5. Any statements that you might have tending to show any connection between Oswald and Ruby.



You are no doubt aware through public sources that a battery of attorneys have been employed for the defense of Ruby in connection with the slaying of Lee Harvey Oswald. There has naturally been considerable speculation as to the source of what would appear to be substantial funds required for the defense. This Office has not conducted active investigation in this regard, however, certain information of possible interest to you has come to our attention.

It has been learned that Michael Shore, 1347 Cahuenga Boulevard, Hollywood, California, has been contacted by Earl Ruby, brother of Jack Ruby, with respect to possible sale of the "Jack Ruby Story" and that Shore has in turn been in touch with officials of the Saturday Evening Post in this regard. 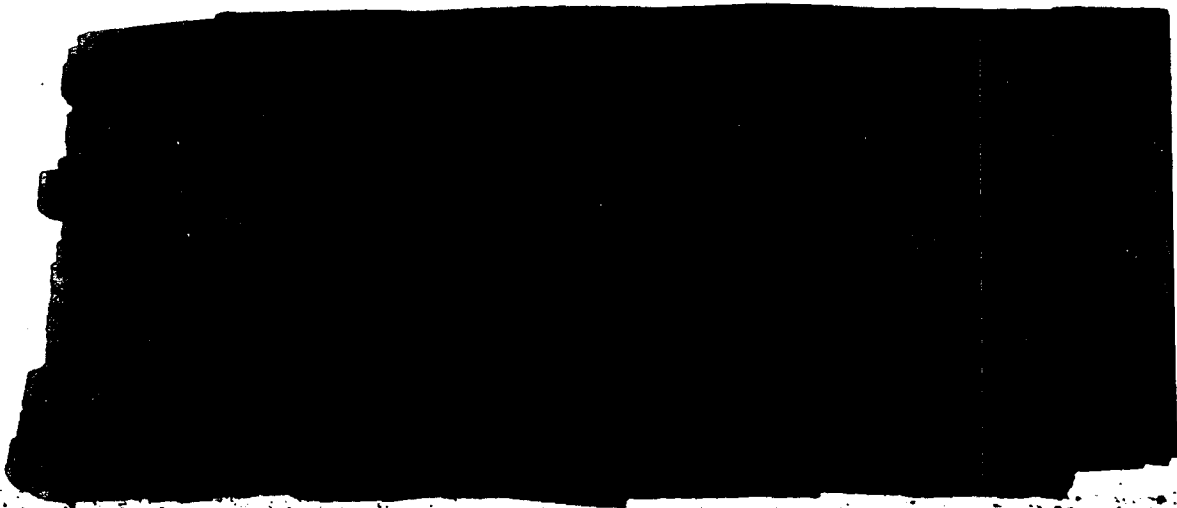

name of William Reed Woodfield, Studio City, California, was suggested by him as an individual who would be qualified to write the "Jack Ruby Story". Earl Ruby traveled to California to see Michael Shore in the above regard. Shore in turn contacted Woodfield.

William Reed Woodfield has confirmed the above contacts and has suggested to Michael Shore a trip to Dallas to confer with Jack Ruby in this connection. It is not known whether these individuals have been in touch with Jack Ruby or whether the idea of sale of the "Jack Ruby Story" has proceeded further.

It has been reported to this Office that Nelson N. Soll, Soll Bail Bonds, 4509 West Pico, Los Angeles, California, was one of local Los Angeles residents interested in starting a defense fund for Ruby. The source indicates Soll had, in 1954, given \$5,000.00 for the defense of a Negro charged with a crime in one of the Southern states, and that he was, in 1957, prominent in an organization known as "Council for the Condemned".

It has been reported that Gene Barnes, NBC cameraman, Hollywood, California, interviewed Soll and that after they were off camera, Soll told Barnes he was ready to post \$50,000 to \$100,000 as a bond for Ruby. It is reported Earl Ruby was present during the interview of Soll but declined comment.

This Office has come into possession of copies of certain correspondence directed to Ruby at the Dallas City Jail, later at the Dallas County Jail, which communication have included contributions for Ruby's defense, ranging from 10 cents to \$100. While these have not been totalled in this Office, it is doubted it would exceed \$200 or \$300. They have been in the form of cash, check and money orders.
