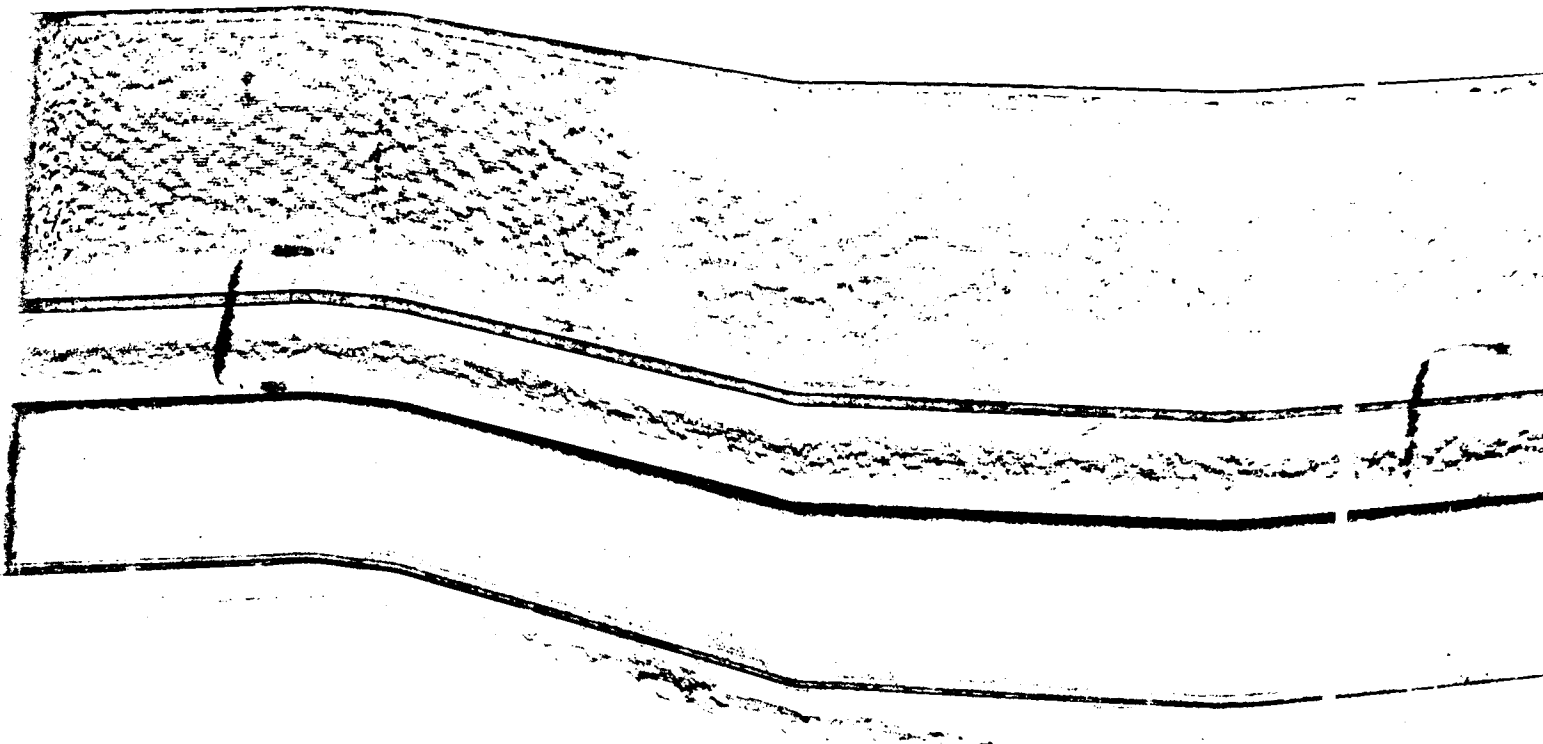

They do have a cousin, EUGENE DIXON who works at the U. S. Post Office as a letter carrier in Mesquite and resides there but the street address of EUGENE DIXON is not known to Mrs. DIXON. Mrs. DIXON advised neither she nor husband knows JACK RUBY and the only solution as to the reason for LEROY DIXON's name to appear in RUBY's address book or effects was that possibly it was another LEROY DIXON. She stated they bought their house at 1701 Kent Drive under the GI Bill but that was the only one and they did not default on it.

BALL, 110 Barnett, Dallas, Texas, an employee of Oak Cliff Cab Company, Dallas, Texas, advised that during the early morning of approximately 1-2 or 3-64, he went to the address of 1351 Galloway, Dallas, Texas, to pick up a customer. This customer, described as a white male, 35 - 40 years of age, tall and very thin, occupation - house painter, entered the cab and immediately stated: "Let's get this cab moving. Her husband may come home at any minute. Boy! Those drinks are sure expensive at the Carousel Club!" Later during conversation, customer stated that the girl he had just left was "one of RUBY's girls". Customer asked BALL to deliver him to 1026 North Beckley, Dallas, Texas. BALL stated he then asked customer if that wasn't the address where OSWALD had resided, and customer stated "Yes". Customer also advised that he had known OSWALD when OSWALD resided at the Beckley address. Extent of acquaintance not known to BALL.

He advised that HAYNES is the only such person with the name HOWARD who has worked in that capacity.

He is a full-time employee of Republic Aviation Corporation, East Farmingdale, NY, and a part-time USPO employee, at the Bay Shore PO Annex, Bay Shore, NY.

He had reported for work about noon on 11/24/63, and about that time the slaying of OSWALD by RUBY was announced on the radio. Shortly thereafter, possibly within one hour, a letter was being sorted, which was addressed to the Jack Ruby Defense Fund, Dallas, Texas, and it bore the name and address of a person living on Fire Island Avenue, West Islip, NY, which he cannot now recall. He pointed out that mail dropped in collection boxes in West Islip is picked up and brought to the Bay Shore PO Annex for cancellation, sorting and processing.

It was the concensus of the postal employees on duty at the time that the person sending the letter must have mailed it immediately upon hearing the radiobroadcast of the slaying or observing the slaying on television. Also, shortly after the letter had been mailed it had been picked up on a collection and brought to the Annex. The employees were impressed with the rapid speed with which the letter reached the PO Annex and he felt that it was almost improbable that the letter could have reached the Annex so quickly, ^{but} it was not impossible from the standpoint of the lapse of time.

US Postal Inspector CARROLL STROUD, Hauppauge, Long Island, NY, and FRANK CIRILLO, Postal Representative, Babylon, Long Island, NY, on 12/9/63, stated the above information had not been brought to their attention.

The above information is being brought to the attention of Dallas inasmuch as Dallas has indicated that it should be advised of sources of funds for RUBY's defense.

Enclosed are 25 copies of an insert reflecting a review of the indices of NYO on Dr. M.S. GUTTMACHER and Dr. M.F. GUTTMACHER of Baltimore, Maryland.

Files of the NYO also reflect a clipping in the "New York World Telegram", night edition of 2/6/59, bearing the dateline Washington, D.C., February 6th. This clipping bears the heading, "FBI Gets Needle From MD". In this article Dr. MANFRED S. GUTTMACHER, a Baltimore physician, is quoted as saying "Physicians have a high sense of social responsibility, but this does not call for them to act as special agents for the police". The article indicates that Dr. GUTTMACHER was peeved by what he termed FBI use of the Journal of the American Medical Association "as a vehicle for catching criminals". He criticized particularly the FBI for asking doctors to help apprehend a "bankruptcy swindler". He indicated this isn't a doctor's business.

On 1/10/64, Inspector J. R. MALLEY, furnished to Dallas Office contents of letter addressed to the Honorable LEE RANKIN, which reads as follows:

"Dear General:

"Pursuant to our telephone conversation, I will appreciate your making known to the Commission the following information with the hope that the Commission may see fit to help the District Attorney of Dallas County, Mr. Henry Wade.

1. In preparing the State's case against Jack Ruby, the District Attorney is presently handicapped by the fact that all records, including written statements, are in the possession of the FBI. Will you please see what can be done to get these statements, etc., in the hands of the District Attorney? The case is presently set for trial in early February.

2. Mr. Wade is concerned about repeated statements made in the press to the effect that there is no connection between Oswald and Ruby. His point is that such press reports should say that no connection has thus far been established. He is aware that such press statements are not based on any statements or activities of yours, Chief Justice Warren, or anyone connected with the Commission.

Inspector MALLEY referred to the request from District Attorney HENRY WADE for certain information from our files in connection with the investigation as reflected by our recent airtel, plus the above letter.

Mr. MALLEY stated that WADE should be contacted as soon as possible and tell him that the FBI Headquarters had been in touch with the President's Commission and the Department of Justice, and we stand ready to give him anything the President's Commission and the Department of Justice will permit them to give him.

He also stated that I should call San Antonio and read to them the above letter, and tell them to get in touch with WAGGONER CARR or in his absence, a responsible official and tell him that with respect to his letter of December 30, 1963 regarding WADE's request, that the FBI Headquarters had been in touch with the Commission and with the Department of Justice and that we stood ready to make available to WADE anything the President's Commission or the Department of Justice would permit us to give out.

At 12:15 PM, I advised District Attorney HENRY WADE of the above. I also called SAC COLE, San Antonio, and asked him to get in touch immediately with CARR or a responsible representative of his Department, and furnish him that information and call me back, as Inspector MALLEY wanted a call as soon as possible so that a memorandum could be sent to the Director saying that the above had been done.

At 2:10 PM this date, SAC COLE of the San Antonio Division advised me that he had attempted to contact Attorney General CARR, who was apparently going to be out the rest of the afternoon. He had, however, talked to Mr. STANTON STONE, Executive Assistant to the Attorney General, and had advised him as instructed by Inspector MALLEY.

I immediately thereafter called Bureau Headquarters and furnished this information, along with the results of my contact with District Attorney WADE, to Section Chief JAMES HANDLEY in the absence of Inspector MALLEY.
