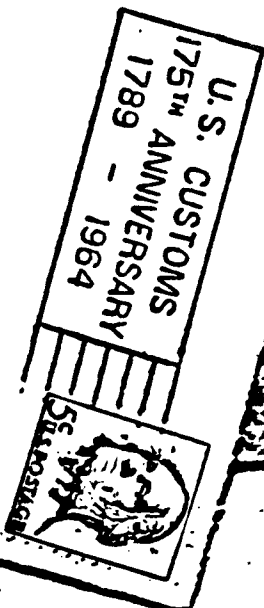

KURT VON HUFFMAN, aka. Charles Huffman, Kurt Huffman, is an individual presently under investigation by GMAC collection investigators for skipping out of Huntsville, Alabama, on 1/23/63 with a 1961 white Cadillac Coupe Deville, SN 61J016088, Alabama 1964 license 47-35389. He bought that Cadillac and was financed by GMAC, Huntsville, Alabama. His last payment on same was 7/7/63. GMAC investigation developed some information that HUFFMAN is known to JACK RUBY in some way. He said this was developed as a matter of course when leads were being covered but specific reason why they are supposed to know each other is not known.

Their investigation is being conducted by about 10 offices. Information was developed that on the night following President KENNEDY's assassination, KURT VON HUFFMAN locked up his club that he had been operating, known as Black Forrest Inn, Huntsville, Alabama, and rented a U-Haul Trailer. He and his wife, who goes under the name of PATSY, rented the U-Haul Trailer under the assumed name of MARTIN W. SALTER from a service station at Huntsville. According to the service station attendant, a woman named PATSY commented they were going to Dallas, Texas. Investigators noted the trailer rent receipt reflects their destination was San Angelo, Texas. The service station attendant who rented the trailer saw two carbin rifles, a sawed off shot gun, one German luger pistols, ammunition, and some hand grenades on the trailer. KURT VON HUFFMAN was said to be a professional hard shark and gambler who skipped out of Huntsville, Alabama, owing creditors about \$50,000. He operates generally as a restaurant chef or manager. He possesses a German from Heidleberg, Germany. His description is as follows:

b7c, d [redacted] said he was interested in determining if the FBI has any information in its files that could be given to him. He was advised the Bureau's files are confidential and available only for official use. He was informed, however, that the fact that the Cadillac automobile is missing and sought by GMAC, would be recorded in our files and he would be advised if any information later comes to our attention concerning the whereabouts of the car.

He advised the GMAC Contract No. concerning the transaction is 14462-H38, of the Huntsville, Alabama, GMAC Office. The complete file concerning instant matter is located there.

It is noted from the above that the suspect named herein has been rumored in the Huntsville, Alabama, area as having been known as JACK RUBY in the past. Also that individual allegedly left Huntsville, Alabama, en route to Dallas, Texas, on the night of 11/23/63 with a trailer in which he had guns described above. His whereabouts since that time has been unknown to GMAC.

ACTION: Check indices concerning KURT VON HUFFMAN, aka. Charles Huffman, Kurt Huffman and Martin W. Salter; also Black Forrest Lounge, Huntsville, Alabama.

If indices are negative consider advisability of letter in RUBY case to Birmingham to ascertain from GMAC, Huntsville, any available specific details that would link suspect KURT VON HUFFMAN with JACK RUBY.

TAPLIN, 5678 Cary Street Dallas, Texas, telephone EV1-2613, telephonically advised he has a film taken in front of the Dallas Police Department, Commerce Street side, on the morning of 11-24-63, the date OSWALD was shot. The film does not include photographs of any activity relating to the shooting, but does show an armored car. He stated the film was available in the event it might be of value.

TAPLIN was advised such film did not appear to be relevant, but that in the event it was desired, he would be contacted.

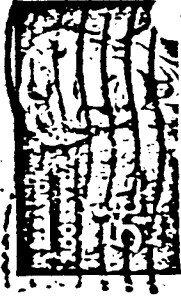
are much to be lamented, and many

Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY called at 4:15 PM today and stated Bureau was in receipt of letter dated 2/25/64 from the Commission which reads as follows:

A review of SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS' report of Nov. 30, 1963, pages 155 through 159, suggests the existence of a file containing information about JACK L. RUBY collected by your Bureau prior to Nov. 22, 1963. This assumption is based upon various pieces of intelligence data intermittently dated as early as May, 1961.

The Commission would appreciate receiving a report on the information relating to RUBY which may have been in your possession prior to Nov. 22, 1963.

Mr. MALLEY instructed that we send by return airmail as quickly as possible, going through this material and identifying the source, such as whatever file number it is in the Dallas Office, the caption, and a brief summary of each item. We would also advise them whether we maintained a file on RUBY prior to 11/22/63.

I informed Mr. MALLEY that we did as I knew we did have a 137 PCI file that had been closed, and that I had notified the Bureau telephonically and that the same had been included in a teletype.

Mr. MALLEY stated he would also want us to include in the airtel whether all pertinent information in our files had been included in this report.

I called Mr. MALLEY back and referred him to serial 1 of 44-1639, which is a teletype to the Bureau, dated 11/24/63, sent at 2:11 PM, which furnished a complete review of all the information in our files, as well as source. He still said he wanted us to review this and send him an airtel.

ADDENDUM

I telephoned Inspector MALLEY and pointed out to him that the sources for all the information on pages 155 through 159 were included in cover pages GG and HH of SA MANNING C. CLEMENTS' report in the JACK L. RUBY case dated 11/30/63. I also advised him that I had checked with SA CLEMENTS and that again references in our files had been reviewed and that all pertinent information had been included in the report on RUBY.

MALLEY stated it would not be necessary for us to send an airtel as they would get the information from the reports at the Bureau, and in the event they needed anything more, they would call back.

ADDENDUM NO. 2

Mr. MALLEY called back and requested that we send to the Bureau to his attention, AMSD, registered the original PCI file on JACK L. RUBY, and instructed that we make a copy to retain in the Dallas Office. This has been done.
