On 2/11/64, Mr. WILLIAM JAMES LOWERY, JR., 4520 Ridlewood
Dallas, Texas, advised that he had been looking over some material
which he had had in his possession while serving as a CP member.
LOWERY, who was a CP member from 9/29/47 to 9/29/63, made available
a leaflet entitled "A Call to the Founding Convention of the New
Texas Political Party in Support of Henry A. Wallace and Owen H.
Taylor." This pamphlet stated that this convention would be held
on 4/25/48 at 10:00 A.M., at the Houston Music Hall.

Officers of this Founding Convention listed from Dallas
are as follows:

JOE BAILEY IRWIN, Executive Secretary
Rev. STACY ADAMS, Vice Chairman, and
SAM BARBARIA, on the Executive Committee.

On the back of this leaflet under the heading "Hundreds
of Prominent Texans Eager to Endorse Wallace" appears the name
SAM RUBY.

LOWERY stated that he did not remember having attended
the Founding Convention of the Progressive Party in Houston,
mentioned in this leaflet, and that he did not know SAM RUBY,
listed on this leaflet. He thought that since the name is the same
as JACK L. RUBY, who has been indicted for the murder of LEO
HARVEY OSWALD, that it might be of some possible use in connection
with that matter. He stated that he had never heard the name SAM RUBY
mentioned while he was a member of the CP during that period and
knew nothing further concerning SAM RUBY such as his occupation
or place of residence.

It is noted that the leaflet has no further identifying
information concerning the SAM RUBY listed on the leaflet, however,
if it has been determined that one SAMUEL DAVID RUBY is a brother of
JACK L. RUBY, who resides in Dallas.

PROGRESSIVE PARTY (PP)

The National Committee, Communist Party, USA (CP), in issuing its final text of the "Resolution Growing Out of the Presidential Elections" in "Political Affairs," issue of Jul 1953, states in substance that in 1948 the CP helped stimulate the formation of the PP and correctly supported the PP through the 1952 elections. It then states:

"However, the mistake our Party made was to confuse this task with the historic task of forming a new mass party of the people. As a consequence, there existed the wrong estimate that the formation of the Progressive Party represented something more than the simple emergency of an important fighting force for peace; that it represented the emergence of a great mass people's Party. t

As a result of this reasoning, the resolution concludes that "Progressive Party, the CP and other progressive forces" must unite in a broad, mass-front coalition. he

Concerning "Political Affairs," mentioned above, ELIZABETH GURLEY FLYNN, a convicted CP functionary, testifying in the case, "US vs ELIZABETH GURLEY FLYNN et al," on October 20, 1952, stated that "Political Affairs" has been the theoretical organ of the CP since the publication's beginning in 1945. Buairtel 3/5/64 instructs certain telephone information be obtained at request of President's Commission. Other offices are to submit FD-302's within 5 days of receipt of communication to Dallas, which, plus Dallas information, are to be included in Dallas report, deadline 3/13/64.

Specifically, the Commission desires information as to toll calls during period 9/26/63 (when late President's trip to Dallas was made public) through 11/22/63, date of assassination, such information to include dates of call time, duration, number called, person or entity to whom called number is listed, identities of persons called and persons making calls, when such information is shown in telephone company records. Corbat said he married about 8/1/63 and Senator later moved in with Ruby; Senator said moved in with Ruby about 11/1/63. Accordingly, effort must be made to identify telephone available to Senator at the apartment from which he moved. Senator worked for Texas Post Card Co., 3616 Cedar Springs, LA 6-6162, which should be covered.

Interview with CRAFORD reflects he was a carnival worker, wound up at State Fair of Texas in October, 1963. When the fair closed, he was hired by Ruby and slept at the Carousel Club. Accordingly, the Carousel telephone would be presumed to be those available to him.

ANDREW ARMSTRONG, JR.

Files reflect Armstrong, who is a Negro and was employed by Ruby at Carousel during pertinent period, lived at 3821 Dickson Circle, Apt. C, when interviewed. No listing is found in telephone directory for his home, although it is believed he has a home phone. The listed phone at Carousel would have been available to him. Check must be made to identify home phone number which must be covered. Armstrong has been interviewed numerous times and there appears to be no reason why he should not be contacted and his home number ascertained. Care should be made to determine whether he had the same phone for all of the pertinent period.

Worth telephone JE 4-8525, non-published to Bruce Carlin. It is understood they have since moved. It is not known whether this was the only residence phone available to them during pertinent period. Carlin's employment is not known, hence any phone at his place of employment during pertinent period must be covered. The marital status of Carlin and Little Lynn is not known. She is currently pregnant, was subpoenaed for Ruby trial under name Karen Bennett. Effort should be made to determine whether she was with Carlin during the entire pertinent period or resided elsewhere during part of the time and therefore had a different phone available.

* * * * *

It is to be noted several reports include information as to toll calls from telephones listed under Jack Ruby's name, above. However, it will be necessary to dig out the identities of persons called. It will likewise be necessary to review the toll tickets as to exact times of calls, names of persons calling, etc., as indicated above.

b2d [redacted] S. W. Bell Tel. Co., Dallas, has been previously requested to maintain until further notice all records available as to the Jack Ruby phones listed above. He should be asked to maintain the additional records which will be covered. Similarly, the proper person at the telephone company, Ft. Worth, should be asked to preserve records as to Ft. Worth phones covered. Confirmatory letters should be written to insure such retention.

Auxiliary offices must be advised immediately by teletype to identify subscribers to numbers called, from telephone company records, and to submit appropriate FD-302's in accordance with deadline. Offices should be instructed to check indices on any names identified from records as to persons called and/or shown as subscribers. If pertinent information is found in office files, appropriate 302's or inserts should be furnished.

At 12:35 PM, this date, EVA GRANT, sister of JACK L. RUBY, telephonically contacted SA RAYMOND E. ECKENRODE, at which she professed great concern for the life and safety of subj RUBY. Mrs. GRANT claimed Rabbi SILVERMAN earlier this date talked with RUBY in his cell at the Dallas County Jail and, their conversation, RUBY allegedly expressed the belief that jailors assigned to his security in the County Jail were going to "kill him." Mrs. GRANT was insistent that Agents of this Bureau be dispatched to the County Jail for the purpose of providing "protection" for RUBY during the tenure of his trial confinement.

Mrs. GRANT was tactfully advised that this Bureau had authority to undertake the assignment she requested and suggested that she lodge her complaint with Sheriff J. E. DECKER. Mr GRANT then asserted she had absolutely no confidence in Sheriff DECKER; that he was a party to the conspiracy to kill her brother and that if this "G D agency" could afford protection for OSWALD (apparently referring to MARINA OSWALD) she felt her was also entitled this similar courtesy. It was pointed out to Mrs. GRANT that this Bureau had never afforded any "protection" to MARINA OSWALD; that in all probability she had the FBI contract with the Secret Service, and it was again reiterated to her that we had no authority whatsoever to take over the responsibilities lawfully charged to the Dallas County Sheriff's Office with respect to her brother. Mrs. GRANT thereupon became extremely abusive and, after a tirade of profanity, threatened that she was going to appear on television this afternoon and expose the FBI for what they were, again stating that, if the FBI could protect OSWALD's wife, that they certainly could do the same for her brother.

Apparently dissatisfied with the responses received from SA ECKENRODE, Mrs. GRANT then demanded to know who had the authority in "that G D office," at which time she was informed that SAC SHANKLIN was in charge and she then insisted on speaking to him.

with Mr. SHANKLIN. Effort was made to transfer this call to SAC SHANKLIN; however, the PBX Operator informed the SAC at lunch, but due to return shortly. This fact was made known to Mrs. GRANT and she stated she would call Mr. SHANKLIN this afternoon.

The above call of Mrs. GRANT was made known to MANNING C. CLEMENTS, who stated he would convey the complaint of GRANT to Sheriff J. E. DECKER on the afternoon of 3/12/64.

It is noted the above complaint is similar to one made personally at the Dallas Office on the night of 3/6/64. At that time, GRANT, accompanied by SAMUEL RUBY, brother of the subject, appeared at the office at approximately 10:15 PM, at which time they were interviewed by SA'S MANNING C. CLEMENTS and RAYMOND C. ECKENRODE. On this occasion, GRANT was insistent on "protection" for RUBY, claiming she had talked with him earlier on 3/6/64 in his cell at the Dallas County Jail, that he told her "the police were out to get him," which she said she interpreted to mean members of the Dallas County Sheriff's Office. At the time of interview, Mrs. GRANT was firm, but tactfully, informed the FBI could not comply with her request for "protection" for her brother; that Sheriff DECKER was a highly competent law enforcement officer, as were the members of his staff; that undoubtedly Sheriff DECKER had initiated all possible security measures to insure the safety of JACK RUBY, noting even Defense Attorney MELVIN BELLI, well as her brother, had publicly commended Mr. DECKER in this regard, and that if she was so insistent it was suggested she report her anxieties with respect to this matter to Mr. DECKER. At this time, Mrs. GRANT commented that she had the highest regard for Sheriff DECKER but that, in her opinion, certain of the officers in his department were independently plotting to dispose of her brother, since his act in killing OSWALD caused great embarrassment for law enforcement generally in Dallas. She requested identity of some higher source to which she could appeal within the county government with respect to her current complaint, and it was suggested she may desire to consult with District Attorney HENRY WADE or perhaps the County Commissioners.

During the above interview, SAM RUBY was extremely apologetic for the inconvenience of the interview, claiming he had attempted to dissuade Mrs. GRANT from coming to the Dallas Office, but to no avail.

At the time the interview was concluded, it appeared to interviewing Agents that Mrs. GRANT was satisfied with the explanations provided her as to the position of this Bureau as it related to her complaint, and the interview was terminated with a general amiable feeling toward the FBI by both Mrs. GRANT and SAM RUBY.

The complaint voiced by Mrs. GRANT during the above interview with respect to the safety of her brother was orally furnished Deputy Sheriff ALLEN SWEATT, of the Dallas County Sheriff's Office, on the morning of 3/7/64, by SA C. CLEMENTS. ANNING
