The National Committee, Communist Party, USA (CP), in issuing its final text of the "Resolution Growing Out of the Presidential Elections" in "Political Affairs," issue of Jul 1953, states in substance that in 1948 the CP helped stimula the formation of the PP and correctly supported the PP throu the 1952 elections. It then states:

"However, the mistake our Party made was to confuse this tas the historic task of forming a new mass party of the geople. consequence, there existed the wrong estimate that the formal of the Progressive Party represented something more than the simple emergency of an important fighting force for peace; t it represented the emergence of a great mass people's Party.

- As a result of this reasoning, the resolution concludes that "Progressive Party, the CP and other progressive forces" mus unite in a broad, mass-front coalition.

Concerning "Political Affairs," mentioned above, ELIZABETH G LEY FLYNN, a convicted CP functionary, testifying in the case, "US vs ELIZABETH GURLEY FLYNN et al," on October 20, 1952, a that "Political Affairs" has been the theoretical organ of t since the publication's beginning in 1945.

The above call of Mrs. GRANT was made known to MANNING C. CLEMENTS, who stated he would convey the compl of GRANT to Sheriff J. E. DECKER on the afternoon of 3/12

It is noted the above complaint is similar to made personally at the Dallas Office on the night of 3/6/ At that time, GRANT, accompanied by SAMUEL RUEY, brother the subject, appeared at the office at approximately 10:1 at which time they were interviewed by SA'S MANNING C. CI and RAYMOND C. ECKENRODE. On this occasion, GRANT was ins on "protection" for RUBY, claiming she had talked with hi earlier on 3/6/64 in his cell at the Dallas County Jail, that he told her "the police were out to get him," which she said she interpreted to mean members of the Dallas Co Sheriff's Office. At the time of interview, Mrs. GRANT w firmly, but tactfully, informed the FBI could not comply with her request for "protection" for her brother; that S DECKER was a highly competent law enforcement officer, as the members of his staff; that undoubtedly Sheriff DECKER initiated all possible security measures to insure the sa of JACK RUBY, noting even Defense Attorney MELVIN BELLI, well as her brother, had publicly commended Mr. DECKER in regard, and that if she was so insistent it was suggested report her anxieties with respect to this matter to Mr. D At this time, Mrs. GRANT commented that she had the higher regard for Sheriff DECKER but that, in her opinion, certa of the officers in his department were independently plot to dispose of her brother, since his act in killing OSWAL caused great embarrassment for law enforcement generally Dallas. She requested identity of some higher source to which she could appeal within the county government with respect to her current complaint, and it was suggested sh may desire to consult with District Attorney HENRY WADE or perhaps the County Commissioners.

During the above interview, SAM RUBY was extreapologetic for the inconvenience of the interview, claims he had attempted to dissuade Mrs. GRANT from coming to the Dallas Office, but to no avail.

At the time the interview was concluded, it as to interviewing Agents that Mrs. GRANT was satisfied with explanations provided her as to the position of this Bure it related to her complaint, and the interview was terming with a general amiable feeling toward the FBI by both Mrs GRANT and SAM RUBY.

The complaint voiced by Mrs. GRANT during the above interview with respect to the safety of her brother was orally furnished Deputy Sheriff ALLEN SWEATT, of the County Sheriff's Office, on the morning of 3/7/64, by SAC. CLEMENTS.
