Several days ago I was contacted by Mr. Drain regarding a check of garages and service stations patronized by Jack Ruby.

On April 5, Lieutenant E. L. Cunningham contacted four such places which, from papers found in Ruby's car, indicated he might have patronized. A copy of Lieutenant Cunningham's report is enclosed.

Donnell D. Whittier, named in the enclosed report, Formerly worked at the Texaco Service Station, Clarendon and Ewing, serviced Ruby's car when he came to the station. As you will recall, Whittier was arrested by officers of this department on November 18, 1963, at which time two machine guns and two Browning automatic rifles were recovered which had been taken in a burglary of the National Guard Headquarters at Terrell, Texas. According to our records he was convicted in Federal Court and is now serving time for this offense.

I contacted Mr. Leo Havarro, 1323 Claude, who owns the Mavarro Garage at 815 South Denley Drive?' He stated he had never met Hr. Ruby, but that a friend of his, a Mr. V. E. Horalli, had given Ruby his name and the address of his garage when Ruby asked Horalli where he could find 3 300d mechanic. Ruby never brought his car to Kaverro for repair work.

Mr. V. E. Horalli, 715 West Penbroke, VII 8-9795, states that Jack Ruby traded at his Texaco Service Station at Eving and Clarendon for about may year. However, he did not know Ruby very well. He gave Ruby a Gard with hee Navarro's address on it when Jack asked him where he could find an honest mechanic. Moralli never did see Ruby with anyone that fit Oswald's description.

Boanell D. Whittier worked at Boralli's Service Station and took care of Rudy's work for him... Nor all states he does not know if they were friends or had relations other than that of customer and station attendant or not. Whittier was arrested Hovember 18, 1963 for burglary of National Guard armory in Terrell, Texas. I understand that he has been convicted of this burglass in Federdal Court.

Mr. & Tilson, 3000 Flackburn, LA 1-7131 was contacted. He stated that he know Jack Ruby when he run the Bilver Spur in 1948. He met Jack about two weeks prior to Kovember 22 in the Merchants State Bank. They greated each other and Jack asked Wilson what he was doing for a living. Ir. Vilson gave Ruby his business card and told him to come to see him. IIr. Vilaca states that to his knowledge Ruby was never in his place.

The Texaso Service Station at 8th and Thornton Freeway was purchased by 3 Mg. Boward on the 15th of Karch, 1964 from Mr. E. D. Harris. Mr. Boward does not know where I'r. Harris could be contacted.







## RE JACK LEON RUBY - MINIFON RECORDING EQUIPMENT

The Chicago Office by communication dated December 4, 1963, furnished information indicating that a Mrs. VIVIAN CURRY, 1855 Elmwood Avenue, Apartment 1, Los Angeles, California, advised SA WAYNE E. ELWANGER on November 29, 1963, that she believed that JACK RUBY purchased some Minifon recording equipment from her when she was employed by either the Adair Engineering Company, address unrecalled, or Ernstrom's Record Shop on Lovers Lane, both Dallas, Texas. She recalled selling him a telephone attachment and other pocket recording devices for approximately \$500. She added that the records of the above companies for the Minifon home office in Chicago, Illinois, would be able to verify or eliminate the possible purchase of this equipment by JACK RUBY since all serial numbers are kept of each recording device sold by them.

On December 4, 1963, Mr. M. J. HIRSCHENBEIN, Vice-President, Fotonite Company, 6424 Northwestern, Chicago, Allinois, advised SA JOHN P. QUINLIN that the Fotonite Company formerly distributed Minifon recording products, but they have no present connection with Minifon. All sales records regarding Minifon products were forwarded to the International Telephone and Telegraph Company, Federal Electric Corporation, 485 Victoria Terrace, Ridgefield, New Jersey.

On December 5, 1963, ROBERT HARZ, Stock Controller, Jederal Electric Corporation, International Telephone and Telegraph Company, Paramus, New Jersey, advised SA RAYMOND F. HOYLE that the Federal Electric Corporation is the repair division of International Telephone and Telegraph Company. stated that he had no records except records of repairs on Ministon recording equipment and that his records begin in August, 1961, at which time the International Telephone and Calegraph Company entered into the distributorship of Minifon equipment. He added that the only sure way to trace repairs on this equipment was through serial numbers but that some of the repairs were made using the name of the person requesting these repairs. He added that he would have his records searched and would advise the Newark Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation should be locate any record for JACK LEON RUBY OF JACK RUBENSTEIN.

Mr. HARZ further advised that the Federal Electric Corporation was formerly located at 485 Victoria Terrace, Ridgefield, New Jersey. He suggested that JACK SCULLY, Manager, Distributor Products Division, International Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lodi, New Jersey, might be able to furnish additional information concerning any recording equipment purchased by RUBY in Dallas, Texas, prior to 1961. The commented that minor repairs on equipment of this type may have been handled by either of the following companies in Dallas, Texas:

Archinal Photo Electro Service 2806 Canton Street

Ernstrom's, Inc. 4356 Lovers Lane

Mr. HARZ subsequently advised the Newark Office delephonically that a review of all his records failed to reveal the repair of any equipment for RUBY as having been handled by the Federal Electric Corporation. He added that he would need a serial number in order to positively trace any repairs.

On December 5, 1963, JACK SCULLY, Manager, Technical Services, Distributor Products Division, International Telephone and Telegraph Company, Route 17, Lodi, New Jersey, advised SA NOTIE that his company took over the distributorship of Minifon equipment in August, 1961. He stated that prior to bhat time the distributorship was handled by the Geiss America Corporation, 6424 Northwestern Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, and bat one LEROY COHEN was general sales manager. He added that the Minison contract was cancelled by the manufacturer who at that there was Protona in Hamburg, Germany, and that there was ill will at the time of the cancellation. Mr. SCULLY said that consequently the International Telephone and Telegraph Company got no cooperation from the Geiss America Corporation and that Aone of the records were ever furnished the International Talaphone and Telegraph Company. He said that when they assumed dealer responsibility for Minifon they had no knowledge of when or to whom the equipment had been sold, and they had to absorb the goat of repairs on some equipment on which he felt sure the warranty had expired.

Mr. SCULLY commented that the Fotonite Company was anknown to him by name but that it was probably identical to the Geiss America Corporation at the same address in Chicago in view of the fact that he has a letterhead from Geiss America Corporation dated approximately one month ago on which a Mr. M. J. HIRSCHENBEIN is listed as Vice-President.

Mr. SCULLY stated that he would have a search of his records made for any customers or the repair of any equipment by JACK LEON RUBY or JACK RUBENSTEIN and that he would advise the Newark Office should any such records be located.

Mr. SCULLY subsequently advised telephonically that he could locate no record at his company for RUBY or RUBENSTEIN.

Roebling and Sons Company, Trenton, New Jersey, which is now the Roebling Division of the Colorado Fuel and Iron Company, advised SA T. HOWARD WALDRON that he believed that CHARLES E.

MELINEY, Sales Manager of the Roebling Division office at \$320 Dora Street, Houston, Texas, has been associated with JACK ROFT in a club in Dallas, Texas. Mr. NERONI said his recollection was vague, but he thought MELUNEY had been connected with the Caronsel in Dallas.

## ME JACK RUBENSTEIN, CIO TEXTILE WORKERS UNION ORGANIZER

The Dallas Office by communication dated November 27, 1963, requested that the Newark Office develop information concerning JACK RUBENSTEIN, CIO Textile Workers Union organizer, for the purpose of ascertaining whether or not this individual was identical to the murderer of LEE HARVEY OSMAID.

On November 26, 1963, Captain JOSEPH MONASH, Garfield, New Jersey, Police Department, advised SA BERNARD J. PIROG that afice reading the newspapers regarding the assassination of tresident JOHN F. KENNEDY during the past few days, wherein the name OSWALD and JACK RUBY, also known as Jack Rubenstein, were mentioned, he recalled that the Garfield Police Department appeared one JACK RUBENSTEIN in 1926.

Captain MONASH stated that the records of the Garfield Police Department reveal that JACK RUBENSTEIN, age 22, who resided at 743 Main Street, Passaic, New Jersey, was an organizer for the Textile Workers Union of America during the 1926 textile strike at the Botany Mills, Passaic, New Jersey. RUBENSTEIN was arrested on February 15, 1926, on a charge of being a disorderly person. He was sentenced by Judge RICHARD BAKER, Garfield, New Jersey, on February 17, 1926, to serve 90 days on this charge in the Bergen County Jail, Hackensack, New Jersey.

Captain MONASH added that the JACK RUBENSTEIN who was apprecied in Garfield, New Jersey, in 1926 would now be 59 years of age, whereas the JACK RUBENSTEIN arrested at Dallas, Texas, where born in 1911 and would now be 52 years of age.

Captain MONASH stated that it is his recollection that the JACK RUBENSTEIN arrested in 1926 was an organizer for the Textile Workers Union of America, New York City, and may now be connected with the same organization in New York City as one of the Officials.

WILLIAM DE MARTINI, Identification Officer, Bergen County Sheriff's Office, Hackensack, New Jersey, advised SA PIROG On November 26, 1963, that Record #15217 of that bureau indicates that JACK RUBENSTEIN, an organizer for the Textile Workers Union

Passalc, New York City, residing at 743 Main Avenue, Passalc, New Jersey, was arrested as a disorderly person at Garfield, New Jersey, on February 15, 1926. He was tried by RICHARD BAKER, Magistrate of the Garfield Municipal Court, Garfield, New Jersey, on February 17, 1926, and was sentenced to a term of 90 days' confinement in the Bergen County Jail, Mackensack, New Jersey.

On February 18, 1926, Judge WILLIAM SEIFERT of the Bergen County Common Pleas Court, Hackensack, New Jersey, released RUBENSTEIN on \$500 bail and ordered a review of the conviction at the Garfield Municipal Court.

Officer DE MARTINI related that there is no further motation in the record, and he would assume that RUBENSTEIN's conviction was reversed and he was allowed to go free. He commented that his records indicate that JACK RUBENSTEIN was age 22 in 1926 and was an organizer of laborers for the Textile Workers Union of America at Passaic, New Jersey. He added that as fingerprints were taken in 1926, but there was a verification of RUBENSTEIN's age; therefore, it could be assumed that he was age 22 in 1926 and would therefore be 59 years of age at the present time.

On November 27, 1963, RICHARD WALL, Captain, Passaic, New Jersey, Police Department, advised SA JAMES R. LAUGHLIN that there is no record in his files indicating that JACK RUBENSTEIN of the Textile Workers Union of America had ever been fingerprinted. The arrest blotter for the year 1926 indicated, however, that on April 6 JACK RUBENSTEIN, age 22, was arrested at 9:02 a.m. on the Eighth Street Bridge, Passaic, New Jersey, and charged with being a disorderly person. Captain WALL added that his records indicate that RUBENSTEIN was committed as a result of this charge and was sentenced to serve six months in the County Jail on April 27, 1926.

NOBENSTEIN's age was given as 22 in April, 1926, he was born in New York City, and his address at the time of his arrest

JOHN M. TANIS, Warden, Passaic County Jail, Faterson, West Jersey, advised SA JOHN R. LYONS on November 27, 1963, that there was no identification bureau in Passaic County until 1930,

and there is no record of a JACK RUBENSTEIN ever having been dingerprinted. The record of commitment concerning RUBENSTEIN indicated he was 22 years of age in 1926, was 5'7" tall, was bown in New York City, and his occupation was given as a laborer. His marital status was single, his father was reported as living, and his mother as deceased.

Warden TANIS added that RUBENSTEIN's record also indicates that on April 28, 1926, RUBENSTEIN was released on bail.
