



The entire world was shocked and saddened by the tragi: death of President John F. Kennedy. We will all miss him very much.

Reading various accounts of the assassination, I have noted two very disturbing faces in a photo of the President al Motorcade which might bear clarification.

Please refer to the Journal "FOUR DARK DAYS IN HISTORY" published by Special Publications, Inc., Los Angeles, Cal., pages 4 and 5, the large photo of the Motorcade covering part of the bottom of page 4 and the bottom half of page 5. On the left in the doorway entrance stands a man who could be Lee Oswald. Now look to the extreme right of the page to a man wearing a hat - it could be Ruby. Checking further, refer to the November 29th issue of LIFE Magazine, page 38 - note that attire of Oswald is identical to that of man in doorway; also, see page 18 of January 6th issue of NEWSWEEK showing front riew of Ruby as he talks with his attorney. Cover his forehead and note similarity to other man in the picture, as mentioned above. If you do not have the magazines mentioned above, I would be happy to lend you my copies. Perhaps the likeness of Oswali and Ruby to the faces in the photo of the Motorcade is just coincidential, however I felt that should be your decision. Therefore I am referring the matter to you.

Because of the painstaking thoroughness of the F. B. I, I hesitated writing you about this. I can appreciate the letters you receive from all sorts of cranks, neurotics, and the like - but on the chance that the above may be of importance, I decided you would be the better judge.



It is suggested that the attorneys for EUBY, and pathers the District Attorney at Dallas, may seek to elicit testimony regarding the background of LEE HARVEY OSWALD; activities of OSWALD; various aspects of the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY; xxxl security type investigation conducted by the FBI regarding OSWALD; and opinions as to the mental condition of RUBY.

It is suggested that the Agents may be called upon to testify to matters not obtained from the interview of JACK L. RUBY, and that the Court may order such testimony, even though the USA may be present and may be able to object to questions calling for such testimony.

It is requested that these possibilities be brough; to the attention to the Bureau, and instructions be obtained for the agents as to what action should be taken by the agents in the event they are ordered to testify to matters which they have not been authorized to do so by the Bureau.

It is further requested that advice be sought from the Bureau as to whether egents should testify from the 302s prepared in this mae, from their notes, or from memory.

It is also possible that RUBY's defense may desire testimony to show that on 12/21/63, Attorney MELVIN BELLI offered to make RUBY available for polygraph or truth serum examinations. On this occasion BELLI was advised that the FBI did not wish to interview RUBY with the use of the polygraph, at that time.
