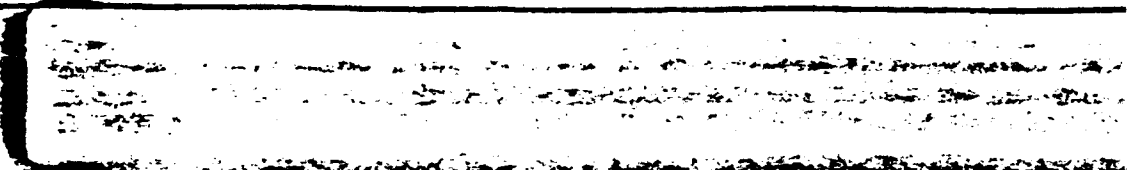

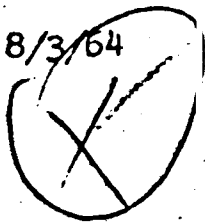

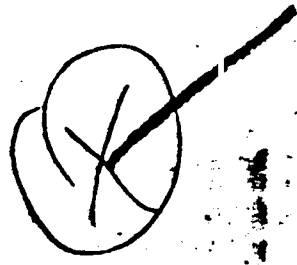

By airtel dated 7/27/64 the Bureau forwarded several invoices of the Dallas Police Department's property room which were in possession of the President's Commission to this office. The Bureau requested that these invoices be exhibited to the property clerks. These clerks were to be interviewed for the purpose of determining from whom and the manner in which they received the property listed on the invoices. The Bureau requested that these clerks be asked to initial copies of these invoices. For the information of the New Orleans Division, one of the property clerks who was employed by the Dallas Police Department on 2/18/64 was Mr. BILLIE JOE SMITH who signed Dallas Police Department Invoice No. 14580G.

Inquiry at the Dallas Police Department reflects that BILLIE JOE SMITH is presently employed by the Texas Instrument Company at Metairie, Louisiana. The Texas Instrument Company office is located in the Ingram Building, 2848 Veterans Highway, which according to the Dallas Police Department is a suburb of New Orleans.

The Bureau has requested that these property clerks be questioned to determine whether any property not listed in these invoices was ~~not~~ to the knowledge of the property clerks taken from RUBY at the time of his arrest; would all such property normally be listed in a property invoice, and were any other property

invoices completed upon RUBY's arrest. The Bureau also requested that the property clerks be asked whether they were aware of any loose press cards or badges that were found lying in the basement after RUBY's apprehension on 11/24/63.

For the further information of the New Orleans Division, SMITH, along with WILLIE MILLS DICKEY, another property clerk, listed other properties that have been viewed by DICKEY and initialed. The invoice being enclosed for the purpose of viewing by SMITH is the only one in which SMITH signed alone.

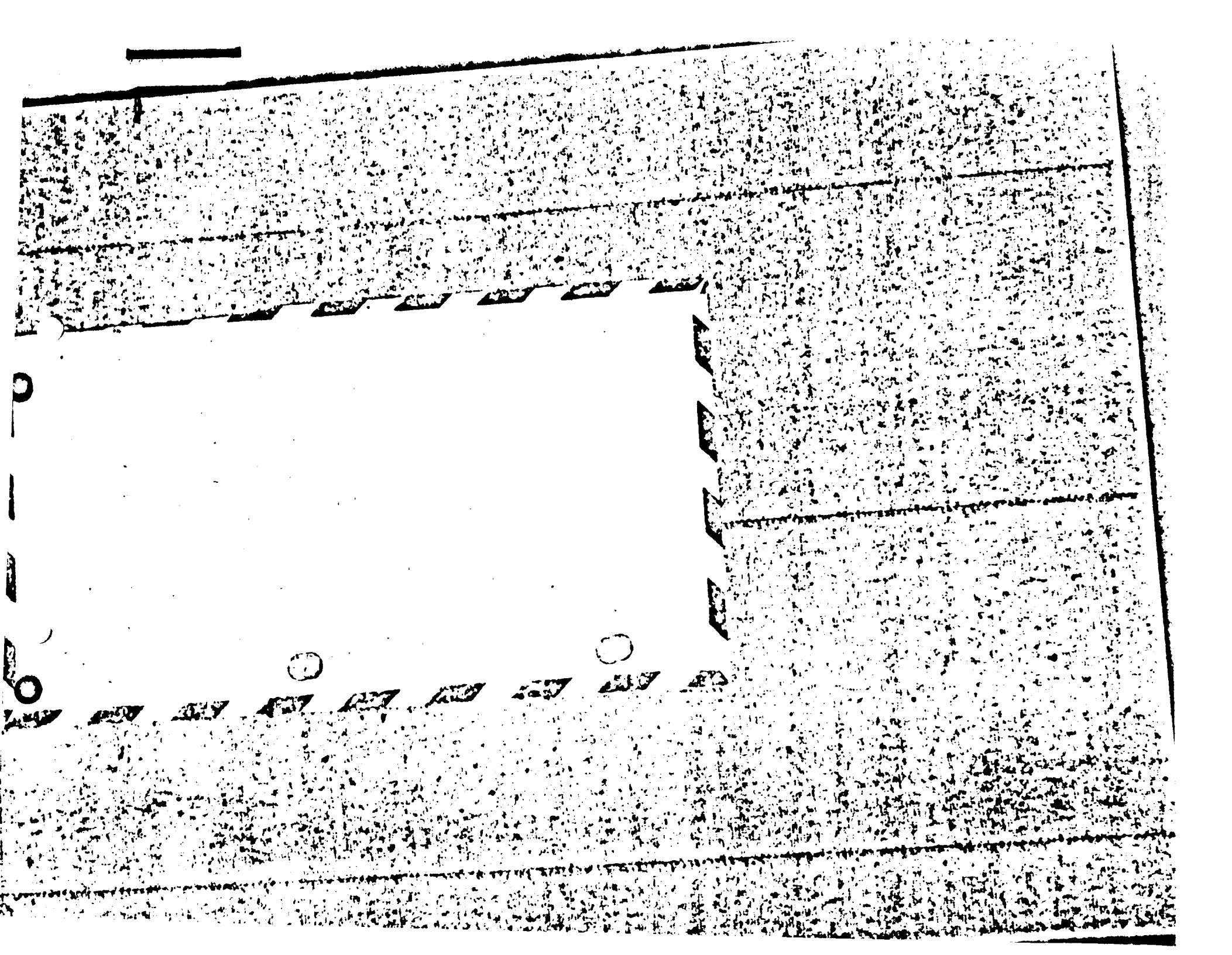

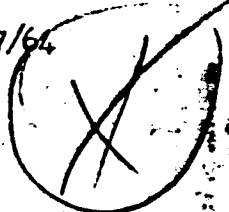

At 2:00 PM today RICHARD D. ROGGE, Bureau Headquarters, advised that they had received a transcription of MARK LANE's conversation with GRAY over a Radio Station. On page 3 of the transcript, which is being sent to Dallas Office, it is stated that the FBI announced for the first time that the Italian carbine was purchased by OSWALD under the name . It goes on to say that FBI Chief in Dallas, Gordon Shanklin, is quoted in the New York Times and other publications and he said that he has seen the paraffin tests which show that OSWALD had gunshot wounds on his face and hands, and since these were on his hands and face, it is proof that he shot the gun.

Mr. ROGGE suggested that I should submit a statement to effect that the statements attributed to me are completely unfounded. He pointed out that there never were any paraffin tests, that he (ROGGE) ^{knew there} has never been any such release made, and there is nothing to this effect in the New York Times.

Mr. ROGGE said there are three more requests of the Commission on the way to the Dallas Office. He stated that SHIRLEY MARTIN is writing again; that she sometimes writes as often as three times a week, and she is claiming some man saw EUBY in the hospital and this man was a representative for the Oklahoma City Times. The Bureau has furnished to the Commission every letter which MARTIN writes, and they are requesting investigation. Mr. ROGGE said there does not appear to be any letup in the Commission's requests.

ADDENDUM: On 8/17/64, I called Bureau and asked for Supv. ROGGE. In his absence, I advised KEN RAUPACH that I had not received referenced communication, and he stated he would check up and try to find what had happened.

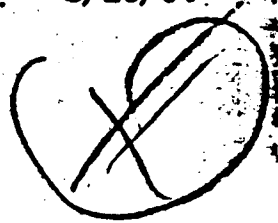

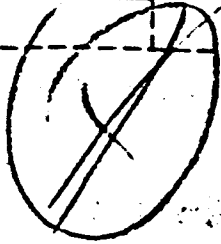
