a quick one. Shorman told The Independent he grabbed a guy at the bar who couldn't pay for a drink. Ruby and an off-duty policeman beat the man up terribly and threw him down the stairs of the second-floor club."

SHORMAN HEARD many stories about Ruby when he started working at the club. None of them were encouraging.

"We heard he was usually in trouble with the police—those he didn't do favors for, anyway," Shorman said. We heard he was arrested at least once for carrying a concealed weapon.

"He used to make vague references to his departure from Chicago. He would say, 'Things got too hot for me there.' We heard it had something to do with gangland activities."

According to Shorman, Ruby is anything but an idealist. He encouraged bartenders to short-change and otherwise "soak" customers. He used B-Girls to hook the suckers, Shorman said.

"The only ideal he had was making a buck," Shorman declared.

* * * * *

"THEY WILL probably try to defend him by saying he was patriotic or something. He wasn't."

Ruby made "a big deal" out of the fact that he neither smoked nor drank. "He was always bragging about it," Shorman said.

If there was one dominant characteristic of Ruby's personality, according to Shorman, it was his compulsive need to be the center of attention.

"He was always looking for attention," Shorman said. "He wanted to be the center attraction. He wanted to be in the limelight when anything was happening.

"If I was to choose any particular reason why he might have shot Oswald, I'd say it was that—plus that mean and violent temper of his."

* * * * *

SHORMAN SAID the Carousel was a favorite hangout for Dallas policemen—patrolmen and detectives—and that the police seldom had to pay for drinks there.

"Ruby knew most of the policemen and they knew him."

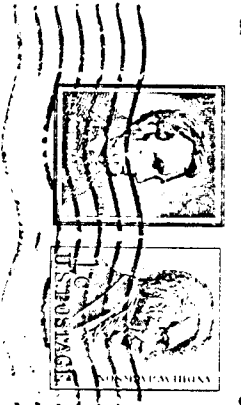

Gentlemen:

During the rapid sequence of events and disclosures yesterday, one short item was broadcast, which seems not to have been again referred to but, at the time, seemed potentially fruitful if followed through. I made no note mental or otherwise at the time as to the station to which I was tuned on my radio, nor to the time of the day, but I am sure it was in the early afternoon.

It seemed that a microphone-carrying newsman had noticed Rubenstein nod or speak to someone in the crowd soon after he was arrested; and the newsman sought them out and asked whether they were friends of Rubenstein. One of them spoke with a heavy accent, while the other attempted to reply but was obliged to explain that he spoke very little English. The spokesman of the two admitted being acquainted with 'Ruby' and said that he had 'dropped up' to see him a few times. He also remarked that his foreign friend had remarked, "Why, that's the fellah we went to see!" The short interview concluded indistinctly with a reference that sounded like, "He is putting in/a telephone call to Warsaw."

In view of ^{Oswald's} doing a certain amount of 'singing', especially about his experiences in Russia and his friendliness toward communism, one may well wonder whether the cash found on Rubenstein or in his possession could have been channeled from somewhere beyond the Iron Curtain.

It is not that I feel capable of helping your great organization to evaluate such things, but I just wondered whether the item had come under your scrutiny, and make this mention to you for whatever it may be worth.

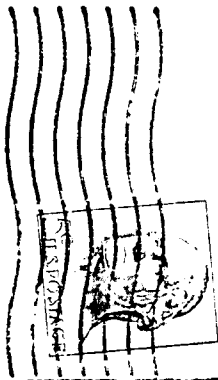

She maintained that Mr. SORRELS should be removed from his position as he was incompetent and did not have the ability to protect the President. She stated he was definitely anti-government, against the KENNEDY administration, and she felt his position was against the security of not only the President but the United States.

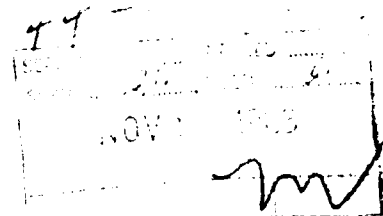

He stated he had also heard that another VINCENT T. LEE, whom he does not know whether or not is identical to the VINCENT T. LEE who formerly resided in Dallas, was to speak to the Fairplay for Cuba Committee at Buffalo, New York, at Hotel Richford, on 11/22/63.

Action: No lead is being set, and it is being left to the discretion of the co-ordinator as to whether or not a lead should be set out, inasmuch as LARRY GROVE could not furnish any information which appeared pertinent, since LARRY GROVE was just basing this on his information.
