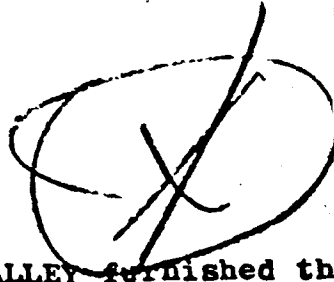

The above information was furnished telephonically to Supervisor GEORGE SCATTERDAY, SOG, 11:45 a.m., 7/21/64.

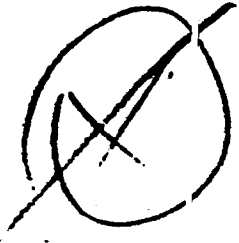

Reference is made to the article appearing in "The Dallas Times Herald" on Wednesday, 7/22/64, referring to full text of the test given RUBY.

It is noted that at approximately 2:30 this afternoon I was talking to Mr. EMMETT COLVIN, who referred to the article appearing in "The Dallas Morning News" and he stated that he and Mr. FOWLER were concerned over the fact that it was unfavorable to RUBY and that FOWLER had indicated he might release the favorable portion. I made no comment, except to state that we had not released anything and that he might desire to talk to RANKIN about it.

Shortly thereafter, the paper appeared and I had already placed a call for Mr. FOWLER. When talking to him, I mentioned the story and he stated he had not yet seen it. He did state, however, that he had made up a list of questions and answers as best he could and had furnished the same to Attorney SOL DANN in Detroit, Michigan, and to EARL RUBY in Detroit. He also stated that SOL DANN was coming in today and that DANN had advised him that he, TONAHILL and BURLESON were all fired. He did not know exactly what their status was. He indicated he was going to look at the paper and it is entirely possible these items had either been released by DANN or EARL RUBY, although he does not know.

Mr. EMMETT COLVIN, Attorney, called and advised that he had seen the article in the "Dallas Morning News" and that the statements made therein were inaccurate regarding what RUBY had supposedly said. While he did not believe that the FBI had made any release concerning the polygraph test, he wanted to be reassured.

I advised him that we had made no comments whatsoever to the press and that the information in this article certainly had not come from any representative of the FBI.

He then mentioned the fact that he understood that a Better Business Bureau report here in Dallas reflects that there is some fund being raised for the RUBY appeal in Chicago, and that the name of BARNEY ROSS, the ex-boxer, may be associated with it. He stated he and Attorney CLAYTON FOWLER have no knowledge of any such fund and that he just wanted to bring this to our attention. If it is being raised, then it is being raised without their knowledge.

Reference is made to memorandum indicating Mrs. TICE claims she had been threatened not to appear before the WARREN Commission, and that apparently a prowler had been at her house in the early morning of 7/22/64, and she connected the two.

Reporter EWELL of the "Dallas Morning News" called and gave me the basic facts as reflected from the police blotter, which reflected that Detective TUTTLE of the Police Department had notified the FBI early this a.m., and he wanted to know what we were doing about it. I told him I was not at liberty at this time to make any statement, but he could call back, and I would check into it to see what was being done.

I telephonically advised Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY at 1:50 p.m., of the facts as well as pointing out to him where the interview with TICE could be found in SA CLEMENTS' report of 7/17/64. I told him we had interviewed her and very possibly this was all a figment of her imagination, but that we would send a teletype this date.

I got switched over to Inspector KEMPER and told him of the request from the newspaper and recommended that I answer the newspaper reporter by saying the Dallas police had brought this to our attention, but that any further questions would have to be answered with "No comment", as I could make no statement as to any pending investigation. He agreed.

At approximately/B. P. HERNDON, FBI Lab Polygraph Operator telephonically advised UPI release had appeared in the Washington papers giving alleged results of test given to RUBY. The results were given as similar to those given in the Dallas papers. Mr. HERNDON advised the Director had written in blue ink, "I assume none of this is coming from the FBI."

Mr. HERNDON stated the purpose of his call is to verify that nothing had been released by the FBI and desired to know the source. I advised him I did not know the source, and it could have come from anyone present, and could have been merely an observation made by one of them. I assured him it did not come from the FBI in Dallas.

Mr. HERNDON advised he would write a memo for the record that we actually had no idea who gave the statement, and that this info could be strictly observations or speculations of a general nature from stories going around Dallas the last few months that RUBY had stated he planned on killing OSWALD to prevent Mrs. KENNEDY's having to come to Dallas to testify, etc.

Mr. HERNDON requested clippings from the Dallas papers be sent to the Bureau. I advised him those available had already been sent and any future clippings would be forwarded to the Bureau.

Mr. HERNDON further advised he had told the COMMISSION that if RUBY is psychotic, the tests would be inconclusive and would have no significance.

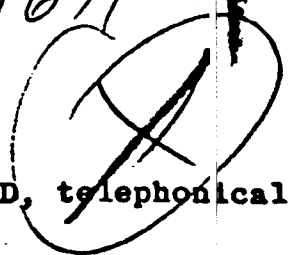

Mrs. WILMA TWICE contacted the Dallas PD shortly after midnight and reported a prowler about her home at 8406 Lakemont, Dallas, Texas, FL 2-2559. A Dallas Police Car was dispatched to her home where it was found her two outside doors were blocked preventing anyone from leaving the house (allegedly by the prowler). Mrs. TWICE advised the Police Officer on the scene she received a letter from the WARREN COMMISSION requesting her testimony concerning an unknown aspect of the Kennedy assassination. She also advised the Officer that after receiving the letter she had received a threatening phone call from an unknown male on July 21, last telling her to "keep her mouth shut or be killed." Mrs. TWICE believes the same person is the prowler that was at her home this morning.

As a result of the inability to locate any documentation, Mr. MALLEY contacted the Commission to find the basis for the Commission's request in the letter. Inspector MALLEY advised that the individual handling this particular phase of the investigation was Mr. BURT GRIFFIN of the Commission and he is to be in Dallas, Friday, 7/24/64, and Saturday, 7/25/64, and can be contacted through the USA's Office. Mr. MALLEY suggested that we contact Mr. GRIFFIN to determine the basis for the letter.

Mr. MALLEY also advised that it was his understanding that difficulty was being encountered as to determining the identity of HARRY OLSEN. Mr. MALLEY stated that HARRY OLSEN is a former Dallas Police officer who dated one of RUBY's strip tease girls. He stated he was furnishing this information for whatever assistance it may be.

At 3:30 p.m., on 7/22/64, Captain JOHN WILL FRITZ, Homicide and Robbery Bureau, Dallas Police Department, inquired as to the information this office had on ~~WILMA TICE~~. FRITZ stated he understood this Bureau had interviewed Mrs. TICE in St. Louis and he wondered if at that time she advised how she established contact with EVA GRANT and EILEEN KAMINSKY. FRITZ was advised this information was not immediately available but that he would be recontacted.

Captain FRITZ was recontacted and informed that Mrs. TICE informed that on 1/23/64 she was involved in an automobile accident in Dallas and that she was bedridden until 4/21/64. During this time in bed, she felt that EVA GRANT, RUBY's sister in Dallas, must be undergoing emotional difficulties as a result of the OSWALD shooting. She stated she decided to telephone Mrs. GRANT and express her sympathy and as nearly as she could recall she believes she did telephone EVA GRANT's residence in mid-February, 1964, and spoke to EILEEN KAMINSKY, RUBY's sister. It was during this first call that Mrs. TICE told EILEEN she believed she saw JACK RUBY at the Parkland Hospital emergency entrance on 11/22/63.

FRITZ was also advised that Mrs. TICE said she almost regretted having made her call to EVA GRANT because each time EVA GRANT would call her it made her, Mrs. TICE, very nervous. Mrs. TICE explained that she normally did not have a nervous condition but as a result of her automobile accident she did.

FRITZ stated he was aware that Mrs. TICE was scheduled to testify before the President's Commission in Dallas on 7/24/64.

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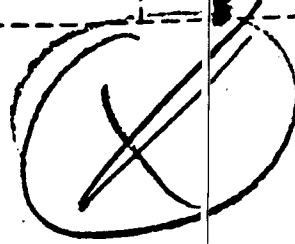

Mr. SLEIGHT stated he had forgotten SWINFORD's name but thought he had talked to SA SWITZER.

Mr. SLEIGHT advised that as a result of the interview by SA SWINFORD he had determined that W. C. CAUGHRON, a Merchant Patrolman, Smith Detective Agency, telephone number RI 1-1011, and who nightly used to check the Sleight Speed Wash, might have some information concerning JACK RUBY and LEE HARVEY OSWALD.
