On January 24, 1964, Mrs. F. P. HAMRAH, 4416 Edmunston, advised her daughter, DELORES, was formerly married to HARVEY KEITH WILLIAMS, JR., however, they were divorced in January, 1962 and WILLIAMS left the Dallas area and possibly returned to Kentucky where his parents formerly resided. She advised WILLIAMS visited the HAMRAH residence at Thanksgiving, 1963, to see his children who were at the HAMRAH residence. He left after Thanksgiving and his present whereabouts is unknown to the HAMRAHs or their daughter, DELORES. Mrs. HAMRAH said she had heard from a source not recalled that his parents, Mr. and Mrs. HARVEY KEITH WILLIAMS, SR., formerly from Anchorage, Kentucky, had moved from Kentucky and his father was an executive with some furniture company, Sanford, North Carolina.

It is noted lead to locate and interview H. KEITH WILLIAMS, JR. is based on information that in about 1959 H. KEITH WILLIAMS, a promoter with the Williams Oil Company, while at the Sovereign Club was hit by JACK RUBY because WILLIAMS had given RUBY a \$60.00 worthless check. WILLIAMS was reportedly in the club on this occasion with two other oil men. It is not believed that further investigation to locate H. KEITH WILLIAMS, JR. is warranted and accordingly no lead is being set out to locate WILLIAMS through his parents.



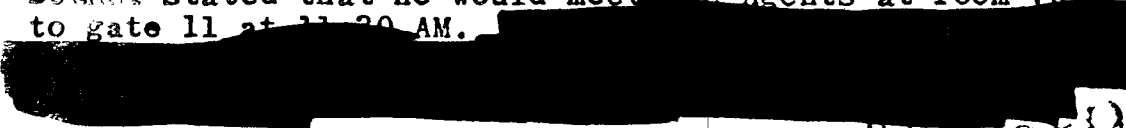

Mrs. RIDER stated that as one of her duties she censors all mail to and from prisoners in the Mobile County Jail and in reading the above letter she noticed that there appears to be a great deal of personal friendship between PARKER and EVA RUBY. She also mentioned that in this letter PARKER stated that she had read in newspaper concerning what had happened to JACK RUBY.

Went on the Monday before Christmas day and en route made an effort to locate the approximate spot where the assassination of JOHN F. KENNEDY took place. He was not able to accurately determine from the maps in his possession the spot, and became lost, and after driving what he later determined to be one mile, from the actual point of assassination he drove into a service station and inquired of the man the actual location of the assassination and learned at that time that he had passed the spot approximately one mile back. The exact name of the service station and location of the service station was not known to C.P. WINTER, however, it is his belief that his brother BILL WINTER will be able to furnish the address or information as to how to locate this service station.

At any rate the service station man indicated to BILL WINTER that he was personally acquainted with LEE HARVEY OSWALD and also with JACK RUBY and they both traded at his service station and he left the impression that perhaps the two were acquainted with one another.

On May 1, 1963, a source reported that it was announced at a meeting of the Westside Jewish Cultural Club in Los Angeles on February 3, 1961, that the Jewish Information Service was to be known henceforth as the Jewish Fraternal Co-Ordinating Committee.

This source had previously advised on May 2, 1960, that the Jewish Information Service was formed about January, 1954, in Los Angeles for the purpose of continuing the activity of the defunct International Workers Order. Prior to March 4, 1956, the Los Angeles Jewish Cultural and Fraternal Clubs were identified as the Los Angeles Jewish Cultural Club, this group being formerly known as Lodges of the Jewish People's Fraternal Order. The Los Angeles Jewish Cultural and Fraternal Clubs are currently active in the Los Angeles area.

The Fraternal Medical Plan of the California Fraternal Service Association was formed about January, 1954 for the purpose of continuing the activity of the Jewish People's Fraternal Order Medical Plan. Since that date the functioning of the Fraternal Order Medical Plan of the California Fraternal Service Association has been integrated into the operation of the Los Angeles Jewish Cultural and Fraternal Clubs, inasmuch as the service provided by the Fraternal Medical Plan of the California Fraternal Service Association is made available most exclusively to members of the Los Angeles Jewish Cultural and Fraternal Clubs; further, effort is made to have members of the Los Angeles Jewish Cultural and Fraternal Clubs also become members of the Fraternal Medical Plan of the California Fraternal Service Association.

The Fraternal Medical Plan of the California Fraternal Service Association is currently active in the Los Angeles area.

The International Workers Order and the Jewish People's Fraternal Order have been designated by the Attorney General of the United States pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

Chicago and New York Offices discontinue efforts to identify and locate Serv-U-Pharmacy mentioned in referenced Dallas airtel as it has been located at Los Angeles, California.

The following investigation was conducted by SA RICHARD WHALEN:

On 1/24/64 it was ascertained that the Serv-U-Pharmacy is located at 1601 West 6th Street, Los Angeles, California.

On 1/24/64 DAVID WEINSTEIN, Manager, Serv-U-Pharmacy, 1601 West 6th Street, stated that HARRY SHULMAN is not connected with this pharmacy in any manner. He said that he, WEINSTEIN, is a close friend of ALEXANDER GRUBER and that GRUBER is a friend of JACK RUBY and one HARRY SHULMAN. WEINSTEIN said the only connection between SHULMAN and the Pharmacy address would be AL GRUBER. He said that he did not know RUBY and he felt that RUBY was wrong in shooting OSWALD.

On 1/24/64 ALEXANDER P. GRUBER, 522 West Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles, advised he is acquainted with DAVID WEINSTEIN, HARRY SHULMAN and JACK RUBY. He said he was previously interviewed by the FBI concerning RUBY. GRUBER advised he often frequents the Serv-U-Pharm and no doubt at an earlier date had advised RUBY of the name and address of that pharmacy. GRUBER said he knows one HARRY SHULMAN, aka "Heckie" who resides in San Francisco, California and was last known to be employed as an operator of a hot dog concession for the City of San Francisco. He did not know any additional location for SHULMAN adding that he is "well known in San Francisco." GRUBER said the above SHULMAN is from the same "Ghetto area" in Chicago, Illinois as GRUBER and RUBY. He said he knew of no connection of the above SHULMAN with the Serv-U-Pharmacy or DAVID WEINSTEIN.

GRUBER added that GRUBER and WEINSTEIN were interested at one time in having a car wash business and GRUBER had discussed this with RUBY. He does not believe RUBY ever met WEINSTEIN. He said that this might be the reason for RUBY having the Serv-U-Pharmacy address but that he did not know of any connection of SHULMAN with that pharmacy or address.

Los Angeles is unable to locate any reference identifiable with HARRY SHULMAN on the basis of information known concerning SHULMAN.

Los Angeles indices reflect DAVID WEINSTEIN is identical with "D. WEINSTEIN" appearing on a 1954 members list of the Fraternal Medical Plan of the California Fraternal Association. Attached is an appendix for the Jewish Fraternal Coordinating Committee.

Los Angeles will not forward inserts or FD-302 to Dallas of the above information.

On 1/28/64, SA ALFRED D. NEELEY obtained from RAU ZAUBER, Editor and Publisher, Oak Cliff Tribune, a bi-week newspaper, copies of the paper from 11/21/63 through 1/27/64. ZAUBER was contacted on the basis (1) he had been subpoenaed as a defense witness in connection with the recent bond hearing and [REDACTED]

ZAUBER told SA NEELEY he had no doubt been subpoenaed in view of a defense effort to get a change of venue on the basis RUBY could not get a fair trial in Dallas County. ZAUBER was never called to the stand during the hearing.

Examination of the newspaper discloses a regular column by ZAUBER called the "Scratch Pad" and that ZAUBER had concerned himself with the assassination of President KENNEDY and the shooting of OSWALD in this column. In addition, the paper includes fifteen "chapters" of a series of articles. It was observed that "Chapter 1" of the series states in the nature of a foreword that the article was submitted by a "prominent law enforcement official in Dallas as a matter of chronological information to the Tribune". Certain of the subsequent "Chapters" likewise give credit to the law enforcement official.

ZAUBER, when queried by SA NEELEY, <sup>LAUGHLIN</sup> logically stated he had personally written the articles in question although saying he "had help" and inferred his principal source of contact and presumably his "help" has been Captain FRITZ, Dallas Police Department, whom he's known and admired for many years (ZAUBER was formerly a Police reporter on a Dallas daily). In the same conversation, ZAUBER, <sup>in referring to</sup>

the articles, said in substance "I've got to sell newspaper".

Examination of the articles indicates ZAUBER, who is factual on bare essentials, raises numerous questions, often set forth in question form so phrased as to infer to the reader that ZAUBER perhaps has information to support a particular theory. His articles infer the existence of a Communist conspiracy, the linking of OSWALD with RUBY, attempted suppression of full facts by public officials, and treatment of OSWALD by the "liberal press", suppression of "conservatives" or "right wing" element, etc.

The writer finds no basis for investigative lead from examination of the articles in question.
