

Dear Mr. Shanklin:

As you are aware, we have a bond hearing on Jack Ruby set on January 20 and the trial for the murder of Lee Oswald set fo February 3 in Criminal District Court No. 3 of Dallas County Texas. In that trial all of the information we can gather with reference to the background of Jack Ruby from the time he was born up to the present, the names of all his business or social associates together with what they might have said concerning him or his mental capacity will be very important. I feel that you have some of this information or all of it in your present files. I would appreciate your obtaining the following:

- 1. Copies of all interviews had by your agents concerning Jack Ruby or any of his associates.
- 2. The names of any persons in any way connected with Ruby together with their statements made concerning him.
- 3. Any physical evidence that you might have in the Ruby case.
- 4. Any summary you might have of the whole activities of Ruby during and at the time of this murder.

5. Any statements that you might have tending to show any connection between Oswald and Ruby.

- 6. Any statements that you might have dealing with whether or not Ruby belonged or had belonged to any subversive groups.
- 7. Copies of the interviews had by your agents at the City Hall and also the Dallas County Jail and what Ruby told them.

None of this information will be released to the press, radio or television, nor to anyone else outside of this office, and vill be used exclusively in the trial of this case for the purposes of cross-examining the defendant should he testify and also cross-examining the character witnesses, and should any of these vitnesses wherein you have a statement from them testify, if they awary from the statements made to your agent, they will be used for the purpose of cross-examining this witness. I hope that this can be arranged as soon as possible since we will have to read and digest these prior to the trial on February 3.

Dear Mr. Cooner:

You are no doubt aware through public sources the t a battery of attorneys have been employed for the defense of Ruby in connection with the slaying of Lee Harvey Oswali . So far as is known to this office, attorneys currently include Tom Howard and Phil Burleson of Dallas, Joe Tonahi 1 of Jasper, Melvin Belli and William Choulos of San Francis o and Sam Brody of Los Angeles.

There has naturally been considerable speculatio as to the source of what would appear to be substantial fu ds required for the defense. This Office has not conducted active investigation in this regard, however, certain information of possible interest to you has come to our attention.

It has been learned that Michael Shore, 1347. Cahuenga Boulevard, Hollywood, California, has been contacted by Earl Ruby, brother of Jack Ruby, with respect to possible sale of the "Jack Ruby Story" and that Shore has in turn been in touch with officials of the Saturday Evening Post in this regard. Shore has advised that the

suggested by him as an individual who would be qualified to write the "Jack Ruby Story". Earl Ruby traveled to California to see Michael Shore in the above regard. Shore in turn contacted Woodfield.

William Reed Woodfield has confirmed the above contacts and has suggested to Michael Shore a trip to Dallas to confer with Jack Ruby in this connection. It is not known whether these individuals have been in touch wire Jack Ruby or whether the idea of sale of the "Jack Ruby Story" has proceeded further.

It has been reported to this Office that Nelson M. Soll, Soll Bail Bonds, 4509 West Pico, Los Angeles, California, was one of local Los Angeles residents intere ted in starting a defense fund for Ruby. The source indicate Soll had, in 1954, given \$5,000.00 for the defense of a Negro charged with a crime in one of the Southern states, and that he was, in 1957, prominent in an organization kn whas "Council for the Condemned".

It has been reported that Gene Barnes, NBC cameraman, Hollywood, California, interviewed Soll and that after they were off camera, Soll told Barnes he was read to post \$50,000 to \$100,000 as a bond for Ruby. It is reported Earl Ruby was present during the interview of Soll but declined comment.



This Office has come into possession of copies of certain correspondence directed to Ruby at the Dallas City Jail, later at the Dallas County Jail, which communication have included contributions for Ruby's defense, ranging from 10 cents to \$100. While these have not been totalled in this Office, it is doubted it would exceed \$200 or \$300. They have been in the form of cash, check and money orders

The above information is supplied for such value as it may have in connection with tax matters.
