

Dallas police sergeant J. F. Bain was standing by the railroad track

had shot. Bain said he heard someone shout "They are bringing him
out." and focused his attention on the spot where they were placing
him out. I didn't see the gun, but I heard the shot and saw the
smoke from the gun. Police officers surrounding Oswald prevented
me from seeing much else. Jack Ruby, Oswald's assassin, came from the
north entrance (in the auto entrance) from the rear. There were
many FBI agents and press representatives in the area.

Ruby jumped out from the crowd as Oswald passed and fired one quick
point blank at Oswald. Following the shot I ran from the crowd and
to the spot of the shooting to assist in the arrest. Then I saw
there officers had Ruby on the ground and were endeavoring to tie
I went then to Oswald. He was lying on the ground, unconscious and
breathing. I went over to him and found a bullet hole in his left side. Officers removed
Ruby and Oswald and put him in an ambulance and took him to
