Enclosed herewith for the Dallas office is a letter from U. S. Secret Service, San Antonio, Texas, to the San Antonio FBI office dated 7/8/64.

This letter contains results of Secret Service interviews with EDWARD HOUSEHOLDER and his wife, IRENE HOUSEHOLDER. The contents of this letter are self-explanatory and San Antonio is conducting no investigation in this matter in view of the nature of the information.

This matter is being furnished the Dallas office for information purposes and any action deemed appropriate.

The EDWARD HOUSEHOLDER mentioned in enclosed Secret Service letter appears to be identical with the subject of a closed case in the San Antonio Division entitled, [REDACTED]

A review of that file reflects that prosecution was declined on HOUSEHOLDER. Inasmuch as it would appear to have no bearing on instant matter, details of San Antonio file 87-2006 are not being set forth herein.

On 7/17/64, BELL P. HERNDON called from the Bureau and advised RANKIN had made arrangements for everything concerning the polygraph except for the following things, which he wanted taken care of here:

1. Make sure there will be a polygraph chair in the Dallas County Jail, if they don't have one there.
2. In view of the fact this is an official interview with RUBY, we will need a good, mature Agent to be available to be present during the entire interview to handle the FI-302. The Commission specifically ruled out HALL, and it should not be a man who has previously interviewed RUBY or is personally acquainted with him. There will be a court reporter there, but this Agent will have to make notes for the FD-302.
3. If HALL is available, he would like to get together with him because of technical aspects which HALL could help him with.

The Agent who is going to work with HERNDON should pick him up at the airport. He is due in on American Airlines flight 121, which arrives 10:55 Dallas time.

SPECTOR may be on the same plane.

HERNDON is 5'9", wears dark blue suit, no hat, 170 pounds.

Reference is made to the interview with RUBY with polygraph on 7/18/64. I telephonically contacted Assistant Director IVAN CONRAD and requested advice as to exactly how he wanted FD-302 prepared pointing out ordinarily no mention is made of polygraph in FD-302. He stated he would consult with Inspector MALLEY and polygraph operator HERNDON and call back.

Upon calling back, he stated he had come to the conclusion that the FD-302 interview should be handled just as they are normally handled and all the by-play and other information should be put on the Administrative page. When this was received they would then submit by letter to the Commission the results of the polygraph. The word polygraph or polygraph examination will not be mentioned in the FD-302.

On this date, I talked with WILLIAM A. BRANIGAN concerning MARGUERITE OSWALD's request to have a written request for copies to be made of exhibits in her possession.

Mr. BRANIGAN advised such a letter should be written today.

I also talked with Inspector J. R. MALLEY, who advised the polygraph examination for JACK RUBY is on again. TOMAHILL called RANKIN today and told him he had been in touch with FOWLER and FOWLER wanted to get it out of the way tomorrow. RANKIN had SPECTOR call MALLEY, who made arrangements for him to get in touch with HERNDON. The Commission is apparently working it out with the attorneys. TOMAHILL called RANKIN and said FOWLER is agreeable to this, and FOWLER is apparently being talked to by SPECTOR and it comes down to where RANKIN said in view of this request, he wants us to be in a position to say we had people there to try to give the polygraph, whether it comes off or not. At least we tried.

The only request SPECTOR had of us in addition to having the polygraph man in Dallas, was for the Dallas Office to call Sheriff DECKER and tell them they want to go through with the polygraph at whatever time they set up. When HERNDON talked to SPECTOR, he was supposed to find out what time the interview is being scheduled for. They are dealing with everyone in this thing, except the Sheriff, which we are to arrange. HERNDON might like to talk to HALL before starting the interview.
