In interview 12/21/63, RUBY advised FBI Agents that on unrecalled date he had noted item in newspaper concerning conviction in Houston, Texas, area of individual, name not recalled, for smuggling guns or other items to Cuba; that he had made effort to contact this person unsuccessfully, thinking he might arrange for a shipment of jeeps to Cuba; that nothing came of this effort.

It appears ROBERT RAY McKEOWN was the individual RUBY referred to.

A reproduced copy of interview with McKEOWN on 1/24/64, at Houston is enclosed for your assistance.

Mrs. NORMA GIDEON, Cherokee Steel, Incorporated, 130 North Rockford, Tulsa, Oklahoma, made available for review the file regarding former employee RALPH EUGENE YOUNG, Social Security Number 430-40-2853.

YOUNG was employed May 4, 1960, as a truck driver and his employment was terminated on August 7, 1961, for drinking on the job. He claimed five exemptions on his withholding statement. His address in May, 1960, was listed as 1811 East Second Street, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and in July, 1960, as 6947 East Virgin Place, Tulsa, Oklahoma.

A letter and file dated December 29, 1961, to Cherokee Steel, Incorporated, from YOUNG requested his income tax statement be sent to 709 West Prospect, Harrison, Arkansas.

A notice of application for unemployment compensation, Oklahoma Employment Security Commission, dated March 6, 1962, from the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission, Interstate Unit, American National Building, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, stated that YOUNG had applied for unemployment benefits under the Oklahoma Employment Security Act.

The file contained a report of an automobile accident or loss of the Standard Insurance Company, Tulsa, Oklahoma, showing that YOUNG, while operating company unit 101, on highway 34, two and one half miles south of Lutesville, Missouri, on May 13, 1961, got off the shoulder of the road when meeting a car which failed to dim its lights and when he got back on the road the truck jackknifed and did damage to the radiator and fan.

His application showed his local address as 1811 East Second Street, Tulsa, Oklahoma. It showed his permanent address as Marshall, Arkansas.

He is employed as a truck driver by Creamer and Dunlap, Incorporated, 1900 West 21st Street, Tulsa, Oklahoma. He has lived in Tulsa, with the exception of approximately seven months, since September, 1959, and he was born in St. Joe, Arkansas, and has never lived in the state of Texas and is not an engineer. His prior employment for the past six or seven years has been that of a truck driver. He has never been employed by the Chance - Vought Aircraft Company in Dallas or Grand Prairie, Texas. He has never lived in Bridgeton, Missouri, nor has he ever lived in the state of Ohio.

YOUNG has had the following previous employers:

Oklahoma Waste Paper Company, Tulsa, Oklahoma, September, 1959 to January, 1960;

Board of Education, January, 1960 to April, 1960;

Inspector JAMES MALLEY advised today that in connection with another request of this office, he had a conversation with BURT GRIFFIN of the Commission's staff and he wanted us to get photographs of all the property of RUBY in WADE's possession. MALLEY told him that in view of the fact the case was still on appeal, that it would not be proper for us to go to District Attorney WADE and ask permission to take photographs of all this property. He now has a letter from WADE saying that he will be happy to make everything available to us, but that some of it has been turned over to the City authorities. (MALLEY said he assumes this means the PD.) When he (GRIFFIN) was down here himself, he talked to Deputy Chief BATCHELOR, and he claimed that he would be glad to do it, but that he didn't have ~~all~~ the material; it was in the possession of WADE. MALLEY said they would like to have photographs of everything they had concerning RUCY, and mentioned that if we run across anything that is in the form of a little booklet or written material, that they want photos of everything on a page by page basis.

Inspector MALLEY stated that WADE said he had sent a letter to effect that he would make material in his possession available. A letter will be sent down to Dallas Office, but Mr. MALLEY stated there is no objection to handling this request before we get the letter.

I mentioned that WADE stated he didn't actually know what he had -- that it is just piled in boxes, but that we will go and get whatever he has.

Mr. MALLEY instructed to go and get what the District Attorney's office has and then try to get what there is at the PD, and submit same with statement that this is what they made available.

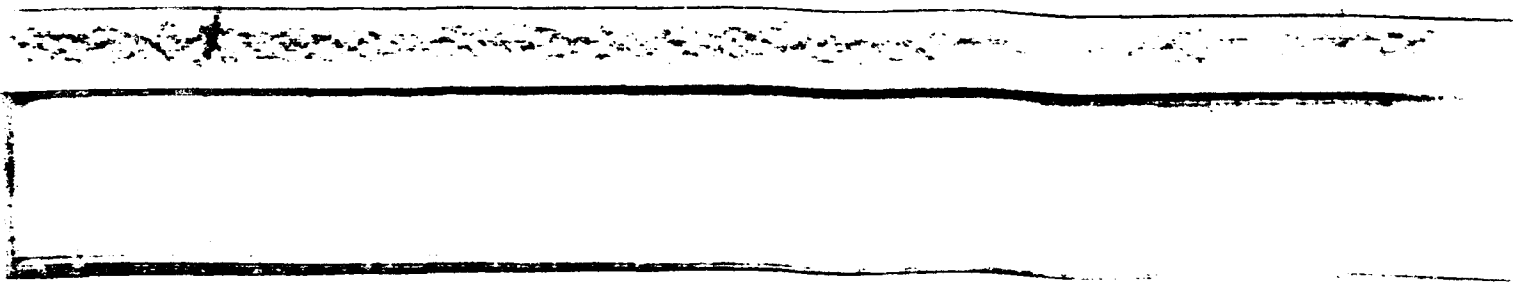
