An individual identifying himself only as ARTHUR JONES telephonically contacted the Boston Office during the evening of January 6, 1964, stating he had some information to provide concerning the captioned matter. JONES sounded as though he had been drinking and was very vague as to exactly where he was. He said he intended to stay at the Hotel Avery, Boston but during the conversation he walked away from the telephone and did not return. Before leaving the telephone, he indicated he had worked in the past at the Fairway Nite Club, Concord, Mass., and further stated that he has an uncle, J. F. JONES, Dallas, Texas, with whom he resided during November, 1963. He stated his uncle's address was 18 Northwest St., N.W., Dallas, Texas. He said the uncle got him a job as a cook for JACK RUBY and he worked there during November, 1963; however, he did not know the name of RUBY's nite club other than it was on the south side of Dallas, Texas.

He stated that while working in RUBY's nite club as a cook, he saw a man come in there who looked like LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and he thought there was something going on between OSWALD and RUBY although he could not say what he meant by this.

JONES stated that in the past he has worked in Vermont, New Hampshire and Arizona, but either could not or would not give any specific locations and would not indicate where he could be now contacted.

Gentlemen:

The entire world was shocked and saddened by the tragic death of President John F. Kennedy. We will all miss him very much.

Reading various accounts of the assassination, I have noted two very disturbing faces in a photo of the Presidential Motorcade which might bear clarification.

Please refer to the Journal "FOUR DARK DAYS IN HISTORY" published by Special Publications, Inc., Los Angeles, Cal., pages 4 and 5, the large photo of the Motorcade covering part of the bottom of page 4 and the bottom half of page 5. On the left in the doorway entrance stands a man who could be Lee Oswald. Now look to the extreme right of the page to a man wearing a hat - it could be Ruby. Checking further, refer to the November 29th issue of LIFE Magazine, page 38 - note that attire of Oswald is identical to that of man in doorway; also, see page 18 of January 6th issue of NEWSWEEK showing front view of Ruby as he talks with his attorney. Cover his forehead and note similarity to other man in the picture, as mentioned above. If you do not have the magazines mentioned above, I would be happy to lend you my copies. Perhaps the likeness of Oswald and Ruby to the faces in the photo of the Motorcade is just coincidental, however I felt that should be your decision. Therefore I am referring the matter to you.

Re Buairtel to DL, 1/9/63, instructing that SAs MANNING C. CLEMENTS and C. RAY HALL should appear in State Court at Dallas, Texas, in response to subpoena, and testify to information obtained from JACK L. RUBY during interview with him.

It is suggested that the attorneys for RUBY, and perhaps the District Attorney at Dallas, may seek to elicit testimony regarding the background of LEE HARVEY OSWALD; activities of OSWALD; various aspects of the assassination of President JOHN F. KENNEDY; ~~and~~ security type investigation conducted by the FBI regarding OSWALD; and opinions as to the mental condition of RUBY.

It is suggested that the Agents may be called upon to testify to matters not obtained from the interview of JACK L. RUBY, and that the Court may order such testimony, even though the USA may be present and may be able to object to questions calling for such testimony.

It is requested that these possibilities be brought to the attention to the Bureau, and instructions be obtained for the agents as to what action should be taken by the agents in the event they are ordered to testify to matters which they have not been authorized to do so by the Bureau.

It is further requested that advice be sought from the Bureau as to whether agents should testify from the 302s prepared in this case, from their notes, or from memory.

It is also possible that RUBY's defense may desire testimony to show that on 12/21/63, Attorney MELVIN BELLI offered to make RUBY available for polygraph or truth serum examinations. On this occasion BELLI was advised that the FBI did not wish to interview RUBY with the use of the polygraph, at that time.
