On 6/12/64 SA DEAN C. KOLSTON contacted ROBERT V. HOLLAND, Attorney, associated with Bogle, Bogle, and Gates, Norton Building, Seattle, Washington, who advised that his office has been attempting to locate JAMES ECKFORD BREEN since the summer of 1963 inasmuch as BREEN is alleged to be a necessary witness in a lw suit.

Mr. HOLLAND stated that as of 8/22/63 they had received word from a San Francisco representative that an investigation had been conducted to locate BREEN at San Francisco with negative results. He stated that as of today, no pending investigation is being conducted to locate BREEN; however, his office desired to obtain BREEN's current address so he can be interviewed as a witness. He advised that he would greatly appreciate being informed if the whereabouts of BREEN were determined.

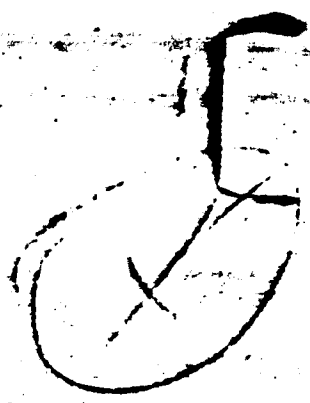

JAMES O. PATTERSON, also known as "Pat" Patterson, Department 513, Badge 7216, Martin Company, residing 2409 Ashland Boulevard, Sylvan Highlands, Orlando, Florida, advised as follows:

He formerly resided at 900 Ferndell Road, Orlando, and he is slightly acquainted with RALPH EUGENE YOUNG. He advised that for a period of about twelve months in about 1957-58 he worked with YOUNG at the Redstone Arsenal, Huntsville, Alabama, while both were employed by the Southern Association Engineers, with home office near Boston, Massachusetts. PATTERSON said that his acquaintance with YOUNG was not close but that he and YOUNG did make a business trip to California in about 1957 on which occasion he has recollections of YOUNG being arrested for intoxication, possibly at Southgate or Huntington Park near Los Angeles. PATTERSON stated that YOUNG did use intoxicants to excess upon occasion.

PATTERSON stated that he has no information as to the present whereabouts of YOUNG and has no recollection of filling out any employment questionnaires on YOUNG. He said that some three or so years ago he read an article written by YOUNG in the "PI News," a trade-type publication published in the Dallas-Fort Worth, Texas, area. In this article YOUNG referred to the fact that he was employed by ABCO, a firm believed located in Tennessee, possibly Nashville, Tennessee.

PATTERSON stated that he does not know YOUNG's friends and acquaintances and has no reason to believe that YOUNG knows JACK L. RUBY.

The following investigation was conducted by SA ROBERT S. CLIFFORD on June 9, 1964:

Mrs. IRENE MORELLI, Manager, Airport Trailer Coach Park, 10640 Gratiot, Detroit, Michigan, advised that the management of this trailer court has changed hands since 1952, Mrs. MORELLI being manager for the past eight years. She further advised that the old records of residents of the trailer court are no longer available and that she is unable to locate any record of RALPH EUGENE YOUNG having been a resident of this trailer court. Mrs. MORELLI also stated this individual was unknown to her and that she has had no inquiries concerning him.

Mrs. MARY GUDENAU, Office Manager, Dolphyn Engineering Company, 31485 Groesbeck Road, Fraser, Michigan, advised that she was able to locate a card which indicated RALPH EUGENE YOUNG was employed by this company in "December of 1951" and another card which showed him employed in "1952". The addresses were shown respectively as 740 and 704 West North Street, Sidney, Ohio. 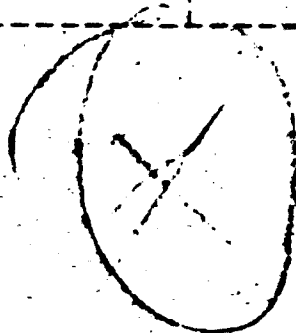

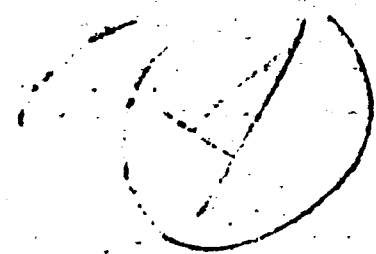

On June 6, 1964, Mrs. BETTY WOOLEY, nee YOUNG, residence address Route 1, Versailles, Ohio, was interviewed at her employment, The Pangles Supermarket, Sidney, Ohio. She advised that she is a sister of RALPH EUGENE YOUNG and that she has not seen him since the summer of 1963, and has no idea as to his present whereabouts. She advised that her parents, CHARLES E. and PEARL A. YOUNG are deceased, having died in 1959 and 1960 respectively. In addition, her brother ROBERT YOUNG is also deceased, having died in 1961. She advised that she has one living brother besides RALPH, who is WILLIAM YOUNG, whose whereabouts are unknown, and who about a year or so ago was last known to be residing in Versailles, Ohio. She has two sisters, LAURA DICKMAN and ANNABELLE BARGA, who both reside in Sidney, Ohio.

Her brother, RALPH, was originally married to VIRGINIA YOUNG, whom he divorced many years ago and who has since re-married, and whose last name is MC CLUSKY. She resides at Piqua, Ohio. Her brother RALPH had two sons, RALPH F. YOUNG, Age about 30, residence address 519 Orr Street, Piqua, Ohio, and CHARLES YOUNG, Age about 28, 1018 Wedgewood Drive, Columbus, Ohio.

She advised her brother, RALPH, is the type of person who seldom visits or communicates with his relatives, and that when she saw him in the summer of 1963, it was the first time that he had visited the Versailles, Ohio, area in several years. His only reason for returning home on this occasion was to insure that he received his full amount of the settlement of his parents' estate. When he visited her, he was driving a Pontiac automobile and pulling a large trailer. He advised that he was now living in a trailer and did not say where he had been residing, but did mention that he was between jobs and might possibly locate in Tennessee. He did not further elaborate as to the job he was anticipating accepting or the town in Tennessee where he would be residing.
