ACCORDING TO MRS. KAMINSKY, RUBY SPOKE WITH MRS. TICE ON NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO LAST AT PARKLAND HOSPITAL, DALLAS, AT WHICH TIME, ACCORDING TO MRS. KAMINSKY, RUBY SAID TO MRS. TICE HE WOULD BE WILLING TO DONATE HIS KIDNEY TO GOVERNOR CONNALLY.

COMMISSION REQUESTS MRS. TICE BE INTERVIEWED TO DETERMINE ALL THE DETAILS OF HER MEETING WITH RUBY AT PARKLAND HOSPITAL, INCLUDING PRECISE INFORMATION AS TO THE TIME AND PLACE, THE NAMES OF ANY OTHER PERSONS WHOM SHE KNOWS TO HAVE SEEN RUBY AT THE

HOSPITAL ON NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO.

EVA GRANT, RUBY'S SISTER, DALLAS, VOLUNTEERED TO BUREAU AGENT, PRIOR TO RECEIPT OF COMMISSION LETTER, THAT MRS. TICE, WHO HAD NOT PREVIOUSLY KNOWN RUBY BUT WHO HAS LATER RECOGNIZED HIM FROM NEWSPAPER AND TV PHOTOS, WAS AT PARKLAND HOSPITAL, DALLAS, ON NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO AND HARD TWO OR THREE MEN TALKING, ONE BEING RUBY, AT ABOUT THREE P.M., NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO. ACCORDING TO GRANT, TICE CLAIMED THERE WAS SOME DISCUSSION ABOUT GOVERNOR CONNALLY NEEDING A KIDNEY AS A RESULT OF INJURIES SUSTAINED COINCIDENTAL WITH SHOOTING OF PRESIDENT, THAT ONE OF THE MEN SAID IN EFFECT "WHO WOULD WANT TO GIVE UP ONE OF THEIR OWN KIDNEYS", TO WHICH RUBY REPLIED THAT HE WOULD.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION, THE ONLY OTHER ALLEGATION RUBY WAS AT PARKLAND HOSPITAL ON NOVEMBER TWENTY-TWO WAS BY SETH KANTOR, SCRIPPS-HOWARD REPORTER, WHO WROTE ARTICLE STATING THAT WHILE AT PARKLAND HOSPITAL, SOMEONE TAPPED HIM IN SHOULDER AND HE TURNED TO DISCOVER IT WAS RUBY, WHOM HE HAD KNOWN FOR SEVERAL YEARS, KANTOR HAVING BEEN PREVIOUSLY ASSIGNED IN DALLAS AREA. RUBY DENIES BEING AT PARKLAND AND OTHER INVESTIGATION WOULD TEND TO ESTABLISH HE WAS NOT THERE AT ANY TIME.

IT IS HIGHLY IMPORTANT MRS. TICE

On the morning of 6/29/64 [REDACTED] telephone [REDACTED], Dallas, Texas, telephoned the Dallas Office and talked to SA ROBERT P. GEMBERLING. Miss [REDACTED] said she had information relating to the shooting of LEE HARVEY OSWALD but refused to discuss it over the telephone. She said she would come to the Dallas Office for an interview. At 2:00 p.m., 6/29/64, [REDACTED] came to the Dallas Office and was interviewed by SA A. RAYMOND SWITZER.

[REDACTED] Dallas Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, 323 S. Industrial Blvd., Dallas, Texas. [REDACTED] said on 11/24/63 she received a telephone call from the Dallas Police Department and they informed her that RUBY had three dogs in his apartment and requested she have them picked up. [REDACTED] said she later telephoned the Dallas Police Department and told them she would not pick up the dogs unless they could give her some type of protection. She said at that time they informed her that RUBY's sister was going to care for the dogs. [REDACTED] stated one of the dogs that RUBY owned was a female German shepherd and she knows he used this dog for sex purposes. She said she does not recall where she got this information but believes it to be true.

[REDACTED] informed that she knows many of the people at City Hall and has had much contact with city officials and with the Dallas Police Department. She said that on the day, 11/24/63, when the Dallas Police were preparing to move LEE HARVEY OSWALD from the City Jail, Chief M. W. STEVENSON, Criminal Investigations Division, Dallas Police Department, cleared the

basement of photographers and newspapermen. Later, she stated Assistant Chief of Police, CHARLES BATCHELOR permitted newspapermen and photographers in the basement area. She said it was at this time that JACK RUBY also came into the basement of the Dallas Police Department. She said in her opinion OSWALD would be alive today if Assistant Chief of Police BATCHELOR had not countermanded the order of Chief STEVENSON. Further, she stated the shooting of OSWALD by RUBY was due to carelessness on the part of the Dallas Police Department.

[REDACTED] said she obtained the above information from a long time female employee at the Dallas Police Department but declined to furnish her name. [REDACTED] requested that her name be held in confidence.

No action is recommended on the above and it is being made a matter of record only.
